**RECENT REDBIRDS:** The St. Louis Cardinals and Los Angeles Angels wrap up a three-game Interleague series tonight at Angel Stadium ... The Cardinals held on to a 7-6 win last night and have now won three in a row, seeking a winning road trip through Milwaukee (1-3) and Orange County (2-0) ... St. Louis is looking to win four straight for the first time since a six-game win streak last season from July 15-20, 2023.

**FLIGHT PATTERN:** The Cardinals open today tied with Cincinnati (18-24) for 4th place in the National League Central, 7.0 games behind first place Milwaukee and 2.5 games back in the NL Wild Card race.

**SO CAL SWEEPSTAKES:** A win tonight would give St. Louis its first series sweep of the season and 2nd consecutive sweep of the Angels at Angel Stadium (May 10-12, 2016 and May 13, 2023-present).

- The Cards five-game win streak is the longest active by a visiting team in Anaheim, and ties for their 4th-longest at an American League ballpark behind a trio all at Kauffman Stadium: 8 (June 28, 2016-Aug. 14, 2019), 8 (May 21, 2011-June 4, 2014), and 7 (June 28, 2003-May 21, 2005).
- St. Louis currently boasts the highest all-time win pct. (.750) at The Big A.

**CARDS CITY CONNECT ON DECK:** Following tomorrow's scheduled off day, the Cardinals open a nine-game, 10-homestand at Busch Stadium against the Red Sox (May 17-19), Orioles (May 20-22), and division-rival Cubs (May 24-26) ... The Cardinals Nike City Connect Series uniforms will be unveiled on Monday, with the on-field debut scheduled for Saturday, May 25 vs. the Cubs.

**MOUSE HOUSE:** The Cardinals are playing their 9th game ever at Angel Stadium (2013-24), tying the Braves for fewest regular season games played here by any Major League team since the stadium opened in 1966 ... Among active Major League stadiums, St. Louis has played fewer games at Yankee Stadium (3), Globe Life Field (3), and Target Field (6).

**CALIFORNIA DREAMIN':** St. Louis is visiting all five California-based organizations during the season for the 2nd time in franchise history (also 2013): March 28-31 at Los Angeles Dodgers (1-3); April 1-3 at San Diego (2-1); April 15-17 at Oakland (2-1); May 13-15 at Los Angeles Angels (2-0); and Sept. 27-29 at San Francisco.

**VOTE FOR PEDRO:** Since RBI became official in 1920, **Pedro Pagés** last night became the first Cardinal at any position to record a three-run double for his first MLB hit and the first Cardinals catcher to drive in 3+ runs on any first career hit as a Major Leaguer ... The last Cardinal with three or more RBI on their first hit was pitcher **Mark Worrell** (3-run home run) at Washington on 6/5/2008) ... The last catcher to drive in 3+ runs on his first MLB hit was Arizona's **Cooper Hummel** (3-run HR) vs. San Diego on 4/10/2022, while the last catcher to do this on a double was Detroit's **Paul Bako** on 5/1/1998 at Seattle. - *Elias*

**DOUBLE TROUBLE:** The Cardinals offense has recorded double-digit hit totals in four straight games (May 11-present), their longest stretch of 10+ hits since the first five games of the 2023 season (March 30-April 4).

**PRODUCTIVE OUTS:** The Cardinals (47, T-4th) and Angels (48, 3rd) rank among the top five teams in MLB in productive outs (33) this season (fly balls, grounders, or bunts to advance runners) ... Arizona (52) leads MLB.

**THE LATE SHOW:** The Cardinals are 7-1 in night games in the Pacific Time Zone this season (1-1 at LA Dodgers, 2-0 at Padres; 2-0 at Athletics; & 2-0 at LA Angels), with a 150-151 record in late night affairs since divisional play began in 1994.

**THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (May 15, 2023):** The Cardinals beat Milwaukee at Busch Stadium III, 18-1, winning by at least 17 runs for the first time since a 21-3 victory over the Chicago Cubs on April 27, 1977 at Wrigley Field ... **Andrew Knizner** came off the bench to pinch run for **Paul Goldschmidt** in the 8th inning and later hit a grand slam in the inning, as the Cardinals scored 10 runs in the frame ... Knizner was the first player in franchise history to enter any game as a pinch runner and hit a grand slam in the same game, and the 3rd in MLB history since at least 1959 to do so.

**Nolan Arenado** was born in nearby Newport Beach, Calif...graduated from El Toro High School in Lake Forest, Calif...resides in San Clemente.

**Lars Nootbaar** was born in and resides in El Segundo, Calif...graduated from El Segundo High School...played three years at USC (2016-18).

**JoJo Romero** was born in Camarillo, CA...graduated from nearby Oxnard (Calif.) High School.

**Keynan Middleton** pitched parts of four seasons with Los Angeles (2017-20), where he made his MLB debut (May 5, 2017 vs. Astros)...originally Selected by the Angels in the 3rd round (95th overall) of the 2013 MLB Draft.

**Miles Mikolas** (May 20, 2012) and **John King** (Sept. 9, 2020) earned their first MLB wins against the Angels.

Hall of Famer **Ozzie Smith** graduated from Locke High School in Los Angeles...played college baseball at Cal Poly, San Luis Obispo.

**Guillermo Zuñiga** pitched in two games for St. Louis in 2023...made MLB Debut with the Cardinals versus the Angels (May 2, 2023 at Busch III)...traded to Angels for cash considerations (Feb. 7, 2024).

**Ron "Pop" Warner** was born in Alhambra, Calif...graduated from Redlands High School.

**Michael Siani** and Angels broadcaster **Mark Gubicza** are both graduates from William Penn Charter in Philadelphia...Siani is first player to make it to MLB who received scholarship established by Gubicza in his father's name for a student from Roxborough neighborhood.

**Brandon Crawford** played three seasons at UCLA (2006-08).

**Luis Garcia** pitched for St. Louis in 2021 (34 G).

**Reid Detmers** was born in Nokomis, Ill...graduated from Glenwood III. High School...grew up a Cardinals fan...father **Kris Detmers** pitched parts of six seasons in the Cardinals minor league organization (1994-99), where he was teammates with **Stubby Clapp** and **Pop Warner**.

Cardinals broadcaster **Bengie Molina** played in eight seasons with the Angels (1998-2004) & won 2002 World Series...originally signed by the Angels as an non-drafted free agent (May 23, 1993).

Hall of Famer **Tony La Russa** served as an executive with the Angels (2019-20).

Cardinals AGM/Scouting **Randy Flores** was born in Bellflower...graduated from El Rancho High School in Pico Rivera...pitched at the University of Southern California (1994-97).

**Jim Edmonds** was born in Diamond Bar, Calif...drafted by the Angels in the 7th round in 1988 ...played seven seasons with the Angels (1993-99), winning two Gold Gloves (1997-98) and was a 1995 AL All-Star...became a Cardinal via trade with the Angels (March 23, 2000), exchanged for **Kent Bottenfield** and **Adam Kennedy**.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Mark McGwire** is a Pomona, CA native...graduated from Damien High School in La Verne, CA and played college baseball at USC...resides in Southern California.

Recently passed Hall of Famer **Whitey Herzog** was California Angels interim manager in 1974 ...later served as Angels General Manager (1993-94).

Former Cardinals personnel now with the Angels include **Phil Plantier**, **Joey Prebyski**, **Tony Ferreira**, **Joe Kruzel**, **Chris Carpenter**, **Jobel Jimenez**, **Mike Gallego**, and **Matt Swanson**.

St. Louis Post-Dispatch reporter **Daniel Guerrero** is an Anaheim, Calif native and grew up as an Angels fan...earned associates degree in journalism at Fullerton College.

Bally Sports West reporter **Erica Weston** worked for Bally Sports Midwest from 2018-21.

**TONIGHT'S GAME**

- Makes his 9th start of the season and the 326th of his career (350th appearance).
- Is making his 13th career start against the Angels, and his 7th at Angel Stadium. **It's his first start against the Angels as a member of the St. Louis Cardinals since July 2, 2013 when he started the Cardinals first-ever game played here in Anaheim.**
- Suffered his first loss of the season, and his first as a St. Louis Cardinal since 2017, during his start last Friday (5/10) at Milwaukee. Posted his 1,000th strikeout in National League play when he fanned Brice Turang to lead off the 1st inning.
- The Cardinals have lost each of his last 3 games started after having won 4 of the first 5.
- Passed **Steve Carlton** (951) in his 5/4 start vs. White Sox for 8th place all-time in Cardinals franchise history for strikeouts. His 957 strikeouts as a Cardinal are 22 back of **Jesse Haines** (979) for 7th.
- The Cardinals have played extra innings in three of his eight starts this year and co-leads MLB starters with six no-decisions in his eight starts.
- Is 54 strikeouts shy of 2,000 for his career and 70.2 innings from 2,000.
- Shares team lead in batters faced (6) with the bases loaded (**Kyle Gibson & JoJo Romero**), allowing no hits. He leads MLB pitchers with 5 strikeouts with the bases loaded.
- Has returned to his original drafting/signing team (1st round, 2008) for the first time since 2017 after pitching for the Twins (2018), Yankees (2018), Rangers (2019-20), White Sox (2021-23) and Dodgers (2023).
- Was teammates with current Cardinals manager **Oliver Marmol** in Quad Cities (2008) and Palm Beach (2009).

**2024**

- Made his 200th career appearance in the National League at NYM (4/28) and 1,000th NL strikeout on 5/10 at MIL.
- Has passed **Carlos Martinez** (927, 11th), **Bill Doak** (939, 10th) and **Steve Carlton** (951, 9th) for 8th place all-time in Cardinals franchise history in strikeouts with 957.
- Recorded his first win as a member of the Cardinals since 2017 coming at OAK (4/16), firing a season-high 7.0 innings allowing two runs (1 ER) and one strikeout. Marked the first time in his career he had thrown 7.0 or more innings in a start and recorded one strikeout or less.
- Was Cardinals Home Opening starter for the first time in his career (April 4 vs. Miami).

**BUSCH STADIUM III (2006-PRESENT)**

- Has never pitched at Busch Stadium as a visitor. Before the Home Opener (4/4/23), his last appearance in St. Louis was Sept. 28, 2017 vs. the Cubs (ND, 5.0 IP, 1 R, 5 K).
- His 81 career starts at Busch Stadium III are 2nd-most in stadium history (2006-present) behind only **Adam Wainwright** (214).
- His last win at Busch Stadium III came on 9/12/17 vs. CIN (13-4).

**CAREER**

- Member of the 2011 Cardinals World Series Championship team and the 2013 National League Champions.
- Ranks 2nd behind only **Adam Wainwright** (29) with 24 postseason pitching appearances among Cardinals.
- Has five postseason wins as a member of the Cardinals, T-3rd in franchise history behind **Chris Carpenter** (10) and **Bob Gibson** (7).
- Won a career-high 18 games with St. Louis in 2012, his first full season as a starting pitcher.
- Two-time All-Star with the National League (2012, did not pitch) and the American League (2021). Pitched a scoreless inning at Coors Field (7/12/21) in relief of starting pitcher **Shohei Ohtani**. Current teammates **Kyle Gibson** and **Andrew Kittredge** also pitched for the A.L. in that game.

- Won 4 consecutive starts against the Angels from 2019 to 2020, all with the Texas Rangers and all in Arlington, TX.
- Is 17-18 career in interleague games with 4.47 ERA in 53 games/50 starts.

**LAST TIME OUT**
