TONIGHT’S TILT...the Mariners continue a 7-game homestand with the first of 3 games vs. Houston...began the homestand with a 4-game series win vs. Oakland (3-1)...following the current series against the Astros will embark on a 10-game road trip at Texas (3 G, 7/30-8/1), Tampa Bay (3 G, 8/2-8/4) and New York-AL (4 G, 8/5-8/8) with off days before and after the trip...tonight’s game will be televised on **ROOT SPORTS**, as well as broadcast on **710 ESPN Seattle** and the **Mariners Radio Network**.

ODDS AND ENDS...the Mariners captured the series win vs. Oakland with a 4-3 win yesterday...have won 3 consecutive games and are 9-4 in their last 13 games, 20-10 over their last 30, 23-11 over their last 34 and 33-20 over their last 53...are 21-13 in day games and 33-33 at night...are 32-21 at T-Mobile Park and 22-25 on the road...are 45-14 when scoring at least 4 runs and 9-32 when scoring 3 or fewer runs...are 38-3 when out-hitting their opponent.

- **Last 11 Series** - The Mariners have won or split 10 of their last 11 series, owning an 8-1-2 series record in their last 11 after taking 3 of 4 from Oakland.
- **SEA-biscuit** - Seattle trailed 2-0 in yesterday’s 4-3 win...earned their second consecutive and 23rd comeback win of the season.
- **You Must Whiff It - Paul Sewald** leads the Majors in strikeouts-per-9 innings (15.73) among pitchers with at least 30 IP...leads Aroldis Chapman-NYY (15.58) and Josh Hader-MIL (15.43).
- **Side of Gravy - Kendall Graveman** ranks 3rd in MLB and leads the American League with a 0.69 WHIP...he also leads the AL with a .140 (15x107) opponent average among pitchers with at least 30 IP.
- **More with Less** - Seattle’s 4-3 win yesterday marked their first win of the season without registering an extra-base hit...improved to 1-10 when not recording an extra-base hit in a game.
- **Yesterday** - The Mariners recalled RHP **Ryan Weber** (#53) and optioned INF **Donovan Walton** to Triple-A Tacoma.

HIGH WATER MARK...the Mariners enter tonight’s game with a 54-46 record...they are a season-high 8 games above .500, the first time they are 8 games above since April 20, 2019 when they were 16-8...with a win tonight, they would be 9 games above .500 for the first time since April 13, 2019 when they were 13-4.

NOT DONE WITH ONE RUN...the Mariners have won 3 consecutive games by 1 run for the first time since May 20-23, 2018...they have won 3 straight by 4-3, 5-4 and 4-3 scores, respectively...Seattle is 23-8 (.742) in 1-run games this season, the most wins and best winning percentage in games decided by 1 run in the Majors this season...Cincinnati (.643, 18-10) has the 2nd-best winning percentage, while the New York Mets (20) have the 2nd-most 1-run wins...if Seattle wins tonight’s game by 1 run, it will be the third time in franchise history that the Mariners have won 4 consecutive games by 1 run...they did it from Aug. 21-24, 1998 and June 8-11, 2007.

MIGHTY MITCH...Mitch Haniger has reached base safely in 23 of his last 24 games since June 25...in that span, Mitch is batting .333 (30x93) with 25 runs, 3 doubles, 9 home runs, 21 RBI, 9 walks and 4 hit-by-pitches...he’s also hit safely in 13 of his last 15 games since July 6...on the season, Mitch is batting .265 (99x373) with 70 runs, 18 doubles, 1 triple, 25 home runs, 62 RBI and 28 walks...among American League players with at least half of their games played in the outfield, Haniger ranks 1st in runs (70), 1st in home runs (25), T2nd in RBI (62), 2nd in extra-base hits (44), 2nd in total bases (194), 3rd in hits (99) and 3rd in slugging percentage (.520).

YOU GOTTA RELIEVE...Seattle’s bullpen is 26-14 with 28 saves and a 4.02 ERA (172 ER, 385.0 IP) with 336 hits allowed, 136 walks and 392 strikeouts this season...*FanGraphs* pegs Mariners relievers as the 2nd-most valuable by Wins Above Replacement (4.8) this season, trailing only Tampa Bay (5.2)...the bullpen’s 3.55 Fielding Independent Pitching also ranks 2nd in the Majors to Tampa Bay (3.40).

- **JT Chargois** (H, 0.1 IP, 1 SO yesterday) has inherited 5 baserunners over his last 3 outings and has not allowed any of them to score...he has a 2.12 ERA (7 ER, 29.2 IP) with 6 walks and 29 strikeouts in 30 games this season...Seattle is 20-10 in JT’s appearances.
- **Anthony Misiewicz** (H, 1.1 IP, 1 SO) has a 1.76 ERA (3 ER, 15.1 IP) with 2 walks and 16 strikeouts in his last 16 games...he’s held opponents to a .148 (8x54) batting average in that span.
- **Drew Steckenrider** (SV#3, 1.0 IP, 1 H) is 3-2 with 3 saves and a 2.08 ERA (9 ER, 39.0 IP) with 12 walks and 41 strikeouts in 35 appearances this season.

LONG DIVISION...the Mariners play the 5th of 10 consecutive games against the American League West Division, their 3rd-longest intra-divisional streak this season...Seattle is 24-16 (.600) in 40 games against the AL West this season and 30-30 in 60 games outside the division...Seattle went 9-5 during a season-high 14-game stretch against divisional opponents from May 24-June 6...the Mariners play their final 13 games of the regular season within the division.

TY ONE ON...Ty France went 1-for-3 with a run scored and hit-by-pitch yesterday...is batting .400 (14x35) with 6 runs, 2 doubles, 1 home run, 7 RBI and 3 hit-by-pitches in his last 9 games...in 53 games since returning from the Injured List on May 24, the Mariners are 33-20 (.623) and Ty is batting .308 (61x198) with 24 runs, 13 doubles, 6 home runs, 30 RBI, 11 walks and 11 hit-by-pitches in that span...his 16 hit-by-pitches this season are tied with Mark Canha-OAK and Jonathan India-CIN for most in the Majors.

SEVEN UP...Luis Torrens went 1-for-4 with a run batted in yesterday, extending his career-high hitting streak to 7 games (7/18-c)...is batting .304 (7x23) with 4 runs, 3 home runs and 4 RBI with a 1.056 OPS during the streak...since June 15, is batting .275 (25x91) with 16 runs, 1 double, 1 triple, 10 home runs, 19 RBI and 12 walks...he’s gotten on-base at a .359 clip, slugging .637 with a .997 OPS in that span.

LOAD ‘EM UP FOR SEAGER...Kyle Seager delivered a game-tying, 2-run single with the bases loaded to score **J.P. Crawford** and **Mitch Haniger** as part of a 4-run bottom of the 3rd in yesterday’s win...Seager is batting .349 (38x109) with 11 doubles, 5 grand slams and 120 RBI in 136 career plate appearances with the bases loaded...Kyle is rated as *FanGraphs*’ 2nd-most clutch player in the Majors this season with a 1.53 “Clutch” metric...he trails only his teammate J.P. Crawford (1.58).

RUNNERS IN SLUGGING POSITION...the Mariners went 3-for-6 with runners in scoring position yesterday...on the season, they are tied with Houston for the 2nd-highest slugging percentage (.471) in MLB with runners in scoring position, trailing only Toronto (.478)...Seattle is batting .264 (189x715) with RISP, 7th-best in MLB...the Mariners are 1 of 2 AL clubs (other: Chicago) with 4 players batting .300 or better with RISP (min. 50 PA each): **J.P. Crawford** is batting .356 (21x59) with RISP, **Ty France** is batting .346 (28x81), **Mitch Haniger** is batting .343 (23x67) and **Kyle Seager** is batting .309 (25x81).

AS YOU KNOW...JT Chargois came into yesterday’s game with 2 baserunners and did not allow either of them to score...he’s stranded 5 baserunners over his last 3 outings...**BUT, DID YOU KNOW?**...that since June 6, the Mariners bullpen has the best inherited runner strand percentage in the Majors?...Seattle relievers have allowed just 7 of 41 (17.1%) inherited baserunners to score in that span which ranks ahead of Toronto (18.1%) and Kansas City (20.4%) for best in the Majors.

ABOUT MCCAUGHAN...

- 25-year-old right-hander is making his 2nd career Major League appearance, his first Major League start and his first career start against the Astros.
- Selected by the Mariners in the 12th round of the 2017 MLB First-Year Player Draft.
- Played 3 seasons (2015-2017) at Long Beach State University and was a member of Team USA's 2016 Collegiate National Team.
- Made his Major League debut on July 21, 2021 vs. Colorado, tossing 5.0 hitless innings and allowing only 1 run with 3 walks and 1 strikeout.
- Graduated from Los Alamitos High School (CA) in 2014.
- Pronounced: mih-CACK-en

LAST OUTING/MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUT...made his Major League debut on July 21 at Colorado, tossing 5.0 innings of relief without allowing a hit...surrendered only 1 run on 3 walks with no strikeouts.

HISTORIC DEBUT...became the 7th player all-time to throw at least 5.0 innings without allowing a hit in his Major League debut, joining Max Kranick-PIT (6/27/2021), Daniel Ponce de Leon-STL (7/23/2018), Ross Stripling-LAD (4/8/2016), Bill Dillman-BAL (1967), Hank Borowy-NYY (4/18/1942) and Red Ames (9/14/1903)...McCaughan was the first to ever do it without recording a strikeout.

COMING IN HOT...in 3 starts with Tacoma prior to being selected to the Major League roster (July 2-19), went 1-1 with a 1.42 ERA (3 ER, 19.0 IP) with 1 walk and 15 strikeouts.

TACOMA TIME...made 10 starts with Triple-A Tacoma earlier this season prior to joining the Mariners...overall, went 5-3 with a 3.97 ERA (26 ER, 59.0 IP), while allowing 13 walks and 46 strikeouts.

HIATUS...did not play in 2020 due to the cancellation of the minor league season.

ARKANSAS DREAMIN'...made his 2021 debut with Double-A Arkansas on May 5, tossing 5.2 innings and allowing 2 runs on 6 hits with no walks and 6 strikeouts...was promoted to Triple-A Tacoma prior to his next start on May 14.

WELCOME TO SEATTLE...selected from Triple-A Tacoma on July 21 and made his Major League debut later that day at Colorado.

PITCHER OF THE YEAR...split the 2019 season between Double-A Arkansas (17 G) and Triple-A Tacoma (9 G)...was named Texas League Pitcher of the Year after going 7-5 with a 2.89 ERA (33 ER, 102.2 IP) with 10 walks and 89 strikeouts in 17 starts with Double-A Arkansas before his promotion to Triple-A Tacoma.

CAREER...selected by Seattle in the 12th round of the 2017 MLB First-Year Player Draft...has appeared in parts of 3 minor league seasons in the Mariners organization (2017-18, 20), going 14-23 with a 3.72 ERA (126 ER, 305.0 IP) with 61 walks and 272 strikeouts in 62 career minor league games (53 starts)...made his Major League debut on July 21 at Colorado, tossing 5.0 innings of relief, while allowing only 1 run without surrendering a hit.

TOMORROW'S PROBABLE STARTING PITCHER: RHP CHRIS FLEXEN (9-4, 3.35)

27-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his 19th start of the season tomorrow vs. the Astros...last outing: 5.1 IP while allowing 2 runs on 6 its, 2 walks and 1 strikeout on July 22 vs. Oakland...W#9 on 7/16 at LAA, his 3rd consecutive victory...pitched 7.0 innings, allowing 1 earned run on 6 hits with 1 walk, 2 strikeouts and 1 home run...Seattle owns a 13-5 record in Flexen's 17 starts...is 6-2 with a 1.89 ERA (14 ER, 66.2 IP) in 11 starts at T-Mobile Park this season, walking 12 and striking out 44 in those outings...on 7/4 vs. TEX, pitched 6.0 innings and allowed 1 earned run on 4 hits, walking none and striking out 5 Rangers on 81 pitches (57 strikes) in the Mariners 4-1 victory...ND on 6/29 at TOR (BUF): went 5.0 innings, allowing 3 earned runs on 7 hits with 3 walks and 2 strikeouts on 89 pitches (54 strikes)...W#6 on June 15 vs. MIN (8.0,4,0,0,0,8)...on 5/27 vs TEX (7.0 IP, 3 H,1 BB, 6 SO) matching his career-high of 7.0 innings pitched for the 2nd time this season and earning W#5...W#4 on 5/14 vs. CLE...W#3 on 5/7 at TEX...W#2 on 4/24 at BOS...tossed 5.0 scoreless innings on 4/3 vs. SF with 2 walks and 6 strikeouts to pick up his first win as a Mariner...**WELCOME TO SEATTLE:** Signed a 2-year Major League contract with Seattle, that also includes an option for 2023 on December 18, 2020...**KBO TOTALS:** Spent the 2020 season with the Doosan Bears in the Korean Baseball Organization and went 8-4 with a 3.01 ERA (39 ER, 116.2 IP) with 30 walks and 132 strikeouts over 21 starts...during the Bears' playoff run, in which they fell to the NC Dinos 4-2 in the Korean Series, he posted a 1.91 ERA (6 ER, 28.1 IP), pitching in both starting and relieving roles...**CAREER:** Flexen has appeared in 3 Major League seasons with New York-NL (2017-19)...was originally selected by the Mets in the 14th round of the 2012 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Newark Memorial (CA) High School...made his Major League debut with New York-NL on July 27, 2017 at San Diego...**vs. HOU:** Is 0-2 with a 7.20 ERA (8 ER, 10.0 IP) with 2 walks and 4 strikeouts in 2 career starts against the Astros...has made 1 start against Houston this season, tossing 6.0 innings and allowing 1 run on now walks and 3 strikeouts at T-Mobile Park on April 17.
