**NATIONALS HISTORY**  
**MAY 6 (6-10)**  
2007 - For the first time in the rich history of Major League Baseball, six players with the first name "Ryan" (Church, Langerhans, Wagner, Zimmerman, Dempster, Theriot) played in the same game. The Cubs sported just two Ryans, but somehow edged the Nationals, 4-3, in 10 innings at Wrigley Field.

## NATIONALS NEWS

**MOVING ON**  
The Washington Nationals square off against the Minnesota Twins in the second game of this three-game series on Wednesday night...Washington to fell to Minnesota, 11-3, in the opener on Tuesday night.

- In the battle of franchises that have called Washington, D.C. home, the Nationals (2005-pres.) are 6-4 over the Minnesota Twins (1901-60) since 2005 when playing in the nation's capital.
- Following this series, Washington will embark on a six-game, seven-day road trip to Miami this weekend and Cincinnati next Tuesday-Wednesday.

**ROSTER MOVES**  
Nationals recalled right-handed pitcher **Zak Kent** from Triple-A Rochester on Wednesday and optioned right-handed pitcher **Andre Granillo** to Triple-A Rochester on Tuesday.

- Kent, 28, joins the Nationals after he was claimed off waivers from the Minnesota Twins on May 3. He pitched to a 3.38 ERA (4 ER/10.2 IP) with 12 strikeouts for Triple-A St. Paul this season...He converted his only save opportunity with the Saints, working 1.1 innings to close out a win over Lehigh Valley on April 17... A Heathsville, Va., native, Kent saw action in two Major League games with the Twins this season and pitched to a 4.91 ERA (2 ER/3.2 IP) with a pair of strikeouts.

**GOOD WOOD**  
**James Wood** leads Major League Baseball with an average exit velocity of 96.5 MPH ahead of **O'Neil Cruz** (96.2).

- Wood is one of three players Major League Baseball with more than one batted ball greater than 116.0 MPH this season with **Yordan Alvarez** (3) and **O'Neil Cruz** (3).
- Wood's 44 batted balls over 100 MPH rank tied for fifth in Major League Baseball.

**OUT OF THIS WORLD**  
**CJ Abrams** is 9-for-25 (.360) with a double, homer, seven RBI, four walks, two stolen bases and four runs scored over his last seven games...He's reached safely in all seven (.520 OBP) and has hits in five of the seven.

- He ranks among National League hitters in RBI (T5th, 28), on-base percentage (6th, .395) and OPS (10th, .911).

**PITCH PERFECT**  
**Simon Mathews'** pitching staff is tied for second in the National League (5th in MLB) with a 3.00 ERA in 10 games since April 24...The staff has pitched to a 3.89 ERA in 20 games since April 14 after entering play that day with a 6.21 ERA through the first 15 games of the season.

- The starters lead the National League (3rd in MLB) with a 3.00 ERA and rank fourth in the NL (5th in MLB) with a .220 opponents' batting average in nine games since April 24.
- The bullpen has pitched to a 2.36 ERA in eight games since April 26, the third-best mark in the National League.

**SPECIFICALLY...**  
Some pitching performances of note include:

- Foster Griffin** ranks seventh in the National League with a 2.27 ERA, while **Cade Cavalli** ranks 10th in the NL (min. 30.0 IP): with 10.38 strikeouts per 9.0 innings.
- Richard Lovelady** has offered scoreless relief in his last six games (6.0 IP), going 1-0 with a save, two holds, six strikeouts, three walks (all intentional) and five hits allowed.
- Left-handed batters are 3-for-19 (.158) with zero extra-base hits against **Mitchell Parker** this season.
- PJ Poulin** has been The Opener five times...He's allowed just one earned run on five hits with five strikeouts and one walk in 6.1 innings pitched.
- Over his last nine games, **Gus Varland** has pitched to a 1.93 ERA (2 ER/9.1 IP) with three holds, three saves, nine strikeouts and one walk.

**HIGH DEGREE OF DIFFICULTY**  
Per Baseball-Reference.com, the Nationals have the hardest strength of schedule in Major League Baseball with their opponents averaging 0.4 runs per game more than the league average team...Washington has faced 23 teams with a record of .500 or better, tied for the most in Major League Baseball with the Pittsburgh Pirates.

- 13 of the Nationals 17 home games have come against teams .500 or better.
- Washington is 10-13 (.435) against teams .500 or better this season and has already played four teams in the top six in wins in Major League Baseball.

**PRETTY OFFENSIVE**  
The Nationals rank tied for fifth in Major League Baseball (4th in NL) with 183 runs scored this season.

- Washington has scored 33 runs in the first inning, the most in Major League Baseball.
- The Nationals have scored 67 runs in the seventh inning or later, the most in the National League and tied for the second-most in Major League Baseball.
- Washington has scored at least five runs 21 times this season, third-most in Major League Baseball.

## FARM REPORT

**KING ME**  
Harrisburg shortstop **Seaver King** has reached base safely in all 26 games this season, the third-longest streak in Minor League Baseball and the third-longest active streak...He's hitting .304 with a .403 on-base percentage and a .549 slugging percentage this season...He ranks tied for third among Nationals farmhands with 14 extra-base hits, while his .549 slugging and his .952 OPS each rank fourth and his .304 average ranks fifth.
