FLIGHT PATTERN: The St. Louis Cardinals continue a seven-game road trip through New York (Apr. 17-20) and Atlanta (Apr. 21-23) into the Easter holiday weekend. The Cardinals play the second game of a four-game series with the National League East Division leaders, the New York Mets. The Cardinals lost to the Mets last night 4-1 as **Brendan Donovan** knocked in **Victor Scott II** for the lone Cardinals run. The Mets will visit Busch Stadium in two weeks (May 2-4) for three games to conclude the season series. New York has won the last five straight between the two clubs dating back to April 28, 2024.

DONNY, YOU'RE OUT OF YOUR ELEMENT: **Brendan Donovan** hit a two-out RBI single in the 3rd inning yesterday establishing a new career-high 13-game hitting streak. The streak:

- Is currently the longest active in Major League Baseball.
- Is the 3rd-longest this season in MLB behind **Jacob Wilson** (15) and **Jackson Chourio** (14).
- Ran his streak against the Mets to 11 games, the longest against them among active MLB players.
- Is now eight straight games at Citi Field.

VIC VISITS SECAUCUS: Earlier today, outfielder **Victor Scott II** made a visit to MLB Network studios in Secaucus, N.J., to be on MLB Central. Yesterday, he recorded a song "Dreams are Running" near the MLB Player Engagement offices under his performing name, "Argo."

A NEW YORK STATE OF MIND: Despite a 26-29 all-time record at Citi Field, St. Louis enters today winners of 12 of its last 19 games in Queens while outscoring the Mets 98-85 over that period.

FOUR SCORE...AND NO MORE: Over the last nine games, Cardinals pitching has held their opposition to four runs or less, the longest active and overall streak in MLB this season. It's the longest streak in MLB since the Padres ran off 11 straight from Sept. 13-25, 2024 and the longest by a Cardinals club since 2017 (Sept. 2-12).

WINN STARTS REHAB ASSIGNMENT: Injured shortstop **Masyn Winn** will begin an injury rehabilitation assignment at Memphis (AAA) tonight as they host the Jacksonville (Marlins) Jumbo Shrimp. Winn was placed on the 10-day Injured List with lower back spasms on April 12. St. Louis is 3-3 in his absence and he would be eligible to return to the active roster on Tuesday in Atlanta.

FINDING OTHER WAYS TO "WINN": **Masyn Winn** was batting .370 over his last eight games before landing on the Injured List. Since then, Cardinals playing shortstop (**Brendan Donovan** & **Thomas Saggese**) have batted .455 (10-22) with four doubles and three RBI.

FOREVER YOUNG: With a victory on Wednesday, 38-year old **Oliver Marmol**, the youngest manager in MLB, earned his 256th career managerial win, passing **Roger Bresnahan** (1909-12) for 14th all-time in franchise history. **Eddie Stanky** (1952-55) ranks next on the Cardinals managerial list in 13th place with 260 wins.

START ME UP: **Lars Nootbaar** drew a lead-off walk to begin Wednesday's game marking the 6th time this season he has "broken up a perfect game" as the first batter. Nootbaar's six games with lead-off walks in March-April are the most in Major League Baseball this season and rank T-7th all-time. With three more in the Cardinals final 12 games in April, Nootbaar will set the MLB record for the early combined months, surpassing **Davey Lopes** (1975).

THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (April 18, 1987): Forever known as "Seat Cushion Night" in the annals of St. Louis Cardinals history, **Tom Herr** hit a walk-off grand slam off **Jesse Orosco** in the 10th inning to give the Cardinals a 12-8 victory against the defending World Series Champion New York Mets. The Cardinals trailed 5-0, 7-6 and 8-7 in the game, rallying three times to win. As the Cardinals won, the 41,942 faithful at Busch Memorial Stadium flooded the field with seat cushions that were given away as a promotion. It was the only grand slam of Herr's 13-year career and one of three hit by the Cardinals that season.

NEW YORK CONNECTIONS

Steven Matz was originally selected by the Mets in the 2nd round of the 2009 MLB Draft out of Ward Melville High School in East Setauket, NY and pitched parts of his first six seasons (2015-20) in New York...was born in Stony Brook, NY.

Brendan Donovan (April 25, 2022 at Busch III), and **Masyn Winn** (Aug. 18, 2023 at Busch III) made MLB debuts against the Mets.

Ryne Stanek was born in St. Louis

Phil Maton was traded to the Mets last season (July 9, 2024) and pitched in 31 games.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **José Oquendo** played the first two seasons MLB career with the Mets...traded by New York with **Mark Davis** to St. Louis for **John Young** and **Angel Salazar** (April 2, 1985).

Mets Pitching Coach **Jeremy Hefner** pitched his final professional season (2016) in the Cardinals minor league organization.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Matt Morris** was born in Middletown, NY...graduated from Valley Central High School in Montgomery, NY...played college baseball at Seton Hall University.

Mets Clubhouse Operations Coordinator **Scott Keltner** previously worked in the Cardinals organization in the Busch Stadium (2016-21) and AutoZone Park (2014-15) visiting clubhouses.

Cardinals Hall of Famer & Mets broadcaster **Keith Hernandez** was selected by the Cardinals in the 42nd round of the 1971 MLB Draft...played 10 seasons in St. Louis (1974-83)...won the 1979 NL MVP Award...named to two National League All-Star teams and won six Gold Gloves.

FanDuel broadcaster **Mark Sweeney** was traded to the Mets with **Jeromy Burnitz**, **Lou Collier**, **Jeff D'Amico**, and cash (January 21, 2002)...attended Spring Training with New York before released (March 13, 2002).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jason Isringhausen** was selected by the Mets in the 44th round of the 1991 MLB Draft...pitched parts of four seasons in New York (1995-97, 1999, 2011).

Hall of Fame Manager **Joe Torre** played for and managed both the Cardinals (1969-74 & 1990-95) and Mets (1975-77 & 1977-81).

TONIGHT'S GAME:

- Makes his 4th start of the season (186th career) in the second game of this weekend's four-game series vs. the Mets.
- Today’s start will be the 176th in his Cardinals career. He's one of just three MLB pitchers to have made as many as 175 starts exclusively with one team since he joined the Cardinals in 2018; also **Aaron Nola**, PHI – 272 & **Kyle Freeland**, COL - 204.
- Has dropped his last two decisions (4/6 [2] at BOS & 4/12 vs. PHI) and is **trying to avoid his first 0-3 start to a season**.
- Has not yet allowed a HR in 2025 over his 13.0 IP.**
- At age 36 (turns 37 on August 28), Miles is the oldest player on the team’s active roster.
- Has entered his 8th season (was injured for all of 2020) with the Cardinals in 2025; Leads active pitchers in innings pitched (1,017.2), wins (60) and games started (175) as a Cardinal and is 2nd to Michael Wacha (759) in strikeouts with 743.
- Has registered 32-or-more starts in every season in which he was not injured or sidelined by COVID-19 protocols. One of three pitchers with at least three 200+ IP seasons since 2018 (**Gerrit Cole** - 4, **Aaron Nola** - 3).
- His 171.2 IP last season were his fewest as a Cardinal; has had three seasons (2018, 2022, 2023) of 200+ IP as a Cardinal.
- The Cardinals are 95-80 in his 175 career starts with St. Louis and 46-40 in his 86 home starts.
- Since joining St. Louis in 2018, Mikolas leads MLB in first strike percentage (68.0) and lowest walk percentage (0.43).

LAST TIME OUT: Fanned a season-high 6 batters in Sat. (4/12) start vs. PHI over his 5.0 IP. Allowed two 1st inning runs and then retired 12-straight before allowing a walk in the 5th inning. Was tagged with the 4-1 loss as the Cardinals grounded into a record 5 double plays.

2025/CAREER NOTES:

- Started Game 2 of 4/6 doubleheader at BOS on ESPN Sunday Night Baseball; Lasted just 2.2 IP in the 18-7 loss, his shortest start since going 2.0 IP on 9/8/24 in 10-4 loss to Seattle.
- Miles was the Cardinals’ Opening Day starter in 2019, 2023 & 2024.
- Posted his fifth season with 32-or-more starts in 2024 and is one of three MLB pitchers with 32+ starts in at least five seasons since 2018 (**Jose Berrios** & **Aaron Nola** - 6).
- Led MLB with 15 starts without a walk in 2024, his single-season career-high, the third-most by a Cardinals pitcher all-time, trailing only **Bob Tewksbury’s** 19 in 1992 and 16 in 1993, and the most by a National League pitcher since **Bartolo Colón** had 15 in 2015 for the New York Mets.
- His nine road starts without issuing a walk in 2024 tied **Bob Tewksbury** (1992) for the most such starts in a single season by a Cardinals pitcher.
- Tallied eight of his 10 wins in road starts last season, tying for the second-most road wins in the NL (1st: **Michael King**, 9).
- Led MLB with a 1.31 walks per 9 IP rate in 2024 that was the lowest in a single season by a Cardinals pitcher since his 1.30 rate in 2018, while his 1.57 rate since joining St. Louis in 2018 is the lowest in MLB.
- Two-time National League All-Star (2018 and 2022).
- Finished 6th in the 2018 NL Cy Young Award voting and was a finalist for NL Comeback Player of the Year by MLBPA Player’s Choice Awards, in a voting by his peers.
- 2018 Darryl Kile Award recipient, voted on by his teammates.
- Pitched three seasons in the Japanese Central League (2015-17) and was a combined 31-13 with 2.25 ERA in 62 starts for the Yomiuri Giants.

MIKOLAS vs. METS:

- Making his 8th career start (9th app.) vs. the Mets with the previous seven starts coming with the Cardinals and one relief appearance in 2012 with the Padres.
- Was a 4-2 winner at Citi Field in his last start here (4/26/24), allowing 2 runs over 5.2 IP; It was his 1st win against the Mets since 4/20/19 and his 1st career win at Citi Field.
- Earned his 1st career win against the Mets on April 20, 2019 at Busch Stadium, allowing two runs over 8.0 innings. Faced the Mets again in 2022 at Busch Stadium and left after both he and Max Scherzer pitched 7.0 scoreless innings each for no decisions, as the Mets won late 5-2 with five runs in the 9th inning.
- Owns a 2-4 career mark with 5.31 ERA against NYM, including a 1-2, 4.82 record in 4 career games (3 starts) at Citi Field.
- Is 15-17 career vs. NL East clubs in 46 games/40 starts .
