Responding

Atlanta begins this series with Toronto after falling to the Reds on Sunday, 6-4.

The Braves own a .789 winning percentage (15-4) in games following a loss, the best record in MLB. The next-closest team, Cleveland, has played to a .654 mark (17-9).

Every other team has at least twice as many losses as Atlanta in such situations.

The Braves' 2.70 ERA in games following a loss is the best in baseball. The team's 5.9 runs per game as an offense rank second behind Washington (6.0).

TODAY'S GAME: The Braves and Blue Jays today begin a three-game midweek series with the first of three games between the clubs this season...This is their only scheduled meeting this season.

- A* The Braves dropped last season's series to the Blue Jays in Canada, 2-1...Since 2021, Atlanta's .200 winning percentage (3-12) against Toronto is its worst against any single opponent.
- A* The Braves endured a nine-game losing streak against the Blue Jays from 2021-2023...Atlanta was outscored 57-27 (-30) during that stretch, wherein its pitching staff logged a 5.94 ERA (51 ER/77.1 IP).
- A* Despite that period, the Braves have only lost one series to the Blue Jays here at Truist Park since the venue opened in 2017, playing to a 3-1-2 series record.
- A* RH Kevin Gausman is set to face his former club tonight with a 4-3 record and a 3.13 ERA (24 ER/69.0 IP)...In four career starts against the Braves, the 6-foot-2, 205-pound Coloradan is 1-1 with a 2.45 ERA (7 ER/25.2 IP)...He has gone at least 6.0 innings and surrendered three-or-fewer runs in each of those turns...Gausman pitched parts of two seasons for Atlanta from 2018-19, going 8-10 with a 4.77 ERA (74 ER/139.2 IP) across 26 starts for the club.

BRYCE ELDER: Will duel the Blue Jays among the National League leaders in innings pitched (5th, 72.0), ERA (6th, 2.50), opponent batting average (9th, .211) and WHIP (9th, 1.08).

- A* The 6-foot-2, 220-pound Texas native has faced Toronto just once in his career, on May 13, 2023, when he pitched 5.0 innings and allowed a pair of earned runs in a Braves loss, 5-2.
- A* In his last turn, Elder failed to complete 4.0 innings for the first time since July 27, 2025...It also marked the first time this season that he's given up more than three earned runs.

SUMMER MONTHS: As the calendar turns to June, the Braves enter the summer months with the best record in Major League Baseball...In the months of June, July and August, since 2022, Atlanta has played to the second-best record in the NL and the third-best in baseball.

- A* The Los Angeles Dodgers (194-119, .620) and the Houston Astros (190-128, .597) are the only clubs that have been better than the Braves (189-130, .592) in that time.
- A* Within those time parameters, Atlanta has the best slugging percentage (.453) and OPS (.779), as well as the most home runs (508) and runs scored (1,646).
- A* Since 2022, Austin Riley (4th, .960) and Ronald Acuña Jr. (6th, .948) are among MLB's leaders in home OPS during the summer.

RONALD ACUÑA JR.: On Sunday at Cincinnati, went 2-for-3 with an RBI-single and his second leadoff home run of the season...The outfielder has homered in five of his last 17 plate appearances and in four straight games.

- A* He's one of three players in MLB this season with multiple leadoff home runs in the same series, joining Shohei Ohtani (LAD) and Yandy Díaz (TB)...Ironically, Díaz's home runs occurred on the same days as Acuña Jr.'s: May 29 and 31...The feat marked the second time that Acuña Jr. had at least two leadoff homers in a single series.
- A* Across four games from May 28-31, he hit five home runs, drew seven walks and stole four bases... He is the only player in modern MLB history to reach those numbers over a four-game span.
- A* Acuña Jr.'s leadoff home run on Sunday was the 39th of his career, extending his own franchise record...Since his debut in 2018, he ranks fourth in that regard behind George Springer (47), Kyle Schwarber (46) and Mookie Betts (41).
- A* Acuña Jr. has homered in four consecutive games on three other occasions, most recently from May 14-17, 2023, in games at Toronto and Texas... His career best is five straight games, which he accomplished from August 11-14, 2018, versus Milwaukee and Miami (doubleheader).
- A* In 42 games through May 27, Acuña Jr. had two home runs, 12 RBI and eight stolen bases...In the four games since then, he has five homers, nine RBI and four steals.

JORGE MATEO: Has homered in back-to-back games for just the second time in his MLB career, and for the first time since April 3-4, 2023 at Texas...He's back in the lineup tonight, batting eighth and playing shortstop.

- A* The infielder has compiled a five-game hitting streak wherein he's slashing .368/.400/.737 (7-for-19) with three extra-base hits, five runs and five RBI...He hadn't reached those numbers throughout a five-game span since 2023.
- A* Although not qualified, Mateo ranks highly in multiple categories, including expected batting average (.302) and expected slugging percentage (.519)...Mateo has hit 48.2% of his balls off the "sweet spot" of his bat, per Statcast, the second-best percentage in MLB (min. 50 batted balls).
- A* Mateo is currently ranked as the third-fastest man in MLB, posting a sprint speed of 30.4 feet per second...He only trails Bobby Witt Jr. (30.5 ft./sec.) and teammate Eli White (30.4x ft./sec.).

ROSTER MOVES: The Braves optioned RHP Anthony Molina to Triple-A following Sunday's game, and outrighted RHP Carlos Carrasco to the Stripers... Carrasco elected free agency, re-signed with the organization, and was re-selected to the MLB roster.

- A* Carrasco pitched 4.0 innings for Atlanta last Wednesday at Boston...He registered his 1,700th career strikeout, becoming one of 14 active hurlers to reach the milestone.

Today's Game

- Makes his 13th start of the season today and the 91st of his career in the opener of a series against Toronto at Truist Park...Faces the Blue Jays for the first time in 2026.
 - Owens a 3.60 ERA (2 ER/5.0 IP) in his lone career start against Toronto, a no-decision...Has yet to earn a win against the Jays.
- Carries a 4-3 record and a 2.50 ERA (20 ER/72.0 IP) through 12 starts, the 10th-lowest mark among qualified major league starters...Has posted a 61-to-22 strikeout-to-walk ratio and a 1.08 WHIP this season...Atlanta is 7-5 in his 12 turns.
- Over a 19-start span dating to August 24 of last season, Elder has tallied a major-league-most 14 quality starts...He owns a 2.62 ERA (34 ER/116.2 IP) and a 1.05 WHIP over the stretch.
- Left-handed batters are hitting .150 (25-for-167) against him this season, the second-lowest opponent average against lefties among qualified right-handed starters, behind only Milwaukee's Jacob Misiorowski (.106)...Right-handers are batting .313 (31-for-99).
- Has incorporated a cutter into his arsenal this season after not throwing the pitch across his first four major league seasons from 2022-25...Has gone to the offering almost exclusively against left-handed batters, throwing it to a right-hander on just three of 121 pitches this season, all on May 16 against Boston.
- Is one of just five pitchers in Atlanta history to make at least six starts in March/April and compile an ERA under 2.00, joining Tom Glavine (1997, 2000, 2002), Greg Maddux (1994), Tim Hudson (2007) and Julio Teheran (2014)...Finished March/April with a 1.88 ERA (9 ER/43.0 IP) over seven starts, the first such mark by an Atlanta starter since Teheran in 2014.
- His four-seam fastball is averaging 92.1 mph this season, a career-high mark that edges his 91.8 average from 2025 and is up 1.4 mph from his 90.7 mph average across his first four major league seasons from 2022-25.
- Since the start of the 2023 season, Atlanta is 45-36 in Elder's starts...His 81 starts for the Braves over the span lead the staff.

2026

- His 1.97 ERA (15 ER/68.2 IP) over his first 11 starts of the season is the second-lowest of his career through 11 turns to open a year, behind only his 2023 mark (1.92, 14 ER/65.2 IP).
 - Across the 11-start span, Elder worked more innings (68.2 to 65.2), allowed 10 fewer hits (47 to 57) and recorded four more strikeouts (60 to 56) than he did to begin 2023...His 0.99 WHIP through 11 starts is a career low for the span, down from 1.16 in 2023.
- Took the loss on May 27 at Boston, allowing season highs in hits (9), runs (6) and earned runs (5) over 3.1 innings on 59 pitches in an 8-0 defeat at Fenway Park... Boston batted around in a six-run fourth inning, matching the most runs Atlanta has allowed in a frame this season.
 - The start snapped an 11-start season-opening streak of allowing three earned runs or fewer, leaving him one of three Braves since 2013 to open a season with at least 11 such turns, joining Reynaldo López (17 in 2024) and Max Fried (11 in 2020)...It also ended a run of 14 consecutive starts of at least 5.0 innings with three earned runs or fewer, dating to September 19 of last season.
- Recorded a no-decision on May 22 against Washington, working 6.0 innings of one-run ball on five hits with one walk and four strikeouts on 87 pitches in Atlanta's 5-4, 11-inning walk-off win at Truist Park.
- Took the loss against Boston on May 16, working 8.0 innings of three-run ball on seven hits with no walks and three strikeouts on 103 pitches in a 3-2 defeat at Truist Park...It marked his longest outing since June 7, 2025 at San Francisco, and tied for the second-longest start of his career.
- Earned his fourth win on May 10 at Dodger Stadium, allowing one hit over 5.2 scoreless innings with four walks and eight strikeouts on 83 pitches in the 7-2 victory at Los Angeles (NL)...Marked his second career win against the Dodgers.
- Took the loss on April 4 at Arizona despite tossing 7.0 innings without allowing an earned run (4 H, 2 R, 0 ER, 1 BB, 8 K, 89 pitches)...Committed his first career fielding error, a throwing miscue in the second inning that resulted in two unearned runs...Atlanta managed just one run of support in the 2-1 defeat.

Career

- Awards:** 2023 National League All-Star.
- Completed his first full major league season in 2023, going 12-4 with a 3.81 ERA (74 ER/174.2 IP) in 31 games, all starts.
- Named to the 2023 National League All-Star Team, his first selection.
- Joined Hall-of-Famer John Smoltz and Michael Soroka as the only starters in Atlanta-franchise history to make the All-Star team in their second year playing.
- Atlanta won 21 games started by Elder in his first full season with the Braves, the second most team victories on the season...Trailed only teammate Spencer Strider's 26 team wins that year.

Career Cont.

- Made six starts in his career of at least 6.0 innings without allowing a run, the most such games in Braves franchise history (since 1900) in a player's first 25 starts...Irv Young (1905), Clif Curtis (1909-'10) and Ian Anderson ('20-'21) each had five such starts.
- Was originally drafted by Atlanta in the fifth round of the 2020 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Texas...Was the fifth member of the 2020 draft class to debut, and the lowest-selected pick to do so.
 - Of the first five members to play in the majors from the 2020 draft class, three were selected with the first 11 picks in the draft - Detroit's Spencer Torkelson (No. 1 overall), the Angels' Reid Detmers (No. 10) and the White Sox's Garrett Crochet (No. 11).
 - The other two were both selected by Atlanta, and chosen with the 126th (Spencer Strider) and 156th (Elder) overall selections.
