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THE TWINS: Began their nine-game, 10-day roadtrip in Seattle last weekend, winning Friday night, followed by consecutive walk-off losses on Saturday and Sunday...tonight, they will continue the trip with the first of three against the Royals at Kauffman Stadium through Thursday...after this series, they will travel to Milwaukee to play the Brewers over the weekend.
☞ Twins are 10-4 this season following an off-day...5-1 in their last six.

TWINS CLIMB BACK JUST TO GET WALKED-OFF AGAIN: The Twins lost to the Mariners on Sunday afternoon at T-Mobile Park by a score of 7-6 as they were walked-off for the second-straight day...Minnesota closed a 0-6 deficit by scoring five runs in the eighth and their sixth run in the ninth inning, which forced a tie entering the bottom of the ninth...Jay Bradley (9-5) was the starter and did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs on seven hits in 6.0 innings pitched...all three of his runs allowed came with two outs (2 in the 1st and 1 in the 6th)...the offense recorded 11 hits, highlighted by a three-run homer from Royce Lewis in the eighth inning and a game-tying home run from Luke Keaschall in the ninth inning.

ROYALTY CHECKS: The Twins and Royals are playing each other today for the 11th of 13 games in 2026...Twins have gone 4-6 vs. KC this season, 1-2 at Kauffman and 3-4 at Target Field...Twins took two of three last week against the Royals at Target Field.

☞ Minnesota's last trip to Kauffman came in the back half of their first roadtrip (March 30-April 2), winning just the finale of the three games.

☞ Since the start of 2023, the twins have gone 18-9 at home vs. the Royals, compared to 8-14 at Kauffman Stadium.

☞ Twins have 197 wins all-time at Kauffman Stadium, their most in any opposing ballpark in their history (since 1961)...also the most for any opponent in this park (next: CWS - 189).

☞ Josh Bell is hitting .299 (35-for-117) with seven doubles, eight home runs, 27 RBI and a .948 OPS in 33 career games vs. Kansas City...three of his 13 home runs this season have been against the Royals (April 1 off Falter, April 2 off Cruz and June 7 off Way)...he has six home runs, 16 RBI and a .972 OPS in 17 career games at Kauffman

☞ Kody Clemens has hit safely in nine-straight against the Royals...in eight games against the Royals this season, Clemens is hitting .400 (12-for-30) with three doubles, four home runs, seven RBI and a 1.338 OPS...he has 17 career hits against the Royals, eight of which are home runs.

KEAS TO THE CITY: Luke Keaschall has hit safely in 12 of his last 13 road games...in his last 25 away games, he is hitting .390 (32-for-82) with a .495 on-base percentage, a .573 slugging percentage and a 1.068 OPS...below are his home and road comparisons this season:

TWINS GET THEIR (HOFF)MAN: The Twins yesterday acquired right-handed reliever Jeff Hoffman and cash considerations in a trade with the Blue Jays, in exchange for minor league left-handed pitcher Dasan Hill, minor league right-handed pitcher John Klein, minor league infielder Demeury Pena and international bonus pool money.

☞ Hoffman, 33, has gone 6-7, 3.94 ERA (48.0 IP, 21 ER), five saves, 12 holds, 18 walks, 75 strikeouts, a 1.38 WHIP and an 11.1 inherited runners scored percent (9 IR/1 IRS) in 51 games for the Blue Jays this season, while ranking sixth among MLB relievers in strikeout ratio (34.9%)...since June 9, the right-hander has allowed just two earned runs over 20.2 innings pitched (0.87 ERA), striking out 28 of his 86 batters faced in 21 games in that span.

☞ Over the last four seasons (since '23), Hoffman has gone 23-19, 5.22 ERA (234.2 IP, 84 ER), 49 saves (65 opportunities), 44 holds, 80 walks, 317 strikeouts (12.2 K/9.0 IP), a 1.10 WHIP and a .206 opponent batting average in 244 games for the Phillies (2023-24) and Blue Jays ('25-26)...in that span — among MLB relievers with a minimum of 230.0 IP — he ranks second in strikeout ratio (32.5%), fourth in opponent batting average (.206) and fielding independent pitching (3.21), fifth in WHIP (1.10) and sixth in saves (49).

☞ An NL All-Star for Philadelphia in 2024, Hoffman has pitched in parts of 11 seasons with the Rockies (2016-20), Reds (2021-22), Phillies (2023-24) and Blue Jays (2025-26), going 38-40, 4.69 ERA (583.0 IP, 304 ER), 50 saves, 48 holds, 255 walks, 638 strikeouts, a 1.39 WHIP and a .248 opponent batting average in 378 games (50 starts)...since the start of 2024, the Latham, New York native ranks fifth in all of baseball in appearances (190), and has pitched in the Postseason each of the last three seasons since 2023.

☞ To make room for Hoffman on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned left-handed pitcher Kendry Rojas to Triple-A St. Paul.

AMERICA'S NEXT TOP JEFF: Ryan Jeffers has reached base safely in a career-high 23-straight games...over those 23 games, he is hitting .301 (25-for-83) with six doubles, six home runs, 15 RBI, 12 walks, a .396 on-base percentage, a .590 slugging percentage and a .986 OPS.

☞ 23-straight games reaching base is the longest on-base streak for a Twin since Ty France's 24-gamer from May 16-June 13, 2025.

☞ It is the second-longest active streak in baseball, trailing Josh Naylor (24).

☞ Jeffers also has an active nine-game hitting streak, longest by a Twin this season; that streak is the third longest of his career (high is 14 games, done in 2023).

HIGHER LARNING: Over his last 35 games, since June 14, Trevor Larnach is hitting .339 (41-for-121) with nine doubles, seven home runs, 24 RBI, a .394 on-base percentage, a .587 slugging percentage and a .981 OPS.

☞ In his last 19 road games, he is hitting .389 (28-for-72) with four doubles, six home runs, 19 RBI, a .450 on-base, a .694 slugging and a 1.144 OPS.

FAST AND LEWIS: Royce Lewis has hit safely in a season-long eight-straight games, one short of his career-high of nine (September 14, 2023-June 5, 2024)...additionally, has reached safely via hit or walk in 14-straight games, setting a new career-high; his previous high was 13 from June 28-July 12...during the streak he has posted a .333 on-base percentage (12 hits, 7 walks).

TWINS MILB MONTHLYS: Twins have named Double-A Wichita outfielder Caden Kendle and Low-A Fort Myers right-handed pitcher Merit Jones as their minor league Player and Pitcher of the Month for July.

☞ Kendle, 24, played in 20 games between Wichita and High-A Cedar Rapids, hitting .423 (30-for-71) with seven doubles, two home runs, 17 RBI, six stolen bases, nine walks, a .500 on-base percentage, a .606 slugging percentage and a 1.106 OPS.

☞ Jones, 23, pitched in six games (3 starts) for the Mighty Mussels, going 3-0, 0.73 ERA (24.2 IP, 2 ER) with eight walks, 30 strikeouts and a .219 opponent batting average.
