## NATIONALS NEWS

### POWER HOUR

The Washington Nationals beat the Cleveland Guardians, 10-2, on the strength of six home runs off the bats of **James Wood** (solo), **Curtis Mead** (multi-homer game), **Jacob Young** (solo), **Luis Garcia Jr.** (2-run) and **CJ Abrams** (solo.)

- PJ Poulin** (2.0 IP, 2 H, ER, BB) and **Zack Littell** (7.0 IP, 5 H, ER, 2 BB, 7 SO) combined to hold the AL Central-leading Guardians at bay.
- Washington's 71 home runs this season are the most by a Nationals club through its first 55 games since the 2018 Nationals hit 73 through their first 55 games.
- The Nationals are in a stretch of 16 straight games without a day off that started on May 12 at Cincinnati... Washington's next day off is scheduled for May 28 at home...The Nationals are 9-5 (.643) during this stretch.

### WINNING WAYS

The Nationals have won three in a row, five of seven and are 17-11 (.607) since April 25...They have won six of their nine series over this stretch.

- In the 17 wins, the pitching staff has recorded a 2.54 ERA, a .203 opponents' average and 9.0 strikeouts per 9.0.
- Washington's 28-27 (.509) record is the best mark through the Club's first 55 games since the 2018 Nationals started the season 33-22 (.600).
- The Nationals are over .500 this late in the season for the first time since July 1, 2021 (40-39, .506).
- The Nationals have a 18-11 (.621) record on the road this season...Washington's 18 wins on the road are tied for the second-most in Major League Baseball behind only the Braves (19) and with the Los Angeles Dodgers (18).

### PITCHING IN

Over the last five games, the Nationals pitching rotation has pitched to an 0.90 ERA (3 ER/30.0 IP) with 32 strikeouts and just five walks.

- Zack Littell** (7.0 innings of one-run ball), **Foster Griffin** (6.0 scoreless innings), **Jake Irvin** (5.0 no-hit innings), **Miles Mikolas** (5.0 scoreless innings) and **Cade Cavalli** (7.0 innings with 2-runs allowed) have contributed to the strong run of outings.
- As a whole, **Simon Mathews'** pitching staff has pitched to a 1.54 ERA (8 ER/46.2 IP) and a .186 opponents average with just one home run allowed.

### VERY OFFENSIVE AS OF LATE

Since May 6, Washington's offense leads Major League Baseball in home runs (34), extra-base hits (86), doubles (47), slugging percentage (.500), OPS (.835) and runs scored (115).

- Of note, the 77 extra-base hits are 21 more than the next closest club (San Francisco, 65), the 34 home runs are seven more than Chicago (AL) and the 115 runs are 20 more than the Dodgers (95).
- The Nationals have recorded at least one extra-base hit in 25 straight games, tied for the third-longest active streak in baseball with the Chicago White Sox and behind San Francisco (29) and Pittsburgh (27).

### GET READY TO VOTE

With All-Star voting set to open next week, **CJ Abrams** and **James Wood** have placed themselves among the best players in Major League Baseball and the National League...See charts to the right for position specific rankings.

- Abrams' 46 RBI are tied for the most in Major League Baseball...He ranks among National League hitters in wOBA (6th, .399), OPS (6th, .924), wRC+ (6th, 158), slugging (T6th, .545), home runs (T7th, 12), extra-base hits (T7th, 25) and on-base percentage (10th, .379).
- Wood leads Major League Baseball with 47 runs scored and four leadoff home runs...He ranks in the National League in walks (1st, 45), on-base percentage (2nd, .405), extra-base hits (3rd, 28), home runs (T3rd, 14), OPS (4th, .938), wOBA (5th, .405), wRC+ (5th, 161), doubles (T5th, 14) and RBI (T8th, 35).

### BACKSTOP BAT

**Keibert Ruiz** has hit safely in eight of his last 10 games, going 14-for-37 (.378) with seven doubles, three homers, 13 RBI, one walk, one stolen base and eight runs scored.

- On the season, Ruiz is tied for first among Major League catchers with 12 doubles and among all catchers (min. 100 PA) in isolated power (4th, .233) and slugging percentage (5th, .485).
- The 12 doubles are tied for the most among all Major League Baseball switch hitters with **Elly De La Cruz** and his .485 slugging percentage is good for fourth (min. 100 PA).

### A NOTE FROM THE LAND DOWN UNDER

On the significance of **Curtis Mead** (Washington) and **Travis Bazzana** (Cleveland) squaring off this week, per *Elías*:

- Last time two Australian-born players faced off on opposing teams was Sept. 6, 2017: **Peter Moylan** (KC) vs. **Warwick Saupold** (DET)
- The last time two Australian-born players both started on opposing teams was June 27, 2011: **Luke Hughes** (MIN) vs. **Trent Oeltjen** (LAD).

## FARM REPORT

### STREA-KING

Rochester shortstop **Seaver King** has reached base safely in all 41 games this season, the longest active streak in Minor League Baseball and the longest streak in MiLB overall this season...He is 9-for-23 (.391) with two doubles, one triple, a homer, nine RBI, two walks and two runs scored in six games since joining Rochester last week.

### CLEAN SWEEP

From the Major Leagues to Single-A, Washington's entire organization went 7-0 on Sunday...The Nationals beat the Atlanta Braves and Triple-A Rochester was postponed due to rain, while Double-A Harrisburg, High-A Wilmington and Single-A Fredericksburg all swept their doubleheaders...On the season, Washington's Minor League system is 120-79 (.603), the second-best record in baseball behind the San Francisco Giants (126-73, .633).
