TODAY IN YANKEES HISTORY

May 19, 2021: Corey Kluber tosses his first career no-hitter in a 2-0 win at Texas, allowing just one baserunner (BB in the 3rd inning) while throwing 101 pitches. It marks the 12th no-hitter in Yankees franchise history (incl. postseason) and the first by a Yankee since David Cone's perfect game on 7/18/99 vs. Montreal.

AT A GLANCE: The Yankees continue their seven-game homestand tonight with the second game of a four-game set vs. Toronto (1-0 thus far)...will also face Tampa Bay in a three-game set this weekend (Fri.-Sun.).

- **Their 29-19 (.604) record is the second-best in the American League and tied for the fourth-best record in the Majors**, trailing only Tampa Bay (31-15, .674), Atlanta (32-16, .667) and San Diego (29-18, .617).
- **Are 19-10 in their last 29 games (since 4/17), 20-11 in their last 31 games (since 4/15) and 21-12 in their last 33 games (since 4/13).**
- Have won or split seven of their last 10 completed series (6-3-1) and 10 of their 15 completed series this season (9-5-1).
- The Yankees' +69 run differential this season is the best in the AL and the third-best in the Majors.

YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Yankees defeated the Blue Jays, 7-6, in their series opener on Monday at Yankee Stadium...**LHP Ryan Weathers** (5.1IP, 7H, 5R/ER, 0BB, 7K, 2HR) started and did not record a decision after allowing a season-high-tying 5R/ER...**1B Paul Goldschmidt** (2-for-4, 1R, 1 double, 1HR, 2RBI, 1BB) reached base three times and drove in two runs, including his fifth career leadoff home run and a game-tying RBI double in the fourth inning...**C.J.C. Escarra** (0-for-3, 1RBI, 1SB) drove in a run in the fourth inning with a sac fly...**CF/LF Cody Bellinger** (2-for-4, 1R, 1HR, 2RBI) hit his sixth home run of the year with a game-tying two-run shot in the seventh inning...**2B Jazz Chisholm Jr.** (2-for-4, 1R, 1HR, 2RBI) hit his fifth home run of the season with a go-ahead two-run shot in the seventh inning...**SS Anthony Volpe** (2-for-4, 1R, 1 double, 2SB) recorded his second straight multi-hit game and stole two bases...**LF/3B Max Schuemann** (1-for-2, 1R, 2BB, 2SB) reached base a season-high three times and recorded a career-high-tying 2SB...**RHP Paul Blackburn** (1.2IP, 1H, 1K) earned his second win of the year after tossing 1.2 scoreless innings of relief...**RHP Fernando Cruz** (1.0IP, 1BB, 3K) tossed a scoreless eighth inning...**RHP David Bednar** (1.0IP, 1H, 1R/ER, 2BB, 2K) recorded his 11th save of the season.

RICE RICE BABY: C/INF Ben Rice has hit .298/.400/.662 (45-for-151) with 35R, 10 doubles, 15HR, 31RBI, 25BB/2IBB, 2HP, 2SF and 2SB in 43 games this season...has reached base safely in 33-of-39 starts.

- Has hit 2HR in his last four games (since 5/15), 3HR in his last seven games (since 5/11), 5HR in his last 13 games (since 5/1), 7HR in his last 19 games (since 4/24) and 11HR in his last 26 games (since 4/16).
- Six of his 15HR this year have given the Yankees the lead, including three of his last 4HR and four of his last 6HR.
- 25 of his 45H this season have been XBH (10 doubles, 15HR).

ALL THAT JAZZ: INF Jazz Chisholm Jr. hit his fifth home run of the season with a go-ahead two-run shot in the seventh inning on Monday vs. Toronto...three of his 5HR this season have either tied the game (one) or gave the Yankees the lead (two).

- **Has recorded multiple hits in each of his last four games (since 5/15), tied for the longest streak of his career** (also had four-game streaks from 8/31-9/3/24 and 6/8-11/21)...**is batting .526/.591/.842 (10-for-19) with 4R, 3 doubles, 1HR, 4RBI, 3BB and 1SB over his last five games (since 5/13).**
- **Has recorded a hit in 13 of his last 16 starts (since 5/1).**
- His 12SB are tied for the fifth-most in the AL and tied for the eighth-most in the Majors this year.

FAST AND FURIOUS: Yankees baserunners recorded a season-high-tying 5SB on Monday vs. Toronto...marks only the fifth time in the last 13 years (since 2014) the Yankees have stolen five bases in a single game (also 4/3/26 vs. Miami, 8/1/25 at Miami, 8/13/23 at Miami and 4/25/19 at Los Angeles-AL)...marks the first time since 2012 (also twice) the Yankees have stolen at least five bases in a single game multiple times in a season.

- With **INF Anthony Volpe** and **INF/OF Max Schuemann** each stealing two bases on Monday, it marked the second time this season and only the third time in the last nine years (since 2018) the Yankees had multiple players steal multiple bases in the same game (also Jazz Chisholm Jr. and José Caballero each stole two bases on 4/3/26 vs. Miami, and Jasson Domínguez and Anthony Volpe each stole two bases on 8/1/25 at Miami).
- **Yankees baserunners** have recorded 47 stolen bases this year, their most through their first 48 games of a season in the last 25 seasons (since 2002) and most since recording 56SB in 2001.

ALL RISE: OF Aaron Judge has reached base in 39 of his last 42 games (since 4/3), batting .289/.430/.624 (43-for-149) with 37R, 8 doubles, 14HR, 27RBI, 35BB/5IBB, 2HP and 5SB over that span.

- 24 of his 46H this season have been XBH (8 doubles, 16HR).
- Has hit .321/.525/.750 (9-for-28) with 4HR, 15RBI, 11BB/5IBB and 1HP with RISP this season.
- His 41HR vs. the Blue Jays are the most by a Yankee against Toronto in franchise history...also marks the second-most HR by any player vs. a single opponent since 2017, trailing only his own 53HR vs. Baltimore...has hit 6HR in his last 18 games (since 6/30/24) against Toronto and 13HR in his last 36 games vs. Toronto (since 5/15/23).

SAVED BY THE BELL: INF/OF Cody Bellinger hit his sixth home run of the year with a game-tying two-run shot in the seventh inning on Monday vs. Toronto.

- **Has hit safely in each of his last 14 home games (since 4/13), batting .462/.540/.981 (24-for-52) with 13R, 8 doubles, 2 triples, 5HR, 20RBI, 10BB, 1SB and 1SF over that span.**...has hit safely in 18-of-20 home games this year, batting .384/.478/.808 (28-for-73) with 17R, 9 doubles, 2 triples, 6HR, 24RBI, 15BB, 2SF and 1SB.
- Has hit .341/.412/.537 (14-for-41) with 4 doubles, 2 triples, 20RBI, 7BB and 3SF with RISP this season.
- According to FanGraphs and Sports Info Solutions, leads all Major League LF in DRS (nine)...is tied for fourth in the Majors in go-ahead RBI (nine, tied for second in AL) and tied for 10th in RBI (32, tied for second in AL).

GOOD WILL WARREN: RHP Will Warren will make his 10th start of the season tonight vs. Toronto...**has gone 5-1 with a 3.42 ERA (47.1IP, 18ER) and 59K in nine starts this season.**...has allowed 2ER-or-fewer in eight of his nine starts.

- The Yankees are 7-2 in his starts...his seven team wins are tied for the fifth-most in the Majors this season.
- Since 2025, has allowed 2ER-or-fewer in 30 of his 42 starts, the most in the AL and tied for the third-most in the Majors over that span.

GOT YOUR NUMBER: INF Ryan McMahon has hit .417/.429/.750 (5-for-12) with 1 double, 1HR and 1BB in his career vs. Toronto's RHP Dylan Cease...**OF Aaron Judge** has hit .308/.412/.692 (4-for-13) with 2 doubles, 1HR and 3BB in his career vs. Cease.

GOOD AS GOLD: INF Paul Goldschmidt reached base three times and drove in two runs on Monday vs. Toronto, hitting his fifth career leadoff home run — his third of the season — and a game-tying RBI double in the fourth inning (also hit leadoff HRs on 3/29/25 vs. Milwaukee, 8/4/25 at Texas, 5/9/26 at Milwaukee and 5/12/26 at Baltimore).

- Each of his three leadoff HR this season have come in his last six games (since 5/9)...has hit 4HR in his last 10 games (since 5/5).
- Has hit .378/.462/.756 (17-for-45) with 10R, 3 doubles, 1 triple, 4HR, 10RBI, 5BB and 2HP over his last 14 games (since 4/26).
- Has hit .600/.750/1.100 (6-for-10) with 2 doubles, 1HR, 9RBI, 4BB and 2HP with RISP this season...as a Yankee (since 2025), has hit .336/.430/.454 (40-for-119) with 8 doubles, 2HR, 43RBI, 18BB/5IBB, 3HP and 2SF with RISP.

HOME SWEET HOME: The Yankees have gone 10-1 in their last 11 home games (since 4/17)...have gone 15-6 (.714) at home this season, the third-best home record in the Majors this season, trailing only Tampa Bay (17-5, .773) and Chicago-NL (18-6, .750).

DYNAMIC DUO: OF Aaron Judge (16HR) and C/INF Ben Rice (15HR) are only the third pair of Yankees teammates in franchise history to each hit at least 15HR in the club's first 48 games of a season, joining Roger Maris (16HR) and Mickey Mantle (15HR) in 1961 and Yogi Berra (16HR) and Mantle (21HR) in 1956...are only the third pair of Major League teammates in the last 25 seasons (since 2002) to accomplish the feat, joining Boston's Mookie Betts (16HR) and J.D. Martinez (15HR) in 2018, and Milwaukee's Prince Fielder (15HR) and J.J. Hardy (15HR) in 2007.

TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER: RHP WILL WARREN (5-1, 3.42 ERA)

RHP Will Warren will make his 10th start of the season on tonight's game vs. Toronto...the 26-year-old will pitch on extended six days' rest due...made his ninth start of the season on Tuesday at Baltimore, recording his fifth win of the year after allowing just 2R/ER in 5.2IP (4H, 1BB, 6K, 0HR, 1WP)...**is 5-1 with a 3.42 ERA (47.1IP, 43H, 23R/18ER, 12BB, 59K, 6HR) in nine starts this season...his 30 starts of 2ER-or-fewer are the most in the AL and tied for the third-most in the Majors since 2025...the Yankees' 24 wins in his starts since 2025 are tied for the fourth-most in the AL and tied for the ninth-most in the Majors**...last season, went 9-8 with a 4.44 ERA (162.1IP, 158H, 90R/80ER, 65BB, 171K, 22HR) in 33 starts, allowing 2ER-or-fewer in 22 of those starts...**according to Elias, his 22 starts of 2ER-or-fewer were the second-most by a Yankees rookie in a single season**, trailing only Stan Bahnsen (25GS in 1968)...is 8-4 with a 3.58 ERA (110.2IP, 105H, 57R/44ER, 30BB, 113K, 17HR) over his last 21 starts (since 7/25/25) after going 6-8 with a 5.92 ERA (121.2IP, 129H, 83R/80ER, 57BB, 146K, 16HR) over his first 27 career games (26 starts) from 7/30/24-7/19/25...has allowed 2ER-or-fewer in 17 of his last 21 starts...saw his first Major League action with the Yankees in 2024, going 0-3 with a 10.32 ERA (22.2IP, 33H, 27R/26ER, 10BB, 29K, 5HR) in six games (five starts) over five stints with the club (7/30, 8/7, 8/14, 8/21-31, 9/28)...was selected by the Yankees in the eighth round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of Southeastern Louisiana University.

LAST TIME OUT: Made his ninth start of the season on Tuesday at Baltimore, recording his fifth win of the year after allowing just 2R/ER in 5.2IP (4H, 1BB, 6K, 0HR, 1WP).

2026: Is 5-1 with a 3.42 ERA (47.1IP, 43H, 23R/18ER, 12BB, 59K, 6HR) in nine starts this season...has allowed 2ER-or-fewer in eight of his nine starts.

- ✦ Has allowed 2BB-or-fewer in seven of his nine starts this season, including 1BB-or-fewer in six of those starts...his six starts with 1BB-or-fewer are tied for the fifth-most in the AL and tied for the seventh-most in the Majors...has issued just 12BB to 198 batters faced.
- ✦ Ranks third in K/9.0IP (11.22, second in AL) and ninth in strikeout rate (29.8%, fifth in AL) and K/BB (4.92, seventh in AL) among Major League pitchers (min. 45.0IP)...among AL pitchers is tied for fifth in wins (five) and is tied for seventh in strikeouts (59).
- ✦ Has recorded at least 6K in seven of his nine starts this season, including each of his last six starts (since 4/13)...has posted a 12.40 K/9.0IP (45K/32.2IP) over that span.
- ✦ His six game streak with at least 6K is a career long...is one of only three Yankees (fifth time) in the last seven years (since 2020) to record six-or-more strikeouts in at least six straight games, joining Cam Schlichtler (9GS from 9/11/25-4/17/26) and Gerrit Cole (3x: 15GS from 8/8/20-G1-4/30/21, 11GS from 6/22-9/1/21 and 12GS from 6/14/22-8/15/22).
- ✦ Has allowed one-or-zero HR in seven of his nine starts this season, including five starts without allowing a HR.
- ✦ The Yankees are 7-2 in his starts, tied for the fourth-most wins in a pitchers starts in the AL and tied for the fifth-most in the Majors.
- ✦ Went 4-0 with a 2.39 ERA (37.2IP, 32H, 15R/10ER, 8BB, 46K, 4HR) in his first seven starts of the season (3/28-5/1)...allowed 2ER-or-fewer in each of those seven starts...the Yankees won six of those seven starts.
- ✦ Allowed 2ER-or-fewer in each of his first seven starts this season (3/28-5/1), the most in the Majors in that span (most in the AL)...was only the seventh Yankees pitcher (eighth time) in the last 66 years (since 1961) to allow 2ER-or-fewer in each of his first seven starts of a season (excluding openers), joining Max Fried (first 11GS in 2025), Michael King (first 8GS in 2023), Gerrit Cole (2x: first 8GS in 2021 and first 7GS in 2023), Nestor Cortes (first 7GS in 2022), Michael Pineda (first 9GS in 2014) and Hideki Irabu (first 7GS in 1998).
- ✦ Made his fifth start of the season and earned his second win of the year on 4/18 vs. Kansas City after allowing only 2R/ER over 7.0 innings (5H, 0BB, 11K, 1HR, 1PO)...**his 11K tied his career high (also 11K on 6/17/25 vs. Los Angeles-AL)**...marked his third career double-digit strikeout game (also 11K on 6/17/25 vs. Los Angeles-AL and 10K on 5/20/25 vs. Texas)...marked the second time in his career he has recorded at least 10K without surrendering a walk (also 11K and 0BB 6/17/25 vs. Los Angeles-AL)...no other Yankee had done so since Warren last accomplished the feat on 6/17/25...his 7.0 innings marked the second-longest start of his career (7.1IP on 5/9/25 at the Athletics)...also marked his sixth career start with 0BB and his second this season (last on 4/3 vs. Miami).
- ✦ Recorded his first win of the season on 4/3 vs. Miami, allowing 2R/ER in 5.2IP (4H, 0BB, 6K, 2HR).

HOME SWEET HOME: Is 3-1 with a 3.73 ERA (31.1IP, 13ER) and 44K in six home starts this season...has allowed 2ER-or-fewer in five of his six home starts this season.

- ✦ Since the start of last season, is 10-5 with a 3.56 ERA (118.2IP, 98H, 54R/47ER, 42BB, 140K, 18HR) in 22 starts at Yankee Stadium...has allowed 2ER-or-fewer in 16 of those 22 starts...his 10 wins at home since 2025 are tied for the fifth-most in the Majors and tied for the second-most in the AL over that span.
- ✦ Was 3-0 with a 2.30 ERA (27.1IP, 7ER) and 37K in his first five home starts of the season (4/3-5/1)...allowed 2ER-or-fewer in all five starts.

VS. TORONTO: Will make his second career regular season start vs. the Blue Jays tonight...tossed 4.0IP at Toronto on 7/2/25 (10H, 8R/ER, 4BB, 4K, 2HR)...tossed 4.2IP in relief at Toronto in 2025 ALDS Game 2 (4.2IP, 7H, 6R/ER, 1BB, 4K, 4HR).

2025: In his first full Major League season, went 9-8 with a 4.44 ERA (162.1IP, 158H, 90R/80ER, 65BB, 171K, 22HR)...opponents batted .250/.320/.418 (158-for-631, 22HR); LH .266/.350/.436 (91-for-342, 12HR); RH .232/.283/.398 (67-for-289, 10HR).

- ✦ Was tied for second in the Majors in starts (33, tied for first in AL)...also ranked eighth in the AL in K/9.0IP (9.48).
- ✦ Was just the third Yankees rookie to make at least 33 starts in a season, joining Stan Bahnsen (34GS in 1968), and Russ Ford (33GS in 1910)...was also the first Major League rookie to make at least 33 starts in a single season since 2009 (Nick Blackburn, 33GS with Minnesota in 2008).
- ✦ Among Major League rookies, ranked first in strikeouts, starts and innings pitched, and was tied for fourth in wins (tied for third in AL).
- ✦ Went 5-5 with a 3.94 ERA (105.0IP, 46ER) over his final 20 starts (6/12-9/26) after going 4-3 with a 5.34 ERA (57.1IP, 34ER) over his first 13 starts of the season (4/1-6/6)...allowed 2ER-or-fewer in 14 of his final 20 starts and one-or-zero ER in eight of those starts.

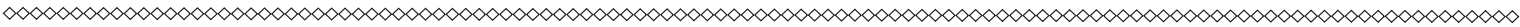
