Last At-Bat Lost

The Braves dropped their fourth game this year in the opponents' final at-bat, losing, 7-6, to Philadelphia last night after Didi Gregorius lifted a sacrifice fly in the ninth inning to score Alec Bohm.

The Braves are now 1-4 in such games this season.

The Braves won eight games in their last at-bat last season, tied for the second most in the National League and one off the lead of the San Diego Padres.

Since Brian Snitker took over as manager on May 17, 2016, the Braves have 85 such wins, the most in the majors.

The Braves led the National League in final at-bat wins in 2016 (19) and 2017 (20), tied for the league lead in 2018 (20) and finished fifth in 2019 (20).

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Marlins open a four-game set tonight with the first of 19 matchups between the clubs this season...The clubs will play again on June 11-13 in Miami for the next meetings between the teams.

- The Braves lost, 7-6, last night to snap a four-game winning streak...Atlanta allowed a season-high three home runs as Philadelphia avoided the sweep and stopped the Braves from moving above .500 for the first time this season.
- The Braves went 6-4 against the Marlins, winning the season series with their NL East rival for the sixth consecutive season...They went 9-10 against the Marlins in 2014.
- The Braves have won 10 of their last 11 series against the Marlins in Atlanta, including taking three-of-four the last time Miami was here, September 21-24, 2020...The Marlins won twoof-three, September 7-9, 2020, although the Braves scored 29 runs in their one win that series.
- RHP Huascar Ynoa is set to make his second career appearance against the Marlins tonight...The 6-foot-3, 235-pound native of Puerto Plata, DR, went 3.0 innings and allowed three runs, earned, on September 21 in a start here in Atlanta during a 5-4 win...Ynoa owns a 7.30 ERA (10 ER/12.1 IP) in five career games, two starts, here at Truist Park.
- RHP Sandy Alcantara is scheduled to face the Braves for the fourth time in his career...The 6-foot-5, 185-pound native of San Juan de la Maguana, DR, has no decisions and a 2.41 in his previous three starts against the Braves...All of his appearances came in 2019, although he did face the Braves in the postseason last year, allowing five runs, earned, over 6.0 innings in Game 1 of the NLDS last season.

RONALD VS. THE MARLINS: OF Ronald Acuña Jr. owns a 1.079 OPS and 17 home runs in 44 career games against the Marlins...He also hit a home run during the Braves three-game sweep of the Marlins in last season's NLDS.

- Acuña has hit five of his franchise-record 20 regular season leadoff home runs against the Marlins... Also led off Game 1 of the Division Series last season with a home run off tonight's starter Sandy Alcantara.
- He hit a leadoff homer in three straight games against the Marlins in August, 2018...He is only the second player with as long of a streak in baseball's modern era (since 1900)...Baltimore's Brady Anderson holds the major-league record, doing so in four consecutive games from 4/18-21/96.
- Acuña Jr.'s streak ended on August 15, after was hit with the first pitch by the Marlins' José Ureña... Acuña has been hit five times, including once in the postseason, by the Marlins...That is the most by any one team.

FREDDIE HOMERS: 1B Freddie Freeman homered for the third consecutive game last night, sending a 1-2 pitch out to center in the fifth inning...Freeman has homered in at least three straight games three times previously, and went deep in a career-most four straight games from May 16-19, 2019.

- Freeman is just 5-for-30 (.167) on the season but four of his five hits have left the park (.567 slugging).
- This season marks the first time Freeman has homered four times through Atlanta's first nine games...In 2019, when he hit a career-most 38 homers, Freeman did not collect his fourth homer until his 26th game.

SERIES WINS: The Braves have won each of the last two series after getting swept by Philadelphia during the season's opening weekend...The Braves took twoof-three from Washington, before winning two-of-three with the Phillies.

 \mathcal{A} The Braves went 11-6-3 in series play last season.

HOME RUNS: The Braves hit three more home runs last night, getting a two-run shot from 2B Ozzie Albies and solo drives from 1B Freddie Freeman and OF Ronald Acuña Ir.

- The Braves are tied for third in the majors with 14 total home runs, two off the lead of the Houston Astros and Cincinnati Reds.
- The Braves have allowed eight home runs this season, tied for the second fewest in the National League...Only San Francisco has surrendered fewer (five).

ACUÑA JR. HEATS UP: OF Ronald Acuña Jr. went 3-for-4 last night, and batted .692/.643/2.027 with three doubles and two homers in the three games against the Phillies.

- Acuna Jr. currently leads in the National League in batting average (.444), slugging percentage (.917), OPS (1.378), hits (16), extra-base hits (9) and total bases (33), while he ranks second in doubles (tied, five) and third in homers (tied, 4)...He has three straight multi-hit games, and has at least two hits in five of his last six contests.
- Acuna Jr. has nine extra-base hits through Atlanta's first nine games (five doubles, four homers)...Hallof-Famer Hank Aaron holds the franchise record for extra-base hits in a season, collecting 92 during the 1959 season (39 homers, 46 doubles, seven triples).

RELIEVERS: Despite taking the loss last night, the Braves bullpen owns a 2.08 ERA (7 ER/30.1 IP) this season, the third-best mark in baseball...Only San Diego (0.84) and New York (1.73) have been better.

Five Braves relievers have yet to allow a run this season, while Will Smith is the only member of the bullpen to give up multiple earned runs.
