Close Ones

Atlanta has played 14 consecutive games to be decided by no more than three runs, including seven straight in which the final score was within two runs.

Its wins on both Saturday and Sunday versus Colorado were by just a single run, and Atlanta has now won five consecutive one-run contests and six of their last seven since August 9.

On the season, Atlanta's 24 total one-run victories are tied with the White Sox for the second most in baseball, only behind the Dodgers (27). The Braves' .558 (24-19) winning percentage in one-run games ranks seventh.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Atlanta Braves and San Francisco Giants tonight play the make-up game of their originally-scheduled matchup on June 18 that was postponed by inclement weather...Tonight marks the second make-up game for the Braves in the last 12 days, after also visiting the Chicago White Sox for a lone game on August 20.

 Atlanta is just 1-4 versus San Francisco this season, including losses in both games here at Truist Park, June 16-17...The Braves went 1-2 at Oracle Park, June 26-28.

 The Braves went 1-5 against the Giants last season, making them just 2-9 in 11 total games versus San Francisco over the last two years...The Giants' .818 winning percentage since the start of last season is the highest versus the Braves in baseball.

 Before going 1-5 last year, Atlanta had won or tied the season series with San Francisco in seven consecutive seasons.

 RH Anthony Molina was traded by the Braves to San Francisco on August 2 earlier this month, and tonight pitches against his former club in his first start of the season...The 6-foot-1, 170-pound Venezuela native made his Giants debut last Tuesday with 4.1 scoreless innings of relief, and is 1-0 with a 2.89 ERA (3 ER/9.1 IP) in four total appearances between Atlanta & San Francisco this season...Tonight marks just the third start of his major league career, and his 57th total appearance.

HOME WORK: Atlanta's win yesterday moved the Braves to 48-23 (.676) here at Truist Park this season, the best home winning percentage in baseball...Atlanta's 48 total wins at home are also the most in the majors.

 The Braves are 21-5 (.808) here at home since the All-Star break, and have lost just one series at Truist Park in that span...**Atlanta's post-All-Star-break stretch matches the best 26-game span in Truist Park history...**The Braves also went 21-5 over a 26-game stretch in 2019, 2022 and 2023.

 Atlanta is on pace for 55 wins at home this season, and is looking for the fourth 50-win home campaign in Truist Park history...In modern-era franchise history, which dates to 1900, the single-season franchise record for home wins is 56, done five times (last in 2013)...**The Braves need to go 8-2 in the remainder of their home schedule to match that mark.**

 The Braves tonight are playing to complete a perfect 7-0 homestand...Atlanta has one such homestand already this season, going 7-0 versus Washington (4-0) and Miami (3-0) from July 30 to August 6.

 Drake Baldwin has hit .298/.371/.490 here at home this season, the eighth-best home batting average in the National League...Thirteen of his 22 homers (59%) and 43 of his 67 RBI (64%) on the season have come here at home.

HIGH-WATER MARK: Atlanta's win yesterday afternoon also pushed the club to a season-best 27 games over .500 at 82-55 (.599)...The Braves currently have the third-best record in all of baseball, tied with the Los Angeles Dodgers.

 Atlanta has also won seven straight games, the longest active winning streak in baseball...The Braves have had just one longer winning streak this season, taking eight straight victories from July 29 through August 6.

STARTING PITCHING: RH Tyler Mahle, whom Atlanta acquired from San Francisco in exchange for RH Anthony Molina, fanned nine over 6.2 one-run innings yesterday afternoon in a no-decision vs. Colorado...**Since the All-Star break, Atlanta's 2.95 ERA (75 ER/228.2 IP) from its rotation is best in the National League.**

 Only the Yankees (2.71) have been better from the rotation in that span.

 In 42 total games since the break, Atlanta's rotation has 12 scoreless starts and has allowed no more than one earned run in 22 of its turns (52%)...Braves starters have allowed more than three total runs just six times in that span.

 **The Braves' 12 scoreless starts since the All-Star break are tied with the Rays for the most in baseball.**

 RH Bryce Elder starts for Atlanta tonight, and is responsible for four of those 22 starts since the break of allowing no more than one earned run...He has done so in four of his seven total turns in that span, while the Braves are 5-2 in his starts since the break.

 Elder has made three prior starts against San Francisco in his career, including earlier this season at Oracle Park, and is 1-1 with a 4.76 ERA (9 ER/17.0 IP) all time against the club...The 6-foot-2, 220-pound Texas native allowed five hits and five runs over just 4.0 innings in that turn earlier this season, June 27 in San Francisco.

CATCHERS: Atlanta's catching tandem of Sean Murphy and Drake Baldwin went 3-for-8 with a homer yesterday afternoon, and has combined to bat .436/.476/.769 with seven extra-base hits, six runs and seven RBI on the Braves' current homestand.

 Since Murphy returned from the injured list on August 3, Baldwin has played 12 games as Atlanta's designated hitter and batted .431/.442/.588 in these contests...He has hits in 11 of the 12 games, and multi-hit efforts in nine of them.

 Murphy has started behind the plate in five of Atlanta's last seven games, and has hit .412/.474/.882 with two doubles, two homers and four RBI...The Braves are a perfect 5-0 in these games...Since joining Atlanta in 2023, the Braves have played to a 144-109 (.569) record in games in which Murphy starts at catcher.

Makes his 26th start of the season and the 104th of his career, in the opener of a home series against San Francisco...Atlanta is 15-10 in his 25 turns.
- 🔥

Will make his fourth career start against the Giants and enters play 1-1 with a 4.76 ERA (9 ER/17.0 IP) all-time against the club...Took the loss in his lone meeting with them this season, allowing five runs on five hits over 4.0 innings June 27 at Oracle Park, with Rafael Devers homering twice off him.

Owens a 3.95 ERA this season, compared to a 6.52 mark in 2024 and 5.30 in 2025...It is his lowest single-season ERA since he pitched to a 3.81 mark as a 2023 National League All-Star.

Has recorded 15 quality starts in 25 outings this season...Twelve of them have come at Truist Park, where he is 6-3 with a 3.49 ERA (38 ER/98.0 IP) in 16 turns.
- 🔥

Has allowed three earned runs or fewer in 20 of his 25 starts this season, including seven of his last eight.
- 🔥

Has completed at least 6.0 innings in 16 starts and pitched to a 2.99 ERA (34 ER/102.1 IP) in those outings, compared to a 6.31 mark (29 ER/41.1 IP) across his nine shorter turns.
- 🔥

Has held left-handed batters to a .211 average (72-for-341) this season, the eighth-lowest mark among 38 qualified right-handers in the majors...Right-handed hitters have batted .287 (60-for-209) against him.
- 🔥

Has incorporated a cutter into his arsenal this year after not throwing the pitch across his first four major league seasons from 2022-25...Has thrown 330 of them in 2026, 270 to left-handed batters, and opponents are hitting .256 (21-for-82) against it.
- 🔥

Opponents have hit .179 (12-for-67) against his changeup with 16 strikeouts, his lowest mark against any pitch...None of the 22 home runs he has surrendered this season have come on it.
- 🔥

Over his last 32 starts, dating to August 24, 2025, Elder is 11-9 with a 3.68 ERA (77 ER/188.1 IP) and a 1.18 WHIP...His 21 quality starts over the span are tied for the fourth-most in the majors.

Received a no-decision August 25 against Los Angeles (NL), allowing three runs on eight hits over 6.0 innings without issuing a walk in a 4-3 Atlanta win at Truist Park...It was his seventh career start against the Dodgers, two more than he has made against any other non-divisional opponent.
- 🔥

Suffered a loss August 10 against New York (NL), allowing seven runs on 10 hits over 5.0 innings in a 5-8 defeat at Truist Park...Brett Baty's first-inning grand slam capped a five-run frame.
- 🔥

Earned the win August 5 against Miami, allowing one run on one hit over 7.0 innings with three strikeouts in a 4-1 victory at Truist Park, making his 100th career start... Did not allow a hit through the first 4.1 innings, the longest no-hit bid of his career.

Reached 100 strikeouts on the season July 31 against Washington, earning the win after allowing one run on four hits over 6.0 innings in a 6-2 victory at Truist Park.
- 🔥

Is one of just five pitchers in Atlanta history to make at least six starts in March/April and compile an ERA under 2.00, joining Tom Glavine (1997, 2000, 2002), Greg Maddux (1994), Tim Hudson (2007) and Julio Teheran (2014)...Finished March/April with a 1.88 ERA (9 ER/43.0 IP) over seven starts.

Joined Hall-of-Famer John Smoltz and Michael Soroka as the only starters in Atlanta-franchise history to make the All-Star team in their second year playing.
- 🔥

Atlanta won 21 games started by Elder in his first full season with the Braves, the second most team victories on the season...Trailed only teammate Spencer Strider's 26 team wins that year.
- 🔥

Made six starts in his career of at least 6.0 innings without allowing a run, the most such games in Braves franchise history (since 1900) in a player's first 25 starts...Irv Young (1905), Clif Curtis (1909-'10) and Ian Anderson (*20-21) each had five such starts.
- 🔥

Was originally drafted by Atlanta in the fifth round of the 2020 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Texas...Was the fifth member of the 2020 draft class to debut, and the lowest-selected pick to do so.
- 🔥

Of the first five members to play in the majors from the 2020 draft class, three were selected with the first 11 picks in the draft - Detroit's Spencer Torkelson (No. 1 overall), the Angels' Reid Detmers (No. 10) and the White Sox's Garrett Crochet (No. 11).

The other two were both selected by Atlanta, and chosen with the 126th (Spencer Strider) and 156th (Elder) overall selections.
