BIRD WATCHING: The St. Louis Cardinals and division-rival Chicago Cubs play the second game a four-game series at Busch Stadium tonight, the first four-game Cards-Cubs weekday series in St. Louis since Sept. 25-28, 2017 ... St. Louis is 1-4 on its eight-game homestand against the Diamondbacks (0-1), Reds (1-2), and Cubs (0-1), and 3-8 through its first 11 of 20 consecutive games before their next open date on August 6, longest since the Cardinals played 20 straight from April 19-May 8, 2022 (11-9 record).

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis enters play today in 4th place in the National League Central, 13.0 games behind 1st place Milwaukee ... The Cardinals are 6th in the NL Wild Card race, sitting 1.5 games behind Arizona and Pittsburgh for the final spot ... According to *Elias*, St. Louis has played MLB's 2nd-hardest strength of schedule (.511) this season behind only the Pirates (.512)

EVEN STEVENS: Since taking two-of-three from the Cubs at Wrigley Field over Independence Day weekend (July 6-present), the Cardinals have gone 6-13 to sport a .500 record for the 5th time this season and first since the start of play on April 14 (8-8 record) ... A loss tonight would give St. Louis a losing record for the first time in 2026.

ARCH RIVALS: The Cardinals and Cubs are playing their first four-game weekday series in St. Louis since Sept. 25-28, 2017 ... St. Louis is combined 14-8 this season against Chicago (4-3), Pittsburgh (5-2), and Cincinnati (5-3), but just 2-8 vs. Milwaukee.

DIRTY MIKE AND THE BOYS: Michael McGreevy has allowed two runs or fewer in 13 of his 20 starts this season, tying Philadelphia's **Cristopher Sanchez**, New York's **Cam Schlichter**, and Arizona's **Eduardo Rodríguez** for the most such starts in MLB this season.

GETTING DEFENSIVE: According to *Baseball Savant*, the Cardinals 31 Fielding Run Value for "Up The Middle" Positions (C, 2B, SS, CF) ranks 2nd-best among all MLB teams this season, behind only the Cubs (33) ... CF **Pete Crow-Armstrong** (21) leads MLB in Fielding Run Value, while 2B **JJ Wetherholt** (16) ranks 2nd and SS **Masyn Winn** is T-5th (10) ... Among middle infield combinations, the Cardinals lead MLB by a wide margin with 27 FRV, with the Royals ranking 2nd at 14.

WETHER FORECAST IS GOOD: Cardinals rookie 2B **JJ Wetherholt** is the 3rd Cardinal with 13+ hits in their first seven career games vs. the Cubs, joining **Showboat Fisher** (17, 1930) and **Lou Brock** (14, 1964) ... Tonight marks Wetherholt's 100th appearance batting leadoff, most among MLB rookies this season and 5th all-time among Redbird rookies behind **Masyn Winn** (102 in 2024), **Lou Klein** (139 in 1943), **Don Blasingame** (143 in 1956), and 1985 NL Rookie of the Year **Vince Coleman** (149).

BASH AND DASH: **Jordan Walker** has driven in **JJ Wetherholt** 20 times this season, accounting for MLB's highest run-scoring combo ... Since the Wild Card Era began in 1994, the best run-scoring Cards duos have been **Scott Rolen** > **Albert Pujols** (32 in 2004) and **Matt Holliday** > **Matt Carpenter** (32 in 2014). - *Elias*

THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (July 28, 2002): On the same day **Ozzie Smith** was inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame, the Cardinals stun the Cubs by scoring six runs in the bottom of the 9th inning for a come-from-behind 10-9 win at Busch Stadium II on ESPN Sunday Night Baseball, highlighted by **Édgar Rentería**'s walk-off three-run homer off **Antonio Alfonseca** ... The following day, Cardinals General Manager **Walt Jocketty** acquired future Hall of Fame 3B **Scott Rolen** from the Philadelphia Phillies.

CHICAGO CUBS CONNECTIONS

Iván Herrera tallied his first MLB hit vs. the Cubs with a single (June 26, 2022)...**José Fermín** notched his first career MLB hit at the Cubs (July 21, 2023) with a bunt single...**Pedro Pagés** swatted his first MLB homer (June 14, 2024) at the Cubs.

JoJo Romero recorded his first MLB save on July 30, 2023 vs. the Cubs.

George Soriano's first cousin is former Cubs OF **Alfonso Soriano** (2007-13).

Carson Kelly was drafted by St. Louis in 2012 and played three seasons (2016-18) for the Cardinals.

Phil Maton pitched in 40 games as a reliever for the Cardinals in 2025 after he signed a one-year deal as a free agent in March 2025.

Brant Brown was the Cubs 3rd round draft pick in 1992 and played parts of four seasons (1996-98 & 2000) with the North Siders.

Cardinals.TV play-by-play announcer **Chip Caray** served as the Cubs play-by-play announcer for seven seasons (1998-2004) on WGN...his grandfather, **Harry Caray**, spent the final 16 years of his career broadcasting Cubs games (1982-97).

Lars Nootbaar and **Shota Imanaga** were teammates on Gold Medal winning Team Japan in the 2023 World Baseball Classic.

Jon Jay played in 141 games for the Cubs in 2017 and was part of their playoff run to the NLCS.

Daniel Descalso played his final MLB season with the Cubs in 2019.

Nelson Velázquez played parts of two seasons with the Cubs (2022-23), where he made his MLB debut (May 30, 2022 vs. Milwaukee)...singled off Ethan Small in his first career plate appearance.

Cubs Scouting VP **Dan Kantrovitz** previously was Cardinals Scouting Director (2012-14)...2001 Cards 25th Rd. draft pick from Brown Univ...first MLB job was Cardinals Scouting Coordinator.

Stubby Clapp (June 18, 2001 at Busch II) made his MLB debut vs. the Cubs...was also a coach on Team Canada for the 2013 & 2026 WBC squads that featured **Jameson Taillon** on the pitching staff.

Cubs Staff Assistant **AJ Lewis** played college baseball at the University of Missouri in 2017 and John A. Logan College (Carterville, IL) in 2018.

Cubs Major League Assistant Strength & Conditioning Coach **Mark Weisman** was the Director of Performance at Southeast Missouri State University (Gape Girardeau, Mo.) in 2020.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jim Edmonds** played part of 2008 with the Cubs.

Cardinals VP & Sr. Advisor **Michael Girsch** is a Chicago native...graduated from the University of Notre Dame and the University of Chicago.

Marquee Sports Network Analyst **Rick Sutcliffe** played for St. Louis in 1994.

Cardinals.TV Analyst **Mark Sweeney** made his MLB debut with St. Louis vs. the Cubs on Aug. 4, 1995 at Busch Stadium II.

Hall of Fame manager **Tony La Russa** played in one game for the Cubs in 1973.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Tom Herr** made his MLB debut vs. the Cubs on Aug. 13, 1979 at Busch Stadium II, and fellow Cards HOF **Jason Isringhausen** made his MLB debut on July 17, 1995 at the Cubs while pitching for the Mets.

TONIGHT'S START:

- Making his 21st start of the season, continuing to add to his career-high in starts and appearances.
- Will be making his 4th career start vs. the Cubs (1-1, 4.70 ERA), but his 1st this season.
- **Allowed two runs or fewer in 13 of his 20 starts this season; his 13 starts of 6.0+ IP and 2 or fewer runs allowed are tied for most in MLB with Cristopher Sanchez (PHI), Eduardo Rodriguez (ARI) and Cam Schlitler (NYY).**
- Since making his MLB debut (July 31, 2024), leads qualifying Cardinals starting pitchers in ERA (3.52), opponent BA (.248), WHIP (1.15), Hits/9 (8.42).
- Has held his opposition to 3 runs or fewer in 9 of 10 home starts this season (2-3, 2.30 ERA, 58.2 IP); ranks 7th among MLB starters in home ERA.
- Is 1-2 with a 2.68 ERA in 8 day games starts this season with an 1,02 WHIP. Lowest day tilt ERA among Cardinals starters and has allowed more than two runs in a day game just two times (at DET, 4/3 - 3 R & vs. ARI, 7/23 - 4 R).
- Distributes pitches well ranking among N.L. leaders in Pct. Pitches Taken (55,1%, 3rd), Pct. Pitches Put in Play (19.9%, 6th), Pct. Swings Put In Play (44.2%, 1st), Fewest Pitches/Inning (15.5, 9th),
- Has made 21 career appearances (19 starts) at Busch Stadium where he is 7-6 with a 3.41 ERA (118.2 IP).
- The Cardinals are 22-17 (.520 win pct.) in his 39 career games started.
- Has yet to issue more than three walks in any of his first 39 career starts, longest such streak to begin a career by a Cardinal. Seattle's **George Kirby** leads active leaders with 131.
- Allowed 1 run or fewer with 6.0+ IP in a four-start stretch (April 26-May 14), the longest such streak by a Cardinal since **Adam Wainwright** had four straight starts from Sept. 2-18, 2019.
- Has pitched 6.0+ innings in 26 of 39 career starts (22 quality starts), including 5-straight since 6/26.
- Since joining the rotation June 8, 2025, St. Louis has won 19 of his starts - three shy of **Matthew Liberatore** for the most among all STL starters.

LAST TIME OUT (Monday, July 23 vs. Arizona):, L, 10-6; 6.1 IP, 7 H, 4 R, 4 ER, 3 BB, 3 SO, 1 HR; 95 pitches

- Faced the D-Backs for a 2nd consecutive start coming out of the All Star break, dropping a 10-6 loss as he walked a career-high 3 batters in his 1st loss at Busch Stadium since 6/1/26 vs. TEX.
- Despite a 3.86 ERA, has gone 1-6 in his last 11 starts since 5/20 and the Cardinals are 3-8 in those games..

2026 HIGHLIGHTS:

TWO FOR THE PRICE OF ONE: Has induced 12 grounded into double plays - a new career high.

HERE COMES THE SUN...: His 2.68 ERA (47.0 IP/14 ER) in Day games is tops among all Cardinals pitchers with 29-to-8 strikeout to walks ratio, however has allowed 7 of 15 HR in his 8 afternoon starts.

EMPTY HANDED: The Cardinals have given him 2 runs of support or fewer in 12 of his starts. The Cardinals have been shut out five times this season, four of which were when McGreevy starts.

FAITH IN FIELDERS: Has the NL's lowest percent (18.7) of Swing & Miss and 6th-best BABIP (.257). His difference in Opponent BA (.241) vs. xBA (.286) leads all MLB qualified starting pitchers (-.045).

NESTING: Has worked at least 5.0 innings with 2-or-fewer runs allowed in eight of his 10 home starts this season, and did so in each of his 1st four starts before allowing three runs in his 5/20 start vs. PIT.

HAPPY BIRTHDAY!: Celebrated his 26th birthday on July 8 with a 5-1 win over division-leading Milwaukee, limiting the Brew Crew to one run over a season-high 6.1 innings. **HAPPY IT HAPPENED:** Had a 14.0 scoreless innings streak that covered portions of three starts from April 26-May 8 snapped on a leadoff HR by **Nick Kurtz** that was his only run allowed during a 6.0-inning start 5/14 at ATH during a 5-4 St. Louis victory.

ONE-HIT WONDER: Struck out a career-high nine batters at SD (May 8) over 6.0 scoreless innings of one-hit ball at Petco Park in a 6-0 Cardinals win.

DODGE BALL: Blanked the Dodgers on 3 hits over 6.0 IP in a 3-2 win on May 2 as the Cardinals turned 4 double plays behind him.

"NO" NEWS IS GOOD NEWS: Retired the first nine batters en route to 6.0 no-hit innings in his first start of the season vs. TB (3/28) in a no decision the Cardinals won in 10 innings (6-5).

FIRST IMPRESSIONS: Became the first Cardinal to throw 6.0+ no-hit innings in a completed start since **Erick Fedde** on April 9, 2025 at Pittsburgh (6.0 IP). Since 1961, the Cardinals record for the longest hitless inning streak as a starter (excluding any possible intervening relief appearances) to begin a season is 8.0 IP by **Daniel Ponce de Leon** - July 23, 2018 (7.0 IP) and Aug. 21, 2018 (1.0 IP) - *Elias*

RARE BIRD: In his season debut on 3/28 vs. TB, became the 2nd pitcher in team history with a hitless start within his first 2 starts (**Jack Flaherty** 4/1/23 vs. TOR) and the 14th time in MLB a pitcher has in a start of 6.0+ IP. **Emerson Hancock** (SEA) had 6.0 no-hit innings vs. CLE the next day.

- All three of his career appearances vs. CHC came during the 2025 season when he went 1-1 with a 4.70 ERA (15.1 IP/8 ER.
- Tossed 6.0 scoreless innings, scattering six hits, on 8/8/25 vs. the Cubs (8/8/25) in a 5-0 win at Busch Stadium.
- Received a no decision in his first career start vs. CHC (6/24/25), allowing five runs over 4.2 innings in a game the Cardinals won 8-7 as he exited at 4.2 innings with an 8-5 lead. All 5 runs came in the 3rd inning on a Kyle Tucker two-run single and Seiya Suzuki 3-run HR.
- Is 5-3 with a 3.68 ERA in 10 career starts (11 app) against N.L. Central opponents (Cardinals are 8-3).
