

# San Francisco Giants (77-79) at Arizona Diamondbacks (87-69) RHP Hayden Birdsong (4-5, 4.74) vs. LHP Eduardo Rodriguez (3-3, 5.09)

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Giants and Diamondbacks play the first game of this three-game series...SF is 4-6 against ARI this season, having gone 3-4 at Oracle Park and 1-2 here at Chase Field...these teams last met at the beginning of the month in SF, with the Diamondbacks taking two of three games...this will be the first series at Chase Field since June 3-5.

- ▶ The Giants will look to keep playing the role of spoiler...last week, they took two of three from the Orioles at Camden Yards before sweeping three games from the Royals at Kauffman Stadium.
- San Francisco has allowed a total of just nine runs in their last six games.

**BRING OUT THE BROOM:** The Giants completed a three-game sweep of the Royals in Kansas City yesterday for their first road series sweep of the season... it was their first road series sweep since July of last year (at PIT) and their first road series sweep of an American League opponent since April 15-17, 2022 at CLE.

▶ Overall, it was just the third time in 12 attempts that the Giants have swept an opponent in a series this season...the only other two sweeps the Giants have completed this year have both come against the Rockies (a three-game set at Oracle in May and a four-game set at Oracle in July).

**BACK-TO-BACK SHUTOUTS:** The Giants earned their 11th shutout of the season yesterday at Kansas City, winning 2-0... they also blanked the Royals, 9-0, on Saturday night...it's the second time this year they've shut out an opponent in back-to-back games (also July 31-Aug. 2).

- ► The Giants have three shutouts on this road trip, winning 10-0 at Baltimore to begin this trip last Tuesday.
- ► SF hasn't had three consecutive team shutouts since May 19-21, 2015 at LA-NL.

**HEATING UP:** The Giants are 7-2 (.778) on the road this month despite playing three teams with winning records (Padres, Orioles and Royals)...only San Diego (5-1) has a better road record this month.

► SF is 5-1 to begin their final road trip of the year, a nine-game stretch at Baltimore (2-1), Kansas City (3-0) and Arizona.

**ROAD CHALLENGES:** The road has been a challenge for SF in 2024 as they enter today with a 36-42 (.462) road record... the .462 road winning percentage is 20th of 30 MLB clubs and is the fifth-lowest in the NL ahead of Colorado (.296), Miami (.360), Washington (.407) and Pittsburgh (.449).

► However, SF has won each of its last three road series which have all come against teams currently in playoff position (Padres, Orioles and Royals).

**KEEP IT GOING: IF Matt Chapman** is the first Giant to have a season with at least 25 home runs and 15 stolen bases since Hunter Pence in 2013...he's the first Giant third baseman ever to do so and the first NL third baseman to hit those marks in a single season since the Reds' Todd Frazier in 2014 (*Stats, LLC*).

**TRYING TO FINISH ABOVE .500:** The Giants will need to win five of their final six games (three at ARI, three vs. STL) to finish with a winning record (82-80) for the second time in the last eight season (107 wins in 2021)...SF finished last season at 79-83 (.488).

**STARTING STRONG:** Giants starting pitchers have limited opponents to three earned runs or fewer in each of their last 14 games, posting a 2.26 ERA (18er, 71.2ip) in that stretch.

- In fact, in the last week (since Sept. 15), Giants starters have given up a total of just six runs in 38.1 innings (1.41 ERA) while holding opponents to a .150 average against.
- ▶ SF starters have not allowed a run in their last 17.2 innings.

**HEY ROOK!: RHP Hayden Birdsong** is scheduled to start tonight and is one of four Giant rookie pitchers to start at least 10 games this season...according to *Stats, LLC*, that's the most rookie pitchers with at least 10+ starts in a single season for the Giants in the modern era (since 1901).

- ▶ Birdsong defeated the Orioles in his last start, allowing three runs in 5.2 innings.
- ► The rookie right-hander had been 0-5 with a 6.75 ERA (20er, 26.2ip) and 21 walks allowed in his previous seven starts before that win against the Orioles last Wednesday.
- ▶ Batters are just 6-for-52 (.115) with only one extra-base hit off Birdsong's curveball this year.

**WALK THE LINE:** Since taking over the closer's role on August 9, **RHP Ryan Walker** has converted all nine of his save opportunities while allowing just three runs (2er) in 17.2 innings...he's struck out 28 and walked just four in that time while opposing hitters have batted .145 (9-for-62).

➤ Since the All-Star break, Walker has allowed four earned runs in 27.2 innings for a 1.30 ERA in 26 games...his 1.30 ERA since the break is the sixth-best among NL relievers.

CONGRATS TO BRYCE!: Top Giants prospect, Bryce Eldridge was named the Giants' Minor League Player of the Year by Baseball America...Eldridge, who was drafted 16th overall by the Giants in 2023, is completing his first full minor league season and spent the 2024 campaign between four minor league affiliates - San Jose (A), Eugene (A+), Richmond (AA) and Sacramento (AAA)...Eldridge has combined to hit .289 with 27 doubles, two triples, 23 home runs, 91 RBI and 59 walks in 116 games between the four levels while posting a .513 SLG, .372 OBP and .885 OPS.

**SEPTEMBER 23, 2001** - The Giants defeated the Padres, 11-2, as **Barry Bonds** hit his 65th and 66th home runs of the season. The homers gave Bonds a Major League record 34 road homers. He also broke Babe Ruth's Major League mark for most home runs over two seasons by a left-handed batter (115).

TODAY'S START: The 23-year-old is scheduled to make his 15th big league start today...he's gone 4-5 with a 4.74 ERA (33er, 62.2ip) in his 14 starts, with the Giants going 5-9 in his outings... had his contract selected from Triple-A Sacramento on June 26.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his first win since July 27...threw 96 pitches across 5.2 innings of work in SF's 5-3 win vs. Baltimore on Wednesday...allowed three runs (all earned) on four hits, two walks and three strikeouts.

**VS. ARIZONA:** Is slated to face the Dbacks for the second time in his career...was charged with the loss in SF's 6-4 defeat vs. Arizona on September 4 at Oracle Park...worked 3.0 innings and allowed two runs on three hits with five walks and four strikeouts.

BACK ON TRACK: Birdsong is steering back on course after struggling last month...in his most recent two starts, Birdsong has allowed just three earned runs across 10.2ip (2.53 ERA) and held opponents to a .162 average and a .414 OPS...in his previous six starts (8/6-9/4), Birdsong posted an 8.31 ERA (20er, 21.2ip) and allowed batters a .253 average and a .926 OPS...the Giants lost each of the six games.

THROW THAT CURVE: He's thrown 231 curveballs this season at the MLB level and batters are 6-for-52 (.115) with 26 strikeouts off the pitch...the Dbacks have done well against the curveball this season...their .251 average against it ranks third-best in the Majors, while their .435 slugging percentage is second-best in the league.

VS. THE LEFTY: Lefties are batting just .198 (26x131) with a .305 slugging percentage off Birdsong this season, while righties are hitting .237 (23x97) with a .505 SLG...however, Birdsong issues far more walks to lefties (6.19 BB/9) vs. righties (4.44 BB/9).

NO PLACE LIKE HOME: Birdsong owns a 3.67 ERA (11er, 27.0ip) at home versus a 5.55 ERA (22er, 35.2ip) on the road...opponents own a .742 OPS against Birdsong on the road and a .697 OPS at

**GETTING AHEAD:** In his last two starts, Birdsong worked ahead with more first pitch strikes, logging a 60.0% first pitch strike rate...in the tough six start stretch that preceded, his first pitch strike % was 46.7%...after Birdsong falls behind 1-0, opposing batters have walked 26 times while posting an .837 OPS...when he's gotten ahead 0-1 they have a .606 OPS and have drawn just 12 walks.

**HEAVY LIFTING:** Birdsong has worked a combined 120.0 innings this year between Double-A Richmond (48.1ip), Triple-A Sacramento (9.0ip) and the Giants (62.2ip)...in fact he's already passed his innings total from last year (100.2 innings across three levels), which was his first full year in pro ball after being drafted in 2022.

THE FUTURE IS NOW: The Illinois native entered the 2024 campaign as the Giants #6 prospect according to Baseball America and #7 according to MLB.com...he has since graduated from the prospect rankings given his accrued MLB time this year but is still one of SF's younger pitching hopefuls having just turned 23 on Aug. 30.

**EARLY ARRIVAL:** Birdsong became the second Giant from the 2022 draft to reach the Majors, joining OF Wade Meckler (eighth round), who did so last year...there are just four players from the first round of that 2022 draft that have reached the Majors overall (IF Jackson Holliday with Baltimore, IF Zach Neto with the Angels, OF Jordan Beck with Colorado, IF Brooks Lee with Minnesota) ... at the time of his debut, there were just 12 players selected ahead of Birdsong (6th round, 30th pick) in that 2022 draft that had made their debuts.

LIKE, REALLY EARLY: According to Grant Brisbee of The Athletic Birdsong's 169.2 minor league innings were the fewest thrown by a Giant before their Major League debut since RHP Tim Lincecum debuted in 2007 with only 62.2 minor league innings under his belt.

2024 IN THE MINORS: He began this year at Double-A Richmond and posted a 4-2 record with a 2.05 ERA (11er, 48.1ip) with 61 strikeouts in 11 starts for Double-A Richmond before being promoted to Triple-A Sacramento on June 11...made two starts for Sacramento after the promotion and posted a 5.00 ERA (5er, 9.0) with 14 strikeouts before his eventual MLB debut on June 26.
