AROUND THE HORN

LOCK IN 2027 TICKETS NOW: D-backs 2027 Advantage Memberships feature Postseason ticket priority, along with discounted ticket plans, preferred seat priority and more, and are available now by placing a deposit at dbacks.com/membership...the 2027 schedule is packed with fan favorites and holiday staples including Mother's Day in May, Father's Day in June and the 4th of July, monthly NL West matchups and exciting Interleague action.

HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs are 6-2 in their last 8 games and 16-7 in their last 23 games.

- The D-backs' 16 wins since July 9 are tied for second most in the Majors (also: Braves), behind the Red Sox (20).
- The D-backs are a season-high-tying 7 games over .500 for the fourth time this season (also: 31-24 on May 27, 59-52 on Aug. 1 and 60-53 on Aug. 4)...were last 8+ games above .500 the final day of the 2024 season (Sept. 29 at 89-73, 16 games above).
- The D-backs are 6-2 in their last 8 home games since July 18... in that span, they lead the Majors in OPS (.887) and SLG (.509) and own the second-best AVG (.300) and OBP (.378).
- Since July 26, the D-backs' 55 runs are third most in the NL, behind the Cubs (58) and Phillies (56) and rank fifth in the Majors.
- **Ryan Waldschmidt** has hit safely in 12 of his last 14 games at a .422 clip (19-for-45)/1.003 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 homer and 4 RBI, with 6 multi-hit efforts.
- **Brandyn Garcia** is scoreless in 20 of his last 21 games, going 0-0 with a career-best 3 saves, 1.04 ERA (3 R-2 ER in 17.1 IP), opponent .119 AVG (7-for-59)/.344 OPS, 0.63 WHIP, 4 walks and 25 strikeouts.

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 10-4 vs. Padres last night, sparked by a 6-run third inning where they had a season-high-tying 6 hits with 7 batters reaching base.

- **Mitch Bratt** recorded his first career win and became the second D-backs rookie starter ever to toss 7.0+ scoreless innings with 1 or fewer hits allowed (1) and 8+ strikeouts (9), along with **Zac Galien** (Sept. 4, 2019 vs. Padres).
- **Tim Tawa** had his second 3-hit effort in his last 3 games and fourth of the season (3-for-4; HR, 2 RBI).
- **Ildemaro Vargas** went 2-for-5 with 1 double, 1 triple and 4 RBI.
- **Ryan Waldschmidt** recorded his second career 3-hit game (3 singles).
- **Corbin Carroll** went 2-for-3 with 1 RBI and 1 walk.
- **Gabriel Moreno** recorded 2 RBI (sac fly and BB) for the fifth time in his last 9 games.
- **Geraldo Perdomo** singled to extend to a 6-game hitting streak.

WILD CARD RACE: The D-backs are tied for second in the NL Wild Card race with the Phillies, 5.0 games behind the Cubs and 2.0 games ahead of the Padres.

HOME SWEET HOME: The D-backs' .589 home win pct. (33-23) is tied for fourth in the NL (also: Dodgers), behind the Braves (.655, 38-20), Brewers (.644, 38-21), Marlins (.596, 34-23).

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: The D-backs have won or split 7 of their last 8 series (2-2 @ Padres, 3-0 @ Dodgers, 2-1 vs. Cardinals, 2-1 vs. Athletics, 1-2 @ Nationals, 2-1 @ Pirates, 2-1 @ Guardians)...the D-backs have clinched at minimum a split in their current 4-game set with the Padres.

*Does not include the 1-game makeup win on July 23 @ Cardinals.

BATS AFTER THE BREAK: Post All-Stat break, the D-backs' 182 hits are tied for second (also: Padres), behind the Cubs (185), while their 267 times on base rank second, behind the Cubs (269).

STARTING PITCHERS: D-backs starting pitchers, in their last 9 bids, have a 2.17 ERA (17 R-13 ER in 54.0 IP), with 16 walks and 41 strikeouts.

'PEN SPOTLIGHT: **Brandyn Garcia** is scoreless in 19 homes game, going 0-0 with an opponent .115 AVG (6-for-52)/.298 OPS, 3 walks and 14 strikeouts.

- Since being acquired in July of 2025, has not allowed an earned run in 24 home games (1 R-0 ER in 21.1 IP), going 0-1 with an opponent .143 AVG (10-for-70)/.335 OPS, 3 walks and 20 strikeouts.
- **Taylor Clarke** is scoreless in 9 of his last 10 games with a 0.00 ERA (1 R-0 ER in 11.2 IP), opponent .146 AVG (6-for-41)/.313 OPS, 1 walk and 7 strikeouts.
- **Juan Morillo** is scoreless in 9 of his last 10 games with a 0.84 ERA (1 ER in 10.2 IP), opponent .121 AVG (4-for-33)/.341 OPS, 3 walks and 12 strikeouts.

STINGY DUO: Since May 8, **Brandyn Garcia** (0 IRS/17 IR) and **Jonathan Loaisiga** (0 IRS/10 IR) are 2 of 3 relievers in the Majors with 10+ inherited runners and 0 scoring [also: Yoendrys Gómez/MIN (0/11)].

WINNING VS. NL WEST: The D-backs' .657 division win pct. (23-12) is second in MLB, behind the Braves (.667, 24-12), ahead of the Brewers (.656, 21-11).

- The D-backs are 13-6 (.684) at home vs. NL West, tied for the NL's best division home win pct. with the Braves and tied for fourth-best in the Majors (also: Braves).

VS. PADRES: The D-backs split their first 2 series vs. Padres (3-3): 1-1 in Mexico City Series from April 25-26 and 2-2 from July 6-9 @ Padres.

- The D-backs are 5-3 in their last 8 meetings.

- **Gabriel Moreno**, in his last 8 starts vs. Padres, is hitting .367 (11-for-30)/.829 OPS with 1 double, 3 RBI and 4 walks.
- **Nolan Arenado**, in his last 8 games vs. Padres, is hitting .367 (11-for-30)/1.073 OPS with 3 homers, 4 RBI and 2 walks.
- **Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base safely in 13 of his last 15 games vs. Padres, hitting .322 (19-for-59)/.953 OPS with 5 doubles, 3 homers, 9 RBI and 6 walks.

ON DECK VS. DODGERS: The D-backs have won 4 straight games and are 5-2 in their last 7 meetings...swept their last 3-game series @ Dodgers from July 10-12.

NEXT STARTER: RHP MERRILL KELLY (8-9, 5.04)

- In his last 3 home starts, is 2-0 with a 3.00 ERA (7 R-5 ER 15.0 IP), 5 walks and 12 strikeouts.
- Won his last home start on July 22 vs. Athletics after allowing 2 runs over 5.0 innings (5 H, BB, 3 K).
- Won his last start vs. Padres on July 9 with a quality start (7.0 IP in 1 ER, 3 H, 3 BB, 6 K).
