**RAY REPORT**—The Rays continue a nine-game, 10-day homestand against the Guardians (1-0, two to play), Rangers (three to play), and White Sox (three to play) tonight at Tropicana Field...have won four of their last five games following a season-high five-game losing streak (July 12-19), which was their longest since April 2-8, 2025 (also 5G — excl. multi-season streaks)...entering the skid, went 13-4 in their previous 17 games (June 24–July 11), and their 17-10 record since June 24 ranks fourth in MLB...are currently 4-5 on stretches of 11 games in 10 days (July 17-26) and 20 games in 20 days (July 17–Aug. 5)...overall, lead the AL with a 60-43 record, fourth best in the majors and their sixth-best mark through 103 games...became the first AL team to reach 60 wins for the second time, joining 2023 (60-35)...have spent 69 days leading the AL East, 39 in second, six in third, four in fourth, and three in fifth, including 28 consecutive days in first (June 27–pres.), their second-longest stay atop the division this season behind May 9–June 12 (35 days)...the 69 total days in first lead AL East clubs, ahead of the Yankees (62)—in all of MLB, only the Dodgers (116), Braves (114), Guardians (95), and Brewers (84) have spent more days leading their respective divisions...marks the latest into a season they have led the AL East since winning the division in 2021.

- ✦ The Rays claimed last night's series opener, 11-3...they churned out 7 XBH (4 2B, 3B, 2HR), tied for their second most this season (also: June 25 vs. KC) behind May 18 vs. BAL (8), and plated double-digit runs for the second time in their last four games (also: 12R on July 20 at TOR) and the sixth time in 2026.
- ✦ All 10 Rays to register a PA reached safely, the club's most since May 18 vs. BAL (10)...all nine starters reached safely for the 12th time (last: June 30 at KC), with the Rays improving to 10-2 in such contests.
- ✦ The Rays 5-9 hitters produced a season-high 10 RBI in the win, their most since June 20, 2025 vs. DET at Steinbrenner Field (10) and most at Tropicana Field since April 19, 2014 vs. NYY (11)...for more information, see the 'Bottoms Up' note below.
- ✦ It marked the Rays AL-leading 29th victory in which they never trailed...in all of MLB, only the Phillies (33) and Brewers (30) have more.
- ✦ The Rays have permitted three runs or fewer in five straight games, tied for their second-longest streak this season (also: June 24-28) behind a franchise-record 13-game stretch from April 22–May 6, which tied the longest streak by an AL club in the Wild Card era (since 1995)...the staff has turned in a 2.25 ERA (44.0IP, 11ER) with 32SO, 9BB, and a .206 (33-for-160) opp. average during the current streak.
- ✦ They are an MLB-best 36-15 at home, including wins in 10 of their last 13 contests at Tropicana Field, outscoring opponents, 73-44 (+29), in that span while out-homering them, 23-16 (+7)...the 36-15 record is their second best through 51 home games behind 2008 (36-15) and marks the best such record by an AL club since the Yankees in 2022 (39-12).
- ✦ The Rays have won each of the last five games started by **Nick Martinez** (June 21–pres.), tied with four others for the longest active streak in the AL and tied for the longest stretch in a Rays pitcher's starts this season (also: **Shane McCann** from April 25–May 18)...the club's last longer streak came when it won seven straight **Shane Baz** outings from May 24–June 26, 2025.
- ✦ In conjunction with MLB Hall of Fame Weekend, the Rays will don their green Devil Rays caps and throwback Devil Rays uniforms during this series...the club is 8-0 when wearing the latter in 2026.

**RECENT TRANSACTIONS**—Earlier today, the Rays reinstated **LHP Steven Matz** (left ankle sprain) from the 15-day IL and optioned **RHP Chris Roycroft** to Triple-A Durham.

**WHAT'S AT STAKE**—With a win tonight, the Rays would:

- ✦ Improve to 6-2-2 in their last 10 series (June 19–pres.) and win back-to-back sets for the first time since June 26–July 2 (vs. AZ, at KC).
- ✦ Move to 11-1-2 in their last 14 series at Tropicana Field (April 24–pres.) and 5-0-2 in their last seven (June 8–pres.), which would mark their most consecutive home sets without a series loss since May 9–June 20, 2025 (7-0-1) at Steinbrenner Field and most at the Trop since June 11–July 31, 2024 (6-0-1).
- ✦ Claim their second season series win over the Guardians in the last three years (4-3 in 2024) and improve to 5-2-1 in the last eight season sets since 2018 (clubs did not meet in 2020).
- ✦ Paired with April 27-29 at CLE, win back-to-back series over Cleveland for the first time since a six-series streak from Aug. 31, 2018–July 25, 2021.
- ✦ Record their third straight series win over the Guardians at Tropicana Field (Aug. 11, 2023–pres.) and sixth in their last seven tries (Sept. 10, 2018–pres.).

**BOTTOMS UP**—The 5-9 spots in the Rays lineup went a combined 11-for-21 (.524) with 3 2B, 2 HR, and 10 RBI last night and have batted .410 (32-for-78) with 32 of the Rays 47 hits (68.1%) and 22 of their 26 RBI (84.6%) over the last four games...during the month of July, the club's 5-9 hitters are slashing .306/.347/.497 (115-for-376) with an .844 OPS—the average slugging pct. and OPS all lead the majors, and only the Pirates 5-9 batters have a better on-base pct. (.355)...that portion of the order is on pace for their best average in a calendar month in club history, ahead of April 2005 (.302), and their fourth-best OPS to April 2023 (.866), June 2009 (.849), and June 2008 (.846).

- ✦ Over his last 11 games, **Victor Mesa Jr.** is slashing .355/.394/.871 (11-for-31) with 12B, 5 HR, 8 RBI, 2 BB, 5 R, and 2 SB...during that span (July 7–pres.), he ranks second in the majors (min. 30PA) in slugging pct. to **SD Ty France** (.930), is fourth in OPS (1.265), and is tied for fourth in homers.
- ✦ **Nick Fortes** is 10-for-15 (.667) over his last four games, tied for the most hits by a Rays catcher across any four-game span in team history (5x, last: **Travis d'Arnaud** from July 6-15, 2019)...between his four-hit effort last night and his 4-for-4 performance on June 10 vs. BOS, Fortes joined **Dioner Navarro** (2G, 2008) as the only Rays backstops with multiple four-hit games in a season.
- ✦ Over his last 19 games (June 24–pres.), Fortes is batting .396 (21-for-53) with 5 XBH, 13 RBI, 12 R, and a 1.032 OPS, MLB's second-best average in that span (min. 50AB) to **ATH Joshua Kuroda-Grauer** (.417).
- ✦ **Chandler Simpson** is 12-for-25 (.480) in his last seven games and has hit safely in 23 of his last 28 contests overall (June 19–pres.), slashing .369/.396/.476 (38-for-103) with 7 2B, 2 3B, 6 RBI, 12 R, and 12 SB...he paces the majors in steals over that timeframe and leads the AL in batting average.
- ✦ **Jonny DeLuca** has gone 9-for-22 (.409) with 3 XBH, 7 RBI, and four multi-hit efforts across a five-game hitting streak...**Ben Williamson** is batting .364 (12-for-33) with 2 2B and 4 RBI in his last nine games.
- ✦ Overall, the Rays lead the AL with 45 HR and 15 multi-homer games in their last 30 contests since June 21, going deep in 22 of those games...this comes after they produced the majors' fewest home runs (60) and multi-homer efforts (14, tied with BOS) over their first 73 games through June 20.
- ✦ The Rays are batting .280 with RISP, second in MLB to the Twins (.282)...they have gone 18-for-41 (.439) with RISP over their last four games vs. 6-for-38 (.158) across their previous six games (July 12-20).

**KIDCAMI**—Junior Caminero needs 1 HR to become the fourth player in franchise history with multiple 30-HR seasons, joining **Evan Longoria** (4), **Carlos Peña** (3), and **Brandon Lowe** (2)...he would join Peña (3 straight, 2007-09) as the only Rays to reach the mark in back-to-back seasons...he currently has 74 HR between his age-21 and age-22 seasons (2025-26; age as of June 30), third most in the modern era (since 1900) behind **MLN Eddie Mathews** (87) and **NY Yankees Joe DiMaggio** (75)...Caminero could become the 11th player in the modern era with multiple 30-HR campaigns before his age-23 season, joining **LAA Mike Trout** (2012, 2014), **FLA Giancarlo Stanton** (2011-12), **FLA Miguel Cabrera** (2004-05), **STL Albert Pujols** (2001-02), **SEA Alex Rodriguez** (1996, 1998), **OAK José Canseco** (1986-87), **ATL Bob Horner** (1978-80), **CIN Frank Robinson** (1956, 1958), Mathews (1953-54), **BOS Ted Williams** (1939, 1941), and **PHA Jimmie Foxx** (1929-30)...he could also become the seventh Dominican-born third baseman in MLB history with multiple 30-HR seasons in his career, joining **Adrian Beltré** (5), **José Ramírez** (4), **Aramis Ramírez** (4), **Rafael Devers** (3), **Tony Batista** (3), and **Pedro Álvarez** (2).

- ✦ Caminero leads MLB with 14 HR in his last 28 contests since June 23...he has hit safely in 11 of his last 13 games (July 9–pres.), batting .340 (17-for-50) with 4 2B, 3 HR, 6 RBI, and a 1.041 OPS in that span.

**THE BAKE SHOW**—**Bryan Baker** converted his 15th consecutive save opportunity on Wed. at TOR, tied with **TEX Jacob Latz** for the majors' third-longest active streak behind **SD Mason Miller** (26) and **TOR Louis Varland** (21)...it marks the longest streak by a Rays closer since **Pete Fairbanks** (15) from May 19–Aug. 30, 2023, with the last longer stretch being **Alex Colomé**'s run of 21 consecutive saves from April 17–July 21, 2016...Baker's 26 saves on the year are tied with **STL Riley O'Brien** and **SD Mason Miller** for second most in MLB to **CLE Cade Smith** (29).

**CAN'T TOUCH THIS**—The Rays and Guardians continue a six-game season series tonight after Tampa Bay took two of three games at Progressive Field from April 27-29...the Rays are 14-17 in the last 31 meetings (July 25, 2021–pres.) on the heels of a franchise-record 11-game winning streak from May 25, 2019–July 24, 2021...however, the club's pitching staff has yielded 3 ER or fewer in a franchise-record 12 straight games vs. CLE (Sept. 15, 2024–pres.), tied with a 12-game stretch vs. the Angels (2011-12) for their second-longest streak against a single opponent in club history, trailing an 18-game streak against the **Astros** (2013-16)...their 2.13 ERA (105.2IP, 25ER) against the Guardians in that span is the third lowest by any AL team against an AL opponent, trailing the Yankees vs. KC (1.58) and the Guardians vs. DET (1.97).

- ✦ The Rays have won six straight games vs. AL Central opponents (June 24–pres.), which comes on the heels of a six-game losing streak against the division (April 29–June 23) and a 10-game winning streak (April 4-28)...overall, their 16-7 (.696) record against the AL Central is the best by any AL team, ahead of the Orioles and Red Sox (both 14-8/.636).

**TONIGHT'S START**—Nick Martinez will make his 20th start with the Rays and 11th at home...marks his 300th career appearance (149th start) and eighth (fourth start) opposite the Guardians...signed as a free agent on Feb. 10, 2026.

- ✦ Ranks second among AL qualifiers with a 2.59 ERA (111.1IP, 32ER) behind NYY Cam Schlitler (2.07), fifth in the majors...his .818 winning pct. this year is tied for eighth among MLB qualifiers and second in the AL behind BOS Sonny Gray (.923).
- ✦ 10 of his 19 starts this season have been quality...with a quality start tonight, he would surpass Drew Rasmussen for the club lead.
- ✦ With a win tonight, he would become the fourth pitcher in the AL to reach 10 wins, joining Gray (12), Schlitler (10), and CLE Gavin Williams (10).

**LAST TIME OUT**—Improved to 9-2 after tossing his 10th quality start in his first start after the All-Star Break on July 20 at TOR (W, 6.OIP, 6H, ER, BB)...yielded a single and a walk in the 1st inning before retiring six straight...worked around five other singles, not allowing an extra-base hit in the outing.

- ✦ Marked his sixth start of 6.0 innings or more with one or zero earned runs allowed (last: May 22 at NYY)...has allowed one walk in each of those six outings...his teams are 24-6 over his career in 30 starts in which he goes 6.0 innings or more with one or zero runs allowed, including 8-2 over his last 10 dating back to June 7, 2025 vs. AZ.
- ✦ Has allowed three runs or fewer in 18 of his 19 starts, second most among AL hurlers behind NYY Cam Schlitler (20).

**CLEVELAND ROCKS**—The veteran right-hander is 2-2 with a 5.66 ERA (20.2IP, 13ER) and 16 strikeouts in seven career appearances (three starts) opposite the Guardians...in the three starts, he has pitched to a 5.79 ERA (14.OIP, 9ER) with 11 strikeouts...his last start against them came earlier this season on April 28 at Progressive Field, when he earned the win after pitching 7.0 shutout innings in a 1-0 victory (W, 7.OIP, 3H, BB, 4SO).

- ✦ Martinez is 8-12 with a 5.12 ERA (142.1IP, 81ER) and 104 strikeouts in 39 career appearances (24 starts) vs. AL Central foes...is 8-10 with a 5.30 ERA (124.OIP, 73ER) and 88 strikeouts as a starter...is 1-1 with a 3.71 ERA (17.OIP, 7ER) in three starts against the division this season, allowing one or zero runs in two of those outings.
- ✦ Martinez has fashioned a 2.61 ERA (69.OIP, 20ER) in games against AL opponents, the fourth-lowest mark among major league pitchers (min. 50.OIP) in 2026...is 7-1 in 12 starts against the AL, with the Rays winning all but one of those games.

**HOME COOKIN'**—In 10 starts at home this season, Martinez is 6-1 with a 3.07 ERA (58.2IP, 20ER) and 35 strikeouts...with a win tonight, Martinez and Shane McClanahan (6-1) would be the first pair of AL teammates to both record seven home wins or more this season.

- ✦ Martinez held a 1.47 ERA (30.2IP, 5ER) through his first five home starts as a Ray, lowest in franchise history by a traditional starter over such a span (min. 25.OIP)...he has a 4.82 ERA (28.OIP, 15ER) in his last five home starts since that stretch (June 3–pres.).
- ✦ Among pitchers with 55.0 innings or more at home this year, his 3.07 ERA is the sixth lowest in the AL...under the same parameter, he is tied for the second-fewest walks allowed (11) among AL pitchers and is one of eight AL arms with six home runs or fewer allowed at home.

**START ME UP**—When pitching in the 1st inning this season, Martinez has logged a 0.95 ERA (19.OIP, 2ER) with 13 strikeouts and a .188 opp. average (13-for-69)...his ERA in the opening frame is the sixth-lowest mark in the AL (min. 15.OIP).
