THE TWINS: Completed their seven-game homestand with a record of 5-2, going 2-1 vs. Texas last weekend, followed by 3-1 vs. Kansas City during the week...tonight, the Twins will begin a nine-game, 10-day roadtrip with the first of three in Houston...they will play three at Minute Maid Park this weekend, then travel to New York for an off-day on Monday...they will play the Yankees for three games from Tuesday-Thursday, then travel to Pittsburgh to play the Pirates for three games next weekend.

⊕ Since April 22, the Twins have gone 24-12, tied with New York-AL for the second-best record in baseball since that date, trailing Philadelphia (25-10).

TWINS LEAVE MINNESOTA WITH ANOTHER SERIES W: The Twins beat the Royals yesterday afternoon by a score of 7-6 at Target Field, improving to 10-4 in one-run games...the win marked the club's 10th series win of the season, making them 10-6-2 in series play this season and 9-2-0 in their last 11 series...Chris Paddack was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs on five hits (2 HR) in 5.2 innings pitched...the offense recorded nine hits as Ryan Jeffers homered twice, his third career multi-homer game...Carlos Correa capped a four-run sixth inning, hitting a bases loaded triple, giving the Twins a 7-4 lead.

RAN OUT OF OIL: These two last met for a best-of-five in the American League Division Series from October 7-11, 2023 as the Astros won the series three games to one, following an AL Wild Card Series in which the Twins swept the Blue Jays in two games...the Twins lost Game 1 in Houston...the only Twins win came in Game 2 here on October 8 as Pablo López threw 7.0 shutout innings with six hits allowed, one walk and seven strikeouts...López joined Jack Morris (G7 - 1991 WS vs. ATL) and Johan Santana (G1 - 2004 ALDS at NYY) as the only pitchers in Twins history (since 1961) to pitch at least 7.0-plus scoreless innings in a Postseason game...the offense recorded 10 hits and was led by Carlos Correa, who went 3-for-4 with a walk, two doubles and three RBI...Kyle Farmer recorded his first career Postseason hit with a second-inning two-run homer...the victory was Minnesota's first in the Division Series since a 2-0 win at New York-AL in Game 1 on October 5, 2004...Minnesota returned to Target Field only to lose Games 3 and 4, ending their season.

SEEING STARS: The Twins went 4-2 against the Astros during the 2023 regular season, going 2-1 at Target Field from April 7-9 (Opening Series) and 2-1 at Minute Maid Park from May 29-31...this was coming off a 2022 season in which they went 0-6 vs. Houston...the Twins are 39-44 all-time against the Astros in the regular season, including a record of 28-35 since Houston joined the American League in 2013.

⊕ In 377 career regular season games at Minute Maid Park, Carlos Correa is hitting .275 (.375-for-1362) with 75 doubles, 64 home runs, 234 RBI, 204 runs scored and an .838 OPS...on this ballpark's all-time list, he ranks seventh in RBI and runs scored, ninth in doubles, tied for ninth in home runs, 10th in hits and 11 in games...since leaving Houston, Correa is just 3-for-29 (.103) against his former team, with one extra-base hit (double), one walk and 12 strikeouts in eight regular season games.

⊕ Alex Kirilloff is hitting .409 (9-for-22) with seven walks, a .567 on-base percentage and a .976 OPS in eight career regular season games vs. Houston.

⊕ Former Astro Christian Vázquez is hitting .315 (34-for-108) with 19 RBI and an .804 OPS in 34 career regular season games vs. Houston...the .315 batting average is his highest against any AL opponent.

HOTELS AND HANDSHAKES: After starting the season 5-7 in their first 12 games away from Target Field, the Twins have gone 10-5 in their last 15 road games...over the 15-game stretch, the Twins have scored 6.1 runs-per-game (91 runs) and hit 19 home runs.

⊕ Carlos Correa has reached safely in 11 straight road games, posting a .391 on-base percentage in that span in his last 36 road games, dating back to August 7, 2023, he is hitting .298 (36-for-121) with a .411 on-base percentage and a .923 OPS...he homered twice in the Twins last road series in Washington D.C.

⊕ Max Kepler has reached safely in 11-straight road games, hitting .382 (13-for-34) with nine RBI and a 1.156 OPS in his last 11 road games.

⊕ Willi Castro is hitting .356 (21-for-59) with nine extra-base hits (6 2B, 2 3B and 1 HR) a .973 OPS in his last 15 road games.

BUSINESS TRIP: Pablo López began the season going 4-3, 3.93 ERA (50.1 IP, 22 ER) with just eight walks, 58 strikeouts, a .237 opponent batting average and seven home runs in his first nine starts from March 28-May 15...in his last two starts (at WSH and vs. TEX), he has combined to go 0-2, 12.10 ERA (9.2 IP, 13 ER) with two walks, 11 strikeouts, a .341 opponent batting average and four home runs allowed...therefore, Pablo decided to wear collared shirts to the ballpark, as he says he packed one for seven of the nine games on this roadtrip, calling the trip "all business." 📌

DON'T STOP RELIEVIN': Over the last nine games, the Twins bullpen has gone 3-0, 1.69 ERA (32.0 IP, 6 ER) with eight walks, 29 strikeouts, a .159 opponent batting average, 11 holds and six saves in six opportunities...their .159 opponent batting average, .230 slugging percentage, .221 on-base percentage and .208 wOBA all lead baseball in that span...additionally, since that date, they have posted a 91.7 mph average pitch velocity, third-best in baseball.

MAX PRODUCTION: Max Kepler drove in a run yesterday afternoon vs. Kansas City, giving him 486 RBI for his career, passing Roy Smalley and moving into sole possession of 13th on the Twins all-time list (since 1961)...he needs five to tie Brian Dozier (491) for 12th.

⊕ Kepler is hitting .330 (35-for-106) with 13 doubles, four home runs, 10 walks, 20 RBI, a .390 on-base percentage, a .566 slugging percentage and a .956 OPS in his last 33 games, dating back to April 22...since that date, he ranks fifth in baseball in batting average, eighth in OPS, 12th in on-base percentage and 13th in slugging percentage.

ROYCE ON REHAB: Royce Lewis is currently on rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul...through four rehab games, Lewis is 3-for-15 with one double, four strikeouts and one stolen base...St. Paul plays at Rochester tonight at 5:45 pm (CT)...Lewis sustained a right quad strain on Opening Day, March 28 at Kansas City, while running the bases...Lewis made his return from the IL (right knee surgery) in 2023 in this ballpark, going 2-for-5 with a home run and four RBI on May 29.

- ☞ Making 12th start of 2024 and 138th of career...last pitched May 26 vs. Texas, allowing six runs on seven hits (1 HR) in 4.2-inning loss, with one walk and six strikeouts; Twins lost, 6-2.
- ☞ Only career regular season start vs. Houston came June 10, 2022; allowed two runs on six hits in 4.1-inning no-decision...also threw 7.0 scoreless innings at Minute Maid Park in Game 2 of 2023 ALDS, earning Minnesota's only win of the series.
- ☞ Sits eight strikeouts shy of 800 in his career...would become the 16th Venezuelan-born pitcher to reach the milestone.

TOUGH START VS. TEXAS: Last pitched May 26 vs. Texas, opposite Gerson Garabito, and took his third-straight loss in Minnesota's 6-2 defeat...allowed six runs on seven hits (2 HR) in 4.2 innings with one walk and six strikeouts...surrendered two home runs to Corey Seager...allowed two runs in the fourth on a HBP and three hits...was pulled with a runner on third and two outs in the fifth; Kody Funderburk entered and allowed an RBI single.

- ☞ Induced seven whiffs on 43 swings (16.3%)...whiff rate has dropped to 27.6 percent, which ranks in MLB's 66th percentile.
- ☞ Allowed seven hard-hit balls (95.0+ mph); Texas went 5-for-7 on those swings, including Seager's two home runs (108.9 and 98.3 mph)...ranks in MLB's 41st percentile with a 39.5 percent hard-hit rate.
- ☞ First time in his career allowing six-or-more earned runs in back-to-back starts...had also never allowed multiple home runs in consecutive starts.
- ☞ Fourth three-start losing streak of career and first since August 29-September 9, 2020.

TWO STARTS AGO: Started May 20 at Washington, opposite Mitchell Parker, and took the loss in Minnesota's 12-3 defeat...allowed seven runs on eight hits (2 HR) in 5.0 innings with one walk and five strikeouts...allowed first two runs on a second-inning home run by Luis García Jr....struck out the side in a 1-2-3 third...Jesse Winker added a solo shot in the fourth...Washington scored four more runs on five hits and a walk in the fifth inning.

- ☞ Seven runs tied for his most allowed in a start with Minnesota (7/15/23 at OAK).
- ☞ Induced nine whiffs on 44 swings (20.5%).
- ☞ Allowed six hard-hit balls; Washington went 2-for-6 with two home runs on those swings.

HOUSTON, WE HAVE A PABLO: Has made one regular season start vs. Houston, on June 10, 2022 at Minute Maid Park; allowed two runs on six hits (1 HR) in 4.1-inning no-decision, with two walks and five strikeouts...also started Game 2 of the 2023 ALDS in Houston, striking out seven in 7.0 scoreless innings with six hits and one walk; earned the win in a 6-2 final, Minnesota's only victory of the series.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Making sixth road start of 2024...has gone 2-2 with a 6.00 ERA (27.0 IP, 18 ER), 1.07 WHIP, 11.33 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings and 2.33 home-runs-per-9.0 innings on the road, compared to 2-3 with a 4.64 ERA (33.0 IP, 17 ER), 1.24 WHIP, 9.55 K/9 and 1.09 HR/9 in six home starts.

- ☞ Has allowed a .270 batting average on balls in play on the road, .344 at home.
- ☞ Has allowed two home runs in both of his last two road starts - May 20 at Washington and April 28 at Los Angeles-AL.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: On May 26, Texas' left-handed hitters went 6-for-15 with a double, two home runs and four strikeouts, while its righties went 1-for-6 with a double, a walk and two strikeouts...through 11 games vs. López, lefties have hit .265 (35-for-132) with a .762 OPS, 26.1 percent strikeout rate and 5.1 percent home run rate, while righties have hit .245 (25-for-102) with a .738 OPS, 29.7 percent strikeout rate and 3.6 percent home run rate.

- ☞ Has allowed a 36.1 percent hard-hit rate to lefties, 44.3 percent to righties.
- ☞ Has a 25.4 percent whiff rate vs. lefties, 30.5 percent vs. righties.

PITCH BREAKDOWN: Has used his typical five-pitch mix thus far in 2024, per Baseball Savant...here's his repertoire through 11 starts:

- ☞ On May 26, Texas went 1-for-5 with three strikeouts vs. López's 4-seamer, with four whiffs on 11 swings (36.4%)...the pitch's 28.6 percent whiff rate ranks 15th out of 132 pitchers (min. 50 PA).
- ☞ Changeup has a career-low 24.5 percent whiff rate, down from 28.4 percent in 2023...pitch has induced zero whiffs on 14 total swings in his last two starts (vs. TEX, at WSH).
- ☞ Sweeper's .280 batting average against compares to .212 expected batting average...its .560 slugging percentage compares to .335 expected slugging.
- ☞ In two-strike counts, opponents have hit .115 (6-for-52) with 28 strikeouts vs. López's 4-seamer...throws the pitch 36.5 percent of the time in those counts.
- ☞ Throws curveball 20.1 percent of the time when ahead in the count...opponents have hit .125 (2-for-16) with 10 strikeouts vs. the pitch in those situations.

KEEP IT DOWN: López's 30.5 percent fly ball rate and 4.4 percent home run rate are both career highs...compare to 25.3 percent and 3.0 percent in 2023...has allowed one-or-more home run in eight of 11 starts this season, and multiple in three starts...average launch angle of 16.1 degrees is also a career high; compares to 12.6 degrees in 2023...his 4-seam fastball has allowed a career-high average launch angle of 27 degrees; compares to 19 degrees in 2023.

- ☞ Among qualified pitchers, López's 1.65 home-runs-per-9.0 innings ranks fourth highest.
- ☞ Allowed seven home runs in May 2023, his most in any month last season.

FEW FREE PASSES: Among qualified MLB pitchers, his 1.50 walks-per-9.0 innings are eighth lowest...ranks in MLB's 92nd percentile with a career-best 4.0 percent walk rate; compares to 6.0 percent in 2023...has issued three total walks in five May starts...has the fourth-highest strikeout-to-walk-ratio (5.22) of the 31 pitchers to start 40-or-more games since the beginning of 2023, trailing only George Kirby (9.48), Zach Eflin (8.21) and teammate Joe Ryan (6.28).

LOOMING MILESTONE: Sits eight strikeouts shy of 800 in his career...would become the 16th Venezuelan-born pitcher to reach the milestone...currently owns a higher career strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.96) than any of the 15 pitchers above him on that list.
