RECENT REDBIRDS: The Cardinals continue their seven-game homestand tonight with the second game of a three-game series against the division-rival Milwaukee Brewers...Colorado and St. Louis face off for the first time in 2019 when the Rockies visit Busch for four-games during Hall of Fame and Players Weekend...Winners of eight of its last 10 and a .629 Post All-Star win pct. (3rdbest in the NL), St. Louis enters play today in 1st place in the National League Central, 0.5 games ahead of Chicago (66-58).

BADER RECALLED, AROZARENA OPTIONED: The Cardinals today recalled outfielder Harrison Bader from Memphis (AAA) and optioned rookie outfielder Randy Arozarena to the triple-A club. Bader batted .317 (20-for-63) with a 1.125 OPS, 7 home runs and 15 RBI in 16 games with Memphis. The right-handed hitting Bader, who was optioned to Memphis on July 29, had hit safely in his last nine games (.400; 14-for-35) and homered in three of his past four.

BREW CREW BASHERS: St. Louis has defeated Milwaukee in its last five games (April 17-present) and four straight at Busch Stadium. The last time St. Louis won six consecutive games over the Brew Crew was July 28-August 16, 2007, one shy of the franchise record of 7 (July 4-October 2, 2001). The last time St Louis won five in a row at home vs. Milwaukee was July 28, 2007-April 16, 2008.

HOME SWEET HOME: The Cardinals conclude the season by playing 23 of their final 39 games at Busch Stadium (including 14 over 17-game stretch), where they are 35-23 with a .603 home win pct. ranking 4th in the NL. Only the Mets (55) have played fewer home games than St. Louis this season in all of MLB.

MOLINA MILESTONES: According to Elias, last night marked the 149th career shutout when Yadier Molina starts at catcher, 4th-most in the modern era (since 1900) in Major League history, trailing Yogi Berra (184), Gary Carter (168), and Carlton Fisk (157). The Cardinals backstop needs one double to pass Gary Carter (372) for 10th all-time among MLB catchers, four RBI for 900 in his career, and six games at catcher to tie Benito Santiago (1,917) for 11th in MLB history.

BLANKETY BLANK: The Cardinals hurled their 8th shutout of the season last night and their MLB-leading 4th in August (3 in their last 7 games). Last night also marked the first time since 2013 the club recorded a pair of one-hitters (also Aug. 1 vs. Chicago): May 10 vs. Colorado (Shelby Miller-9.0) and Sept. 24 vs. Washington (Michael Wacha-8.2 & Trevor Rosenthal-0.1).

TAKING CARE OF BUSINESS: The Cardinals are 32-22 in divisional play this season, and have won 16 of 22 over divisional opponents since the All-Star Break. Their .593 divisional winning pct. trails the Dodgers (.667, 36-18 vs. NL West) and Braves (.667, 32-21 vs. NL East) among NL teams.

WE'RE GOING STREAKING: Paul DeJong (.425, 17-40, 4 HR) is riding a 10game hit streak vs. Milwaukee this season (March 29-present), MLB's 2nd-lon-

gest active streak trailing only Dustin Pedroia's 11-gamer (May 17, 2008-May 11, 2017). The longest hit streak vs. the Brewers by a Cardinal is 19 shared by Allen Craig (April 13, 2013-July 13, 2014) and Albert Pujols (3/31/03-4/8/04).

AND NOW, DEEP THOUGHTS: Paul Goldschmidt has hit six of his team-leading 28 home runs against the Brewers this season. Goldy's six home runs against Milwaukee trail only Cincinnati's Eugenio Suarez (8) in MLB this season, and are tied for his 3rd-most vs. any opponent in a season (8 vs. the Dodgers in 2015; 7 vs. Pirates in 2019; 6 vs. the Dodgers in 2013). Albert Pujols holds the Cardinals single-season record of homers vs. the Brewers (8 in 2010). The Cardinals sport a 19-7 record when Goldy goes deep this season, with 15 of his 28 homers (53.6%) giving St. Louis a tie or the lead.

MATT CARPENTER FIELD DEDICATION: The Cardinals, in conjunction with Cardinals Care, the City of Pagedale, and Beyond Housing, will dedicate Matt Carpenter Field at 9:30 a.m. on Thursday, August 22 at the Pagedale Family Support Center. Located in nearby Pagedale, the professionally designed field is the result of a six-figure investment by Cardinals Care that includes a graded and irrigated playing field, two paved and covered dugouts, bleachers, fencing, and a state-of-the art solar powered scoreboard. The field will play an integral role in teaching Redbird Rookies participants the values of teamwork, integrity, self-esteem, and leadership. Matt Carpenter Field is the 24th field dedicated by Cardinals Care since its inception in 1997

MILWAUKEE CONNECTIONS

Paul DeJong graduated from nearby Antioch (III.) High School...resides in Hazelhurst, Wisc.

Marcell Ozuna was a Marlins teammate of Brewers outfielder Christian Yelich (2013-17).

Dexter Fowler and **Jordan Lyles** were traded for each other during the 2013-14 offseason (Dec. 3, 2013)...Colorado sent Fowler to Houston for Lyles and outfielder **Brandon Barnes**.

Yadier Molina hit his first Major League home run off Milwaukee's Matt Wise (Sept. 23, 2004).

Tyler Webb pitched for Brewers in two games in 2017...claimed off waivers by San Diego (April 2018).

Cardinals Pitching Coach Mike Maddux previously served as the Brewers Pitching Coach from 2003-08...oversaw Brewers staff that ranked 2nd in the NL with a 3.85 ERA in 2008, lowest mark by a Milwaukee club in 16 years, en-route to securing the Brewers' first postseason berth in 26 years.

Devin Williams was born in Florissant. Mo. and resides in Maryland Heights...was First Team Rawlings/Perfect Game Preseason High School All-American as a senior at Hazelwood West High School in 2013...committed to the University of Missouri before being selected by Milwaukee in the 2nd round of the 2013 MLB Draft.

Cardinals Hall of Famer, broadcaster and Special Assistant **Jim Edmonds** played in 73 games for Milwaukee in 2010.

Cardinals Director of Medical Operations/Head Athletic Trainer **Adam Olsen** is a native of Green Bay, Wisc...earned his Master's in Physical Therapy from The University of Wisconsin-Madison.

Cardinals Special Assistant to the GM, Player Procurement **Matt Slater** started in professional baseball serving as the Brewers' Scouting and Player Development Assistant (1991).

Cardinals Hall of Fame catcher Ted Simmons played 13 seasons with St. Louis (1968-80), where he was a six-time NL All-Star and 1980 Silver Slugger Award winner...later traded by St. Louis with pitchers Rollie Fingers and Pete Vuckovich to Milwaukee for outfielders David Green and Sixto Lezcano and pitchers Dave LaPoint and Lary Sorensen...played five seasons with the Brewers (1981-85), where he was a two-time AL All-Star and faced off against the Cardinals in the 1982 World Series.

Brewers broadcaster Bob Uecker played two seasons (1964-65) with St. Louis...won the 1964 World Series...originally traded by the Milwaukee Braves to St. Louis for catcher Jimmie Coker and outfielder Gary Kolb (April 9, 1964).

Brewers broadcaster ${f Jeff}$ Levering previously worked three seasons (2010-12) as broadcaster for the Springfield Cardinals (AA).

- Is making his first start at home since 6/21 outing vs. LAA, a 5-1 win. Six of his last seven appearances (4 starts, 2 relief) have come on the road. Provided 4.2 relief innings in his last appearance (7/27 vs. HOU) on the Busch Stadium mound
- Is 5-6 with a 5.40 ERA in 16 starts and 1-0 with a 5.68 ERA in five relief appearances. However, he is 1-0 with a 1.54 ERA in his last four relief appearances following a six-run outing (1.0 IP) in his first relief appearance of the season at PHI (5/29).
- Is 4-5, 5.40 ERA in 11 road starts (14 app.) and 2-1, 5.51 ERA in five starts (7 app.) at Busch Stadium in 2019.

- Has returned to the starting rotation twice this season after being sent to the bullpen; first on June 10 at Miami after two appearances out of the bullpen and last Thursday (8/15) after three relief appearances (7/19-27).
- Went 2-2 with a 2.84 ERA (25.1 IP) and 17 strikeouts in five June games (four starts).
 Was the 13th-lowest ERA in the NL and the lowest June ERA in his career.
- Is averaging 6.01 run support average, which would lead St. Louis and rank 9th in the National League, but does not have enough qualifying innings.
- Has thrown 3.0 innings or more in each of his last two relief appearances with the most recent tossing 4.2 innings vs. HOU (7/27) holding the Astros to one run on six hits.
- Earned the win at CIN (7/19) tossing 1.2 scoreless innings as the Cardinals rallied from a 7-0 deficit with 10 runs in the 6th inning for a 12-11 win. It was his first relief win since 8/19/13 at MIL, and the Cardinals largest comeback win since 2002 (8 runs at CIN).
- Threw a season-high 7.0 innings at SD (6/28) allowing two runs in a 3-1 Cardinals loss at PETCO Park; his longest outing since tossing 8.0 scoreless innings vs. PIT on June 3, 2018 at Busch Stadium after carrying a no-hitter into the 9th inning.
- Allowed one run over 6.0 frames in the Cardinals 5-1 win vs. LAA (6/21). Was his longest home start of the season. Marked his first Interleague win at home since 6/16/15 vs. Minnesota. Earned his 31st career win at Busch Std III, moving past Kyle Lohse into sole possession of 5th place.
