RAY REPORT—The Rays continue a season-long, 10-game, 10-day homestand against the Nationals (2-1), Royals (four to play), and Diamondbacks (three to play) tonight at Tropicana Field...are 6-6 in their last 12 games (June 8–pres.) since dropping 10 of their previous 13 (May 24–June 7), which came on the heels of a 22-4 stretch (April 22–May 22)...have lost 7.5 games on the AL East-leading Yankees during that timeframe, whom they now trail by 2.0 games for the division lead...are 2-1 on a stretch of 23 games in 24 days leading into the All-Star break (June 19–July 12), with the lone off day coming on June 29...had the best record in the AL for 35 straight days between May 9–June 12, which included eight consecutive days atop the majors from May 18–25...have spent 41 days in first place in the AL East, 34 in second, six in third, four in fourth, and three in fifth.

- ★ The Rays earned their 19th come-from-behind victory with a 4-3 win over the Nationals to close their three-game set...they have won eight of their last nine series at Tropicana Field.
- ★ The club has won three straight rubber games at Tropicana Field (June 21 vs. WSH, 4-3; May 31 vs. LAA; May 17 vs. MIA) and is 10-2 in home series finales overall.
- ★ **Jonny DeLuca** lifted a go-ahead, two-run homer in the 7th inning that provided the game-winning RBI...see more in "Jonny DeClutch" note below.
- ★ They improved to a major league-best 17-7 (.708) against left-handed starters in 2026.
- ★ The win snapped a streak of five straight losses in one-run contests...they are now 11-8 (.579) in one-run games, fourth best in the AL.

RECENT TRANSACTIONS—Today, **OF Austin Slater** cleared waivers and elected free agency...Slater hit .273 (6-for-22) with 2 2B in seven games as a Ray.

BALLOT BOXING—Today, MLB announced the second voting update for 2026 All-Star balloting...**Junior Caminero** paces all AL third basemen with 1,310,879 votes, **Yandy Diaz** ranks third among AL designated hitters with 459,371 votes, and **Jonathan Aranda** is eighth among AL first basemen at 193,544 votes...all three are chasing their second career All-Star nods, with Caminero and Aranda aiming for their second consecutive selections...Caminero is looking to become the first Ray to start back-to-back All-Star games.

- ★ Caminero ranks highly among AL third basemen (min. 200PA, min 50% of games at 3B) in hits (12nd, 78), on-base pct. (2nd, .373), slugging pct. (2nd, .484), OPS (2nd, .857), OPS+ (2nd, 136), home runs (3rd, 15), average (4th, .280), and RBI (4th, 34).
- ★ Diaz ranks highly among AL hitters in average (1st, .326), hits (2nd, 89), on-base pct. (3rd, .406), OPS (6th, .915), RBI (T8th, 49), total bases (T9th, 139), slugging pct. (10th, .509)...he has hit safely in 54 of 71 games and reached base safely in 66 of 71 contests.

ALL RAS, NO BRAKES—Over three starts in June, tonight's probable starter, **Drew Rasmussen**, paces the AL in ERA (0.43/21.0IP 1ER), strikeout-to-walk ratio (29.00/29SO, 1BB), opp. average (.129), quality starts (T1st, 3), opp. on-base pct. (2nd, .153), WHIP (1st, 0.48), and opp. OPS (.324)...he also ranks highly in strikeouts (2nd, 29), opp. slugging pct. (2nd, .171), and wins (T6th, 2)...his 0.43 ERA is on pace to be the best ERA in a month in franchise history (min. 30.0IP), the lowest in the AL since **OAK/HOU Scott Kazmir** (0.26) in July 2015, and the lowest by an AL right-hander since **OAK Cory Lidle** (0.20) in August 2002.

- ★ He is the second Rays arm in team history to throw 20.0 innings or more, with one or zero runs allowed and 29 strikeouts or more in a three-start span, joining **Blake Snell** (June 25–July 7, 2018 - 21.2IP 1R, 29SO)...his 29 strikeouts over a three-start span are the most by a Ray since **Tyler Glasnow** (31SO, June 25–July 7, 2023), and he is the fourth Ray (5x, see table on the right) to have 29 strikeouts or more with one or zero walks in a three-start span.
- ★ He is seeking to become the third pitcher in franchise history to be named an All-Star in consecutive seasons alongside **McClanahan** (2022-23) and **David Price** (2010-12).

CAMICAN—**Junior Caminero** went 3-for-3 with an intentional walk Saturday vs. WSH, his seventh game reaching base safely four times or more, tying **HOU Yordan Alvarez** and **LAA Mike Trout** for the most in the AL...in all of MLB, only **WSH James Wood** (10G) has more such games...the three hits tied his season high, matching June 5 at MIA...his .373 on-base pct. on the season ranks 14th in the AL and marks a 62-point improvement from 2025 (.311), tied for the ninth-largest year-to-year increase in the majors...he has reached base at a .404 clip since the calendar flipped to May, seventh in the majors.

ARANDA & ARAÑITA—Through the team's first 74 games this season, **Yandy Diaz** has reached base safely 127 times and **Jonathan Aranda** has reached base 121 times...Diaz's 127 TOB are the most in team history through this point of the season, while Aranda's 121 TOB are tied for sixth most with **Junior Caminero** and **Carl Crawford** (see table on the right)...the duo have combined for 100 RBI (Aranda, 51 & Diaz, 49) thus far this season, the first Rays pairing to accomplish the feat through 74 team games since **Evan Longoria** (52) & **Carlos Peña** (48) in 2010...only four pairings have accomplished the feat in team history (Longoria/Peña in 2010 & 2009, **Fred McGriff/Gerald Williams** in 2000, and **Jose Canseco/McGriff** in 1999).

- ★ Diaz (445) plated 1 RBI yesterday to move one shy of **Brandon Lowe** (446) for seventh most in franchise history, two shy of **B.J. Upton** (447) for sixth most, and four shy of **Aubrey Huff** (449) for fifth most.
- ★ After going 0-for-11 in the series against the Tigers between June 1-3, Aranda has recorded a hit in 11 of 14 games (June 5–pres.) with four multi-hit contests and has reached base safely in 13 of 14.

JONNY DECLUTCH—**Jonny DeLuca** lifted a go-ahead, two-run home run in the 7th inning of yesterday's matinee...he has homered in back-to-back games with a PA for the first time in his career (June 19–pres.)...each of his four home runs this season have come in the 7th inning or later, with nine of his 12 career long balls coming in the 7th or later...the Rays are 20-4 when DeLuca hits safely in 2026, including 14 straight wins...in wins (32G), he is batting .297 (30-for-101) with 11 2B, 4 HR, and 18 RBI.

HOME SWEET HOME—The Rays MLB-leading 26-10 home record ties 2008 for the second-best home start in team history behind 2023 (30-6)...they have won 22 of their last 28 games at Tropicana Field...since May 13, the Rays are 12-6 at home (2nd in AL/T3rd in MLB) compared to 3-12 in road affairs (30th in MLB)...on the year, the 275-point discrepancy between their home (26-10/.722) and road (17-21/.447) winning percentages is the second largest in MLB behind the White Sox with a 292-point difference...the Rays are in a stretch of 19 home games within a 28-game span from May 29–June 28, going 10-11 thus far (7-5 at home)...they have several notable active home streaks:

- ★ The Rays have recorded nine hits or more in a season-high five straight home games...the club last had a run of five home games or more between Aug. 16-31, 2024 (5G).
- ★ The Rays are 12-0 against the AL East at Tropicana Field, MLB's longest season-opening, home winning streak over division rivals since the 2009 Dodgers won their first 12 home games vs. the NL West...among AL clubs, only the 2003 Royals (13-0) have had a longer streak in the divisional era (since 1969)...they are 14-10 against all other opponents at home.
- ★ **Yandy Diaz** has reached base safely in 19 straight home games (May 5–pres.), tied with **ATH Zack Gelof** and **SD Fernando Tatis Jr.** for the longest active streak in the majors...he is slashing .411/.476/.767 (30-for-73) with 5 2B, 7 HR, and 22 RBI at Tropicana Field during that stretch.
- ★ **Kevin Kelly** has recorded 17 scoreless outings (18.0IP) at Tropicana Field, the third-longest season-opening streak at home by a Rays reliever behind **Jake McGee** (19G) in 2012 and **Trevor Miller** (17G) in 2008...per Stats Perform, the 18.0-IP streak at home is the third longest to begin the season in MLB this year, trailing **NY Yankees Brent Headrick** (19.2, active) **MIA Tyler Phillips** (18.1), and is the longest to open a campaign in Rays history (see table on the right).

REAL ROYALTY—The Rays and Royals will complete a seven-game season series over the course of 11 days from June 22–July 2, beginning with tonight's series opener...it will mark the Rays first four-game series this season—they were scheduled to play four at Fenway Park from May 7-10, but the third contest of the series was postponed due to inclement weather...the Rays and Royals have split their last two season sets (3-3 in 2024-25), but the Rays have not lost a season series to Kansas City since 2017 (4-3), going undefeated in the previous seven (5-0-2; clubs did not meet in 2020)...last year, the road team swept both series, with the Rays posting back-to-back shutout wins from June 25-26 to close the season set (4-0, 3-0).

JUST SOME MINOR DETAILS—Today, **C Caden Bodine** [TB No. 12] was named Player of the Week in the South Atlantic League (June 15-21)...last week, he hit .519 (14-for-27) with 1 2B, 1 HR, 8 RBI, a .567 OBP, and a 1.234 OPS...he recorded four multi-hit games during the six-game set and added a 5-RBI game on Wednesday...this is his second MiLB award this season after being named Carolina League Player of the Month in April.

DOUBLE IT—Rays top prospect **OF Theo Gillen** [MLB No. 40 | TB No. 1], was promoted to Double-A Montgomery today...in 57 games with Class-A Bowling Green, he slashed .342/.449/.589 (75-for-219) with 12 2B, 3 3B, 12 HR, 44 RBI, and 28 SB...he has reached base in 133 of 138 career minor league games.

TONIGHT'S START—Drew Rasmussen will toe the rubber tonight for his 15th start of the campaign and 145th career appearance (96th start)...has made the ninth-most starts in franchise history, trailing **Jeremy Hellickson** and **Blake Snell** (both 108GS)...min. 50.0 IP, leads AL arms in opp. on-base pct. (.234) and WHIP (0.88), and ranks highly in opp. AVG (2nd, .192), strikeout-to-walk ratio (2nd, 6.46), and ERA (4th, 2.59).

- With a win tonight, Rasmussen would reach five home wins this season, tying the AL lead with SEA **Logan Gilbert** (5-3), CWS **Anthony Kay** (5-0), CWS **Davis Martin** (5-0), TB **Shane McClanahan** (5-0), MIN **Bailey Ober** (5-0), and SEA **Bryan Woo** (5-0).
- He is one of 15 AL pitchers with eight quality starts or more this season, a group that also includes rotation-mate **Nick Martinez** (9QS), and holds the second most among Rays arms since the start of 2021 (28QS) behind **Shane McClanahan** (37QS).
- Since 2021, his 2.76 ERA is second-best among all major league pitchers (min. 500.OIP), behind LAD **Shohei Ohtani** (2.66).

LAST TIME OUT—Rasmussen delivered a third consecutive 7.0-inning outing for the first time in his career despite taking his third loss of the season on June 16 at LAD (L, 7.0IP, 6H, R, BB, 7SO, HR)...his lone blemish was a solo home run by **Shohei Ohtani** in the 6th inning—the first run he has allowed this month—which snapped Rasmussen's 19.0-inning scoreless streak...retired six of his final seven batters faced after the homer, sitting down 19 of 26 batters overall.

- Became the third MLB arm to deliver three consecutive starts of 7.0 innings or more with one run or fewer allowed this season, joining MIL **Jacob Misiorowski** (May 25–June 12) and PHI **Cristopher Sánchez** (May 5–June 3)...was the first Ray to turn the trick since **Blake Snell**, who did so across four straight starts from June 19–July 7, 2018.
- The right-hander tossed a career-high 102 pitches, eclipsing the 100-pitch mark for the second time in his career alongside May 11, 2026 at TOR (100).
- Generated 17 whiffs, the second most he has recorded in a start this season and sixth most in an outing in his career, behind 22 whiffs on Sept. 9, 2022 at NYY...nearly half of the whiffs (8) came on his four-seam fastball.

ROYALLY RAS—Across six career appearances (four starts) against the Royals, Rasmussen has posted a 4-1 record with a 2.38 ERA (22.2IP, 6ER) and 24 strikeouts...as a starter, he is 3-1 with a 2.16 ERA (20.2IP, 6ER) and 20 strikeouts...his two relief outings came when he was a member of the Brewers.

- In his last start vs. Kansas City on May 25, 2025 at Steinbrenner Field, Rasmussen fired 5.0 scoreless innings, allowing two hits and two walks against five strikeouts for his seventh win of the year...he has 25 starts of 5.0 scoreless innings or more in his career.
- He is 7-4 with a 3.05 ERA (100.1IP, 34ER) through 28 career appearances (19 starts) vs. AL Central foes...as a starter, he is 6-4 with a 2.53 ERA (89.0IP, 25ER).

JUNE BOOM!—During June, Rasmussen is 2-1 with a 0.43 ERA (21.0IP, 1ER) across three starts, leading MLB qualifiers in ERA and WHIP (0.48), while ranking highly in opp. average (2nd, .129) and strikeouts (T5th, 29).

- The right-hander's 0.43 ERA would be the lowest ERA by a pitcher during any single month in franchise history (min. 20.OIP), surpassing **Chris Archer's** 0.73 mark in July 2013...the lowest June ERA by a Ray under the same parameters is **Shane McClanahan's** 1.36 (33.OIP, 5ER) clip in 2022.
- He is the only MLB pitcher to allow one run or fewer this month (min. 15.OIP).
- Over 15 appearances in June over his career, he is 5-3 with a 2.54 ERA (67.1 IP, 19 ER), 69 strikeouts, and a .204 opponent average (49-for-240)...among AL pitchers since 2021 (min. 50.OIP), he ranks highly in WHIP (5th, 0.95), opp. on-base pct. (6th, .257), and ERA (8th).

ROCK THE TROP—Rasmussen is making his seventh start at home this season...is 4-1 with a 2.88 ERA (34.1IP, 11ER), and he has gone 5.0 IP or more with 3 ER or fewer in four of his six outings at Tropicana Field this year.

- His .593 (16-11) home winning pct. as a Ray ranks seventh in franchise history (min. 250.OIP)...teammate **Shane McClanahan** (26-8) who tops the list at .765.
- Since 2021, Rasmussen is one of five MLB arms (min. 250.OIP) to allow 200 hits or less at home (196), alongside TEX **Jacob deGrom** (152), LAD **Tyler Glasnow** (166), HOU **Cristian Javier** (182), and LAD **Shohei Ohtani** (198).

RIGHT ON—Right-handed hitters are batting .125 (14-for-112) with 31 SO and 3 BB against Rasmussen, the lowest mark in the majors (min. 100BF)...right-handed batters are hitting .091 (3-for-33) against his cutter, 1-for-18 (.056) off his four-seamer, and 8-for-49 (.163) against his sinker.

- Min. 300 BF, his .175 (63-for-359) opp. average vs. right-handed batters since the start of 2025 is the lowest in the majors.

OL' RELIABLE—Rasmussen's outing on May 30 vs. LAA (L, 4.0IP, 4H, 5R, 2BB, 4SO, HR) snapped a streak of allowing four earned runs or fewer in 48 straight regular-season starts (April 30–May 24, 2026), the longest run in franchise history by a traditional starter, ahead of **Shane McClanahan's** 44-start run from April 29, 2021–July 26, 2022...he is one of seven pitchers in the modern era (since 1900) to turn the trick and the first since **Jacob deGrom's** 59-start streak between May 22, 2019–Sept. 18, 2022...finished eight starts behind opener **Ryne Stanek** (56GS from May 26, 2018–July 16, 2019) for the longest streak by any starter in franchise history.

- Rasmussen has fashioned a 2.76 ERA (525.1IP, 161ER) since the start of 2021, ranking second in the majors (min. 500.OIP) behind LAD **Shohei Ohtani** (2.66ER/549.OIP, 162ER)...his 1.02 WHIP under the same parameters is tied for second with DET **Tarik Skubal**, trailing PHI **Zack Wheeler** (1.00) while his .213 (412-for-1930) opp. average is eighth.
