THE TWINS: After completing their six-game roadtrip with a record of 3-3 (1-2 at Cleveland and 2-1 at Detroit), the Twins began their three-game homestand with a split of the first two games against the Royals...today, the Twins will complete the short homestand with the three-game series finale against Kansas City...after today's game, Minnesota will travel to New York for a short roadtrip with three games at Yankee Stadium from Monday-Wednesday. 

◆ The Twins enter today 4-9 in rubber games...Twins won their last rubber game on Wednesday in Detroit, snapping their streak of eight-straight losses in rubber matches.

**WE WILL, WE WILL, ROKU!:** Today's game will be streamed live and free on The Roku Channel, as part of Major League Baseball's Sunday Leadoff deal with Roku...Minnesota's last Roku game was on September 15, 2024 as they beat the Reds 9-2 at Target Field.

**OPPORTUNITIES ROYALLY SPOILED:** The Twins lost to the Royals last night at Target Field by a score of 2-0, snapping their three-game winning streak...it marked their eighth time being shut out this season, fourth time at home...Bailey Ober (4-7) was the starter and loser, allowing one run on four hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with one walk and four strikeouts...the offense recorded eight hits (all singles), three coming from Ryan Jeffers...Austin Martin also added two hits...Minnesota went 0-for-10 with runners in scoring position and left 10 men on base.

LAKES AND FOUNTAINS: The Twins are playing the 10th of 13 games against the Royals this season...Minnesota is 4-5 against the Royals, going 1-3 at Kauffman and 3-2 at Target Field. 
♣ These two will face each other for the final time from September 5-7 for three games at Kauffman Stadium.
♣ Twins are 21-5 in their last 26 home games against the Royals.
♣ Twins are 32-20 in their last 52 overall against the Royals, dating back to April of 2022.
♣ Rocco Baldelli has a career managerial record of 60-42 vs. Kansas City...60 wins are his most against any opponent.
♣ This season, Ryan Jeffers is 10-for-23 (.435) with two doubles and three walks against KC.

TURNING PAGES: Twins have won four of their last six, outscoring their opponents 32-23

over those six.

♣ Over their last six games, the Twins are hitting .271 (56-for-207) with 10 home runs, 32 runs scored (5.3 runs-per-game), a .343 on-base percentage, a .473 slugging percentage and an .817 OPS.

♣ Over these six games, the Twins defense has turned eight double plays.

₹ Over those six games, the Twins defense has turned eight double plays. They have struck out just 18 times in their last four games (159 plate appearances).

YES JEFF: Ryan Jeffers extended his season-high hitting streak to 11 games last night...his career-high is 14, done July 15-August 9, 2023...he is the second Twin with a double-digit hitting streak this season...the high for a Twin in 2025 was Brooks Lee's 19 (May 28-June 20). 
₱ It's the second-longest active streak in baseball, trailing Dominic Smith's 13. 
₱ He now has multiple hits in four-straight games, marking a career-high (2, 2, 3, 3). 
₱ Over his last 23 games, Jeffers is hitting .393 (33-for-84) with seven doubles, two home runs, 10 RBI, four walks, a .433 on-base percentage, a .548 slugging percentage and a .981 OPS.

SERIES DISCUSSIONS: With a win today, the Twins will earn their 16th series victory this season and their second in a row...they haven't won consecutive series since taking three-straight from Tampa Bay, Chicago-NL and Pittsburgh, from July 4-13...Minnesota is 15-20-2 in series play, going 9-7-2 at home and 6-13-0 on the road.

◆ Minnesota is seeking its second consecutive series win over Kansas City after taking two of three from them here, May 23-25.

TWINS MiLB WEEKLYS: Twins have named Double-A Wichita infielder Kaelen Culpepper and Low-A Fort Myers left-handed pitcher Dasan Hill as the club's minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.

♣ Culpepper, 22, played in six games for the Wind Surge, hitting .367 (11-for-30) with one triple, two home runs, seven RBI and a 1.00 OPS...the organization's fifth overall prospect was selected by the Twins in the first round (21st overall) out of Kansas State University.

♣ Hill, 19, made the start for the Mighty Mussels last Saturday, pitching 4.0 shutout innings, with one hit allowed, no walks and three strikeouts...the club's eighth overall prospect (3rd ranked pitcher) was selected by the Twins in the second round (69th overall) in the 2024 First-Year Player Draft out of Grapevine High School in Grapevine, TX.

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In **1971**, Harmon Killebrew hit his 500th and 501st career home runs against Baltimore at Met Stadium... also, in **2007**, Twins third base coach Tommy Watkins made his MLB debut for the Twins in Anaheim, grounding out in his lone at-bat... in **2024**, former general manager Terry Ryan and former coach Rick Stelmaszek were inducted into the Twins Hall of Fame.

MEETING MINNESOTA: Last started on August 3 at Cleveland, opposite Joey Cantillo, in his Twins debut...did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 5-4 victory; allowed two runs on five hits (1 HR), with one walk and three strikeouts in 4.0 innings...was his most strikeouts recorded since April 28 when he fanned three against Washington...also his longest outing in the majors since May 6 against the Angels when he threw 4.1 innings...only two runs allowed came in the first inning on a home run from José Ramírez, scoring Daniel Schneemann...also marked Ureña's 1000th career major league hit allowed. major league hit allowed.

TWO STARTS AGO (TRIPLE-A): Started on July 26 with Triple-A St. Paul against Worcester and turned in his longest outing with the Saints since being stretched out as a starter...pitched around two walks and a hit by pitch before conceding his first hit with two outs in the third inning, an infield single off the bat of Kristian Campbell...threw up four zeroes before handing off a 2-0 lead to the bullpen...threw 26 sinkers (44%), 23 sliders (39%), seven four-seamers (12%) and three change-ups (5%) while generating five swings-and-misses, led by three on the slider...recorded two of his four strikeouts on the slider and one each on the changeup and sinker.

I'VE BEEN EVERYWHERE, MAN: After signing a one-year minor league contract with the New York Mets in February, Ureña is pitching for his fourth different organization already...after starting the year on the development list for Triple-A Syracuse, Ureña was activated to Syracuse's roster before making three appearances in the International League before a big league call-up...he would pitch in just one game for New York before being designated for assignment...because of his over eight years of MLB service time, he elected free agency rather than accept an assignment to Triple-A and has bounced around between the Blue Jays and Dodgers since, each time being DFA'd and electing free agency to sign with another club...over the past four seasons (2022-25), Ureña has been DFA'd or released a combined six times and pitched for nine different organizations (7 of them in the majors)...over his 17-year professional career, he's pitched for nine different MLB franchises the majors)...over his 17-year professional career, he's pitched for nine different MLB franchises and pitched for 33 different clubs between the major leagues, minor leagues and winter ball teams following his first appearance as a St. Paul Saint.

**THE ROYAL TREATMENT:** Ureña is facing the Kansas City Royals for the fifth time in his career...has two appearances (1 start) in 2021 with Detroit and two appearances in 2024 with Texas...has gone 1-0-1, posting a 4.97 ERA (12.2 IP, 7 ER) with three walks, two strikeouts and a .271 (13-for-48)

opnent batting average.

◆ Last faced Kansas City on June 23, 2024 with Texas at Globe Life Field...pitched innings 6.0-9.0, and earned the save in Texas' 4-0 shutout win...allowed just one hit with one walk and one

strikeout in 4.0 shutout innings of relief.

₱ Earned the win in his last start against Kansas City on May 21, 2021 at Kauffman Stadium; Tigers won 7-5...allowed five runs on 10 hits (1 HR), with no walks and one strikeout over 6.0 innings.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In his career, Ureña has gone 16-46 with a 4.62 ERA (498.2 IP, 256 ER), 6.08 K/9, 3.16 BB/9 and 1.25 HR/9 in 120 games (79 starts) at home compared to 28-31 with a 4.94 ERA (472.0 IP, 259 ER), 5.93 K/9, 3.53 BB/9 and 1.26 HR/9 in 122 road games (76 starts).

◆ He is 0-0 in five games at home so far this season with a 3.38 ERA (8.0 IP, 3ER), two walks and five strikeouts; compared to 0-0 with a 6.28 ERA (14.1, 10 ER), one save, four walks and eight

strikeouts in five games (3 starts) on the road.

**PLATOON SPLITS:** Through 10 major league games in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed .255/.321/.569 in 51 at-bats vs. Ureña, while righties have slashed .357/.372/.548 in 42 at-bats... lefties have posted an average exit velocity of 90.8 mph and a whiff rate of 18.3; compared to righties' 86.5 mph and 17.9 percent.

THE ARSENAL: Ureña has used a four-pitch mix this season, per Baseball Savant...he primarily uses his sinker and changeup against left-handed batters while favoring his slider and 4-seamer against
