RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals embark on a seven-game road trip tonight with the opener of a four-game series against the division-rival Milwaukee Brewers at American Family Field ... Beginning Monday, the Cardinals visit Angel Stadium for the first time since 2016 for their three-game Interleague series with the Los Angeles Angels (May 13-15) ... Yesterday's rain-out at Busch Stadium concluded the Redbirds five-game homestand against the White Sox (1-2) and Mets (0-2).

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis has dropped four straight and opens today in 5th place in the National League Central, 6.0 games behind division-leading Milwaukee (21-15) and Chicago (22-16) ... The Cardinals haven't lost five in a row since a six-game skid last season (June 10-16, 2023).

WHAT'S BREWING: St. Louis is 8-4 in series openers (5-1 on the road).

DIVISIONAL DIVIDE: Only three of the Cardinals first 36 games have been against divisional opponents ... Prior to this season, the Redbirds fewest divisional games through the first 36 games was six in 1996. - *Elias*

NORTHERN EXPOSURE: Since St. Louis and Milwaukee began regular season play in 1997, the Cardinals own the most wins against the Brewers (239-192, .555) and have the best road winning percentage (.577) of any team to visit Milwaukee since 1997 ... Their .587 win pct. (111-80) since American Family Field opened in 2001 is tops among all teams who annually play in Milwaukee.

BUT SKUNKY BEER: The Cardinals have lost five in a row to Brewers (Sept. 27, 2023-present), tying the club's 2nd-longest skid to Milwaukee behind a seven-game losing streak from May 11-Aug. 26, 2008.

ALL IN THE FAMILY: The Cardinals have hit the most home runs (234) of all opposing teams at American Family Field since it opened in 2001 ... **Paul Goldschmidt** has gone yard 18 times at American Family Field, 6th among all visiting players and 2nd among active opponents to **Joey Votto** (24) ... Goldy enjoyed a three-homer game here on March 29, 2019 in his second career game as a Cardinal.

IT'S ALWAYS SONNY: On the mound for the Cardinals tonight is ace **Sonny Gray**, who paces Major League Baseball in ERA (2.52), FIP (2.66), and HR/9 (0.38) since the beginning of the 2023 season ... Gray enters today's game with a 0.89 ERA, lowest by any Cardinal through his first five appearances as a starting pitcher dating back to 1910.

MAKE YOURSELF AT HOME: **Nolan Arenado** is the American Family Field stadium leader in both slugging (.747) and OPS (1.185), is 2nd in batting average (.373) to **Adrian González** (.382), and ranks 3rd in on-base pct. (.439) among Major Leaguers with at least 120 career plate appearances here.

CLOSE CALLS: Twenty-seven of the Cardinals 36 games (75%) this season have been decided by three or fewer runs, tied with the Yankees, Mets, Pirates, and Tigers for most in Major League Baseball ... St. Louis is 13-14 in those games.

IT IS YOUR BIRTHDAY: Happy 29th birthday to Gold Glove Award winner **Tommy Edman**, who currently is on the 60-Day Injured List with a right wrist sprain ... Edman is first Cardinals switch-hitter since **Ozzie Smith** (1991-93) with consecutive seasons of 150+ hits (2021-22) and one of nine Cardinals all-time to hit 50+ home runs and steal 100+ stolen bases in their career.

THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (May 9, 1992): Trailing 9-0 after 3 1/2 innings and 11-3 after 4 1/2 with future Hall of Famer **John Smoltz** pitching for Atlanta, the Cardinals rally with two runs in the 5th, four in the 7th, and three in the 8th to beat the defending National League champion Braves, 12-11 at Busch Stadium II ... Pinch hitter **Gerald Perry** hits a three-run double in the 7th, **Félix José** ties the score with a two-run homer, and **Luis Alicea** drives in the game-winning run with a single.

MILWAUKEE CONNECTIONS

Ryan Helsley made his MLB debut on April 16, 2019 at Milwaukee...his first strikeout victim was Ryan Braun (swinging) that night.

Devin Williams was born in Florissant, Mo... was 1st Team Rawlings/Perfect Game Preseason High School All-American at Hazelwood West High School in 2013...committed to the Univ. of Missouri before drafted by Milwaukee in the 2nd round in 2013.

Trevor Megill was originally selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2014 MLB Draft, but did not sign to return to Loyola Marymount Univ.

Cardinals AGM/Player Development **Gary LaRocque** was selected by Milwaukee in the 14th round of the 1975 MLB Draft.

Hall of Famer **Ted Simmons** played five seasons with Milwaukee (1981-85), where he was a two-time AL All-Star and faced off against St. Louis in the 1982 World Series...traded to Milwaukee with **Rollie Fingers** and **Pete Vuckovich** in exchange for **David Green**, **Sixto Lezcano**, **Dave LaPoint** and **Lary Sorensen**.

Willson Contreras' younger brother, **William**, is also a catcher for the Brewers.

Bryan Hudson graduated from Alton (Ill.) High School, where he set school records for career wins (25) and strikeouts (324)...committed to the University of Missouri prior to being drafted by the Cubs in the 3rd round. of 2015.

Joe Ross's older brother **Tyson Ross**, pitched in nine games for the Cardinals in 2018.

Turner Ward played parts of three seasons (1994-96) with the Brewers.

Chris Roycroft pitched for the Joliet Slammers (2021-22) in the independent Frontier League.

Ricky Horton made five starts for the Denver Zephyrs (AAA) in the Brewers organization in 1990.

Steve Dillard, father of Brewers broadcaster **Tim Dillard**, was hitting coach for the Single-A Quad Cities Swing/River Bandits from 2006-07 and hitting coach for the High-A Palm Beach Cardinals in 2007...later piloted Quad Cities in 2008-09, where he managed infielder **Oliver Marmol**.

Cardinals Hall of Famer & broadcaster **Jim Edmonds** played in 73 games for Milwaukee in 2010.

Cardinals Special Asst. to the GM, Player Procurement **Matt Slater** is a Marquette Univ. graduate... started in pro baseball as the Brewers' Scouting and Player Development Assistant (1991).

Brewers broadcaster **Bob Uecker** played two seasons (1964-65) with St. Louis...won the 1964 World Series...traded by the Milwaukee Braves to St. Louis for **Jimmie Coker** and **Gary Kolb** (Apr. 9, 1964).

Brewers broadcaster **Jeff Levering** previously worked three seasons (2010-12) as broadcaster for the Springfield Cardinals (AA).

KMOX broadcaster **Matt Pauley** hosted Brewers pre- and postgame shows for parts of six seasons (2017-22)...was radio play-by-play voice of the Univ. of Wisconsin-Green Bay women's basketball team.

Cardinals Dir. of Medical Operations/Head Athletic Trainer **Adam Olsen** is a native of Green Bay... graduate of The University of Wisconsin-Madison.

TONIGHT'S GAME

NL Rankings: Wins (4, T-8th), Winning Pct. (.800, T-9th).

- Makes his 6th start of the season and 2nd against the Brewers this season.
- Has an 0.89 ERA through his first five starts with St. Louis, lowest by a Cardinal in his first five appearances as a starter with the organization since 1910.
- Has yet to allow a run in the first four innings of any start this season.
- Surpassed 1,600 career innings in his last start vs. the White Sox (5/3), firing 7.0 scoreless innings of three -hit ball in a 3-0 win, his 7th career win vs. the Pale Hose, the opponent he has his 3rd-most wins against.
- Ranks 18th in the National League with 38 strikeouts despite making his first start on April 9.
- Would lead the National League in ERA (0.98), but is five innings shy of qualifying after his most recent start.
- Opened the season with 17.0 scoreless innings, longest by a Cardinals starting pitcher this season and 4th-longest in MLB. The last time a Cardinals starting pitcher opened the season with 17.0+ scoreless innings was **Woody Williams** (24.2 IP) in 2003, who set the franchise record in the Divisional Era (1969-present). - *Elias*
- Struck out 12 batters vs. Milwaukee (April 21), his most since a career-high 13 vs. Houston (April 7, 2023); the 15th double-digit strikeout game of his career.
- Recently became the 13th active pitcher to reach the 100 win milestone (4/15 at OAK), joining teammates **Lance Lynn** (137, 5th) and **Kyle Gibson** (105, 10th).
- Gray is one of three free-agent starters (**Lance Lynn & Kyle Gibson**) that the Cardinals signed this past off-season.
- Has joined his fifth Major League team: Athletics (2013-17), Yankees (2017-18), Reds (2019-21), Twins (2022-23) and Cardinals (2024).

LAST TIME OUT

- Threw a season-high 7.0 scoreless innings in a 3-0 win over the White Sox, dropping his ERA to 0.89, the lowest by a Cardinals pitcher in his first five starts with the club since 1910.

CAREER

- Selected by the Oakland Athletics in the 1st round (18th overall) of the 2011 Major League Draft out of Vanderbilt University.
- His 3.45 career ERA ranks 6th among active pitchers & 1,532 strikeouts rank 15th.
- Has made seven career starts at Busch Stadium, with four of those being Quality Starts. He is 2-3, 2.90 ERA career at Busch (40.1 IP/13 ER). Five of his seven starts at Busch Stadium were with the Cincinnati Reds.

2024

- Has struck out 32 batters over his first four starts for the Cardinals, the first pitcher in franchise history to post 30 or more and the most since **Stu Miller** with 29 in 1952.
- Struck out a season-high 12 batters over 6.2 innings in a 2-0 loss to MIL (4/21). Marked his 15th career double-digit strikeout game and first since a career-high 13 vs. HOU (4/7/23). Surrendered a two-out single to Owen Miller in the 7th as part of three consecutive hits before exiting.
- Made his Cardinals regular season debut on April 9 vs. Philadelphia. Joined **John Smoltz** (Aug. 23, 2009 at San Diego - 5 IP, 3 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 9 K) as the 2nd Cardinal since 1901 (37th MLB pitcher overall) to pitch 5.0+ scoreless innings with 5 hits or fewer, zero walks, and 5+ strikeouts in his first game with the franchise.
- Struck out **Bryce Harper** (swinging) on April 9 for his first strikeout in a Cardinals uniform.
- Began the season on the 15-day I.L. with right hamstring injury, suffered on March 4.

- Making his 2nd start and appearance against the Brewers this season.
- Took the loss at Busch Stadium on April 21, 2-0 defeat to the Brewers when he struck out a season-high 12 batters. Allowed three straight two-out singles in the 7th inning accounting for the two runs.
- Won his last two starts vs. the Brewers at American Family Field as a member of the Reds and enters on an 11.0 inning scoreless streak. Has three career scoreless starts of his six career at the stadium.
- His 2.48 ERA at American Family Field ranks 3rd among active pitchers with six or more starts trailing only Clayton Kershaw (1.54) and teammate Lance Lynn (2.29).
- Has only allowed two home runs at Milwaukee, both in the same game (6/21/19) to Christian Yelich and Mike Moustakas, two batters apart in the 5th inning.
