AT HOME: The Brewers are 10-8 at home, going 3-2-1 in series play.....the Brewers had a season-high 5-game home winning streak snapped yesterday.

**ON THE ROAD:** The Brewers are 14-8 on the road, going 4-2-1 in series play.....the team has lost its last two road series (1-2 at CHC/1-2 at KC) after going 4-0-1 in its first five.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.....Murphy spent the previous eight seasons (2016-23) as bench coach.....his only Major League managerial experience previously came in 2015 as interim manager of the San Diego Padres (42-54), replacing Bud Black in June of that season.....Murphy enjoyed a 25-year college head coaching career spent primarily at the University of Notre Dame (1988-94) and Arizona State University (1995-2009).

COACHES: First base coach Quintin Berry (4th season), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (2nd season/1st in current role), hitting coach Connor Dawson (3rd season), assistant pitching coach Jim Henderson (3rd season/1st in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (6th season), third base coach Jason Lane (9th season/4th in current role), run prevention coordinator Walker McKinven (5th season/1st in current role) and hitting coach Ozzie Timmons (3rd season) all returned from the 2023 staff..... Rickie Weeks (associate manager), Daniel de Mondesert (assistant coach) and Charlie Greene (bullpen coach) are in their first seasons on the coaching staff, all Major League coaches for the first time.

**LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE**: The Brewers have made eight replay challenges this season, going 5-3.....their last challenge came on 5/11 vs. St. Louis as a safe call at first base involving Masyn Winn stood.

#### TONIGHT'S STARTER: #48 - RHP COLIN REA (7gs, 3-0, 3.29)

**REA AT A GLANCE**: Colin Rea, 33, will be making his eighth start of the season and first against the Pirates.....Rea last started last Tuesday at Kansas City and had no decision in the Brewers' 6-5 win (4.2ip, 7h, 4r, 4er, 1bb, 2k, 65 pitches).....the team is 6-1 in his starts.....has has 2 quality starts.....opponents are batting .242 (37-for-153, 5hr).....Rea is signed through the 2024 season with a club option for 2025.....name is pronounced "RAY."

**LAST SEASON:** Rea went 6-6 with a 4.55 ERA in 26 games/22 starts during five stints with Milwaukee last season.....the team went 14-8 in his starts.....he had 4 quality starts.....opponents batted .235 (110-for-468, 23hr).....he set career highs in wins (6), games (26), starts (22), innings pitched (124.2) and strikeouts (110).

CAREER: Is 17-14 with a 4.57 ERA in 69 games/56 starts (317.1ip, 161er).....has pitched in the majors for San Diego (2015-16), Miami (2016), Chicago-NL (2020) and Milwaukee (2021, '23-24).....is 15-13 with a 4.64 ERA as a starter (290.2ip, 150er) and 2-1 with a 3.71 ERA as a reliever (26.2ip, 11er).....Rea was selected by San Diego in the 12th round of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft out of Indiana State University....he underwent "Tommy John" surgery on 11/11/16, causing him to miss the entire 2017 season.....Rea also pitched in Japan with the Fukuoka SoftBank Hawks in 2021 and 2022.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 4-4 with a 4.41 ERA in 18 games/15 starts (83.2ip, 41er).....is 2-0 with a 3.00 ERA in 3 starts this season (18ip, 6er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 8-6 with a 4.63 ERA in 31 games/23 starts (140p, 72er).....is 1-0 with a 3.54 ERA in 4 starts this season (20.1ip, 8er).
