PITTSBURGH PIRATES (14-14) vs. SAN FRANCISCO GIANTS (13-15)

APRIL 28, 2024 at Oracle Park, San Francisco, CA - 1:05 PDT - GAME #29/ROAD #17

RHP JARED JONES (2-2, 2.79 ERA) vs. RHP KEATON WINN (2-3, 3.54 ERA)

THE PIRATES:...improved to 4-0 in extra innings after winning 4-3 last night in 10 innings...Began the season 5-0 for the first time since 1983...Won nine of their first 11 games before losing nine of their next 11 from 4/9-21...Are 3-3 in their last six contests...Are in a stretch that has the team playing 13 straight days before their next scheduled off day on Thursday following their current six-game road trip to San Francisco and Oakland.

KEEPING UP WITH THE JONES': Jared Jones has thrown 5.0-plus innings and allowed three or fewer runs in each of his five career games, matching the most by a Pirates pitcher to start a career...According to the Elias Sports Bureau, the only other Pirates to accomplish that are Nick Maddox (1907), Cy Blanton (1934-35), Pascual Perez (1980-81) and Gerrit Cole (2013).

FROM THE BUREAU: Jared Jones comes into today with 39 strikeouts while allowing just four walks this season...Since 1893 when the mound to plate distance was set at 60'6", the only pitcher before Jones with 35-plus strikeouts and four or fewer walks through his first five MLB games was Masahiro Tanaka (35 strikeouts, two walks allowed in 2014)...Courtesy of the Elias Sports Bureau.

SWINGIN' AND MISSIN': Jared Jones' 98 swings-and-misses are tied for the eighth-most by a pitcher in his first five starts of season since data began being tracked in 2008...The only pitchers with more in that time are Jacob deGrom in 2021 (118), Shane Bieber in 2020 (111), Bieber in 2021 (107), Spencer Strider in 2023 (105), Shane McClellan in 2023 (100), Max Scherzer in 2018 (100) and Chris Sale in 2017 (99)...He's tied with Kevin Gausman in 2022 (98).

START ME UP: Pittsburgh's starting rotation has recorded a 1.67 ERA (32.1ip/6er) in the team's last six games...Pittsburgh's starting rotation ranks sixth in all of MLB in ERA (3.42), fourth in innings pitched (155.1) and 10th in batting average against (.232).

THE ARMS RACE: The Pirates had four pitchers (Paul Skenes, Jared Jones, Anthony Solometo and Bubba Chandler) coming into 2024 ranked among the top 100 prospects in the game according to MLB Pipeline...That's the most top 100 pitching prospects among all organizations...The Reds and Padres have the second-most at three apiece.

EXTRA SPECIAL: Bryan Reynolds' game-winning two-run home run in the 10th inning last night was the second of his career in extra innings...Prior to last night, Reynolds' only other home run in extra innings came on April 30, 2019, in the 11th inning at Texas, which was also the first home run of his big league career.

THE RENEGADE: David Bednar has converted each of his last four save opportunities and comes into today with 66 as a member of the Pirates...Bednar's next save will tie him with Matt Capps for the eighth-most in team history...Since the beginning of last year, Bednar ranks second in all of MLB with 44 saves, trailing only Emmanuel Clase (52).

HEADING ACROSS THE BAY: The Pirates will continue their six-game road trip tomorrow night with the opener of a three-game series against the Athletics...It's Pittsburgh's first trip to Oakland since sweeping a three-game series in 2016...In addition to 2016, Pittsburgh has also played in Oakland in 2004 and 2010.

KE'S TO THE GAME: Ke'Bryan Hayes' home run in the 10th inning Saturday was the first of his career in extra innings...Hayes is now 9-for-27 (.333) in his last seven games.

GO JOE: Connor Joe extended his on-base streak to 11 games after going 2-for-5 last night...Joe's 11-game on-base streak is the longest by a Pirate this season and tied for the fourth-longest active streak among National League players (Nolan Arenado has the longest active streak at 25 games).

LIKING ALIKA: Alika Williams brings an eight-game hitting streak into today, which is the longest by a Pirate this season...Williams is 8-for-24 during his current streak and has been held hitless just once this season.

BAILEY FALTER: The 27-year-old lefthander will make his sixth start of the season tomorrow night against the Athletics...Struck out a career-high tying eight batters, allowed one run in 7.0-plus innings, and won a 2-1 decision against the Brewers in his last start Tuesday night...Had 13 swings and misses on his fastball Tuesday, which were the most by a Pirates lefty since Oliver Perez in 2004 according to StatsPerform...Has recorded a 1.57 ERA (23.0ip/4er) in four starts this month...Opposing hitters are batting .069 (4-for-58) against his four-seam fastball (has thrown the pitch 213 times this season)...Allowed five of his 10 runs this season in the first inning in his first start on 3/31 at Miami.

vs. OAKLAND: 0-1 in one career appearance as a member of the Phillies...He allowed two runs in 2.1 innings of relief on 4/10/22 at Citizens Bank Park.
