**RECENT REDBIRDS:** The Cardinals continue their six-game road trip through Kansas City (2-0) and Cincinnati, playing the opener of a four-game series at the division-rival Cincinnati Reds tonight and wrapping up their play in the Queen City for the 2019 season...the Cardinals enter play today tied for 1st place in the NL Central (63-55, .5339), .0006 pct. points ahead of Chicago (64-56, .5333)...on the heels of a season-high-tying five-game losing streak, the Cardinals' current five game win streak ties the Yankees for MLB's longest active streak, and are 19-11 since the All-Star Break, 3rd-best winning pct. (.633) in the NL.

**SWEEP STAKES:** Each of the Cardinals last four series have resulted in sweeps, losing five in a row and then winning five straight...the club was swept by the Athletics (2G) and Dodgers (3G) and swept the Pirates (3G) and Royals (2G).

**SEEING RED:** The Cardinals are 15-4 in their last 19 games at Great American Ballpark (August 5, 2017-present), and now sport an all-time winning record (72-71).

**SECOND HOME:** **Yadier Molina** is slashing .321/.361/.507 with 15 home runs and 60 RBI in 105 career games at the Great American Ball Park. The backstop is the all-time stadium leader for visiting players in games played, hits (123), doubles (26) and RBI (60).

**MOLINA MILESTONES:** Last night, Molina (15979.0) passed **Tony Peña** for 7th place all-time in MLB history in innings caught while making his 148th start at catcher in a shutout, extending his MLB record among Latin American-born players (Peña, 140) for most starts at catcher in which team allows no runs (since 1900). Molina needs one double to reach 372 and pass **Gary Carter** (1974-92) for 10th all-time among MLB catchers, and four RBI to reach 900 for his career.

**WAKA WAKA:** **Michael Wacha** leads active MLB pitchers in career wins (12) against Cincinnati, and trails only (**Cole Hamels**, 2.21) in ERA (2.79) (*min. 15 starts*). Wacha also sports the 2nd-highest all-time win pct. (.923, 12-1) vs. the Reds in MLB history (*min. 15 starts*), trailing **Red Lucas** (.933, 14-1 from 1924-38)...St. Louis has won Wacha's last 13 overall starts vs. the Reds (Sept. 20, 2014-present), going 10-0 with a 2.48 ERA, while the right-hander has earned the win in each of his last seven outings (7-0) at the GABP (April 11, 2015-present).

**Blankety Blank:** St. Louis has shut out the opposition in its last 18.0 consecutive innings, recording its 2nd straight shutout win last night and 7th of the season. The last time St. Louis posted consecutive shutouts was during a three-game stretch from August 6-8, 2015 at Cincinnati (1) and at Milwaukee (2). **Jack Flaherty** (23.0) and **Giovanny Gallegos** (16.1) currently boast MLB's top two active scoreless innings streaks.

**DIVISIONAL DOMINANCE:** The Cardinals are 29-20 in divisional play (17-7 at home), and have won 14 of 17 over divisional opponents since the All-Star Break. Their .592 divisional win pct. trails the Los Angeles Dodgers (.667, 36-18 vs. NL West) and Atlanta Braves (.615, 32-20 vs. NL East) among NL teams.

**DE-BOMB:** **Paul DeJong** has hit 12 of career 63 homers against the Reds since making his MLB debut (May 28, 2017), his most against any opponent. Over that period, DeJong's 12 home runs tie **Christian Yelich** for 2nd-most in MLB, trailing **Kyle Schwarber** (13). Last night, DeJong became the first Cardinals shortstop to produce multiple 20-homer seasons (25 in 2017).

**THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (August 15, 2001):** The Cardinals defeat the Reds, 8-4 at Busch Stadium, for their 7th straight win. **Mark McGwire** singles in the 5th inning, marking his first hit other than a home run in 72 at-bats. McGwire's previous 11 hits had been homers, a run unprecedented in the last 25 years. **Jim Edmonds** also hit a two-run, first-inning homer off **Chris Reitsma** in the win.

### CINCINNATI CONNECTIONS

**Michael Wacha's** uncle, **Dusty Rogers**, was a Reds 1st round draft pick in 1984...played in the Reds minor league organization from 1984-88.

After the 2015 season, **Paul Goldschmidt** gifted his NL Silver Slugger Award to then current Reds hitting coach **Turner Ward**, who previously served as a Diamondbacks hitting coach (2013-15) and Mobile (AA) manager of Goldschmidt in 2011.

Pitching coach **Mike Maddux** was born in Dayton, Ohio...originally selected by the Reds in the 36th round of the 1979 MLB draft, but did not sign to attend the University of Texas at El Paso.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Vince Coleman** played in 33 games for the Reds in 1996.

Cardinals 2019 Hall of Fame inductee **Scott Rolen** played his final four seasons in a Reds uniform (2009-12), where he was a 2010 Gold Glove Award winner and two-time All-Star (2010-11).

Cardinals Translator **Carlos Villoria** is related to Reds Hall of Fame infielder **Dave Concepción**.

Cardinals broadcaster and Hall of Famer **Jim Edmonds** played 13 games for the Reds during his final professional season in 2010.

Reds first base coach **Delino DeShields** played two seasons with St. Louis (1997-98).

Reds manager **David Bell** previously served as a Cardinals assistant hitting (2014) and bench coach (2015-17)...played parts of four seasons with St. Louis (1995-98)...traded by Cleveland with catcher **Pepe McNeal** and pitcher **Rick Heiser** to the Cardinals for pitcher **Ken Hill** (July 27, 1995).

Reds Executive Advisor to the CEO **Walt Jocketty** served as the Cardinals General Manager for 13 seasons (1995-2007)...during tenure, the Cardinals compiled seven NL Central Division championships (1996, 2000-02, '04-06), two NL Championships ('04, '06), and one World Series Championship ('06)...the Cardinals recorded seven straight winning seasons under Jocketty, including a pair of 100+ win seasons ('04-05)...named MLB Executive of the Year (2000, '04, '10).

Reds Bullpen Coach **Lee Tunnel** pitched in 32 games for St. Louis in 1987.

Reds pro scout **Bruce Manno** worked in the Cardinals front office for six seasons as Director of Player Development (2002-06) and Senior Director of Pro Scouting & Special Assistant to the General Manager (2007) before joining Atlanta.

Reds broadcaster **George Grande** previously worked as a Cardinals play-by-play announcer for two seasons (1991-92).

Reds Special Asst. to the GM **Marty Maier** spent 24 seasons with St. Louis as an area scout, Latin American coordinator, asst. director of scouting, scouting director and special asst. to the GM.

Reds Player Performance Special Asst. **Eric Davis** played two seasons (1999-2000) for St. Louis.

Reds broadcaster **Jeff Brantley** pitched in 48 games for St. Louis in 1998.

Reds Special Assistant to the GM **John Morris** played five seasons for St. Louis from 1986-90.

Reds Special Assistant to the GM, Player Personnel **Cam Bonifay** worked for the Cardinals as a special assistant, evaluating the American League East from October of 2007-08.

Cardinals Principal Owner and Chief Executive Officer **William DeWitt Jr.** was a prior owner of the Reds and shareholder of the Cincinnati Bengals...his father, **William O. DeWitt**, was a sole owner of the Reds from 1961-67.

Reds CEO **Robert Castellini**, Chairman **W. Joseph Williams Jr.** and Vice Chairman **Thomas Williams** were Cardinals investors from 1995-2006...their interests were sold as a condition of their acquisition of a controlling ownership stake of the Reds.

## TONIGHT'S GAME

- Makes his 16th start (21st appearance) of the season, and the 143rd start of his career (157th appearance).
- Has a 12-1 career record against the Reds and is 7-0 in his last seven appearances at Great American Ballpark.
- Earned his first relief win since 2013 coming in his last appearance at Cincinnati (7/19).
- Needs one win for 60 career wins. His .615 career winning percentage (59-37) ranks 8th all-time among Cardinals with 90 or more decisions.
- Is 5-5 with a 5.52 ERA in 15 starts and 1-0 with a 5.68 ERA in five relief appearances. However, he is 1-0 with a 1.54 ERA in his last four relief appearances following a six-run outing (1.0 IP) in his first relief appearance of the season at PHI (5/29).
- Has thrown 3.0 innings or more in each of his last two relief appearances with the most recent tossing 4.2 innings vs. HOU (7/27) holding the Astros to one run on six hits.
- Is 4-4, 5.56 ERA in 10 road starts (13 app.) and 2-1, 5.51 ERA in five starts (7 app.) at Busch Stadium in 2019.
- Has returned to the starting rotation twice this season after being sent to the bullpen; first on June 10 at Miami after two appearances out of the bullpen and today after three relief appearances (7/19-27).

## LAST TIME OUT

- Surrendered two home runs, including a 1st inning 3-run shot to Cody Bellinger, as the Dodgers jumped out to a 3-0 lead and scored six runs over 3.2 innings en route to an 8-0 win at Dodger Stadium.

## 2019

- Went 2-2 with a 2.84 ERA (25.1 IP) and 17 strikeouts in five June games (four starts). Was the 13th-lowest ERA in the NL and the lowest June ERA in his career.
- Is averaging 6.35 run support average, which would lead St. Louis and rank 6th in the National League, but does not have the qualifying innings.
- Earned the win at CIN (7/19) tossing 1.2 scoreless innings as the Cardinals rallied from a 7-0 deficit with 10 runs in the 6th inning for a 12-11 win. It was his first relief win since 8/19/13 at MIL, and the Cardinals largest comeback win since 2002 (8 runs at CIN).
- Threw a season-high 7.0 innings at SD (6/28) allowing two runs in a 3-1 Cardinals loss at PETCO Park; his longest outing since tossing 8.0 scoreless innings vs. PIT on June 3, 2018 at Busch Stadium after carrying a no-hitter into the 9th inning.
- Allowed one run over 6.0 frames in the Cardinals 5-1 win vs. LAA (6/21). Was his longest home start of the season. Marked his first Interleague win at home since 6/16/15 vs. Minnesota. Earned his 31st career win at Busch Std III, moving past Kyle Lohse into sole possession of 5th place.

- Earned the win in each of his last seven appearances (7-0) at Great American Ballpark dating back to 4/11/2015 with a 2.45 ERA over 36.2 innings.
- Allowed just three home runs over 36.2 innings at Great American Ballpark averaging an 0.74 HR/9 IP, with the MLB average at 1.32 HR/9 IP.
- Is 4-2 with a 3.77 in 10 appearances (7 starts) vs. teams with a sub-.500 win pct.
