**CLIMBING BACK:** Last night the Giants won their second straight contest to improve to 2-3 on the season and are looking for a win today to sweep the Padres in a three-game set here at Petco Park for the first time since July 1-3, 2019.

**ON THE MOUND: RHP Adrian Houser** is slated to make his first start of the year and his first in a Giants uniform...this year marks his ninth overall in the Majors.

- ▶ Went 1-0 with a 3.46 ERA (5er, 13.0ip) with 11 strikeouts and a 1.15 WHIP over three Cactus League starts...he also made an exhibition start vs. Team USA.
- ▶ Has solid numbers against the Padres over his career, posting a 3.00 ERA (11er, 33.0ip), 27 strikeouts and a 1.03 WHIP in eight career games (six starts)...despite not appearing in a game at Petco Park since 2022, he has a 1.93 ERA (3er, 14.0ip), 10 strikeouts and a 0.93 WHIP in three games (two starts).
- ▶ Houser's sinker had a run value of +6 last season per *Baseball Savant*, which is the pitch's best mark since it had a +23 run value in 2021...since the start of last season, the Padres' .714 OPS vs. sinkers is 27th in MLB.

**LEADING THE WAY:** Including last night, **IF Willy Adames** has been the starting leadoff hitter four times in his career...he recorded four hits yesterday, including his second career leadoff home run (also: Sept. 28, 2025)...his team is now 4-0 and has scored 24 runs in those four games (3 for Giants, once for Rays in 2018)...in those games he went 2-for-5, 1-for-3, 1-for-4, and now 4-for-5 (*SIS*).

- ▶ Adames now owns a .407 career on-base percentage against the Padres, third best among active players (minimum 100 PA)...it also is Adames' highest mark against any team in his career (*STATS, LLC*).

**AGAINST THE PADRES:** Dating back to September 2024, the Giants have struggled against the Padres, posting a 4-14 (.286) record with a -43 run differential.

- ▶ Despite winning each of the last two contests, SF has still dropped nine of its last 17 games here at Petco Park...during that stretch, SF hitters have posted a .235 batting average, while Giants' pitchers have posted a 5.80 ERA and allowed 6.1 runs per game.

**IT'S EARLY, BUT IT STILL COUNTS:** The Giants defense has turned 86% of the grounders and bunts against it into outs, which is the highest rate in the Major Leagues so far...they have got at least 1 out on 49 of 57 ground balls and bunts...last year, the Giants turned 74% of ground balls and bunts into outs, which ranked 14th in MLB (*SIS*).

**NOTABLE BVP:** A few Giants have posted solid numbers against today's starter Nick Pivetta with **OF Jung Hoo Lee** batting .500 (6-for-12) with five extra base hits, **IF Willy Adames** going 5-for-16 (.313) with four doubles, a home run and three walks and **IF Luis Arraez** hitting .444 (4-for-9).

**IN THE 'PEN:** The Giants' bullpen has been a bright spot for SF through the first five games of the season, posting a 1.93 ERA (4er, 18.2ip) and 20 strikeouts with a .159 opponents batting average against.

**ON DECK:** Following today's game, the Giants will travel home to open a seven-game homestand tomorrow against the New York Mets (Thursday-Sunday) and Philadelphia Phillies (Monday-Wednesday).

**TONY V:** Manager **Tony Vitello** was named the 40th field manager in Giants history on October 22, 2025.

- ▶ Vitello spent the last eight years (2018-2025) as head coach of the University of Tennessee where he went 341-131 (.722), leading the Vols to a National Championship in 2024.
- ▶ The 47-year-old helped transform Tennessee baseball into a national powerhouse during his time in Knoxville, guiding the program to six NCAA regional appearances (2019, 2021-2025), five super regionals (2021-2025) and three Men's College World Series

**YO ADRIAN:** Enters his first season in a Giants uniform and 10th overall in the Majors...the 33-year-old signed a two-year contract with the Giants this past offseason.

**CACTUS LEAGUE:** Went 1-0 with a 3.46 ERA (5er, 13.0ip) with 11 strikeouts and a 1.15 WHIP over three Cactus League starts...also made an exhibition start vs. Team USA.

**AGAINST THE PADRES:** Has solid numbers against the Padres despite zero wins...he has a 3.00 ERA (11er, 33.0ip), 27 strikeouts and a 1.03 WHIP in eight career games (six starts)...despite not appearing in a game at Petco Park since 2022, he has a 1.93 ERA (3er, 14.0ip), 10 strikeouts and a 0.93 WHIP in three games (two starts).

**2025 RECAP:** Had a well-traveled 2025...he originally pitched in Spring Training with Texas on an MiLB deal...after not making the Rangers out of camp, he pitched nine games (eight starts) with Triple-A Round Rock before opting out of his contract to sign an MLB deal with Chicago-AL...he promptly went 6-2 with a 2.10 ERA (16er, 68.2ip) with the White Sox before being traded to the Rays at the deadline...he went 2-3 with a 4.79 ERA (30er, 56.1ip) in 10 starts to end the season with Tampa Bay.

**SINK OR SWIM:** Houser's sinker had a run value of +6 last season per *Baseball Savant*, which is the pitch's best mark since it had a +23 run value in 2021...since the start of last season, the Padres' .714 OPS vs. sinkers is 27th in MLB.

**THE SENIOR CIRCUIT:** Had a 2.19 ERA (13er, 53.1ip) in nine starts against National League opponents while owning a 4.14 ERA (33er, 71.2ip) in 12 starts against American League foes.

**DAY MAN:** In 2025, Houser had a 2.36 ERA (13er, 49.2ip) in eight day game starts compared to a 3.94 ERA (33er, 75.1ip) in 13 night games...over his career, the vet has been nearly a half run better in day games than night games in his career...he is 15-12 with a 3.78 ERA (112er, 267.0ip), 202 strikeouts and a 1.34 WHIP in 67 career day games (44 starts)...in 106 night games (81 starts), he is 25-32 with a 4.22 ERA (219er, 466.2ip), 374 strikeouts and a 1.37 WHIP.

**CRACK OF THE BAT:** Houser had a 47.6% hard hit rate last season, which ranked in the bottom 5% of MLB...vs. his sinker, opponents had a 53.0% rate of balls hit 95+ mph.

**LEFT ON READ:** Left-handers slashed .274/.356/.456 (.812 OPS) while righties slashed .249/.293/.320 (.612 OPS).

**CHANGIN' THE PACE:** Houser's changeup had an opposing batting average of .234, but an xBA of .276...he posted a 35.1% whiff rate with his changeup.

**Pitch Arsenal:** Slider, Sinker, Split Finger, Sweeper

**Last Game:** 3/28 vs. NYY; 1.0ip, h, r, k, hr (15 pitches)

- ▶ Made his fourth career Opening Day roster (also with Pirates in 2025, 2024 and with Blue Jays in 2021).
- ▶ Signed a Major League contract with the Giants on March 21 after opting out of his minor league deal with the White Sox on March 20...was in camp with the Sox as a NRI and went 2-0 with eight strikeouts and a 0.67 WHIP over 6.0 shutout innings.
- ▶ Appeared in 39 games at the Major League level in 2025 for Pittsburgh (35 games) and Toronto (four games) and was a combined 1-3 with a 4.63 ERA (18er, 35.0ip).
- ▶ Left-handed batters were 7-for-60 (.117) with two extra-base hits (both doubles) off him last season...has held lefties to a .181 clip (67-for-370) in his MLB career.
- ▶ **Cactus League Stats:** 0.00 ERA, 3h, 0r, bb, 8k, 0.67 WHIP (6g)

- ▶ Was acquired from the Mets on July 30, 2025 as part of the RHP Tyler Rogers trade.
- ▶ Pitched in 21 games for SF last season, going 2-1 with a 4.50 ERA (10er, 20.0ip), 17 strikeouts and a 1.45 WHIP.
- ▶ Was 3-2 with a 3.64 ERA (19er, 47.0ip), 41 strikeouts and a 1.38 WHIP in 34 games with the Mets before the trade last season.
- ▶ His 55 appearances in 2025 were by far a career-high after being used as a primarily as a starter prior to the 2024 season.

- ▶ Made his first career Opening Day roster...has appeared in three of SF's first five games, tossing 3.0-scoreless innings.
- ▶ Signed a MiLB deal with SF on July 2, 2025 after spending the majority of the year in the Tigers organization.
- ▶ Went 0-1 with a 3.91 ERA (11er, 25.1ip), 24 strikeouts and a 1.50 WHIP in 27 games (two starts) for the Giants last season.
- ▶ Has not allowed a HR in his last 35.2 innings dating to June 11, 2023.
- ▶ He's the first wearer of #93 in SF Giants history...#93 is the highest player-worn uniform number in SF-era history, passing No. 87 (worn by RHP Dan Otero in 2012).
- ▶ Originally was a 10th-round pick of the Giants in 2014 before his career journey brought him back to SF last season.
- ▶ **Cactus League Stats:** 2.84 ERA, 3h, 2r, 2er, 9k (7g)

### #45 CALEB KILIAN ▶ RHP

(kill-EE-en)

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Curveball

**Last Game:** 3/25 vs. NYY; 1.0ip, k (10 pitches)

- ▶ On his first career Opening Day roster after returning to the Giants organization on a minor league deal with a spring invite.
- ▶ Has not appeared in a game since Opening Night (3/25).
- ▶ Dealt with a right shoulder strain for most of the 2025 season while with the Cubs organization.
- ▶ During his rehab last season, he changed his diet to add more muscle and got his weight up to 215 pounds...he also tinkered with his mechanics after talking with roommate and former Giants farmhand Wil Jensen.
- ▶ Originally drafted by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2019 draft and was one of the organization's top prospects when he was dealt to the Cubs at the trade deadline in 2021 along with OF Alexander Canario in exchange for IF/OF Kris Bryant.
- ▶ **Cactus League Stats:** 0.96 ERA, 6h, r, er, 2bb, 11k, 0.86 WHIP

- ▶ Hit his second career leadoff HR last night and is 5-for-9 with two runs, a double, homer and two RBI from the leadoff slot this year.
- ▶ Had four hits last night...had just two four-hit games all last year.
