GENO BOBBLE SATURDAY: The D-backs will give away the **Eugenio Suárez** Bobble, courtesy of Chase, to the first 20,000 fans @ Chase Field on Saturday, April 12.

MORE FIREWORKS!: Friday, April 11 will be the second installment of Postgame Fireworks presented by Seat-Geek themed to boy-band music in conjunction with the Special Event Boy Band Tee Ticket Pack, which includes an exclusive tee featuring Ketel Marte, Corbin Carroll, Gabriel Moreno, Lourdes Gurriel Jr. and Geraldo Perdomo.

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 4-3 last night vs. Orioles.

- Corbin Carroll went 2-for-3 with his first homer @ Chase Field this season (fourth overall) to tie the game in the third inning.
- Josh Naylor went 1-for-3 with a go-ahead double in the fifth inning.
- Merrill Kelly (W; 3 ER in 6.0 IP, 4 K) tossed a quality start on the way to his second win.
- Shelby Miller, A.J. Puk and Justin Martinez (SV, 2) combined for 3.0, 1-hit frames.

FOR A SERIES: With a win today, the D-backs will notch their second series win (also: @ NYY) to improve to 2-1-1.

FREE PASSES: The D-backs 52 walks thru their first 12 games are tied for fourth most in franchise history (also: 2008), behind 2022 (56), 2005 (55) and 2018 (54).

- Arizona's 52 walks rank second in the Majors, behind the Cubs (75).
- The D-backs franchise record for the most walks thru their first 13 games is 59.

BULLPEN PICK UP: In the last 6 games, the D-backs' bullpen has allowed just 1 run over 20.2 innings (0.44 ERA) and owns a 0.68 WHIP, opponent .132 AVG., with 5 walks and 21 strikeouts.

 Since April 3, the D-backs bullpen's 0.44 ERA and 0.68 WHIP are the best in the Majors.

SCORELESS RELIEVERS IN APRIL: Since April 1, D-backs' relievers Jalen Beeks (4.2 IP), Shelby Miller (4.0 IP), Justin Martinez (3.0 IP), Ryne Nelson (5.1 IP) and Bryce Jarvis (2.0 IP) are scoreless and have combined to allow 4 hits with 19 strikeouts.

CARROLL'S STREAK: Corbin Carroll has reached base in each of his first 12 games this season (12 H, 5 BB, 3 HBP)...his on-base streak to start the season is the longest by a D-back since Josh Rojas in 2022 (14 G; May 6-20).

- Dating back to Sept. 23, 2024, Carroll has reached base in 18 straight games, 3 shy of tying his career high of 21 from July 7-Aug. 4, 2024.
- Entering today, 5 players in the Majors had reached base in 12+ straight games to start their respective seasons: Shohei Ohtani/LAD (13 G), Corbin Carroll (12 G), Fernando Tatis Jr./SD (12 G), Vladimir Guerrero Jr./TOR (12 G) and Jacob Wilson/ATH (12 G).

SCORCHING CARROLL: Over his last 5 games, since April 4, Corbin Carroll has 6 extra-base hits (2 doubles, 1 triple, 3 homers)...in the span, is slashing .421 AVG/.500 OBP/1.105 SLG/1.605 OPS.

CARROLL AT THE TOP: Corbin Carroll ranks among the Majors in the leadoff spot (min. 20 PA) in SLG (1st, .867, ahead of S. Ohtani-LAD/.600), OPS (1st, 1.261, ahead of P. Goldschmidt-NYY/1.055), isolated (raw) power [SLG-minus-AVG] (1st, .533, ahead of K. Schwarber-PHI/.346), home run rate (1st, 12.1%, ahead of K. Schwarber-PHI/9.4%) and extra-base hits (1st, 7, ahead of S. Ohtani-LAD/6).

TEAM OFFENSE: Among the Majors, the D-backs are tied for first with 27 doubles with Red Sox, second with 52 walks (behind 75 Cubs), fourth with 42 extra-base hits (behind 47 Yankees, 45 Cubs, 44 Dodgers) and tied for fifth with 63 runs with Dodgers (behind Cubs 94, Yankees 78, Cardinals 71, Red Sox 66).

OFFENSE VS. RELIEVERS: The D-backs' offense vs. relievers ranks among the league in AVG (1st, .282), OBP (2nd, .378), OPS (2nd, .814), SLG (4th, .436), doubles (T-4th, 10), walks (T-5th, 24), hits (6th, 44) and runs (6th, 32).

GENO CHASING 30: With a homer vs. Orioles, Eugenio Suárez will have homered against every MLB team in his 12-year career...he would become the second D-back on the current roster to homer vs. all teams, joining Randal Grichuk.

ON DECK - MILWAUKEE BREWERS: Following Thursday's off day, the D-backs welcome the Brewers to Chase Field.

- Since 2022, the D-backs are 12-8 vs. Brewers (6-4 @
- Arizona has won 4 of its last 5 games vs. Milwaukee, dating back to Sept. 15, 2024.

NEXT STARTER: LHP EDUARDO RODRIGUEZ (0-1, 6.10)

- · Will make his second home start this season (third overall)...made last start on April 5 @ Nationals (L; 4 ER in 5.0 IP).
- In 2 career starts vs. Brewers, is 0-1 with a 2.45 ERA (3 ER in 11.0 IP).
- Made his last start vs. Brewers on Sept. 13, 2024 @ Chase Field (L; 2 ER in 5.0 IP, 5 H, 7 K).

LAST START: Earned the win in his last start on April 4 @ Nationals (W; 4 ER in 6.0 IP, 0 BB, 4 K).

VS. ORIOLES: Made his lone start @ Oriole Park at Camden Yards on May 10, 2024 (L; 3 ER in 6.0 IP).

VS. AL EAST: Has made 4 career starts vs. AL East opponents...is looking for his first win against an opponent in the division.

MAKE YOU CHASE: His 35.2 chase pct. ranks 10th among MLB qualified starting pitchers.

STRIKE THROWER: His 67.5 strike pct. ranks 10th among NL qualified starting pitchers and fourth among NL righties (behind Hunter Greene-CIN/74.1, Spencer Schwellenbach-ATL/69.3 and Paul Skenes-PIT/67.7).

CHANGING IT UP: Is throwing his changeup 23.1% and limiting hitters to a .222 AVG (2-for-9).

2024 RECAP: Went 11-10 with a 4.71 ERA (103 R-95 ER in 181.2 IP), opponent .259 AVG (183-for-707), 42 walks and 185 strikeouts over 32 starts in his second season with the D-backs.

CAREER-BEST SCORELESS INNINGS STREAK: Recorded a career-best 16.2 scoreless-innings streak over 4 starts from July 6-July 27, 2024.
