**RECENT REDBIRDS:** The St. Louis Cardinals return home for a nine-game homestand over 10 days against two American League opponents (Boston, May 17-19 & Baltimore, May 20-22) and their National League Central Division rivals, the Chicago Cubs (May 24-26).

**FLIGHT PATTERN:** The Cardinals open today in 5th place in the National League Central, 8.0 games behind first place Milwaukee (26-17) and a half game behind 4th place Cincinnati (19-25). St. Louis has won three of their last four games, but have lost their last four straight games at Busch Stadium dating back to May 4.

**WINNER'S CIRCLE:** Over the upcoming 10 days, the Cardinals next three opponents all have records of .500 or better combining for a .569 winning percentage (74-56).

**ALL EYES ON US:** The Cardinals will be televised nationally three times on this homestand. Sunday, May 19, the Roku Channel will air the Cardinals-Red Sox game with a first pitch time of 12:05 p.m. Central Time. Two games during the Cubs series will air on FOX Saturday Baseball (May 25) and ESPN Sunday Night Baseball (May 26).

**A BEAST VS. THE (A.L.) EAST:** The Cardinals posted the best winning percentage against American League East Division opponents in 2023 with an 11-4 mark (.733). They swept a three-game series against Red Sox at Fenway Park (May 12-14) and won the series at Busch Stadium versus the Blue Jays (2-1) and Yankees (2-1), and on the road at the Rays (2-1) and Orioles (2-1). The Cardinals are 18-13 (.581) against A.L. East opponents under third-year manager **Oliver Marmol**, his best record against any division with the N.L. Central (70-65, .519) ranking second.

**SEVEN YEAR ITCH:** The last time the Boston Red Sox visited Busch Stadium was seven years ago today (May 17, 2017), when they defeated the Cardinals 5-4 in 13 innings in a game that took 4-hours and 20-minutes. The Red Sox have only played five regular season games (3 World Series games in 2013) at Busch Stadium III, 2nd-fewest of any MLB opponent. The Baltimore Orioles have the fewest with three games and will be coming in to town after the Red Sox depart for a three-game series (see chart left).

**GOLD-RUSH:** **Paul Goldschmidt** has hit safely in his last five games and has scored a run in his last four. The run streak is tied for the 2nd-longest by a Cardinals this season trailing **Willson Contreras** (6) who has two other streaks of four runs. Goldschmidt most recently scored in four straight games from July 19-24, 2023 when he ran off five. His longest streak of runs is eight games from May 12-20, 2017, while with Arizona.

**THE GOOD AND THE BAD:** The Cardinals have homered in each of their last four games, one shy of their season-high with five (April 7-12). They have also committed an error in their last three games. St. Louis hasn't posted an error in four straight games since April 23-26, 2023. Habitually a team who exhibits more home runs in May than April, the Cardinals went from 30th in MLB in AB/HR with 49.0 in April, have moved up to 27th in May (44.7 AB/HR). Last season, St. Louis hit 32 longballs in March/April then smashed 44 in May. Currently, the Cardinals have hit 12 home runs over 13 games in May after 20 in 30 games between March and April.

**BIRTHDAY BASH:** The Cardinals are facing Red Sox pitcher **Brayan Bello** on his 25th birthday tonight. He becomes the first starting pitcher to pitch on his birthday at Busch Stadium against the Cardinals since **Esmil Rogers** (26) on Aug. 14, 2011, as St. Louis won 6-2. Rogers allowed four runs over 5.0 innings getting the loss.

**CARDS CITY CONNECT ON DECK:** The Cardinals Nike City Connect Series uniforms will be unveiled on Monday, with the on-field debut scheduled for Saturday, May 25 vs. Chicago.

**WATCH ME (WHIP):** Among qualified Major League pitchers in Interleague play this season, **Kyle Leahy** sports the 4th-lowest (0.32) WHIP, while **Ryan Helsley** has the 5th-lowest (0.33).

**A COMEBACK IS "KEY":** Cardinals reliever **Keynan Middleton** (right forearm flexor strain) continues his injury rehabilitation assignment to Springfield (AA) with his second appearance last night. Middleton's first rehab appearance was cut short by a rain delay after six pitches. Last night, Middleton threw 10 pitches in a scoreless inning against Midland facing three batters.

**Willie McGee** played in 67 games for the Red Sox in 1995, and appeared in the ALDS vs. Cleveland.

**Lars Nootbaar** and **Masataka Yoshida** were teammates on 2023 Gold medal winning Japan in the 2023 World Baseball Classic.

**Nolan Arenado's** older brother, Fernando Jr., goes by his middle name, Cousy (named in honor Boston Celtics guard **Bob Cousy**).

**Ryan Fernandez** was selected from Red Sox in Rule 5 Draft in Dec., 2023...he was 23rd round draft selection by Boston in 2018.

**Nick Robertson** was acquired in trade from Boston 12/8/23 in deal for OF Tyler O'Neill. Appeared in 9 games for the Red Sox in 2023.

**Tommy Edman's** father, **John Edman**, was a four-year starting shortstop at Williams College in Williamstown, Mass. where he was a team captain his final two years...earned a Bachelor of Arts in economics with a concentration in mathematics.

**Chaim Bloom**, Cardinals Advisor to President of Baseball Operations, was the Red Sox Chief Baseball Officer from Oct. 28, 2019 to Sept. 14, 2023.

**Julio Rangel** spent the past two seasons (2021-22) as the Red Sox Minor League Pitching Coord.

**Tyler O'Neill** played parts of six seasons with the Cardinals (2018-23) and co-led the team with 34 HR's in 2021. He won Rawlings Gold Glove Awards in 2020 and 2021 as a Cardinal.

**Tanner Houck** was born in St. Louis...graduated from Collinsville (Ill.) High School...pitched three seasons at the University of Missouri (2015-17).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **John Tudor** pitched his first five MLB seasons in Boston (1979-83)...was selected by the Red Sox in the 3rd round of the 1976 MLB January Draft-Secondary Phase.

Red Sox principal owner **John Henry** was born in Quincy, Ill...spent most of his childhood on the family farm in Forrest City, Ark. where he was a Cardinals fan who grew up listening to Harry Caray, Jack Buck, and Joe Garagiola on the radio...was age nine when he saw his first MLB game at Sportsman's Park in St. Louis.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Chris Carpenter** was born in Exeter, NH...graduated from Trinity High School in Manchester, NH.

**Carlos Villoria** worked for the Cardinals as a Spanish Interpreter for two seasons (2018-19).

**Kyle Hudson**, Red Sox third base coach, played baseball (outfield) & football (wide receiver) at Univ. of Illinois...is from Mattoon, IL.

Bally Sports Midwest reporter **Jim Hayes** attended Emerson College in Boston for one year.

St. Louis defeated Boston in seven games in the 1946 World Series, highlighted by **Enos Slaughter's** 8th inning "mad dash" in Game 7 at Sportsman's Park.

The Cardinals defeated the Red Sox in seven games in the 1967 World Series...**Bob Gibson** (3-0, 1.00 ERA, 26 K) was WS MVP...first WS since 1948 that did not feature the Yankees, Dodgers, or Giants.

St. Louis lost the 2004 WS to Boston in four games.

The Cardinals lost to the Red Sox in six games in the 2013 World Series...marked the first World Series since 1999 to feature both #1 seeds from the AL and NL and first since 1958 to feature two teams with identical regular season records.

- Making his ninth start of the season and as a member of the Cardinals (303rd career start). It's his 11th career start against Boston and first against them at Busch Stadium.
- Has made one other start against an American League team this season holding Detroit (4/30-G1) to one run over 7.0 innings in a no decision.
- Is 1-2 with a 3.41 ERA over six career starts at Busch Stadium regardless of which team he has pitched. First win at the stadium was as a Cardinal vs. ARI (4/24).
- Had his streak of seven consecutive starts pitching 6.0 or more innings, snapped in his last start at MIL (5/11). Was the most by a Cardinals pitcher since 2017 (**Mike Leake** - 11 & **Michael Wacha** - 7).
- Became the 9th active pitcher with 300 or more games started at Detroit (April 30-G1). **Justin Verlander** leads the active list with 513.
- Is one of eight pitchers this season with seven starts of 6.0 or more innings, trailing Seth Lugo (8, KC) for the MLB lead.
- Posted his career-highs for innings pitched (38.0) and strikeouts (29) in the month of April. Tied his most starts with six (also 2021 w/TEX). The 38.0 innings are the 3rd-most for Gibson in any calendar month, most recently tossing 39.1 with the Twins in 2018.
- St. Louis area resident and University of Missouri Baseball alum signed with the Cardinals as a free agent last November. Is one of three free-agent starters (**Sonny Gray** & **Lance Lynn**) that the Cardinals signed this past off-season.
- Joins his fifth Major League team Twins (2013-19), Rangers (2020-21), Phillies (2021-22), Orioles (2023) and Cardinals (2024).

**LAST TIME OUT**

- Registered a no decision in a 5-3 loss to MIL (5/11) tossing 5.0 innings allowing two runs on three hits while matching his season-high four walks with seven strikeouts.
- Threw a season-high 104 pitches and exited with the bases loaded and no outs in the 6th inning as JoJo Romero escaped the jam allowing one inherited runner to score on a hit by pitch.

**CAREER**

- Since 2013, leads active Major League Baseball pitchers in ground into double plays (211). Has allowed 209 career home runs over that period for comparison.
- Has posted a 3.24 ERA (25.0 IP) with **Willson Contreras** behind the plate, the 4th-lowest ERA of any of the 24 catchers he has pitched with in his career.
- Has career marks of 106-102, one of 17 active pitchers with 100 or more wins. Ranks T-11th among active pitchers with 106 wins with Yu Darvish, two behind **Wade Miley** (108) for 10th and three behind **Carlos Carrasco** (109) for 9th.
- Durable starting pitcher, has made 29 or more starts in eight of the last 10 seasons, the most by any MLB pitcher.
- Has posted eight 10-win seasons since his MLB debut in 2013, tied for 4th-most among over that period trailing only **Max Scherzer** (10), **Gerrit Cole** (9) & **Clayton Kershaw** (9).
- One of four pitchers since 2014 to record 100 or more strikeouts in 9-of-10 seasons with **Jacob deGrom**, **Clayton Kershaw** and **Max Scherzer**.

**2024**

- Pitched four straight quality starts (4/19-5/11), tied with **Sonny Gray** for the longest streak by a Cardinals pitcher since **Jordan Montgomery** ran off five straight (6/9-7/2/2023).
