# ATLANTA BRAVES (9-11-2) at BALTIMORE ORIOLES (17-5-1) <br> RH Spencer Strider (3-0, 0.00) vs. RH Tyler Wells (2-0, 1.50)

TODAY'S GAME: The Braves continue their exhibition schedule today against the Baltimore Orioles, splitting their squad between Sarasota and North Port, where the Braves will also play the Boston Red Sox...The matchups are their 23rd and 24th of 32 games this spring...Following today, Atlanta will have four games remaining at CoolToday Park in North Port, Fla. and four games on the road...This afternoon's contest is the last of five scheduled exhibition meetings between the clubs...Baltimore won each of the first three exhibitions, before Atlanta won its first, 7-5, on Wednesday.. The Orioles will also field a split-squad for today's game...During the regular season, the Braves will visit Oriole Park at Camden Yards for a three-game set, June 11-13.
A The Braves host nine different major league teams at CoolToday Park, including three games each against the Baltimore Orioles and Minnesota Twins and two games each against the Boston Red Sox, Pittsburgh Pirates and Tampa Bay Rays...The Detroit Tigers, New York Yankees, Philadelphia Phillies and Toronto Blue Jays will make one visit each to North Port.

CAMP BREAKDOWN: The Braves currently have 36 players in camp, 17 of whom are pitchers (seven left-handers and 10 right-handers)...Atlanta also has four catchers, eight infielders and seven outfielders in camp... There are six non-roster invitees (two catchers, three infielders and one outfielder)...The club opened camp with 60 players.

A On Thursday, the Braves signed OF Adam Duvall to a one-year major league contract worth $\$ 3$ million for the 2024 season...The club also released OF Jordan Luplow.

A On March 12, the Braves reassigned INF Nacho Alvarez Jr., INF Luke Waddell and OF Luis Liberato to minor league camp.

A On March 5, MLB Pipeline unveiled its prospect rankings for the 2024 season...Atlanta opened camp with seven players that currently rank among the team's top 30 prospects, including top overall prospect, RHP AJ Smith-Shawver...Also included are fellow top 10 prospects RHP Hurston Waldrep (No. 2) and INF Nacho Alvarez Jr. (No. 6).

23 IN '23: The Braves clinched the 23rd division title in franchise history last season, beating Philadelphia, 4-1 on September 13 at Citizens Bank Park to win the National League East...The 23 division titles are the most in major league history, two more than Los Angeles (NL) and three more than New York (AL)...Last season also marked the franchise's 29th postseason berth in the Modern Era (since 1900) and its sixth straight.
A The Braves won a major league-record 14 consecutive division titles from 1991-2005, with the first three coming as NL West champs before moving into the NL East in the strike-shortened 1994 season...They also won the West in 1969 and 1982, and the East in 2013 and every year since 2018.

A The six straight division titles marks the longest streak in baseball...The Astros have won three straight AL West titles dating to 2021, while the Dodgers have won each of the last two NL West crowns.

## Probable Pitchers

Spencer Strider • RHP • 6-0 • 195 • 25 yrs • \#99

- Makes his fourth start of the spring, last: March 11 vs. Minnesota...Has logged 14.0 scoreless innings with 22 strikeouts and four walks.
- Finished fourth in the NL Cy Young voting last season...In his first full season as a starter, went 20-5 with a 3.86 ERA (80 ER/186.2 IP).
- His 281 strikeouts established the franchise's Modern Era (since 1900) single-season record, surpassing the previous mark of 276, set by Hall-of-Famer John Smoltz in 1996...Recorded 11 double-digit strikeout games, one shy of Smoltz's single-season franchise record, also set in ' 96.


## Dylan Lee • LHP • 6-3 • 214 • 29 yrs •\#52

Makes his seventh appearance of the spring, last: March 13 at Baltimore...Owns a 6.00 ERA (4 ER/6.0 IP) with eight strikeouts.
Appeared in 24 games with Atlanta last season, 23 in relief...Posted a 4.18 ERA (11 ER/23.2 IP)...On Atlanta's Injured List, twice, May 19 (retro. May 17) to September 1 (left shoulder inflammation) and September 12 through season's end with the same ailment.
