THE TWINS: After completing their six-game roadtrip with a record of 3-3 (1-2 at Cleveland and 2-1 at Detroit), the Twins began their three-game homestand with a split of the first two games against the Royals...today, the Twins will complete the short homestand with the three-game series finale against Kansas City...after today's game, Minnesota will travel to New York for a short roadtrip with three games at Yankee Stadium from Monday-Wednesday. **☞** The Twins enter today 4-9 in rubber games...Twins won their last rubber game on Wednesday in Detroit, snapping their streak of eight-straight losses in rubber matches.

WE WILL, WE WILL, ROKU!: Today's game will be streamed live and free on The Roku Channel, as part of Major League Baseball's Sunday Leadoff deal with Roku...Minnesota's last Roku game was on September 15, 2024 as they beat the Reds 9-2 at Target Field.

OPPORTUNITIES ROYALLY SPOILED: The Twins lost to the Royals last night at Target Field by a score of 2-0, snapping their three-game winning streak...it marked their eighth time being shut out this season, fourth time at home...Bailey Ober (4-7) was the starter and loser, allowing one run on four hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with one walk and four strikeouts...the offense recorded eight hits (all singles), three coming from Ryan Jeffers...Austin Martin also added two hits...Minnesota went 0-for-10 with runners in scoring position and left 10 men on base.

LAKES AND FOUNTAINS: The Twins are playing the 10th of 13 games against the Royals this season...Minnesota is 4-5 against the Royals, going 1-3 at Kauffman and 3-2 at Target Field. **☞** These two will face each other for the final time from September 5-7 for three games at Kauffman Stadium. **☞** Twins are 21-5 in their last 26 home games against the Royals. **☞** Twins are 32-20 in their last 52 overall against the Royals, dating back to April of 2022. **☞** Rocco Baldelli has a career managerial record of 60-42 vs. Kansas City...60 wins are his most against any opponent. **☞** This season, Ryan Jeffers is 10-for-23 (.435) with two doubles and three walks against KC.

TURNING PAGES: Twins have won four of their last six, outscoring their opponents 32-23 over those six. **☞** Over their last six games, the Twins are hitting .271 (56-for-207) with 10 home runs, 32 runs scored (5.3 runs-per-game), a .343 on-base percentage, a .473 slugging percentage and an .817 OPS. **☞** Over those six games, the Twins defense has turned eight double plays. **☞** They have struck out just 18 times in their last four games (159 plate appearances).

YES JEFF: Ryan Jeffers extended his season-high hitting streak to 11 games last night...his career-high is 14, done July 15-August 9, 2023...he is the second Twin with a double-digit hitting streak this season...the high for a Twin in 2025 was Brooks Lee's 19 (May 28-June 20). **☞** It's the second-longest active streak in baseball, trailing Dominic Smith's 13. **☞** He now has multiple hits in four-straight games, marking a career-high (2, 2, 3, 3). **☞** Over his last 23 games, Jeffers is hitting .393 (33-for-84) with seven doubles, two home runs, 10 RBI, four walks, a .433 on-base percentage, a .548 slugging percentage and a .981 OPS.

LUUUUUUUUUUUUUUUUUKE!!!: Since returning from the Injured List, Luke Keaschall has gone 7-for-17...he has now hit safely in each of his first 10 games with an at-bat to start his career...also has reached base safely in all 11...below are Twins (since 1961) best on-base streaks to begin their career (above) and best hitting streaks to begin their career (below):

SERIES DISCUSSIONS: With a win today, the Twins will earn their 16th series victory this season and their second in a row...they haven't won consecutive series since taking three-straight from Tampa Bay, Chicago-NL and Pittsburgh, from July 4-13...Minnesota is 15-20-2 in series play, going 9-7-2 at home and 6-13-0 on the road. **☞** Minnesota is seeking its second consecutive series win over Kansas City after taking two of three from them here, May 23-25.

TWINS MiLB WEEKLYS: Twins have named Double-A Wichita infielder Kaelen Culpepper and Low-A Fort Myers left-handed pitcher Dasan Hill as the club's minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week. **☞** Culpepper, 22, played in six games for the Wind Surge, hitting .367 (11-for-30) with one triple, two home runs, seven RBI and a 1.00 OPS...the organization's fifth overall prospect was selected by the Twins in the first round (21st overall) out of Kansas State University. **☞** Hill, 19, made the start for the Mighty Mussels last Saturday, pitching 4.0 shutout innings, with one hit allowed, no walks and three strikeouts...the club's eighth overall prospect (3rd ranked pitcher) was selected by the Twins in the second round (69th overall) in the 2024 First-Year Player Draft out of Grapevine High School in Grapevine, TX.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1971, Harmon Killebrew hit his 500th and 501st career home runs against Baltimore at Met Stadium...also, in 2007, Twins third base coach Tommy Watkins made his MLB debut for the Twins in Anaheim, grounding out in his lone at-bat...in 2024, former general manager Terry Ryan and former coach Rick Stelmazek were inducted into the Twins Hall of Fame.
