RAY REPORT—The Rays continue a nine-game, 11-day homestand vs. Boston (0-3
Kansas City (0-1, 2 to play) and Oakland (3 to play) today at Tropicana Fieldthe Rays
have lost a season-high five straight games, their longest skid since dropping five straigh
from July 16-20, 2023entering the streak, they had gone 11-4 in their previous 15 games
from May 3-18 on the heels of a 2-8 stretch from April 21–May 1Thursday's off day
began a stretch of four in a span of 15 days from May 23–June 6…the Rays are a season
high 10.5 games back in the AL East standings, their largest deficit since concluding the
2022 season 13.0 games backthey have spent the entire season within four games of
the .500 mark.

On mark.

Last night's 8-1 loss to the Royals dropped the Rays to 8-12 against clubs that currently own a winning record...they are 17-15 against below-500 teams. Tampa Bay has dropped five consecutive games, all by 3+ runs, for the first time since a six-game skid from June 19-25 (G1), 2016...the club record is eight consecutive losses, set from July 21 (G1)-28, 2007.

The five-game skid is tied with the Rangers for the longest active losing streak in the majors...during the streak, the Rays are averaging 2.0 runs per game and have been outscored, 31-10 (-21)...they are slashing .167/.235/.231 (26-for-156) collectively with only 6 XBH.

Tampa Bay has trailed by 5+ runs at some point in four of the five losses...they held a lead in each of the previous three, their longest streak of consecutive blown lead losses since a five-game run from June 17-22, 2021 (Elias).

Tampa Bay pitching has yielded 5+ runs in all five games of the losing streak, their longest single-season stretch since Aug. 9-13, 2023...their last six-game streak came from June 16-22, 2021.

The Rays need a win today to avoid their first home series loss to the Royals since May 8-11, 2017, which would snap a streak of five consecutive undefeated home sets against Kansas City (4-0-1)...a loss would also mark their first time losing three straight home series since July 4-23, 2023 (PHI, ATL, BAL).

**TROP TROUBLES**—At 14-16, the Rays own a losing record through their first 30 home games for the first time since 2018 (14-16)...last season, they held an MLB-leading 25-5 record through their first 30 home games, the best mark in franchise history...the Rays 30 home games played are tied with the Dodgers and Phillies for the most in the majors.

WHAT'S THE DIFF?—The Rays -47 run differential is third worst in the AL, better than only the Athletics (-62) and White Sox (-111)...it signals their lowest mark through 52 games since 2007 (-77)...the Rays have a +24 (76-52) run differential in innings 1-3, third best in the AL behind the Yankees (+41) and Royals (+27)...their -63 (117-54) mark in the 4th-6th frames is the worst in the majors, with the White Sox (-48) being the next closest club...they own a -8 (84-76) mark from the 7th inning on.

Tampa Bay has been outscored, 47-12 (-35), in the 5th inning, their most runs allowed and fewest scored in any frame (excluding extras)...its 8.13 ERA (52.0IP, 47ER) in the 5th is the third worst in the majors in any individual inning, better than only the Athletics in the 4th (8.66) and the Cardinals in the 5th (8.45)...in club history, the highest ERA in a single frame over a full season is 6.48 (8th inn., 2007).

Each of the Rays last five wins have come by two runs or fewer, while each of their last seven losses have been by 3+ runs...they lead the majors with 18 wins by two runs or fewer, and their .692 (18-8) winning pct. in such contests ranks second behind the Philles (14-6/700)...conversely, Tampa Bay 7-19 (.269) in games with a differential of 3+ runs, second worst in MLB, ahead of the White Sox (6-23/.207).

The Rays have been held to two runs or fewer 20 times, tied for second most in the majors behind the White Sox (25G).

**PEN PALS**—The Rays bullpen has pitched to an 8.80 ERA (15.1IP, 15ER) in their last three games on the heels of posting an MLB-best 1.59 ERA (62.1IP, 11ER) in their previous 17 contests from May 3-20...their eight runs allowed yesterday marked their second most in a game this season (9 on April 5 at COL), but all eight tallies were charged to bulk reliever **LHP Tyler Alexander**.

LHP Garrett Cleavinger owns a 12.0 scoreless inning streak, the second-longest active run among AL relievers who have pitched in 2024 behind TOR Yimi García (15.1)...Cleavinger has gone 18 games without allowing an earned run, the second-longest active streak in the AL behind CLE Emmanuel Clase (19G).

RHP Pete Fairbanks has retired all 15 BF across five scoreless appearances since returning from the 15-day IL on May 11, recording 7 SO...RHP Phil Maton has posted a 1.32 ERA (13.2IP, 2ER) and 0.73 WHIP in his last 15 games.

SMALL BALL—Tampa Bay has recorded an AL-leading 67 infield hits, second most in the majors behind Milwaukee (70)...the Rays lead the AL in stolen bases (55), ahead of the Royals (53), and rank highly in times reaching via error (2nd, 17), pitches per plate appearance (3rd, 3.98), hit-by-pitches (T3rd, 24), singles (4th, 294) and sacrifice hits (T4th, 5).

However, the Rays .356 slugging pct. is 14th, ahead of only the White Sox (.332)... in club history, only the 2002 Devil Rays (.355) recorded a lower mark through 52 games...their 117 XBH are second fewest in MLB, more than only the Marlins (113).

The Rays have allowed 69 HR, tied with the White Sox for the most in the majors, while hitting 42 HR of their own, 13th most in the AL/27th in MLB...their -27 HR margin is second lowest in the majors, besting only the White Sox (-33).

WELCOME BACK, Q!—Prior to being hired in Kansas City last season, Royals Manager Matt Quatraro spent five years on the Rays coaching staff, serving as bench coach (2018) and third base coach (2018-22), helping guide the club to its second World Series appearance in 2020...he began his coaching career with 10 seasons in the Rays farm system from 2004-13, primarily as a manager...Quatraro, who played all seven of his minor league seasons in the Rays system from 1996–2002, became the first Tampa Bay farmhand to join the organization as a coach in 2004.

Quatraro is one of three former members of Kevin Cash's coaching staff currently managing in the big leagues, joining MIN Rocco Baldelli and PIT Derek Shelton.

ROYAL AFFAIRS—The Rays and Royals meet for the second of six games in 2024 today in St. Pete...Tampa Bay will travel to Kauffman Stadium to conclude the season series from July 2-4...the Rays have won five straight season series over the Royals dating to 2018 (clubs did not meet in 2020), going 23-12 (.657) in that span (4-3 in 2023)...they have won three of five, six of 10, and 10 of the last 17 meetings...the Rays are 8-1-2 in their last 11 series vs. the Royals since Aug. 2017.

The Rays are 3-7 against the AL Central, going 3-4 at home...this, after posting the AL's best winning pct. against the division in 2023 (.719/23-9).

Amed Rosario is a career .322 (59-for-183) hitter against the Royals...Yandy Díaz is 14-for-28 (.500) with 4 2B, 2 HR and 5 RBI in his last eight games against Kansas City...José Caballero is 7-for-18 (.389) with 3 2B in six career games vs. the Royals.

Today's Royals starter, Brady Singer, throws his slider 44.0 pct. of the time, his most utilized pitch...the Rays .259 (77-for-297) average in at-bats ending with sliders is second highest in the majors, trailing the Padres (.278).

- Royals starter RHP Brady Singer pitched at the University of Florida (2016-18) and is a graduate of Eustis (FL) High School, located approximately 40 miles northeast of Orlando.
- Royals starter **RHP Michael Wacha** appeared in 29 games (23 starts) for the Rays in 2021.
- Royals reliever RHP Nick Anderson pitched for the Rays for three seasons (2019-21)...OF Hunter Renfroe appeared in 42 games for the Rays in 2020...both players were members of Tampa Bay's 2020 World Series squad.

TODAY'S START—Civale will take the ball for his 11th start of the season, including his sixth at home...has gone 0-3 with a 8.48 ERA (28.2IP, 27ER) in his last six starts after pitching to a 2-1 mark and 2.74 ERA (23.0IP, 7ER) in his first four...is seeking his first win since April 9 at LAA...has gone 4-7 with a 5.66 ERA (97.0IP, 61ER) in 20 starts since the Rays acquired him from the Guardians on July 31, 2023.

**LAST TIME OUT**—Took the loss on May 19 at Toronto after allowing five runs (four earned) on six hits and four walks with three strikeouts over 5.1 innings...has taken a loss in each of his last three decisions, matching the longest streak of his career (4x, last: June 26-Aug. 28, 2022).

Allowed a Daniel Vogelbach solo homer in the 2nd inning...with two outs in the 4th frame, allowed back-to-back doubles by Vogelbach and George Springer, followed by an error, walk and HBP.

**KING OF QUEENS**—Civale has made nine career starts opposite Kansas City, going 4-1 with a 3.15 ERA (54.1IP, 19ER) and a 0.99 WHIP...he has earned a victory in each of his last four starts vs. the Royals from Sept. 30, 2022–July 25, 2023, recording a 1.67 ERA (27.0IP, 5ER)...in his previous five starts against Kansas City, Civale went 0-1 with a 4.61 ERA (27.1IP, 14ER).

CENTRAL INTELLIGENCE—Civale is 17-10 with a 3 44 ERA (235 IJP 90ER) in 42 career starts against the AL Central..in a 13-start stretch vs. AL Central foes from May 20, 2022–July 30, 2023, Civale allowed two earned runs or fewer in each outing, going 6-0 with a 1.62 ERA (72.1IP, 13ER)...in five starts since joining the Rays, however, he is 1-2 with a 4.81 ERA (24.1IP, 13ER) against the division.

**STARTING AT THE TOP**—Civale has limited opposing lead-off hitters to a .107/.167/.214 (3-for-28) line, the second-lowest opp. AVG in MLB (min. 25BF) behind SEA **Logan Gilbert** (.074/2-for-27)...five and six-hole hitters have given him the most trouble, as they are hitting a combined .415 (17-for-41) with 5 2B, 4 HR and 11 RBI...overall, opposing 5-9 hitters have gone 33-for-100 (.333) with 6 2B, 7 HR and 21 RBI off Civale...1-4 hitters are 22-for-105 (.210) with 3 2B, 3 HR and 8 RBI.

TIME TO BATTLE BACK—In four starts to open the season, Civale went 2-1 with a 2.74 ERA (23.0IP, 7ER) while limiting opponents to a .200 (17-for-85) average...in six starts since, he is 0-3 with an 8.48 ERA (28.2IP, 27ER) while allowing opponents to hit .317 (38-for-120).

CRUISING. THEN BRUISING—From innings 1-3, Civale has posted a 2.40 ERA (30.0IP, 8ER) and a .193 (21-for-109) opp. average...from the 4th inning on, he owns a 10.80 ERA (21.2IP, 26ER) with a .354 (34-for-96) opp. average... he has allowed a combined 25 runs in the 4th and 5th innings compared

to 11 tallies in all other frames...this includes 14 runs allowed in the 5th inning, tied with STL **Miles Mikolas** for the most in the majors.

He has struggled to escape innings, allowing opponents to slash .314/.392/.543 (22-for-70) with two outs...17 of the 29 RBI recorded against him have come with two outs, including 4 of his 10 HR.

BIT BY THE LONG BALL—Civale's 10 HR allowed are tied for fourth most in the AL, behind teammate Tyler Alexander (12HR) and CLE Logan Allen/SEA Bryce Miller (both 11HR)...he has yielded at least 1 HR in nine of his 10 starts this season and 15 of his last 17 dating back to Aug. 23, 2023 vs. COL...entering that stretch, he had permitted just 1 HR in his previous 10 starts from June 25-Aug. 16, 2023.

Nearly half (17) of the 36 runs he has allowed this season have come on the 10 HR against him.

3 IS THE MAGIC NUMBER—For his career, Civale is 31-1 with a 3.41 ERA (316.2IP, 120ER) in games when he receives three or more runs of support... he has a 2-29 record with a 5.18 ERA (210.0IP, 121ER) in games receiving two or fewer runs of support.
