IT WON'T BE THE SAME: This season marks just the second without **Bob Uecker** on the radio for the Milwaukee Brewers (also 1970).....the 2003 Hall of Famer passed away at the age of 90 on January 16.

IN THE TRAINER'S ROOM: LHP Nestor Cortes (left elbow), LHP Robert Gasser (left elbow), 1B Rhys Hoskins (left thumb), OF Garrett Mitchell (left oblique), OF Blake Perkins (right shin), LHP Connor Thomas (left elbow) and LHP Rob Zastryzny (ribs) are on the injured list.....Cortes, Gasser, Mitchell, Perkins and Thomas are on the 60-day IL.

IN THE STANDINGS (113 days): The team has spent the following number of days alone or tied at each spot in the NL Central standings: **FIRST:** 10*, **SECOND:** 46, **THIRD:** 43, **FOURTH:** 11, **FIFTH:** 3.....the Brewers are currently in second place, trailing the first-place Cubs by 2.5 games (*9 days tied for first from 3/18-3/26 before playing a game).

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: The team is 17-11-2 in series play, including this series.

AT HOME: The team is 29-17 at home, going 11-4-0 in series play, including this series.....are 17-8 in their last 25 home games, including 6-1 in the last 7 contests.

ON THE ROAD: The team is 23-23 on the road, going 6-7-2 in series play.....the Brewers are 13-5 in their last 18 road games.....they have had two season-high 5-game road winning streaks (5/25-6/2 and 6/19-7/2).

MANAGER: Pat Murphy is in his second season as Brewers manager.....he was voted 2024 NL Manager of the Year after going 93-69 and winning the NL Central division championship.....he is the first manager in franchise history (in either league) to earn the honor.....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.

COACHES: Returning from 2024 is associate manager **Rickie Weeks** (2nd season), field coordinator **Néstor Corredor** (3rd season/2nd in current role), pitching coach **Chris Hook** (7th season), assistant pitching & strategy coach **Jim Henderson** (4th season/2nd in current role), bullpen coach **Charlie Greene** (2nd season), hitting coach **Connor Dawson** (4th season), assistant coach **Daniel de Mondesert** (2nd season), infield coach **Matt Erickson** (2nd season) and third base coach **Jason Lane** (10th season/5th in current role).....first base coach **Julio Borbón**, lead hitting coach **Al LeBoeuf** and hitting coach **Eric Theisen** are all in their first seasons on the staff.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The team has made 15 replay challenges this season, going 9-6.....their last challenge (won) came on 7/7 vs. Los Angeles-NL as an out call at third base involving Isaac Collins was overturned.

BREWING SUCCESS: The Brewers have made the postseason six times in the last seven seasons (2018-24) and won the NL Central in four of the last seven, three of four, and two in a row.....Milwaukee is one of five teams to make the postseason in at least six of the last seven seasons, joined by the Astros (7), Braves (7), Dodgers (7) and Yankees (6).....the team was just 2 games away from qualifying for the postseason in eight straight seasons (2017-24), missing by a single game in both 2017 and 2022.

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only teams with 86+ wins in each of the last seven full seasons (2017-24).....this does not include 2020.....the Brewers have 718 wins since 2017 (5th in MLB/2nd in National League).

2025 Arsenal: Sinker (46.1%) - Changeup (22.2%) - Curveball (13.1%) - 4-Seam Fastball (9.8%) - Slurve (8.8%)

QUINTANA AT A GLANCE: José Quintana, 36, will make his 13th start.....he last started last Thursday at New York-NL in a 3-2 loss (5.1ip, 6h, 3r, 3er, 0bb, 3k, 1hr, 80 pitches).....the team is 8-4 in his starts.....he has 3 quality starts.....opponents are batting .256 (64-for-250, 7hr).....he was on the 15-day injured list from 5/14-5/31 with a left shoulder impingement, retroactive to May 11.....Quintana signed with Milwaukee as a free agent on March 5.....he is signed through the 2025 season with a mutual option for 2026.....name is pronounced “keen-TAH-nuh.”

MR. COLOMBIA: Quintana, born in Arjona, Colombia, is his country’s all-time leader in nearly every statistical category in the Major Leagues, including games (371), starts (345), wins (108), innings pitched (2035.0) and strikeouts (1,771).....he pitched for Colombia in the 2017 World Baseball Classic.

BEEEN THERE, DONE THAT: Quintana has made 345 starts since 2012 - his first season - trailing only **Max Scherzer** (360).....this includes nine seasons of 30+ starts.

CAREER: Is 108-106 with a 3.73 ERA in 371 games/345 starts (2035.0ip, 844er).....is in his 14th Major League season while pitching for Chicago-AL (2012-17), Chicago-NL (2017-20), Los Angeles-AL (2021), San Francisco (2021), Pittsburgh (2022), St. Louis (2022), New York-NL (2023-24) and Milwaukee (2025).....was an All-Star in 2016 as he finished 10th in American League Cy Young Award voting.....Quintana was originally signed by the Mets as a non-drafted free agent on 4/26/06.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 7-6 with a 4.47 ERA in 17 starts (92.2ip, 46er).....is 2-2 with a 5.96 ERA in 5 starts this season (25.2ip, 17er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 54-56 with a 3.72 ERA in 188 games/176 starts (1028.0ip, 425er).....is 4-1 with a 1.82 ERA in 7 starts this season (39.2ip, 8er).

CAREER vs. DODGERS: Is 3-2 with a 2.04 ERA in 13 games/10 starts (61.2ip, 53h, 19r, 14er, 23bb, 52k, 4hr).....took a 3-0 loss last season with the Mets on 5/28 at Citi Field (6ip, 8h, 3r, 3er, 0bb, 3k, 2hr).....also started and lost Game 4 of the NLCS on 10/17 at Citi Field (3.1ip, 5h, 5r, 5er, 4bb, 2k, 1hr).

RHP Quinn Priestester will be making his 17th appearance and 13th start of the season.....Priester last pitched last Friday in a start at Miami and had no decision in the 6-5 win [4.2ip, 7h, 5r, 4er, 2bb, 4k, 2hr, 83 pitches].....the team is 6-6 in his starts.....he has 4 quality starts.....opponents are batting .238 [75-for-315, 10hr].....he has gone 4-2 with a 2.90 ERA as a starter [62ip, 20er] and 2-0 with a 5.66 ERA in relief [20.2ip, 13er].....his only career outing against Washington came in a 7-6 win in relief with the Pirates on 9/13/23 at PNC Park [4ip, 4h, 4r, 4er, 1bb, 4k, 2hr].
