TODAY'S GAME:

- Is Game 3 (1-1) of a 3-game series vs **Kevin Collins' Rockies**, the finale (3-3) of a 7-game homestand that includes a 4-game series split vs the **Marlins** (7/7-7/10), and the final game before the All-Star break.
- Following today's "first-half" finale vs **Col**, the Reds will enjoy 4-day break before lifting the lid on the season's "second half" at **NYM** (7/18-7/20) and **Wsh** (7/21-7/23).
- Cin went 2-4 on its most recent road trip at **Bos** (1-2) and **Phi** (1-2).

**ALL-STAR ABBOTT:** On Tue, **LHP Andrew Abbott** was named to the National League All-Star team as a replacement for **LAD's Yoshinobu Yamamoto**.

- It's his first career All-Star selection.
- Is the first Reds All-Star **LHP** since **Aroldis Chapman** in 2015.
- Is just 1 of 4 Cin left-handed starting pitchers over the last 40 years to be selected to the All-Star team (**John Smiley** 1995, **Tom Browning** 1991, **Danny Jackson** 1988).
- Ranks among all Major League pitchers with at least 91 innings in several categories, including ERA (2.07), runs (26), earned runs (21), AVG (.219), OBP (.272), SLG (.348), WHIP (1.08), base runners allowed (100), hits (75), extra-base hits (24), strike pct (66.2), hard hit pitches (62) and hard hit pct (.332).

**ALL-STAR DE LA CRUZ:** **SS Elly De La Cruz** has been named to the National League All-Star team for the second consecutive season.

- He's the first Reds player to be selected as an All-Star in back-to-back years since **Joey Votto** (2017-18).
- Is the sixth primary shortstop in Reds history to make consecutive All-Star teams, joining **Barry Larkin** (1988-91, '93-'97, '99-2000), **David Concepcion** (1975-82), **Leo Cardenas** (1964-66), **Roy McMillan** (1955-57), and **Eddie Miller** (1943-44, '46-'47).
- Is the seventh Red to earn multiple All-Star selections within his first 3 career seasons, the first since **Chris Sabo** (1988, '90).
- Joins **Johnny Bench** (4, 1968-71), **Frank Robinson** (3, 1956-59), and **Vada Pinson** (2, 1959-60) as the only Reds players named to multiple All-Star teams before turning 24.

**FUTURES GAME:** The **NL Futures** defeated the **AL Futures**, 4-2 in yesterday's **All-Star Futures Game** at **Truist Park** in Atlanta...**C Alfredo Duno** (0-for-1) and **3b Sal Stewart** (0-for-1) represented the Cin organization.

**NO ROOM FOR THE BROOM:** The Reds have not been swept in any of their first 31 series this season, including this series vs **Col** (1-1).

- It's the second-longest streak in club history...only the 1970 Reds team, which won the organization's fifth National League pennant, opened a season with a longer streak, going 32 straight series before getting broomed in a 2-game set at **Chc** from 7/22-23.
- Cin is the only Major League team not to have been swept this season.

SERIES NOTES:

- The Reds are 122-116 all-time vs the **Rockies** (51-70 in **Colorado**).
- From 4/25-4/27 the Redlegs swept the **Rockies** at **Coors Field** for the second consecutive season...have won 6 straight games and 7 of their last 8 in the **Mile High City**.
- Since 6/19/23 Cin has won 13 of 15 overall vs **Col**, including 7 of 9 here at **Great American Ball Park**.
- Yesterday's game was the first in the Reds/**Rox** all-time series to feature a walkoff win since Cin's 3-2 victory on 9/2/22...the Reds are 15-6 all-time in walkoff games vs **Col**.

**ELLY'S 25 STEALS** : **SS Elly De La Cruz** is the sixth Red in club history to collect at least 25 steals before the All-Star break in back-to-back seasons.

**FRANCONA AT 1,999 WINS:** **Terry Francona** enters today's game 1 win away from reaching 2,000 as a Major League manager.

- He'd become the 13th manager to reach the 2,000-win milestone.
- Would be the second active manager in the majors with 2,000 wins (**Tex' Bruce Bochy** 2,218).
- Each big league skipper with 2,000 career wins, except for **Bochy** and **Dusty Baker**, are in the Hall of Fame.
- Baker** (2,183) and **Sparky Anderson** (2,194 wins) are the only 2,000-win skippers to manage the Reds.
- Leo Durocher** is the only 2,000-win manager to play for Cin (1930-33).
- Would be the fourth manager to earn his 2,000th win for a team he once played for (1987), joining **Bochy** (**SF**), **Bucky Harris** (**Det**), and **John McGraw** (**NYG**).

**WREAKING HAVOC IN THE FIRST:** The Reds have scored at least 1 run in the 1st inning 31 times this season, including yesterday vs **Col** (1r).

- Cin has plated 69 runs in the 1st inning this season, second-most in the majors, behind only **Bos** (70)...this includes the 10 runs plated in the 1st inning on 5/10 at **Hou**.
- Cin has outscored opponents 69-41 in the first inning and are slashing .267/.347/.415 with 11 home runs.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Suffered the 12-2 loss on 7/8 vs Mia (5.0ip, 7h, 10r/10er, 3bb, 2k, 85TP).

- Allowed a career-high 10 runs...the most runs allowed by a Reds pitcher since RHP Carson Spiers on 8/20/24 at Tor (10r)...the most runs allowed by a Reds pitcher at Great American Ball Park since RHP Graham Ashcraft on 6/3/23 vs Mil (10r).
- Of the 10 runs he allowed, 7 came in the 3rd inning, a career-high for runs allowed in an inning.
- Retired 13 of the 15 batters he faced outside the 3rd inning (2bb).

**JULY 2:** Earned the 8-4 win on 7/2 at Bos (6.2ip, 9h, 4r/4er, 0bb, 2k, 89TP).

- Held Bos to 1 run through the first 5 innings before allowing a 2-out, 2-run HR to Wilyer Abreu in the 6th inning.
- Prior to Abreu's HR, had allowed just 2 runs over his previous 16.2 innings dating back to 6/21 at StL.
- Pitched at least 6.0 innings in consecutive starts for the first time since doing so in 6 straight outings from 4/28-5/26.
- Pitched into the 7th inning for the fifth time this season.

**JUNE 27 (NO-HIT BID):** Earned the 8-1 win on 6/27 vs SD...carried a no-hitter into the 9th inning before allowing a double to the inning's second batter, **Elías Díaz** (8.0+ip, 1h, 1r/1er, 2bb, 6k, 112TP).

- The 8-inning no-hit bid marked the longest of his career.
- Was the longest no-hit bid by a Reds pitcher since LHP Wade Miley's no-hitter on 5/7/21 at Cle and the longest by a Reds pitcher at Great American Ball Park since RHP Homer Bailey's no-hitter on 7/2/13 vs SF.
- Pitched into the 9th inning for the first time in his career, as a starter.
- Matched his career-high with 8.0 inning pitched (also: 9/27/24 at Chc).
- Was the sixth time he allowed exactly 1 hit in a start (last: 8/10/24 at Mil).
- Matched his career-high with 112 pitches (also: 5/28/15 for Tex vs Bos).
- After walking Jackson Merrill in the 1st inning, retired the next 22 consecutive batters until he walked Trenton Brooks in the 9th inning.
- Marked the first time in the expansion era (since 1961) that any Major League team had a pitcher throw 8 or more no-hit innings in the same game in which a teammate (Spencer Steer) hit 3 or more home runs (*Elías*).

**JUNE 23 (RELIEF):** In Mon's 6-1 win vs NYY made his second consecutive relief app (1.0ip, 1k, 12TP)...was his 139th career app out of the bullpen.

- Replaced reliever Scott Barlow in the top of the 7th...retired DJ LeMahieu (flyout), Jasson Domínguez (groundout), and Paul Goldschmidt (strikeout swinging) in order.

**JUNE 21 (RELIEF):** In Sat's 11-inning 6-5 loss at StL made his first relief app of the season, his first since 8/2/24 vs SF.

- Relieved starter Brent Suter in the 3rd inning and retired all 6 batters he faced (18TP).

**JUNE 19:** Suffered the 12-5 loss on 6/19 vs Min (2.2ip, 7h, 7r/7er, 1bb, 4k, 3hr, 1hb, 52TP).

- Allowed a season-high 3 home runs for the second straight outing...marked the first time in his career that he gave up 3 homers in back-to-back appearances...became the first Reds pitcher to give up 3 or more homers in consecutive outings since Tanner Roark did it in 2019.
- Was his shortest start since 6/9/14 for Tex vs Cle (2ip).
- The 7 runs allowed were his most in an appearance since 8/1/17 for Tex vs Sea (7r).

**JUNE 13:** Suffered the 11-5 loss on 6/13 at Det (5.0ip, 8h, 4r/4er, 2bb, 5k, 3hr, 89TP).

- Allowed a season-high 3 home runs for the first time since 8/21/24 at Tor.
- Entered the 6th inning with the Reds trailing 3-2...walked the first batter in the inning and the last batter he faced (Javier Báez)...that runner would go on to score on a sac fly off reliever Scott Barlow...the 3 previous runs he allowed in the game came via 3 solo homers.

**JUNE 13:** Suffered the 11-5 loss on 6/13 at Det (5.0ip, 8h, 4r/4er, 2bb, 5k, 3hr, 89TP).

- Allowed a season-high 3 home runs for the first time since 8/21/24 at Tor.

**LIMITING FREE PASSES:** Has issued 36 walks through his first 34 starts as a member of the Reds, second-fewest by a Cin pitcher in that span since the mound moved to its current distance in 1893, per *Elías*, fewer than only Slim Sallee (25bb, 1919-20).

**LIMITING HARD CONTACT:** Among all pitchers with at least 90 innings, his hard-hit percentage of .372 ranks among the best in the majors...*hard-hit percentage measures the percentage of pitches put in play at an exit velocity over 95 mph...league avg is .411*.

**1-2-3 BATTERS :** Is holding batters at the top of the order (1, 2, 3) to a .216/.264/.399 slash line with just 8 walks (163 BF)...his 1-2-3 batters have reached safely just 43 times.

**QUALIFIED:** On November 19, 2024, Martinez accepted the club's qualifying offer to return for the 2025 season after opting out of his original 2-year contract he signed in 2023.
