<u>ON THE ROAD</u>: The Brewers are 29-18 on the road, going 11-3-1 in series play....had a season-high 6-game road winning streak from 5/22-6/8 and a season-high 5-game road losing streak from 5/3-5/7.....are currently on a 4-game road winning streak.

<u>ALL-STARS</u>: The Brewers were represented at the All-Star Game by **Corbin Burnes**, **Josh Hader**, **Freddy Peralta**, **Brandon Woodruff** and **Omar Narváez**.....the five players selected tied a franchise record, all consecutively (also 2018 and 2019)....it marked the first time in franchise history that the team had three or more pitchers selected.

MANAGER: Craig Counsell is in his seventh season as manager (490-451) and sixth full season.....he is second in franchise history in wins, trailing Phil Garner (563-617).... under Counsell, the Brewers have made the postseason in three consecutive years for the first time in franchise history.....Counsell was named the 19th manager in franchise history on 5/4/15, replacing Ron Roenicke.....he is signed through 2023.

<u>COACHES</u>: Assistant hitting coach <u>Jacob Cruz</u> (2nd season), hitting coach <u>Andy Haines</u> (3rd season), pitching coach <u>Chris Hook</u> (3rd season), bullpen coach <u>Steve Karsay</u> (3rd season), third base coach <u>Jason Lane</u> (6th season, 1st as 3B coach), associate pitching, catching and strategy coach <u>Walker McKinven</u> (2nd season) and bench coach <u>Pat Murphy</u> (6th season) all returned from the 2020 coaching staff.....new to the staff is first base coach <u>Quintin Berry</u>.

TODAY'S STARTER: #25 - LHP BRETT ANDERSON (13gs, 2-5, 4.33)

ANDERSON AT A GLANCE: Brett Anderson, 33, will be making his 14th start of the season and first against the Royals.....Anderson last started on 7/7 at New York-NL in the second game of a doubleheader and received no decision in the Brewers' 5-0 win (4ip, 3h, 0bb, 1k, 44 pitches).....the team is 7-6 in his starts.....he has 2 quality starts..... opponents are batting .280 (58-for-207, 7hr).....he was on the 10-day injured list from 4/24-5/8 with a strained right hamstring and from 6/22-7/5 with a right knee contusion.....Anderson, who signed with Milwaukee as a free agent on 12/13/19, re-signed as a free agent on 2/22/21.

LAST SEASON: Anderson went 4-4 with a 4.21 ERA in 10 starts during his first season with the Brewers.....the team went 5-5 in his starts.....he made 4 quality starts..... opponents batted .270 (50-for-185, 6hr).....he began 2020 on the 10-day injured list with a blister on his left index finger.

CAREER: Is 65-70 with a 4.07 ERA in 211 games / 199 starts (1096.1ip, 496er)....is in his 13th Major League season....has pitched for Oakland (2009-13, 2018-19), Colorado (2014), Los Angeles-NL (2015-16), Chicago-NL (2017), Toronto (2017) and Milwaukee (2020-21).....pitched in the postseason in 2012, 2013 and 2015.....Anderson was originally selected by Arizona in the second round of the 2006 First-Year Player Draft out of Stillwater (OK) High School.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 3-2 with a 3.51 ERA in 10 starts (51.1ip, 20er).....is 1-1 with a 2.86 ERA in 4 starts this season (22ip, 7er).
