SECOND HALF SURGING: The Orioles have gone 6-3 to begin the second half, including winning two of three series...Their .667 winning percentage ranks as the fifth-highest in the AL and the majors.

⚾ The O's have hit at least two home runs in four-straight games for the third time this season, also: June 17-20 and April 7-11; have yet to had five-straight such games this year.

⚾ O's pitchers have posted a 3.89 ERA (34 ER/78.2 IP) in the second half after posting a 5.60 (478 ER/768.2 IP) in the first half...O's pitchers have allowed seven home runs in their nine second-half games, tied for the second-fewest in the AL and third-fewest in the majors; allowed a Major League high 136 home runs in the first half.

⚾ The O's collected their first win of the season on Sunday in which they trailed entering the ninth inning and are now 1-51 in such games...Was their third walk-off win of the season, second coming off the bat of **INF Ramón Urías**...Also improved to 6-15 in one-run games.

HOME COOKIN': The Orioles recorded their first home series sweep of the season this past weekend against Washington; first since July 31-August 2, 2020 vs. TB and their third home series sweep since the beginning of the 2018 season (also: August 27-29, 2018 vs. TOR)...Was their third series win at Oriole Park this season (May 31-June 2 vs. MIN and June 4-6 vs. CLE)...Have won three-straight home games after winning only two of their previous 12.

⚾ The O's have committed just 14 errors in their 46 home games, including just three in their last 29 home games (since May 10); have a .992 fielding percentage at Oriole Park.

⚾ **OF Cedric Mullins** has hit safely in nine-straight home games and in 38 of 46 overall...His .331 (59-for-178) home batting average ranks as the second-highest in the AL and third-highest in the majors.

⚾ **INF/OF Ryan Mountcastle** is slashing .299/.326/.563 (50-for-167) with 11 home runs in 45 home games compared to .198/.270/.329 (33-for-167) with five home runs in 47 road games.

REVERSE THE DERBY CURSE: **INF Trey Mancini** has hit safely in eight-straight games, five being multi-hit games, and is batting .351/.385/.622 (13-for-37) since the All-Star Break...His 13 hits are tied for the third-most in the AL since the break.

⚾ Mancini has homered in back-to-back games, the third time this season he's homered in consecutive games and the 13th-time in his career homering in consecutive games; his career-long is three-straight games from July 24-26, 2019.

⚾ Mancini has recorded an extra-base hit in four-straight games, tied for the longest active streak in the majors.

START IT UP: Orioles starters have completed 6.0 innings of work four times in nine games since the All-Star Break...Prior to the break, O's starters had worked 6.0+ innings three times in their previous 40 games, dating back to May 27; 16 total times in the first half...O's starters are 3-2 since the break, after going 13-43 in the first half.

⚾ O's starters worked a total of 400.1 IP in the first half, averaging 4.50 innings per start, the fewest innings in the majors...In the second half they've worked 47.2 IP, averaging 5.24 innings per start, the eighth-highest in the AL.

⚾ The O's bullpen has posted a 2.90 ERA (10 ER/31.0 IP) in the second half...Their 11.03 SO/9 and 3.45 SO/BB are each the third-highest in the AL in the second half.

INTERLEAGUE PLAY: The O's will play in their 13th Interleague game tonight, having gone 5-7 in their first 12 games (1-1 - MIA, 1-3 - NYM, 3-3, WSH).

⚾ The O's will match up with the Marlins for the second time this season, after splitting a two-game set in Miami from April 20-21 earlier this year.

⚾ All time, the O's have gone 9-27 against the Marlins, including 6-13 at Oriole Park...The O's .250 all-time winning percentage against Miami is tied for the lowest against an opponent in club history (Chicago-NL, 3-9).

⚾ **INF Trey Mancini** is hitting .340/.404/.617 (16-for-47) in 12 Interleague games...His 1.021 OPS ranks as the eighth-highest in the AL during Interleague play.

IF YOU AIN'T FIRST, YOU'RE LAST: **OF Cedric Mullins** is batting .391 (34-for-87) in the first inning this season...His 34 first-inning hits are the most in the majors, six-more than the second-most (**Winker**, CIN - 28); the 34 hits are also the most in any single inning in the majors...The O's single-season record for the most hits in the first inning is 52 by **Nick Markakis** in 2007; Markakis also has the second-highest total of 51 in 2014...Mullins' 13 first-inning extra-base hits (8-2B, 1-3B, 4 HR) are tied for the third-most in the majors.

⚾ Mullins is batting .374 (58-for-155) when leading off an inning, with his 58 hits being the most in the majors.

PAPA FRITA: **LHP Paul Fry** has faced 162 batters this season without allowing a home run, the fourth-most batters faced without surrendering a long ball in the majors this season: **Adam Ottavino**, BOS leads with 180 BF...His 42.0 homerless inning streak, dating back to September 15, 2020, is the fifth-longest active streak in the majors...Fry has allowed just one extra-base hit this season (2B), the only pitcher in the majors (min. 15 IP) to have allowed one-or-fewer extra-base hits.

THIS AND THAT:

⚾ Orioles catchers lead the majors in caught stealing percentage (42.2%), throwing out 19-of-45 attempted base runners; their 19 catcher caught stealings lead the American League and are third-most in the majors.

⚾ **Austin Hays** has doubled in five of the last six games in which he has had an at-bat, including three-straight, and has eight total doubles in the month of July (17 G); his eight doubles in July are tied for the most in the AL and tied for the fourth-most in the majors.

⚾ Orioles No. 1 prospect (No. 2 overall in MLB, according to *Baseball America*), Double-A Bowie **C Adley Rutschman**, was named the Double-A Northeast Player of the Week for the week of July 19-25...For the season, Rutschman has slashed .281/.408/.518 with 14 doubles, 15 home runs, 52 runs scored, 48 RBI, and 51 BB to 49 K in 68 games.

WELCOME TO THE SHOW: **RHP Conner Greene** had his contract selected from Triple-A Norfolk on July 24...Greene's first appearance will be his Major League debut...A Major League-high 11 players have made their Major League debuts this season for the O's...The O's club record for most MLB debuts in a season is 15, set in 2018...The Orioles have used 47 different players this season (28 pitchers and 19 position players).

QUICK HITS: His victory on 7/6 snapped a 24-game streak in which an O's starting pitcher did not earn a win, the longest such streak in club history, per *STATS*...Is the only player selected in the 30th round of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft to have made his Major League debut...Had his contract selected from Triple-A Norfolk prior to the game on 6/30 at Houston...Signed by the Orioles as a Minor League free agent on 2/3/21...Almost walked away from baseball to take up a coaching opportunity with a high school freshman team in Arizona prior to being signed by the Orioles...Did not play in 2020 due to the cancellation of the Minor League season...Was originally selected by the Detroit Tigers in the 30th round of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft out of Western Oregon University.

LAST START: Earned the first quality start of his career in the win on 7/19 at Tampa Bay...Tossed a career-high 6.0 innings of one-run ball with four hits, two walks, and a career-high seven strikeouts...Became the first Orioles starter to allow one earned run-or-less in three-straight starts this season...He joined RHP Dean Kremer (2020) as the only O's pitchers in team history (since 1954) to allow one earned run-or-less in each of their first three career starts.

INTERLEAGUE PLAY: Will be facing the Miami Marlins and a National League opponent for the first time in his career...Will mark the fifth different opponent he has faced since his MLB debut on 7/2 at Los Angeles-AL; has yet to face an opponent twice.

LEFT IS RIGHT: Held left-handed batters hitless through his first three big league appearances since making his Major League debut on 7/2...Lefties are batting .083 (2-for-24) against him through four games (three starts), compared to a .300 mark (9-for-30) against right-handed batters...Only three balls put in play by a lefty against Watkins have been hard-hit, all resulted in an out.

WELCOME TO THE BIGS: Became the 11th Oriole (ninth pitcher) to make his Major League debut this season on 7/2 at Los Angeles-AL...The nine O's pitchers to make their debuts this year are the most in the majors...Entered with two outs in the fifth frame and tossed 1.0 perfect inning; induced a Taylor Ward fly out to end the frame for his first MLB out before retiring his next two batters faced in the sixth inning... Earned his first-career win in his first big league start on 7/6 vs. Toronto...Threw 5.0 one-run innings, allowing three hits and three walks, while striking out two...Punched out Randal Grichuk swinging in the second frame for his first MLB strikeout.

ON THE FARM: Appeared in seven games (six starts) with Triple-A Norfolk this year, in which he went 1-2 with a 3.58 ERA (13 ER/32.2 IP), 11 walks, and 27 strikeouts... Posted a 1.10 WHIP through the seven contests...Three of his six starts were 6.0 innings-or-more...Earned his lone win in his most recent start on 6/23 vs. Gwinnett, in which he allowed three runs on three hits (one home run) and one walk with four strikeouts through 6.0 innings...Struck out a season-high six batters through 4.0 in-nings on 5/12 at Charlotte...Held opponents to a .205 average (25-for-122) across the seven games.

2019 HIGHLIGHTS: Spent time with three different affiliates, Class A-Advanced Lakeland, Double-A Erie, and Triple-A Toledo...Made a season high 14 starts (16 appearances) with Toledo, going 5-6 with a 7.98 ERA (68 ER/76.2 IP)...Went 9-7 across the three levels of Detroit's organization and pitched to a 6.07 ERA (93 ER/138.0 IP) with 44 walks and 121 strikeouts.

SPRING TRAINING: Was a non-roster invite to Orioles 2021 Spring Training...Ap-peared in three Grapefruit League games as a reliever, tossing 1.2 scoreless, hitless innings with one walk and one strikeout.

BRING HOME THE HARDWARE: Watkins was named a Florida State League Mid-Season and Postseason All-Star while with Class-A Advanced Lakeland in 2018, and was named the FSL Pitcher of the Week on 7/1/18...Was named a New York Penn-League Mid-Season All-Star while with Short-Season A Connecticut in 2015, as well as the NYPL Pitcher of the Week on 8/31/15.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP JORGE LOPEZ (2-12, 5.84 ERA)

López will be appearing in his 90th career game and making his 54th career start when he faces the Marlins for the third time in his career, and the first since making the start on 9/6/19 at Miami while with Kansas City; tossed 6.0 scoreless innings with four hits and five strikeouts in the win...Threw 2.1 innings of relief while suffering the loss on 7/11/18 vs. Miami while with Milwaukee...Has made two starts against the NL East this year, both against the Nationals, going 0-1 with a 2.79 ERA (3 ER/9.2 IP); is 2-2 in 12 games (five starts) against the NL East in his career with a 2.82 ERA (14 ER/44.2 IP)...His most recent outing was on 7/23 vs. Washington where he allowed one run on four hits (one home run) and two walks with three strikeouts through 4.2 innings of the no decision.
