HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs and Brewers are meeting for the first time since Aug. 23-25, 2019 in Milwaukee.

- ♦ The D-backs have lost a club record 14 consecutive road games.
- ♦ **Ketel Marte** is batting .524 (11-for-21) with 2 doubles, 2 home runs and 6 RBI during his 5-game hitting streak.
- ♦ **Nick Ahmed** has a 5-game hitting streak, going 9-for-19 (.474) with 2 doubles, 1 triple and 2 RBI.

26 & COUNTING: Last night, **Humberto Castellanos** made his D-backs debut, becoming the D-backs’ 13th Mexico-born player (11th pitcher) and 26th different pitcher used by Arizona this season.

- ❑ **MOST PITCHERS USED IN MLB IN 2021:** 28 - Mariners; **26 - D-backs** and Cubs; 25 - Blue Jays; 24 - Angels, Orioles, Reds and Pirates.
- ♦ The D-backs featured 26 different pitchers in 2020.

D-BACKS ON TOP SINCE MAY 25: **Pavin Smith** leads the Majors with a .459 average since May 25, followed by teammate **Josh Reddick** (.417) and Nick Castellanos/CIN (.417).

- ♦ **Nick Ahmed** (.405) is sixth and **Ketel Marte** is (.400) is seventh during that span.
- ❑ **BEST AVERAGE IN MLB SINCE MAY 25:** **.459 - Pavin Smith/ARI; .417 - Josh Reddick/ARI** and Nick Castellanos/CIN; .409 - Dominic Smith/NYM; .407 - Yonathan Daza/COL; **.405 - Nick Ahmed/ARI; .400 - Ketel Marte/ARI.**

 - Rays' eighth-round pick in the 2010 draft.

- WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW: Is looking for his first win since April 27 (0-4, 4.10 ERA since).
- With a win today, he will equal his total from 2020 (3).

LAST START: Lost on May 31 vs. Mets, allowing 5 runs on 9 hits in 6.2 innings.

- VS. BREWERS: Will be making his third career start...has gone 0-1 with a 5.56 ERA (7 ER in 11.1 IP) in 2 starts.
- Lost his last start on Aug. 23, 2019 @ Milwaukee (7 ER in 4.1 IP).

- STRIKEOUT STATS: Boasts 20 strikeouts and only 2 walks in his last 3 starts.
- Became 1 of 6 D-back pitchers with 12+ strikeouts and no walks in a game on May 26 vs. Giants (last: Patrick Corbin in 2018) and 1 of 4 overall to do so as an opponent @ Dodger Stadium (also: Curt Schilling/ARI, Ray Sadecki/SF and Robbie Ray/ARI).

- MISSING BARRELS: Has lowered his barrel pct. down from 11.1 in 2020 to 7.1 in 2021.
- Barrel = comparable hit types (exit velo. + launch angle) that have lead to a min. .500 BA/1.500 SLG

- 2020 REVIEW: Limited to 5 starts before undergoing season-ending right shoulder thoracic outlet surgery on Aug. 25.
- At the time of his injury, was 3-2 with a 2.59 ERA (9 ER in 31.1 IP) and ranked among NL leaders in fewest walks per 9.0 (2nd, 1.44), strikeout-to-walk ratio (6th, 5.80), wins (T-5th, 3), ERA (10th, 2.59) and WHIP (10th, 0.99).

- ♦ **Eric Hinske** (assistant hitting coach) was born in Menasha, Wis....his 137 Major League home runs are the fourth most by a Wisconsin-born player, trailing Al Simmons (307), Andy Pafko (213) and Ken Keltner (163).
- ♦ **Mike Fetters** (bullpen coach) was named to the Brewers' Wall of Honor in 2014 after recording 79 saves in 289 games with Milwaukee from 1992-97.
- ♦ **Joakim Soria** played 26 games with the Brewers in 2018.
