DLAND BITES: The Orioles continue their final homestand of the year tonight against the ees (0-1, 3 to play) and Rays (3 to play)...Baltimore is in the midst of 13 games in as many with the club's next scheduled off day on Monday, September 22.
 Despite last night's loss, the Birds are 12-6 (.667) since August 30, tied for the second-best record in the AL during that time with the Mariners, behind the Guardians (.737, 14-5)...Since May 24, the Orioles are 56-48 (.538), an 87-win pace, which is the fifth-best record in the AL over that period behind the Blue Jays (.621, 64-39), Astros (.569, 58-44), Red Sox (.564, 57-44), and Yankees (.544, 56-47).
 The Orioles struck out 15 times on Thursday, tied for their second-most strikeouts in a game this season behind May 6 at Minnesota (17 K)...Since August 1, the O's have fanned 10+ times in 27 games, second most in the majors behind the Angels (28 G) over that period.

Orioles starters have allowed three runs or fewer in 14 of 16 games in September while posting a collective 2.91 ERA (26 ER/80.1 IP)...That ERA is the fourth-best in the AL during that time.

ROSTER MOVES: The Orioles recalled right-handed pitcher Jose Espada from Triple-A Norfolk and placed righty Chayce McDermott on the Bereavement/Family Medical Emergency List...For Espada, his first appearance will be his team debut and his second major league appearance (also 9/24/23 vs. STL w/SD)...Right-hander Scott Blewett (right elbow discomfort) was returned from his rehab assignment, reinstated from the 60-day Injured List, and designated for assignment, while infielder Emmanuel Rivera cleared outright waivers and accepted an assignment to Norfolk.

MR. ROGERS' NEIGHBORHOOD: Trevor Rogers has allowed two runs or fewer in a career-high 14 consecutive starts, the longest such stretch by an Orioles starter in team history (since 1954) and tied for the longest by a starter this season with TEX's Jacob deGrom (4/18-7/1)...The last major league starter (non-opener) to post a longer streak of two or fewer runs is LAD's Julio Urias (17 G) from July 16, 2022-April 10, 2023.

Oscince he debuted in game two on May 24 at Boston, among players with at least 100.0 innings pitched during that time, Rogers leads the majors in ERA ahead of PIT's Paul Skenes (1.83 ERA) and DET's Tarik Skubal (1.94 ERA).

Oscince he was named AL Pitcher of the Month for August after going 4-1 with a 1.29 ERA (6 ER/42.0 IP), 41 strikeouts, and 0.86 WHIP across six starts...Rogers allowed exactly one run in each of his six starts last month, becoming the first pitcher in franchise history to make 5+ starts in a month and allow one or no runs in all of them.

Oscince he debuted 6.0+ innings in 12 of 16 starts, 7.0+ innings seven times, and 8.0 innings twice...Rogers is the first O's starter with multiple starts of at least 8.0 innings in a season since 2022 (Bradish, 2 G)...Kevin Gausman is the last Oriole to have more than two in 2018 (3 G).

IT TAKES A VILLAGE: With José Castillo making his team debut last night, Baltimore has used 69 different players this season, one shy of the major league record set by the 2024 Marlins... The 2021 Cubs also used 69 players, while the 2022 Pirates finished with 68...The Braves have used 68 players this year...The previous team record for the Orioles was set in 2021 with 62.

① The O's have used 40 different pitchers this year (including position players), second most in a season in franchise history (since 1954) behind the 2021 Orioles (42).

① The Orioles have had 34 different position players appear in a game, the most by a major league team since 2022 (37, SF; 34, LAA, OAK, PIT) and tied for the most in a season in franchise history with 1955.

② The Orioles have had 23 players hit a home run for the team, breaking the team record (since 1954)...That's the most players to homer by one MLB team since 2024 (SF, 23).

② Baltimore has had 19 players steal a base, breaking the O's record.

③ The Birds have used seven different players at catcher, setting the franchise record...The last MLB club to use at least seven catchers in a single season was the 2023 Cleveland Guardians (also 7)...The last to use eight were the 2022 Pirates.

HOLLIDAY SEASON: Jackson Holliday had his career-high 17-game on-base streak snapped on Wednesday...It was the third-longest active streak in the AL and the longest by a player not currently on the Injured List...He's batting .324/.446/.500 (22-for-68) with four doubles, one triple, two homers, nine runs scored, six RBI, 15 walks (1 IBB), 16 strikeouts, and five stolen bases in 18 games since August 28...During that time, he ranks among AL leaders in walks (4th) and on-base percentage (6th).

Oh He paces the Birds with 17 home runs, one ahead of Gunnar Henderson (16 HR)...The only Oriole under 22 years old to finish the season leading the club in homers is Eddie Murray (27 HR 1977).

Holliday's 17 long balls are the fifth most by an Oriole in their age-21 season or younger (as of age of July 1 of season) in team history (since 1954), trailing **Cal Ripken**, **Jr**. (28 HR, 1982), **Eddie Murray** (27 HR, 1977), **Boog Powell** (25 HR, 1963), and **Curt Blefary** (22 HR, 1965), per *Stats Perform*.
Baltimore has not had a player fail to reach the 20 home run mark since 2001, when **Jay Gibbons** and **Chris Richard** each paced the club with 15 homers apiece...Only five teams in Orioles history (since 1954) have not had a player hit 20+ homers ('01, '74, '57, '55, '54).

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS: Dylan Beavers has reached base safely in 22 of his first 27 career games since August 16, ranking among AL leaders in on-base percentage (5th, .423) and walks (5th, 21).

(b) He's homered in consecutive games after entering Tuesday with one career home run.

(c) His 21 walks are tied with Glenn Gulliver (21 BB, 1982) for the most in O's history (since 1954) through a player's first 27 career games...The club record through 28 games is currently held by Gulliver (23 BB).

(c) He has reached base safely 44 times to begin his career, second most through a player's first 27 career games in team history (since 1954) behind Billy Ripken (48 TOB, 1987)... The most through 28 games is Ripken (48 TOB).

(d) Since making his debut, he's averaging 4.44 pitches per plate appearance, sixth most in MLB (min. 95 PA) behind LAA's Mike Trout (4.65 P/PA), DET's Gleyber Torres (4.64 P/PA), ATL's Marcell Ozuna (4.61 P/PA), SD's Jake Cronenworth (4.58 P/PA), and DET's Dillon Dingler (4.45 P/PA). Dingler (4.45 P/PA)

YANKEE DOODLES: Baltimore and New York meet six times over the final 10 days of the regular season, including three more times in this series at Camden Yards and three times at Yankee Stadium to wrap up the schedule from September 26-28...New York holds a 4-3 season series lead in 2025...The O's have won two straight season series against the Yanks since 2023 after losing six straight years from 2017-22...Baltimore has not won three consecutive season series against New York since 2014-16.

(b) Jackson Holliday has reached base in all seven of his career games against the Yankees...

(c) The last Orioles player to do so in each of their first seven games against the Yankees...

The last Orioles player to do so in each of their first seven games against the Yankees was **David Newhan** in 2004, per *Stats Perform*...The last Oriole to reach safely in his first eight games against the Yankees is **Brian Roberts** (14 G) from 2001-03.

QUICK HITS: Set to make his 17th start of the season and his 21st as an Oriole...The QUICK HITS: Set to make his 17th start of the season and his 21st as an Oriole...The O's are 12-4 in his starts this year...Appointed from Triple-A Norfolk as the Orioles' 27th man for the doubleheader on May 24 (G2) at Boston and recalled from Norfolk on June 18...Placed on the 15-day Injured List on March 27 (retroactive to March 24) with right knee subluxations...On May 11, was reinstated from the IL and optioned to Norfolk...Acquired by the Orioles from the Marlins in exchange for INF/OF Connor Norby and OF Kyle Stowers on July 30, 2024...Selected by the Marlins with the No. 13 overall pick in the 2017 First-Year Player Draft out of Carlsbad (NM) High School.

<u>LAST TIME OUT</u>: Did not factor in the decision on September 12 at Toronto after allowing one unearned run on three hits and a season-high four walks with six strikeouts in 5.0 innings...Exited after the fifth frame with left toe discomfort...Threw 79 pitches, 50 strikes.

- Did not allow an earned run for the fifth time this year (last: 7/26 vs. COL).
- Has not completed 6.0 innings in back-to-back games after holding a career-high 10-start streak of working 6.0+ innings.

 All three hits came against his changeup...Opponents are 13-for-51 (.255) off the pitch since August 6 (7 GS) after going 7-for-49 (.143) from June 23-August 1 (7 GS).

<u>NEW YORK</u>, <u>NEW YORK</u>: Set to make his third career start against the Yankees, pitching to a 2.70 ERA (2 ER/6.2 IP) through his two prior outings...Last faced the club on July 31, 2021 at loanDepot park, allowing two runs on five hits, three walks, and one

hit batter with four strikeouts in 3.2 innings.

Bis career 2.66 ERA (22 ER/74.1 IP) against the AL East is his lowest mark against any single division.

FEELING HOT, HOT: Rogers was named the American League Pitcher of the Month for August after pitching to a 1.29 ERA (6 ER/42.0 IP) with four wins, 41 strikeouts, an 0.86 WHIP, and .199 opponent average (30-for-151) across six starts... Became the first Oriole pitcher to earn the recognition since Corbin Burnes in September 2024 and the first Oriole southpaw since Erik Bedard in July 2007.

(b) Led the majors in innings pitched and led the AL in ERA and WHIP.

(c) Was the only pitcher to throw a complete game during the month (8/1 at CHC).

(c) Recame the first Oriole in franchise history (since 1954) to make at least five starts.

- Became the first Oriole in franchise history (since 1954) to make at least five starts and allow one or zero runs in each of the outings in a single month.

OFF AND RUNNING: Rogers' 1.43 ERA is the lowest by an Oriole through his first 16

- Starts of a season in franchise history (since 1954), surpassing Jim Palmer (1.53 ERA, 1975)...The lowest mark through 16 starts is also held by Palmer in 1975 (1.56 ERA).

 The 1.43 mark is the lowest ERA through a major league starter's first 16 games of the season since HOU's Nolan Ryan in 1981 (1.29 ERA)...NYM's Jacob DeGrom held a 1.08 ERA (11 ER/92.0 IP) in 2021, but only made 15 total starts that season.
- His ERA, opponent on-base percentage (.236), slugging percentage (.249), and OPS (.485) on the year lead all major league pitchers, while his opponent average (.184) ranks second (min. 100.0 IP).

LIMITING THE LONG BALL: Since the beginning of the 2021 season, Rogers has allowed 0.75 home runs per nine innings, tied for the fifth-lowest mark among all MLB starters during that stretch (min. 450.0 IP).

Oh Has allowed one or zero home runs in 46 of his last 47 starts since September 12,

- 2022 (2 HR, 5/4/24 at OAK).
- Rogers' 0.27 home runs per nine innings on the year would be the third-lowest mark by an Oriole starter in franchise history (min. 100.0 IP), behind Bill Wight (1957) and **Bob Turley** (1954), who both held a 0.25 clip.

TWO STRIKES, TWO OUTS: Opponents are hitting .123 (24-for-195) with a .321 OPS in two-strike counts and .139 (15-for-108) with a .367 OPS with two outs off Rogers...His .330 opponent OPS with two strikes is the third lowest among all major league pitchers (min. 175 BF) while his .367 opponent OPS with two outs leads MLB (min. 115 BF).


