HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs and Brewers are meeting for the first time since Aug. 23-25, 2019 in Milwaukee.

- ◆ The D-backs have lost a club record 14 consecutive road games.
- ♦ **Ketel Marte** is batting .524 (11-for-21) with 2 doubles, 2 home runs and 6 RBI during his 5-game hitting streak.
- ◆ Nick Ahmed has a 5-game hitting streak, going 9-for-19 (.474) with 2 doubles, 1 triple and 2 RBI.

26 & COUNTING: Last night, **Humberto Castellanos** made his D-backs debut, becoming the D-backs' 13th Mexico-born player (11th pitcher) and 26th different pitcher used by Arizona this season.
