THE WORD ON THE BIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals conclude their three-game weekend series against the defending back/back World Series Champion Los Angeles Dodgers this afternoon and are looking to sweep LA for the first time since a 4-game series sweep in 2019 here at Busch Stadium (April 8-11)...the two teams won't meet again until a Sept. 1-3 series at Dodger Stadium...the Cardinals posted their season-high 6th-straight win (longest active win streak in MLB) with a 3-2 win in last night's game...the Cardinals will host the Milwaukee Brewers for a three-game series beginning tomorrow night in their 1st meeting of the season with the defending NL Central Champs...the Cardinals are a season-best 7 games over .500 at 20-13 & are one of seven MLB teams with 20+ wins.

SERIES STUFF: The Cardinals have now won three-consecutive series against the Dodgers dating to last season, and are one of two teams with an active streak of 3+ regular season series wins against the Dodgers along with the Phillies who have done so in 5-straight series. (*Elias*).

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis entered today tied with Cincinnati for 2nd place in the NL Central, 1.0 game back of first place Chicago... today's game is their 10th in a season-high stretch of 17-straight games without an off day (6-3 record)...the Cardinals are 57-62 in games played against the Dodgers in the seasons (2026, 2025, 2021, 1989, 1982, 1964, 1960 and 1956) that followed their World Series titles.

WHAT A WEEK: The Cardinals have gone 6-0 this week with a four-game series sweep at Pittsburgh, followed by two wins over the Dodgers...in that span, the Cardinals co-lead MLB with 10 HR's (NYY) and are 2nd in team OPS to the Pirates (.923)...their starters are 4-0 with a 2.97 ERA.

MAY'S DAY: Dustin May, who changed to uniform #3 when he signed with St. Louis (because his preferred #85 is retired by the Cardinals - former team owner August Busch, Jr.) makes the start today against his former club for the first time after spending 5+ years in Dodger Blue. Former Redbirds pitcher **Jakie May** (1917-21) is the only other player with a surname of May in team annals, and he posted a career mark of 2-5 during his namesake month. One of his May wins came on May 25, 1918 against the Brooklyn Robins at Robison Field in St. Louis when he worked 8.2 innings in relief of starter Lee Meadows in a 7-6 victory.

WHO LET THE DOGS OUT? Not related to the anthem song from their 2000 playoff push when they played to the winning tune of "Who Let the Dogs Out?" by Baha Men, the Cardinals introduced a Home Run dugout celebration chain on Friday night that displays an inscription of "Got that Dawg in Me"...the Cardinals are currently ranked T-3rd in the NL with 44 HR's, and are in barking distance of the Dodgers (45) & Braves (48).

MANAGER MATH: Cardinals manager **Oliver "Oli" Marmol** (345-336 from 2022-26) needs just one more win to tie **Miller Huggins** (346, 1913-17) for 11th on the franchise's all-time managerial wins list and he is six wins shy of matching **Joe Torre** (1990-95) for 10th all-time with 351.

Dustin May pitched parts of six seasons with Los Angeles (2019-25)...member of the 2020 World Champion Dodgers...originally selected by Los Angeles in the 3rd round of the 2016 MLB Draft.

Lars Nootbaar, **Shohei Ohtani**, **Roki Sasaki**, and **Yoshinobu Yamamoto** were teammates on Japan's Gold Medal-winning team in the 2023 World Baseball Classic.

Andre Pallante was born in Mission Viejo and resides in San Clemente...graduated from San Clemente High School...played college baseball at the Univ. of California, Irvine (2017-19).

Michael McGreevy was born in and resides in San Clemente...graduated from San Clemente High School...played college baseball at the University of California, Santa Barbara (2019-21).

Justin Bruhl pitched parts of three seasons with the Dodgers (2021-23) where he made his MLB debut...played college baseball California Polytechnic State University, San Luis Obispo.

Dean Kiekhefer made his MLB debut at Dodger Stadium (May 14, 2016)...struck out career-high four of six total batters faced, including first batter, Joc Pederson (looking).

Tommy Edman played parts of five seasons with St. Louis (2019-24)...won a Gold Glove at second base in 2021...selected by the Cardinals in the 6th round of the 2016 MLB Draft.

Lars Nootbaar was born in & resides El Segundo, Calif...Graduated from El Segundo High School... Played college baseball at USC (2016-18).

JoJo Romero was born in Camarillo, CA...graduated from Oxnard (Calif.) High School.

Brant Brown previously served as Dodgers Assistant Hitting Coach and Minor League Hitting Coordinator for five seasons (2018-22).

Victor Scott II made his MLB debut at Dodger Stadium (March 28, 2024)...is the only Cardinal (since 1900) to steal a base in his Major League debut on Opening Day.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Mark McGwire** was born in Pomona and resides in San Clemente, Calif... graduated from Damien High School in La Verne, Calif...played college baseball at the University of Southern California...served as Dodgers Hitting Coach for three seasons (2013-15).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Al Hrabosky** graduated from Savanna High School in Anaheim...played college baseball at Fullerton (Calif.) College.

Cardinals broadcaster **Ricky Horton** pitched in 35 games over parts of two seasons (1988-89) for the Dodgers between stints with St. Louis...member of 1988 World Series champion Dodgers.

Hall of Fame Manager **Joe Torre** managed both the Cardinals (1990-95) and Dodgers (2008-10).

Cardinals AGM/Scouting **Randy Flores** was born in Bellflower...graduated from El Rancho High School in Pico Rivera...pitched at the University of Southern California (1994-97).

Ron "Pop" Warner was born in Alhambra, Calif.

Cardinals broadcaster **Mark Sweeney** played his two final MLB seasons with the Dodgers (2007-08)...Was originally selected by the Dodgers in the 39th round of the 1990 MLB draft, but did not sign.

Hall of Famer **Ozzie Smith** graduated from Locke High School in Los Angeles...played college baseball at Cal Polytechnic State Univ., San Luis Obispo.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **John Tudor** pitched two seasons (1988-89) with Los Angeles, where he won a World Series...originally traded by St. Louis to the Dodgers for **Pedro Guerrero** (Aug. 16, 1988).

Cardinals broadcaster **Polo Ascencio** worked for parts of 10 seasons (2008-16) for Dodgers radio and Spanish website.

Dodgers MLB Field Coordinator **Bob Geren** played five minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization (1981-85).

St. Louis Post-Dispatch reporter **Daniel Guerrero** is an Anaheim, Calif. native...earned associates degree in journalism at Fullerton College.

Athletic reporter **Katie Woo** previously covered the Cardinals for five seasons (2021-25).

TODAY'S GAME:

- The 28-year-old **Dustin May** makes his 7th start as a member of the Cardinals this evening; It's his 64th career start (78th appearance).
- Enters on a three-game win streak, longest active on the Cardinals and matches his career-long. A win today would set a new career-high win streak of 4-games.**
- A win this afternoon would also boost his career winning percentage over .500.
- Has four caught stealing on attempted base stealers, tied with Toronto's **Patrick Corbin** for the most in MLB among pitchers.
- Signed as a free-agent deal for 2026 with mutual option for 2027, in December. St. Louis becomes his 3rd team, having previously pitched for the Dodgers (2019-25) & Red Sox (2025).
- Lifetime 3-3 with a 3.50 ERA (43.2 IP) in nine career May starts; his best ERA of any month.

MAY DAY:

- Starts on May 3 while wearing uniform no. 3, against his former team.
- Is the 27th Cardinal to wear uniform No. 3, but the first Cardinals pitcher to have worn the number: notable former Cardinals to wear #3 are **Édgar Rentería**, **Brian Jordan**, **Carlos Beltrán** and most recently **Dylan Carlson**.
- LHP **Darrell May** wore #21 in 1996 and #22 in 1997 for the Angels and #31 for the Royals in 2002, but never appeared on May 21, May 22, or May 31 those seasons.
- LHP **Jakie May** pitched in five seasons (1917-21) for the Cardinals before uniforms were first issued in 1923.

LAST TIME OUT (Monday, April 27 at PNC Park): ND, 4-2; 6.0 IP, 7 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 2 BB, 2 SO, 95 pitches.

- Earned a no-decision in Monday's series opener at Pittsburgh in the Cardinals come-from-behind, last-at-bat 4-2 win over at PNC Park.
- Held his opposition to two earned runs or fewer 4th straight start.
- Received no runs of support as the Cardinals were no-hit through 6.2 innings.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS:

KICKING THE BABIP HABIT: 17 or his 40 hits allowed came in his first two starts).

DON'T WALK TO STRANGERS: Has the lowest walk/batters faced percentage of any Cardinals starting pitcher 5.4% and is in the 92% of all MLB pitchers (34th overall).

BACK-TO-BACK JACK: Gained a 5-3 win vs. CLE (4/15) as he paired back/back quality starts & wins over BOS & CLE during that homestand.

MILESTONE WIN: Bested his former team the Red Sox in the homestand opener (4/10) in a 3-2 win. It was his 1st win as a member of the Cardinals and his 20th career win.

TIGER STRIKE: Was hit for a season-high seven runs on seven hits (and struck in leg by line drive) over 3.1 innings in an 11-6 loss at Detroit (4/4) in his second start. First Cardinals pitcher since **Mike Parisi** (2008) to begin a season allowing 6 or more runs in his first two starts of a season; and the first Cardinal to pitch the Opening Day series since **Dizzy Dean** (1936).

OPENING ACT: Took the loss in his Cardinals debut at Busch Stadium vs. TB (3/29) allowing six runs over 4.0 inning. Tied his career-high allowing 10 hits, the first Cardinals pitcher to allow double-digit hits in his debut in 55 years since **Chris Zachary** surrendered 10 to the Phillies (5/3/1971) *Elias*. Recorded his 300th career strikeout retiring **Junior Caminero**.

MAY VS. LOS ANGELES DODGERS:

- Played the majority of his professional and Major League career with the Dodgers organization (2019-25 before being traded to the Boston Red Sox at the 2025 trade deadline).
- Originally selected by Los Angeles in the 3rd round of the 2016 MLB Draft.
- Carries three World Championship rings as a member of the Los Angeles Dodgers. Played in the 2020 World Series at the neutral site at Globe Life Field. Was on the Injured List during the 2024 World Series. Was traded before the Dodgers won the World Series in 2025.
- Became the first Dodgers rookie to make an Opening Day start when he took the mound on July 24, 2020 in place of injured Clayton Kershaw, The last Dodgers rookie to make an Opening Day start was Fernando Valenzuela in 1981.
- Made his Major League debut vs. San Diego at Dodger Stadium on Aug. 2, 2019.

LOOKIE AT THE ROOKIE: Hit a pair of home runs vs. CLE (4/14), his first multi-HR game and first by a Cardinal since Masyn Winn (4/30/25 at CIN).
