**THE TWINS:** After completing their 10-game roadtrip with a record of 4-6 (3-0 at Boston, 1-3 at Chicago-AL and 0-3 at Pittsburgh), the Twins began their seven-game homestand with a win over the White Sox last night...tonight, Minnesota will continue the homestand with the second of three against the White Sox through tomorrow afternoon...after this series, Minnesota will host the Royals for four games, from Thursday-Sunday.  
 ☞ Twins have won four of their last five games at home...they have won two of their last three series' (May 12-14 vs. Miami and May 18-20 vs. Houston) in Minnesota.  
 ☞ Twins are on day 12 of a 17 games in 17 consecutive days...next day off is Monday, June 8.

**THE TWINS, YOUR JUNE GRAND SLAM LEADERS:** The Twins beat the White Sox last night at Target Field by a score of 9-6, snapping their five-game losing streak...Joe Ryan (4-3) was the starter and winner, allowing four runs on eight hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with no walks and nine strikeouts...the offense recorded 10 hits and scored four runs in both the fourth and fifth innings...Tristan Gray highlighted the scoring, hitting his second career grand slam in the fourth...he finished with a career-high-tying five RBI.  
 ☞ Joe Ryan became the first pitcher in Twins/Senators history (since 1901) to go three consecutive starts with 9 K/0 BB...10th time in his career he has done that, which moves him within three of Johan Santana (13) for the most such starts in Twins history (since 1961).

**JUSTIN TIME:** After last night's game, the Twins acquired right-handed pitcher Justin Lawrence from the Pirates in exchange for cash considerations...the 31-year-old appeared in 23 games for the Pirates this season, going 0-2, 5.32 ERA (22.0 IP, 13 ER), 12 walks, 25 strikeouts, two holds and a .244 opponent batting average, and was designated for release or assignment by Pittsburgh on May 29...the Canal Zone, Panama native was originally selected by Colorado in the 12th round of the 2015 MLB Draft out of Daytona State College and has gone 13-14, 5.05 ERA (233.2 IP, 131 ER), 130 walks and 236 strikeouts in 222 career major league games (all in relief) for the Rockies (2021-24) and Pirates (2025-26)...in 17 games for the Pirates last season, the 6-foot-3, 211-pound right-hander went 1-0 with a 0.51 ERA (17.2 IP, 1 ER), eight walks, 23 strikeouts, a 0.96 WHIP and a .153 opponent batting average.  
 ☞ To make room for Lawrence on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned left-handed pitcher Kody Funderburk to Triple-A St. Paul.

**NORTH STARS & SOUTH SIDERS:** The Twins and White Sox are playing the sixth of 13 games this season...Twins are 2-3 vs. the Sox this season.  
 ☞ Minnesota has gone 26-13 in its last 39 against the White Sox, dating back to May 4, 2023.  
 ☞ Over his last 56 games against the Sox, Byron Buxton is hitting .317 (63-for-199) with 18 doubles, three triples, 17 home runs, 36 RBI, a .693 slugging percentage and a 1.080 OPS...Buck's 24 career home runs, 100 hits, 31 doubles and 57 RBI against the Sox are his most against any opponent.  
 ☞ Buck has 24 career home runs against the White Sox, tied with Tony Oliva for fifth-most in club history (since 1961), trailing Harmon Killebrew (61), Bob Allison (34), Torii Hunter (25) and Justin Morneau (25).  
 ☞ Luke Keaschall is hitting .356 (16-for-45) with four doubles, eight walks, five stolen bases, a .455 on-base percentage and an .899 OPS in 13 career games vs. the Sox...he has reached safely in all 13.

**BYE BYE BYRON:** Byron Buxton has hit 17 home runs in 37 games since April 13...since that date, he ranks second in baseball, trailing Kyle Schwarber (18) and ahead of Munetaka Murakami (16)...he is currently in a four-game homer drought, his last being a leadoff homer on Wednesday at Chicago-AL, off David Sandlin...it marks his longest home run drought since April 15-19 (also 4).  
 ☞ Since 2020, nobody in baseball has homered more against the White Sox than Buxton (17).

**50 SHADES OF GRAY:** Tristan Gray hit his second career grand slam yesterday, the other coming on April 3 vs. Tampa Bay in the Twins Home Opener, off Yoendrys Gómez...he is one of three players in baseball with multiple grand slams; the other two are San Francisco's Harrison Bader and Baltimore's Jeremiah Jackson...with 23 hits and 23 RBI on the season, Gray is one of two players in baseball with equal amounts of hits and RBI, the other being Miami's Heriberto Hernandez with 20 hits and 20 RBI (credit *Elias Sports Bureau*).  
 ☞ Gray's 14 RBI with the bases loaded are the most in baseball...Brooks Lee is tied for second in baseball (13) with Michael Busch.

**TWINS TRY TO MEATLOAF THE SOX:** One win in these next two games and the Twins will earn their eighth series win of the season...they have gone 7-11-1 in series play, 4-3-1 at home and 3-8-0 on the road...season results in the right margin.  
 ☞ Twins are seeking their first series win over the White Sox since taking two of three from April 22-24, 2025 at Target Field...they have gone 0-3-0 head-to-head in series play since.

**SANDS OF TIME:** Cole Sands is scheduled to begin his rehab assignment tonight with Triple-A St. Paul...the Saints host Indianapolis with first pitch at 7:07 pm (CT)...Sands was placed on the 15-day Injured List on May 2 with a right forearm strain.

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 1986, Rod Carew announced his retirement from baseball at the age of 40...he was inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in 1991...in 2023, former Minnesota pitcher Bartolo Colón officially announced his retirement... "Big Sexy" made 15 starts for the Twins in 2017, going 5-6, 5.18 ERA (80.0 IP, 46 ER), including a complete game on August 4, 2017 vs. Texas at the age of 44.

**LOU GEHRIG DAY:** MLB, in coordination with all 30 Clubs, will observe the sixth annual Lou Gehrig Day today — a date carrying the significance of both the 1925 game when Gehrig became the Yankees' starting first baseman to launch his legendary "Iron Horse" consecutive game streak, and also the day he passed from ALS complications 16 years later.  
 ☞ The Twins will host 300 members of the ALS community at Target Field, while honoring ALS Association staff on the field alongside patients...the pregame ceremony will feature an awareness video, a ceremonial first pitch from an individual living with ALS and a special spotlight on Dr. Timothy Culbert — a retired developmental pediatrician who, upon his own ALS diagnosis, founded the nonprofit Mental Wellness Innovations to help children experiencing trauma...two retired U.S. service members living with ALS will raise the American and Twins Territory flags, respectively, prior to the game...the club will also acknowledge Twins legends Kent Hrbek and Terry Steinbach, who both lost parents to ALS...furthermore, Manager Derek Shelton will host a meet-and-greet with ALS staff via his "Shelty's Shirts" program and Club partner, Carrier, will make a financial donation to the ALS Association for every strikeout thrown by a Twins pitcher at Target Field this season.

- Connor Prielipp is slated to make his eighth career MLB start and second in a row against the Chicago White Sox.
- In his last outing on May 27 at Chicago-AL, Prielipp suffered the loss, surrendering a career-high six runs (all earned) on eight hits with three walks and five strikeouts in 4.1 innings pitched.
- Prielipp will make his fourth start of the season at Target Field, where he has an ERA of 2.81, compared to a 7.27 ERA in four road starts.

**LAST TIME OUT:** On May 27, Prielipp made the start at Rate Field in Chicago against the White Sox opposite right-hander David Sandlin...gave up a career-high runs (all earned) across 4.1 innings while allowing a career-high eight hits, with three walks and five strikeouts...left the game in the fifth with the Twins trailing 4-1 and two runners on base (Randal Grichuk at 1st and Miguel Vargas at 3rd) who both later came around to score to make it 6-1 in favor of the Sox...the Twins went on to lose 15-2 and Prielipp was charged with his third loss in his last four starts.

- Prielipp walked the first batter of an inning three times in the start (first inning, third inning and fifth inning)...the Sox did not take advantage of the free pass in the first inning, but struck for one in the third and three in the fifth off Prielipp following the walks to begin the frame.
- Has now made two consecutive starts in which he has allowed five-or-more earned runs after not allowing more than two earned runs in each of his first five big league starts.
- Threw 93 pitches, which tied his MLB career high (also 93 pitches on May 8 at Cleveland).

**TWO STARTS AGO:** On May 22 at Fenway Park, Prielipp endured his shortest outing since his MLB debut on April 22 at New York-NL...he went 4.0 innings, giving up a career-high six runs (five earned) on a career-high seven hits, with three walks and a career-low one strikeout...departed from the ballgame with the Twins trailing 6-3, and did not factor into the decision as Minnesota rallied to win 8-6.

**FIRST FIVE / LAST TWO:** After not allowing more than two earned runs in any of his first five starts, Prielipp has struggled in his last two starts...here are his numbers from his first five outings compared to his last two:

**GET BACK GAME:** Prielipp will face the Sox tonight for the second start in a row...it will be the first time in his career that he will face a team in back-to-back starts and his first time facing a team for the second time in his MLB career...White Sox hitters hit .421 (8-for-19) off Prielipp in his last start, including two-hit games from Colson Montgomery (2-for-3 with a double and an RBI) and Randal Grichuk (2-for-3 with an RBI and a strikeout).

- CAREER AGAINST THE AL CENTRAL:** Tonight will be Connor's third career start against a member of the American League Central (May 8 at Cleveland and May 27 at Chicago-AL)...is 0-2 through two starts with a 6.75 ERA (9.1 IP, 7 ER), five walks, 11 strikeouts, a .316 (12-for-38) BAA and a 1.82 WHIP.

**HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** Through seven games, Prielipp has started three times at home and four times on the road...on the road he is 0-2 with a 7.27 ERA (17.1 IP, 14 ER), eight walks, 18 strikeouts and a 1.79 WHIP, compared to 1-1 with a 2.81 ERA (16.0 IP, 5 ER), seven walks, 17 strikeouts and a 0.88 WHIP in three starts at Target Field.

- LAST TIME OUT AT TARGET FIELD:** On May 16 vs. Milwaukee, Prielipp gave up two runs (one earned) on three hits (1 HR) with two walks and eight strikeouts in six quality innings; the quality start was his only one so far in his major league career.

**LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS:** Through seven MLB starts, lefties are slashing .273/.333/.455 (9-for-33) with three doubles, one home run, four walks and seven strikeouts, while righties are slashing .231/.324/.374 (21-for-91) with two doubles, one triple, three home runs, eleven walks and 28 strikeouts against Prielipp.

- SPLITS IN THE MINORS:** In his minor league career, lefties slashed .313/.392/.413 (47-for-150) with seven doubles, one triple, two home runs, 15 walks and 44 strikeouts while righties slashed .241/.317/.340 (80-for-332) with 11 doubles, two triples, six home runs, 35 walks and 124 strikeouts.

**THE ARSENAL:** In his seven starts, Prielipp has used a five-pitch mix...here are his numbers and results, per Baseball Savant:

- ON THE FASTBALL:** In his May 27 start, White Sox hitters were 4-for-4 with three singles and a double against Prielipp's 4-Seam Fastball...heading into the game, opposing hitters were hitting just .125 (3-for-24) against the fastball which was second in baseball (min. 30 PA and 500 total pitches).
- MORE OFFSPEED?:** Despite success against the heater on May 27, Sox hitters were a combined 0-for-8 with five strikeouts against Prielipp's slider and curveball (0-for-4 with two strikeouts vs. the slider and 0-for-4 with three strikeouts vs. the curveball)...more on those two pitches below:
- SLIDER (SEASON NUMBERS):** Prielipp's .152 (7-for-46) BAA his slider ranks fifth among starting pitchers in MLB (min 50 PA and 500 total pitches)...the four pitchers he trails are Dylan Cease (TOR) - .130, Chase Burns (CIN) - .137, Jacob deGrom (TEX) - .143 and Chris Sale (ATL) - .150.
- CURVEBALL (SEASON NUMBERS):** Prielipp's .158 (3-for-19) BAA his curveball ranks 14th among starters (min. 20 PA and 500 total pitches)...among Twins starters (min. 50 curveballs thrown) the .158 BAA ranks third behind Zebby Matthews (.083) and Joe Ryan (.119).
