Four Straight

Atlanta's win, 10-1, last night was its fourth consecutive victory, tying the club's longest winning streak of the season. The Braves also won four straight from April 18 to April 21.

The club has outscored its opponents, 27-10 (+17), over these four games, and has cut its season run differential to -9.

The Braves are one of just four clubs in baseball this season that has yet to win five consecutive games, joining the Athletics, Rockies and White Sox.

Atlanta has not won five consecutive games since September 21 through September 28 of last season.

TODAY'S GAME: The Braves and Guardians today conclude a three-game weekend series in what are the only scheduled meetings between the two teams this season...Atlanta is making just its fourth-ever trip to Cleveland.

 Atlanta has won each of the first two games of this series by a combined score of 12-1, and will play for a sweep this afternoon.

 The Braves won two-of-three from the Guardians last season, and have won exactly two-of-three in each of the last three series between the clubs dating to 2019...Two of the three games last season went to extra innings.

 Atlanta has made just three visits here to Cleveland all-time, and last played at Progressive Field in 2023...The Braves are 8-3 (.727) here in 11 total games, and have never lost a series in this building...Atlanta's nine games here entering this series were tied for its fewest in any visiting city dating to the start of interleague play in 1997, matching its number of games in Detroit.

 The Braves and Guardians have played just 23 times since the advent of interleague play in 1997, with Atlanta playing to a 14-9 record (.609) all-time versus Cleveland...The two franchises have met twice in the World Series, with the then-Indians beating the Boston Braves in six games in 1948, before Atlanta bested Cleveland in six games in 1995 for the championship.

 RH Erick Fedde has never lost to Cleveland, going a perfect 2-0 with a 2.37 ERA (5 ER/19.0 IP) in three career starts, four appearances, against them all-time..The 6-foot-4, 205-pound right-hander faced them twice last year while with the White Sox, and combined to allow just a single earned run over 12.0 innings in a pair of wins...Fedde stopped a nine-decision losing skid and earned his first win with Atlanta in his last turn, August 9 vs. Miami.

 RH Logan Allen has made just one prior start against Atlanta in his career, pitching at Truist Park on April 26 of last season...The 6-foot-0, 190-pound Floridian took the loss that night, allowing five hits and four runs over 4.2 innings...Cleveland has won each of his last three starts, during which Allen is 1-0 with a 2.65 ERA, allowing just five earned runs over 17.0 total innings.

BOTTOM OF THE LINEUP: 3B Nacho Alvarez Jr. and SS Nick Allen, batting eighth and ninth respectively last night, each collected three hits...The duo combined to go 6-for-9 with a double, three runs and three RBI.

 It was the first three-hit game of Alvarez Jr.'s career, and the third baseman is 5-for-17 with a .294/.400/.353 line over his last five games.

 For Atlanta, last night marked the most hits by its eight and nine-hole batters since Game 1 of a doubleheader at Citi Field on August 12, 2023...Michael Harris II (2), Forrest Wall (PH, 1) and Nicky Lopez (4) combined for seven that day.

HARRIS II MULTIPLE HITS: Michael Harris II went 2-for-5 with a double, homer and three RBI last night, and has collected at least two hits in each of his last eight games...It is the longest such streak of his career, the longest multi-hit run in baseball this season, and tied for the longest such span in franchise history.

 Harris II is 17-for-34 (.500) during the run, which dates to the first game of last Saturday's doubleheader vs. Miami...He has seven two-hit games and one three-hit effort during the streak...Eight of his 17 hits have gone for extra bases (four doubles, four homers), and he has driven in 13.

 No Atlanta batter has ever had at least two hits in nine straight games...Harris II is one of just five Braves all-time to do so in eight straight games, joining Walter Barbare (1921), Hall-of- Famers George Sisler (1928) and Hank Aaron (1959), and Chris Johnson (2013).

 Since 2000, just eight players across baseball have tallied nine consecutive games with at least two hits, with Xander Bogaerts' nine-game run in 2022 the last such streak...Lourdes Gurriel Jr. had 11 straight two-hit games in 2018, the most for a player this millennium.

 Spanning the All-Star break and dating to July 11, a stretch of 31 games, Harris II's 2.1 fWAR are most in the National League and third most in all of baseball...He has batted .384/.398/.704 with a 1.102 OPS since that date, and raised his season average by 49 points (.205 to .254), on-base by 45 points (.229 to .274), slugging by 106 points (.310 to .416) and OPS by 152 points (.539 to .691).

PITCHING: Atlanta has combined to allow just eight hits and one run over the first 18.0 innings of this series here in Cleveland, both games of which have been wins...In its last three games dating to the finale of the series in New York, the Braves have surrendered 14 hits and just three earned runs over their last 27.0 frames.

 Hunter Stratton pitched 3.0 scoreless innings out of the bullpen last night, and the Braves' 1.72 ERA (11 ER/57.2 IP) in relief in August is the lowest in baseball...Five of those 11 earned runs came over 4.0 innings last Tuesday, and Atlanta's bullpen has tossed 16.0 consecutive scoreless innings since.

 Atlanta has just one longer scoreless-inning streak in relief this season, pitching 18.0 straight scoreless frames from August 5 through August 9.

OFFENSE: Atlanta scored double-digit runs for the fourth time in 28 games since the All-Star break last night, and the club's 143 total runs since the break are fourth most in baseball and second most in the NL.

 Only Milwaukee (179), Toronto (171) and the Athletics (144) have scored more runs since the break.

 The Braves are scoring a full run more per game since the break (5.11) than before (4.08).

Became the 13th player to make a start for Atlanta this season...Was also the eighth player to make a start for the Braves that was not on Atlanta's Opening Day roster.

Picked up his first win with Atlanta in his last outing and first since May 9 while with St. Louis, snapping a nine-decision winless streak...Allowed five hits and four runs over 5.0 innings pitched in Game 2 of a doubleheader against Miami.

At the time, it was the longest active in the majors, and second-longest overall this season behind Mitch Keller's 10-game skid (PIT, April 4-June 21).
- 🍷

Suffered the loss in his Braves debut on July 29 after allowing five hits, four runs, two walks, and a homer while fanning three Kansas City hitters over 4.2 innings pitched.
- 🍷

Was acquired on July 27 from the St. Louis Cardinals along with cash considerations in exchange for a player to be named later or cash considerations.
- 🍷

St. Louis went 5-15 in Fedde's starts this season.
- 🍷

Held Washington to six hits while recording eight strikeouts in his first career shutout on May 9 earlier this year...It was the first appearance against at Nationals Park since leaving the organization that drafted him in 2022.

Pitching to a 7.29 ERA in the first inning this season.
- 🍷

Posting a 4.85 ERA in all other combined innings.
- 🍷

Enters play with a eight-game losing streak...It is the longest active streak in baseball and the second longest streak in 2025.
- 🍷

Has gone 13 outings without a win dating to his shutout performance against Washington on May 9.
- 🍷

Fedde is averaging 4.15 walks per nine innings pitched, the fifth-highest rate in the majors this season.

Held Pittsburgh hitless through 6.0 frames tossed before being removed from the game to start the bottom of the seventh inning on May 9.

It was the deepest Fedde had taken a no-hit bid in his career.
