RECENT REDBIRDS: The Cardinals continue their beerstand homestand with the penultimate game of a four-game series against the Colorado Rockies over Players' and Cardinals Hall of Fame Weekend. St. Louis opened its homestand by taking two of three from division-rival Milwaukee...tonight is the Cardinals' 12th of 16 straight games without an off-day (August 13-28).

TIME TO FLY: Winners of 11 of their last 14 (August 9-present) and sporting the National League's 3rd-best winning pct. (.641, 25-14) since the All-Star break, the Cardinals enter today a season-high 11 games over .500 and in first place in the NL Central, 0.5 games head of Chicago.

DAK ATTACK: Dakota Hudson, who earned his first career Major League win against the Rockies (July 30, 2018), enters tonight's start with 7.2 consecutive innings without allowing a hit (dating back to the 6th inning of his August 14 start at Kansas City) and a career-high 12.2 consecutive scoreless innings (3rd-longest active in the NL). Since Ground Ball percentage became a recorded stat in 1987, Hudson's MLB-leading 57.8% currently is the 8th-highest single-season mark in Cardinals history & highest since Jaime García (57.9) in 2016.

TAP THE ROCKIES: Since Busch Std. III opened in 2006, St. Louis' .735 home win pct. (36-13) against the Rockies is its best against any opponent. The Cardinals have defeated Colorado in 10 of their last 11 home games (May 18, 2016-present) and are 27-6 (.818 win pct.) at Busch vs. the Rock Pile over their last 33 meetings (since Sept. 30, 2010). The last time St. Louis lost consecutive home games to the Rockies was part a four-game series sweep (June 5-8, 2009).

HOME SWEET HOME: The Cardinals are 8-1 (.889) at home since August 1, with only Houston (.900, 9-1) and Oakland (.900, 9-1) sporting a higher home win pct in August across Major League Baseball. Overall this season, St. Louis is 38-24 at Busch Stadium with a .613 home win pct. ranking 4th in the NL.

REHAB UPDATES: Left-handed pitcher Austin Gomber made his first injury rehab appearance with Palm Beach (High-A) last night, allowing three runs on a pair of hits and walks over 0.1 innings (22 pitches, 9 strikes). In two games with Memphis (AAA), Tyler O'Neill is 2-for-6 with a walk and three strikeouts while logging 13.0 innings defensively in left field. Outfielder Jose Martínez (right shoulder sprain) is scheduled to join Springfield (AA) on Monday.

TAKING CARE OF BUSINESS: Beginning Monday, 20 of St. Louis' remaining 33 games are against NL Central opponents (Chicago 7; Milwaukee 6; Cincinnati 4; Pittsburgh 3). The Cardinals are 33-23 in divisional play this season, including a 18-6 record since the All-Star Break.

Dexter Fowler played first six seasons with the Rockies (2008-13)...originally selected by Colorado in the 14th round of the 2004 MLB Draft...is the Rockies franchise record holder in career triples (53)...traded by Colorado with cash to Houston for **Brandon Barnes** and **Jordan Lyles** (Dec. 3, 2013).

Marcell Ozuna's cousin, **Pablo Ozuna**, played in 17 games for the Rockies in 2003.

Paul DeJong made his MLB debut at Colorado (May 28, 2017)...became the 9th Cardinal in history to homer in his first MLB at-bat, a pinch-hit 9th inning solo home run off **Greg Holland**.

Harrison Bader (July 25, 2017 at Busch Stadium) and **John Brebbia** (May 28, 2017 at Coors Field) both made their MLB debuts against the Rockies.

Matt Wieters (junior) and **Charlie Blackmon** (medical redshirt-tendinitis in throwing arm) were teammates at Georgia Tech Univ. in 2007.

Cardinals Scouting Director **Randy Flores** pitched in a combined 82 games in three seasons (2002, '09-10) over two stints with Colorado.

Andrew Miller and **Bryan Shaw** were teammates on the 2016 AL Champion Cleveland Indians.

Rockies manager **Bud Black** previously managed **Miles Mikolas** (2012-13) while in San Diego, where he made his MLB debut under Black.

Tim Melville graduated from Wentzville Holt High School, where he was the Aflac National Player of the Year as a junior.

Dom Nuñez and Cardinals 2016 1st rounder **Dylan Carlson** were teammates at Elk Grove (Calif.) High School in 2013.

Rockies bullpen coach **Darren Holmes** pitched in five games for St. Louis during the 2000 season.

MLB.com Cardinals reporter **Anne Rogers** previously worked as a Rockies Associate Reporter under **Thomas Harding** in 2018.

St. Louis Post-Dispatch reporter **Derrick Goold** is originally from Boulder, Colo...attended Centaurus High School in Lafayette, Colo...worked as a staff writer for the Rocky Mountain News (2000-01).

Cardinals President of Baseball Operations **John Mozeliak** began his baseball career with the Rockies...initially served as a left-handed batting practice pitcher in 1993 and worked in a variety of positions in the home clubhouse and in baseball operations...joined St. Louis as an assistant in scouting operations following the 1995 season...graduated from Fairview High School in Boulder, Colo., where he was a first baseman and pitcher...graduated from University of Colorado at Boulder.

Cardinals Sr. Special Asst. to the GM **Bob Gebhard** served as the Rockies' first GM (1991-99)...hired **John Mozeliak** in 1993...worked as a special assistant to former Cardinals General Manager **Walt Jocketty** in St. Louis after leaving the Rockies in 1999...resides in nearby Centennial, Colo.

FS Midwest reporter **Erica Weston** is a Highlands Ranch, CO native...attended Colorado State Univ.

- Rookie right-hander makes his 26th career start (53rd appearance) in tonight's start
- Leads all Major League rookies with 12 wins and is T4th in the National League.
- His team-leading 12 victories makes him the first Cardinals rookie to lead the Cardinals in that category since Matt Morris (12, 1997). The last Cardinals rookie to win more games was Shelby Miller in 2013 (15-9).
- Is 5-2 with a 3.24 ERA in 12 home starts this season. Lifetime, is 7-2 with an 2.67 ERA (81.0 IP) in 26 games (12 starts) at Busch Stadium.
- Is 7-4 on the road this season, his seven road wins at T2nd among N.L. pitchers.
- Is 10-3 over his last 17 starts since May 18, tied for 2nd-most wins among National League pitchers with Clayton Kershaw (10-2) trailing only Washington's Stephen Strasburg (12-2).
- Since Ground Ball Pct. became a recorded stat in 1987, currently has the 8th-best single-season mark (57.8) in Cardinals history & lowest since Jaime Garcia (57.9) in 2016.

LAST TIME OUT

- No-hit the Brewers for 6.2 innings on Mon. (8/19) before pitch count reached 111, one shy of his career high. Gained his team-leading 12th win while also stretching his scoreless innings streak to a career-high 12.2 inning & fanned a career-high seven.
