### Soroka on the Road

RHP Mike Soroka tossed 6.0 shutout innings last night, lowering his road ERA this season to 1.35 (14 ER/93.2 IP).

Soroka's road mark is the 12th lowest for a single season in baseball history, and the lowest since Roger Clemens had a 1.32 ERA (14 ER/95.2 IP) in 2005 for Houston.

Bob Gibson had the lowest ever in 1968, compiling a 0.81 mark in 16 road starts.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Braves and Nationals continue a three-game set today with the 18th of 19 meetings between the teams this season...The teams are set to finish their season series this weekend.

With last night's victory, the Braves have taken the season set from the Nationals for the second consecutive season...They went 10-9 against Washington last season...From 2015-2017, the Braves went 18-39 (.316) against their National League East division rival.

After opening the season series with three straight losses to Washington, the Braves have won 10 of the last 14 games between the clubs despite outscoring Washington by just six runs (76-70)... The Braves took three of four from the Nationals last weekend, September 5-8, at SunTrust Park.

Atlanta has now won three straight in Washington, the club's longest single-season winning streak at Nationals Park since 2013...They won their first six games here that season.

RHP Mike Foltynewicz is 5-4 with a 4.86 ERA (36 ER/66.2 IP) in 12 career games, all starts, against Washington...The righty has faced the Nationals one time this season, taking a no-decision after allowing eight runs, earned, over 4.0 innings in a 13-9 win.

RHP Austin Voth is set to face the Braves for the fourth time in his career and for the third time as a starter, all of which have come this season...The righty allowed two runs, earned, in each of his previous two starts against Atlanta while striking out a combined 13 hitters.

**HOME RUN RECORD:** 2B Ozzie Albies last night drove the first pitch of the seventh inning from Tanner Rainey out to right-center field to give the Braves a franchise record-tying 235 home runs this season...The club matched the record set by the 2003 Braves.

The Braves rank second in the National League with their 235 home runs, trailing only the Dodgers' total of 261.

The Braves have hit 112 homers away from SunTrust Park this season, and are 12 shy of the franchise record for single-season road home runs, first set in 1957 and matched in 2003.

The club already has the franchise record for most home runs at home, after they finished their last homestand with 123...The old record of 119 was set by the 1966 team.

**MAGIC NUMBER:** The Braves enter today with a magic number of six to clinch the National League East, which would give the club their second consecutive division title...The Braves can also clinch a postseason berth today with a win, or a loss by both Chicago and Philadelphia.

The Braves are looking for their 19th division title in franchise history, and they are currently tied with New York (AL) for the most in MLB history.

**SERIES PLAY:** The Braves can take another series with a win today or tomorrow after last night's 5-0 win the opener of this three-game set.

The Braves have not lost a multi-game series since dropping both games to Kansas City, July 23-24, at SunTrust Park...They have gone 10-0-4 in multi-game series play since that sweep.

The Braves' streak of 14 straight multi-game series without a loss is the longest such streak in the majors this season...The Astros went 13 straight from May 4-June 14.

The 14-series streak is the longest by a Braves team since another similar length streak in 2004.

Only three Braves team in the modern era have had longer such streaks than this year's club: the 2002 club had a franchise-record 22-series streak, while the 1996 team went 17 without a loss...The 1916 Boston Braves had the longest pre-Atlanta streak, going 15 from June to the middle of August.

**40-40?:** OF Ronald Acuña Jr. homered and stole two bases Thursday moving him within one home run and four steals of becoming the fifth player in baseball history to collect a 40-homer, 40-steal season.

OF José Canseco was the first player to go 40-40, reaching 42 home runs and 40 steals in 1988...Barry Bonds then matched those numbers in 1996, while Alex Rodríguez had 42 homers and 46 steals in 1998...Alfonso Soriano then had 46 and 41 in 2006.

Thursday, Acuña Jr. became the 15th player in history to have 35 home runs and 35 stolen bases in a single season, and the youngest to accomplish the feat...The last player to reach those marks was Matt Kemp in 2011 with the Dodgers.

**FOLTYNEWICZ WINS:** The Braves have won each of RHP Mike Foltynewicz's last 10 starts dating to June 11 vs. Pittsburgh, including each of his seven turns since returning from his option to Gwinnett...Foltynewicz is 5-0 with a 4.28 ERA (26 ER/54.2 IP) during the stretch.

The run of team wins in his starts is the longest such streak of his career, and the longest by any Atlanta pitcher since the Braves won an MLB-record 23 straight starts by Kris Medlen from 2010 to 2012.

Foltynewicz's streak is the third run of at least eight wins by Atlanta in a pitcher's starts this season, after winning eight straight games started by Mike Soroka from June 1 to July 14, and nine straight by Max Fried from July 15 to September 5.

Atlanta is one of just two teams in the majors with three such streaks of at least eight wins...The Yankees won at least eight straight starts by Chad Green (9 games), Domingo German (8) and James Paxton (8).
