**THE TWINS:** The Twins opened their 66th season with a series loss in Baltimore over the weekend, winning just the middle game on Saturday afternoon...today, the Twins will continue the trip with the first of three at Kauffman Stadium against the Royals...they will enjoy an off-day tomorrow then play game two of the series on Wednesday night and game three on Thursday afternoon...following this trip, Minnesota will open its 17th season at Target Field with a three-game weekend series against the Tampa Bay Rays, followed by a four-game series against the Detroit Tigers, next Monday-Thursday.  
 ☞ Twins are going for their second victory today...they didn't get their second win of 2025 until their sixth game, on April 2 at Chicago-AL...they began last season in St. Louis and were swept in three games to start 2025.

**TWINS UNABEL TO PIGGYBACK FOR A VICTORY:** The Twins lost to the Orioles yesterday afternoon in Baltimore by a score of 8-6, suffering the series loss...Bailey Ober was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs on four hits in 4.0 innings pitched, with one walk and one strikeout...Mick Abel "piggybacked" Ober with 3.1 innings of relief, allowing five runs on eight hits with four walks and four strikeouts and was dealt the loss...the offense recorded 12 hits, two apiece from Josh Bell, Victor Caratini and Trevor Larnach...Royce Lewis hit his second home run of the season and Tristan Gray went 2-for-4 with a double and three RBI in his Twins debut.

**USING YOUR HEAD:** Twins enter today having used the ABS challenge system 11 times, the most in baseball...Twins have won seven of those challenges, posting a 64% success rate...they have won four of six on the hitting side and three of five on the pitching side.

**ROYALTY CHECKS:** The Twins went 6-7 against the Royals last season, going 2-5 at Kauffman Stadium and 4-2 at Target Field...KC winning the season series marked their first over the Twins since 2021 (9-10).

☞ The last time these two teams met was for a three-game series at Kauffman from September 5-7, 2025 as the Twins lost the series 2-1.

☞ Twins are 34-22 in their last 56 overall against the Royals, dating back to April of 2022.

☞ Twins have 196 wins all-time at Kauffman Stadium, their most in any opposing ballpark in their history (since 1961).

☞ Byron Buxton went just 2-for-18 against the Royals last season, but has hit .303 (47-for-155) over his last 42 games against KC, with 16 doubles, three triples, eight home runs, 23 RBI, 35 runs scored, a .600 slugging percentage and a .966 OPS...over his last 23 games at Kauffman, Buxton is hitting .318 (27-for-85) with 11 doubles, two triples, four home runs, 15 RBI and a 1.001 OPS.

☞ Josh Bell is hitting .341 (29-for-85) with six doubles, five home runs, 18 RBI and a 1.005 OPS in 23 career games vs. Kansas City...he has a .941 OPS in 14 career games at Kauffman...he has reached safely in seven-straight games in this ballpark.

☞ Last season, Ryan Jeffers hit .393 (11-for-28) with a .916 OPS in eight games against KC.  
 ☞ In six games last season, Luke Keaschall hit .360 (9-for-25) with five RBI, two stolen bases and an .880 OPS in six games vs. the Royals.

**FOUNTAIN POP:** The Twins have hit 318 home runs at Kauffman Stadium all-time...below are the club's all-time road homers by ballpark (since 1961):

**DID YOU KNOW?:** Justin Morneau is the club's all-time leader in home runs at Kauffman with 15.

**WITH ARMS WIDE OPEN:** Twins pitchers have struck out 29 batters through three games, 17 from starters (Joe Ryan - 7, Taj Bradley - 9 and Bailey Ober - 1) and 12 from the bullpen...29 strikeouts are tied for fourth-most in Twins history through the club's first three games (also 2020)...the only three times in which Twins pitchers struck out more batters through the first three was 39 in 2019, 36 in 2021 and 30 in 2018.

☞ Twins staff has a 10.44 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings pitched ratio, sixth in the AL and 10th in baseball...the starting staff has a 11.20 K/9.0 IP, fourth-best in the AL and seventh-best in baseball.

**LONGBALL LIMITS:** The Twins bullpen has yet to allow a home run in 11.1 innings...they are one of eight bullpens in baseball to not allow a homer, the others being Atlanta, Los Angeles-AL, Los Angeles-NL, Miami, New York-AL, St. Louis and Texas.

☞ Twins staff as a whole has allowed just one home run, a Tyler O'Neill homer yesterday in Baltimore off Ober...Twins are one of six staffs to allow one homer-or-fewer, the others are New York-AL (0), Detroit (1), Los Angeles-AL (1), San Diego (1) and St. Louis (1).

**ROYCE MAKING NOISE:** Royce Lewis has both the Twins homers this season, hitting his first on Saturday off Kyle Bradish and his second yesterday off Yaramil Hiraldo...Lewis is one of 19 players in baseball with multiple homers...the leader is Chase DeLauter with four.

☞ A homer today will mark the 13th time in club history (since 1961) for a player to homer three times in the club's first four games of any season...the last to do it was Joey Gallo, who homered three times in the club's first four of 2023.  
 ☞ He needs two more homers to reach 50 for his career.

**LOOK AT ALL THESE LEFTIES:** Twins hitters are 5-for-32 (.156) with one extra-base hit (Josh Bell double off Grant Wolfgram) off lefties this season...notable individuals vs. lefties last season:  
 ☞ Byron Buxton hit .306 (33-for-108) with 10 home runs, a .676 slugging percentage and a 1.050 OPS — his highest OPS vs. lefties in his career...Buck's 1.050 OPS ranked second-best in baseball in 2025 (min. 100 PA) and his .676 slugging percentage ranked third.  
 ☞ Austin Martin hit .346 (18-for-52) with an .884 OPS against lefties in 2025.  
 ☞ Ryan Jeffers hit .313 (35-for-112) with a .466 on-base percentage and an .885 OPS...his on-base percentage ranked second-highest in baseball among qualifiers, trailing only Aaron Judge (.491).

**THERE'S A NEW SHELTY IN TOWN:** 2026 marks Derek Shelton's first season as Twins manager...he was hired as the 15th manager in Twins history on October 30...had a career managerial record of 306-440 (.410) in five-plus seasons in Pittsburgh (2020-25)...he was named the 41st manager in Pirates history on November 17, 2019 and, after beginning the 2025 season 12-26, he was relieved of managerial duties on May 8, 2025...finished his Pittsburgh tenure as one of 11 managers to win 300-or-more games with the team...prior to managing in the majors, coached under Rocco Baldelli (2019) and Paul Molitor in Minnesota (2018), under John Gibbons in Toronto (2017), Joe Maddon in Tampa Bay (2010-16) and Eric Wedge in Cleveland (2005-09)...prior to his time in the major leagues, he coached (or managed) at the minor league levels from 1997-2005.  
 ☞ Shelty has a career managerial record of 5-8 against the Royals, including a record of 3-5 at Kauffman Stadium.

**SPRING RECAP:** Finished his fourth official major league spring training with Minnesota, appearing in six games (5 starts) in Fort Myers...went 0-2 with a 5.85 ERA (20.0 IP, 13 ER), five walks, 16 strikeouts, a 1.60 WHIP and a .325 (27-for-83) BAA.  
 ☞ Recorded a spring training career-high five strikeouts against the Philadelphia Phillies on March 8, allowing one run on one hit through 4.0 innings  
 ☞ Made his final start of the spring on March 20 vs. Toronto at Lee Health Sports Complex, allowing two runs on a spring-high nine hits through 5.0 innings with one walk and three strikeouts.

**2025 RECAP:** Was a member of the Twins season-opening rotation for the first time in his career...posted a career-high in wins, finishing 7-4 with a 4.04 ERA (111.1 IP, 50 ER) along with 46 walks, 107 strikeouts, and a 1.28 WHIP, his lowest in a full season...was one of two Twins pitchers (5th time) to record double-digit strikeouts in a game (Joe Ryan x2, Pablo López and Chris Paddack)...finished the season third on the team in strikeouts (107), starts (22) and innings pitched (111.1)...recorded a career-high 11 strikeouts in a scoreless, 6.0 inning outing against the New York Yankees on September 15.  
 ☞ In six starts against the AL Central, posted a 3.99 ERA (29.1 IP, 13 ER) with 30 strikeouts and avoided a loss in each of his final four starts against divisional opponents.  
 ☞ Held opponents to a 1.94 (27-for-139) BAA post-All Star Break, owning a 2-0 record with a 4.23 ERA (38.1 IP, 18 ER), 18 walks, 45 strikeouts and a 1.17 WHIP during that span.  
 ☞ Finished the season 5-0 over his last 12 starts beginning June 26 vs. Seattle; posted a 3.10 ERA (58.0 IP, 20 ER) with 61 strikeouts and a 1.10 WHIP during that stretch.

**ROYAL FLUSH:** Sim has made three starts against the Royals, going 1-2 with a 4.80 ERA (15.0 IP, 8 ER) and 12 strikeouts...has walked nine Royals, his second most walks against a single opponent in his career (CWS - 10)...recorded the loss in his last start vs. KC on April 7, 2025, where he allowed four runs on eight hits through 5.2 IP, with six strikeouts.  
 ☞ 0-2 with a 5.40 ERA (10.0 IP, 6 ER) in two career starts at Kauffman Stadium; 6.30 BB/9 in those starts.
