NATIONALS NEWS

THE START OF SUMMER

The Washington Nationals square off against the Cleveland Guardians tonight in the first of three games at Progressive Field...The Nationals defeated the Atlanta Braves yesterday to take their first series at Truist Park since May 27-30, 2024.

- **Foster Griffin** worked 6.0 scoreless innings to earn his sixth win of the year and **Orlando Ribalta** stranded the bases loaded with one out to earn the save in Washington's 2-1 win.
- The Nationals are in a stretch of 16 straight games without a day off that started on May 12 at Cincinnati... Washington's next day off is scheduled for May 28 at home...The Nationals are 8-5 during this stretch so far.

WINNING WAYS

The Nationals have won three of their last four series and earned a split of the fourth (vs. NYM, May 18-21).

- The Nationals are 16-11 (.593) since April 25 and have won six of their nine series over this stretch.
- In the 16 wins, the pitching staff has recorded a 2.57 ERA and a .202 opponents' average with 149 strikeouts.
- Washington's 27-27 (.500) record is the best mark through the Club's first 54 games since the 2018 Nationals started the season 32-22 (.593).

ROTATION CELEBRATION

Over the last four games, the Nationals pitching rotation has pitched to an 0.78 ERA (2 ER/23.0 IP) with 25 strikeouts and just three walks.

- **Jake Irvin** (5.0 no-hit innings), **Miles Mikolas** (5.0 scoreless innings) and **Foster Griffin** (6.0 scoreless innings) all kept the Atlanta Braves off the scoreboard at Truist Park over the weekend.
- As a whole, the pitching staff tossed a season-high 17.0 consecutive scoreless innings from Saturday's one-hit shutout through the eighth inning of Sunday's win.
- **Simon Mathews'** staff has not surrendered a home run in four consecutive games, the longest active streak in Major League Baseball and the longest by a Nationals staff since July 21-26, 2025 (5 G).

ROAD SWEET ROAD

The Nationals have a 17-11 (.607) record on the road this season...Washington has taken at least a share of six of the last seven series away from home.

- Washington's 17 wins on the road are tied for the third-most in Major League Baseball behind only the Braves (19) and Dodgers (18).

VERY OFFENSIVE AS OF LATE

Since May 6, Washington's offense leads Major League Baseball in home runs (28), extra-base hits (78), doubles (45), slugging percentage (.477), OPS (.809) and runs scored (1st, 105).

- Of note, the 77 extra-base hits are 17 more than the next closest club (San Francisco, 61), the 45 doubles are 10 more than both Arizona and San Francisco (35) and the 105 runs are 25 more than the Dodgers (90).

A IS FOR ABRAMS AND...ALL-STAR?

With All-Star voting set to open in a few weeks, **CJ Abrams** has placed himself among the best players in MLB, as well as one of the top shortstops in the NL...See chart to the right for Abrams' rankings among NL shortstops.

- He leads Major League Baseball with 45 RBI...He ranks among National League hitters in wOBA (.397), OPS (.5th, .918), wRC+ (6th, 156), slugging (.8th, .536), extra-base hits (8th, 24) and on-base percentage (9th, .382).

A NOTE FROM THE LAND DOWN UNDER

On the significance of **Curtis Mead** (Washington) and **Travis Bazzana** (Cleveland) squaring off this week, per *Elías*:

- Last time two Australian-born players faced off on opposing teams was Sept. 6, 2017: **Peter Moylan** (KC) vs. **Warwick Saupold** (DET)
- The last time two Australian-born players both started on opposing teams was June 27, 2011: **Luke Hughes** (MIN) vs. **Trent Oeltjen** (LAD).

BULL PENNING

Over the last six games (26.2 IP), Washington's bullpen has struck out 26 batters, issued seven walks and has pitched to a 2.36 ERA (7 ER/26.2 IP) with a .202 opponents' average...Notable recent performances include:

- **Clayton Beeter** has tossed two hitless outings (2.0 IP) with four strikeouts and one walk since returning from the Injured List on May 21.
- **Andrew Alvarez** recorded his first career save on May 20 vs. New York (4.0 IP, 2 H, 2 ER, HR, BB 5 SO).
- **Brad Lord** has not issued a walk in his last five outings while striking out 13 batters and pitching to a 0.79 ERA (1 ER/11.1 IP) over this stretch...On the season, he's recorded 4.83 strikeout-to-walk ratio (29 SO/6 BB).
- **Richard Lovelady** is 1-1 with four saves, four holds and a 1.23 ERA (2 ER/14.2 IP) and 14 strikeouts in his last 15 outings...He's posted a 1.72 ERA in 16 games with the Nationals.
- **Orlando Ribalta** closed out his second career save by stranding all three runners after coming in with the bases loaded and one out at Atlanta on May 24.

FARM REPORT

CLEAN SWEEP

From the Major Leagues to Single-A, Washington's entire organization went 7-0 on Sunday...The Nationals beat the Atlanta Braves and Triple-A Rochester was postponed due to rain, while Double-A Harrisburg, High-A Wilmington and Single-A Fredericksburg all swept their doubleheaders...On the season, Washington's Minor League system is 119-79 (.601), the second-best record in baseball behind the San Francisco Giants (126-73, .633).

CAREER

Veteran starter is one of 27 pitchers in Major League Baseball to make 67 starts and maintain an ERA under 3.99 since the beginning of 2024.

- Littell (lih-TELL) began his career as a reliever before moving to the rotation in 2023 after being claimed by Tampa Bay...Is 21-27 with a 3.99 ERA in 80 starts since June 29, 2023.
- In 2024, was named the recipient of the Paul C. Smith Champion Award by the Tampa Bay chapter of the BBWAA, presented to the player who best exemplifies the spirit of true professionalism on and off the field.

LAST START

Littell tossed 5.0 innings of two-run ball against the New York Mets on May 20 to earn his second consecutive win...He struck out three and did not issue a walk.

vs. CLEVELAND

Littell is set to make his 12th career appearance against Cleveland...He is 4-0 with a 1.59 ERA and 14 strikeouts in his previous 11 outings.

- Littell is 1-0 with a 3.38 ERA in two career starts at Progressive Field...He worked 6.0 scoreless innings, allowed just two hits and struck out five in a win on Sept. 13, 2024 in Cleveland.

LAST FOUR OUTINGS

Littell is 3-0 with a 2.55 ERA (5 ER/17.2 IP) in his last four outings...All three of his wins have come at home, pitching to a 1.98 ERA (3 ER/13.2 IP) at Nationals Park during that span.

- During this stretch, opponents are hitting .206 (13-for-63) and lefties are 7-for-32 (.219).

2025

He led Major League Baseball with .042 walks per batter faced and was second with 1.54 walks per 9.0 innings...His 32 starts were tied for ninth in Major League Baseball...Did not issue a walk in 13 starts, tied with Tarik Skubal for the most-such outings in MLB...Was acquired by the Reds at the Trade Deadline.

- Set career highs in wins (10), starts (32) and innings pitched (186.2), while pitching to a 3.81 ERA for Tampa Bay and Cincinnati in 2025.
- He tossed his first career complete game on May 31 at Houston (9.0 IP, 10 H, 3 ER, BB, 6 SO).
- Made his Reds Postseason debut as the club's starting pitcher in Game 2 of the National League Wild Card Series at Los Angeles (NL)...Was his first career Postseason start after five Postseason relief appearances with Minnesota (2019), San Francisco (2021) and Tampa Bay (2023).
- Made his Reds debut on Aug. 5 at Chicago (NL)...Became the fifth pitcher in Reds history with at least 7.0 innings, one run or fewer allowed and at least eight strikeouts in his team debut (also: Brady Singer, 3/31/25 vs TEX; Johnny Cueto, 4/3/08 vs AZ; Mo Sanford, 8/9/91 at SD; Tom Seaver, 6/18/77 at MON).
- 2025 Pitch Mix:** Slider (27.5%) Split Finger (27.3%) Four Seamer (23.8%) Sinker (16.0%) Sweeper (5.4%)

2024

In his first full season as a starter, went 8-10 with a 3.63 ERA in his seventh Major League season.

- Led the Rays in wins (T1st, 8), innings (156.1), starts (29) and quality starts (T1st, 10)...All were career highs.
- From April 17-May 4, recorded at least six strikeouts without issuing a walk in a club-record four straight starts....On May 11 vs. New York (AL), he walked Anthony Rizzo in the second inning to end a streak of 123 BF without walk, the fourth longest in franchise history.
