TONIGHT’S TILT...the Mariners begin a 3-city, 10-game road trip with the 1st of 3 games against the Kansas City Royals...will also travel to Oakland (4 G, 9/20-9/23) and Los Angeles-AL (3 G, 9/24-9/26)...tonight’s game will be televised on **ROOT SPORTS NW**, as well as broadcast on **710 ESPN** and the **Mariners Radio Network**.

ODDS AND ENDS...the Mariners have won 8 of their last 14 games and 9 of their last 16...are 19-13 over their last 32 games, 20-14 over their last 34, 22-19 over their last 41, 27-22 over their last 49, 33-26 over their last 59, 44-32 over their last 76, 47-33 over their last 80 and 57-42 over their last 99...are 31-22 in day games and 47-46 at night...are 42-33 at T-Mobile Park and 36-35 on the road...are 62-25 when scoring at least 4 runs and 16-43 when scoring 3 or fewer runs...are 50-9 when out-hitting their opponent.

- Series Openers** - The Mariners are 28-19 (.596) in series openers this season.
- Series Record** - The Mariners own a 15-9-2 series record since June 14, winning or splitting 17 of their last 26...the Mariners own a 23-19-5 overall series record.

2023 ALL-STAR GAME...Baseball Commissioner Robert D. Manfred, Jr. announced yesterday that Major League Baseball has awarded the 2023 All-Star Game and accompanying All-Star Week festivities to the Seattle Mariners...marks the third time in franchise history that the Mariners will host the Midsummer Classic, joining the 1979 contest at the Kingdome, when the National League claimed a 7-6 win, and the 2001 event at T-Mobile Park, when the American League earned a 4-1 victory.

SWEET SIXTEEN...the Mariners have 16 games remaining in the regular season...they begin a 3-game series with Kansas City before finishing the season with 13 consecutive games against American League West Division opponents...the Mariners are 37-26 (.587) against their division this season.

FLEXEN ON THE ROAD...Chris Flexen is 3-0 with a 2.58 ERA (11 ER, 38.1 IP) in 6 road starts since the All-Star Break...he’s walked 8 and struck out 29...his 2.58 road ERA in the 2nd half ranks 4th-best in the American League among pitchers with at least 30 IP...Flexen trails Lucas Giolito-CWS (1.64), Jordan Montgomery-NYY (2.02) and Lance McCullers Jr.-HOU (2.08)...Marco Gonzales ranks 5th in the AL with a 2.91 road ERA in that span.

KAUFFMAN KINGS...Seattle has won 6 consecutive games at Kauffman Stadium since April 10, 2018...the Mariners swept a 4-game series at Kansas City in the clubs’ most recent meeting at the Royals home ballpark from April 8-11, 2019...the Mariners outscored the Royals in that series 32-19...Seattle’s offense batted .340 (53x156) with 9 home runs over those 4 contests.

D THE Z...since August 1, the Mariners pitching staff has the fewest walks (103) and 2nd-lowest walks-per-9 innings (2.47) in the Majors trailing only Toronto (2.45)...in 41 games since August 1, the Mariners pitching staff has the 2nd-highest strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.25) trailing only Toronto (3.78) and the 5th-lowest WHIP (1.25) in the American League.

AWESOME IN AUTUMN...Mitch Haniger is batting .302 (16x53) with 10 runs scored, 4 home runs, 10 RBI and 7 walks in 13 September games...he’s reached base safely in 12 of his last 13 games and hit safely in 10 of his last 13...he’s gotten on-base at a .383 clip, slugging .528 with a .912 OPS since in that span...in 87 career September games, Haniger is batting .307 (102x332) with 52 runs, 17 doubles, 3 triples, 18 home runs, 43 RBI and 28 walks...he is the first Mariners player to score 100 runs in a season since Robinson Canó scored 107 in 2016 and the first Mariners outfielder to score 100 in a season since Ichiro Suzuki scored 103 in 2008.

MAJOR SEAG POWER HITTER...Kyle Seager went 1-for-4 with a double and 2 RBI on Wednesday vs. Boston...the double was his 558th extra-base hit in a Mariners uniform, passing Jay Buhner for 3rd-most extra-base hits in franchise history...Seager has 34 home runs and 96 RBI this season, currently on pace to finish with 38 homers and 107 RBI...he is 3 RBI away from matching his season-high 99 RBI in 2016...he is 4 RBI away from becoming the first Mariners player with at least 100 RBI in a season since Nelson Cruz had 119 RBI in 2017.

SECOND-HALF SEAGS...Kyle Seager has 18 home runs and 46 RBI since the All-Star Break...the 18 home runs are tied for 2nd-most in the American League since the break with Jorge Polanco-MIN, trailing only Salvador Perez-KC (24)...the 46 RBI are 3rd-most behind Perez (59) and Teoscar Hernández-TOR (55)...Seager’s 30 walks in that span are tied for 4th-most in the AL.

MULTI-HIT JARRED...Jarred Kelenic went 2-for-4 with 2 runs scored in his last game...it was his 12th multi-hit game of the season...he is batting .235 (12x51) with 8 runs, 2 doubles, 3 home runs, 8 RBI, 3 walks and 2 stolen bases in 13 September games.

ON BASE AT THE TOP...J.P. Crawford has reached base safely in 14 of his last 15 games, hitting safely in 12 of 15...he’s batting .317 (19x60) with 14 runs, 3 doubles, 2 home runs, 9 RBI and 10 walks in that span, getting on-base at a .408 clip, slugging .467 with an .875 OPS and 147 wRC+ since August 30.

ONE-RUN GAMES...Seattle has played 49 games this season decided by 1 run, most in the American League and tied for 3rd-most in the Majors with Philadelphia, trailing New York-NL (59) and Atlanta (51)...the Mariners are 31-18 in 1-run games, with their 31 one-run wins leading the Majors and their .633 winning percentage ranking 2nd in the AL and 3rd in the Majors to Los Angeles-AL (.697/23-10) and San Francisco (.643/27-15)...the franchise record for most 1-run games in a season is 60, with the 2016 Mariners going 30-30 that season.

PITCHES PER PLATE APPEARANCE...Seattle batters are averaging 3.99 pitches per plate appearance this season, 2nd-most in the Major Leagues...the New York Yankees lead MLB with 4.09 pitches per plate appearance...San Francisco (3.97), Detroit (3.96) and the Chicago White Sox (3.94) round out the top five.

WINNING MONTHS...the Mariners are 7-6 in September...they finished August 15-13 (.536), their 3rd straight winning month...the Mariners went 14-12 (.538) in June and 14-10 (.583) in July...Seattle last recorded 3 consecutive winning months from March/April-June 2017...this season, the Mariners have put together a winning record in 4 of 5 months...they went 15-12 (.556) in April and 13-15 (.464) in May...the Mariners have put together a winning record in 5 of their last 6 months, going 12-11 (.522) in Sept. 2020.

AS YOU KNOW...Casey Sadler has not allowed a run over his last 22 appearances since July 27...the streak has spanned 19.2 innings, with Sadler walking 4 and striking out 16 during the streak...opponents are batting just .143 (9x63) against him in that stretch, but...DID YOU KNOW?...that Sadler’s 22-outing scoreless streak is tied for 2nd-longest in Mariners history?...Lucas Luetge went 22 consecutive appearances without allowing a run from Apr. 17-June 15, 2012...Ed Vande Berg went 22 consecutive appearances without allowing a run from Aug. 30, 1982-Apr. 16, 1983...Luetge, Vande Berg and now Sadler trail only Shigetoshi Hasegawa’s franchise record 25-game scoreless streak...Hasegawa did not allow a run in 25 consecutive appearances from June 3-Aug. 17, 2003.

ABOUT FLEXEN...

- 27-year-old right-hander is making his 39th career start (55th appearance), his 28th start of 2021 and 1st career start against the Royals
- Signed with the Mariners as a free agent, agreeing on a 2-year contract with an option for 2023 on Dec. 18, 2020.
- Was originally selected by the Mets in the 14th round of the 2012 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Newark Memorial (CA) High School... made his Major League debut with New York-NL on July 27, 2017 at San Diego.
- Graduated from Newark Memorial High School (CA) in 2012... played 4 years of baseball and was a quarterback on the football team for 2 years.....was committed to Arizona State University before signing with the Mets.
- Appeared in parts of 8 minor league seasons with Mets organization (2012-19)...overall, went 43-31 with a 3.61 ERA (236 ER, 588.0 IP) with 192 walks and 513 strikeouts in 122 games (105 starts)...in 2013, was named Topps Appalachian Player of the Year.
- In his Mariners debut on April 3, 2021, became the 900th Seattle Mariners player in franchise history.
- Recorded his 100th career strikeout when he struck out Cavan Biggio on 6/29 against Toronto (in Buffalo).

**LAST OUTING...**L #6 in last start on 9/11 vs. Arizona...gave up 5 runs on 6 hits and 2 walks in 5.0 innings of work with 4 strikeouts...4 of the runs came in the 4th inning with the Diamondbacks getting 5 hits in the inning including a 2-run homer...marks just the 3rd time he has allowed more than 3 runs in 15 starts at T-Mobile Park this season.

**DISTINGUISHED COMPANY...**Flexen is the 13th pitcher in franchise history to record a 10-win season in their first season with the Mariners joining Floyd Bannister (1979), Gaylord Perry (1982), Matt Young (1983), Mark Langston (1984), Tim Belcher (1995), Sterling Hitchcock (1996), Jeff Fassero (1997), Freddy Garcia (1999), Aaron Sele (2000), Miguel Batista (2007), Joe Saunders (2013) and Roenis Elias (2014)...tied with Batista (20 GS) for the 3rd fastest to achieve the feat behind Aaron Sele (17 GS) and Freddy Garcia (19 GS).

**WINNER...**the Mariners are 18-9 (.667) in Flexen's 27 starts this season...posted a career-best 4-game winning streak, June 15-July 16...went 4-0, 1.36 (39.2 IP, 6 ER) in 6 starts during the streak...struck out 29 while walking just 8 and has limited opposing hitters to a .200 BAA...his previous career-best winning streak was 3 games (4/24-5/14/21).

**LATELY...**Flexen is 1-2 with a 3.56 ERA (19 ER, 48.0) with 38 strikeouts and 12 walks over his last 8 starts dating back to August 2...his 3.56 ERA during that span is 11th best in the American League.

**BIRTHDAY MONTH...**went 3-2 with a 3.38 ERA (11 ER, 29.1 IP) in 5 starts in July...walked 5 and struck out 17 in the month.

**ONE AND DONE...**has recorded 10 games this season where he has tallied at least 6.0 innings while allowing 1 earned run or fewer, tied for 3rd most in the American League (also: Nathan Eovaldi and Lance Lynn-CHW) behind Gerrit Cole (NYY) who has had 12 such starts and Robbie Ray (TOR) who has 11.

**CAREER DAY...**earned win #6 this season against Minnesota after setting career highs in innings pitched, strikeouts and (then) pitches thrown... went 8.0 scoreless IP, allowing 4 hits, striking out 8 without walking a batter...26 BF in 8.0 IP...threw 107 pitches, 77 for strikes.

**FIRST 11 AT HOME...**Flexen went 6-3 with a 1.89 ERA (14 ER, 66.2 IP) in his first 11 home starts with the Mariners (April 3-July 22)...his 1.89 ERA was the lowest in club history through a player's first 11 home starts of a season, ranking ahead of Félix Hernández (2.09 in 2014) and James Paxton (2.15 in 2017).

**FIRST WIN...**earned his first win as a Mariner in his first Mariners start, tossing 5.0 scoreless innings with 2 walks and 6 strikeouts on April 3 vs. San Francisco...became first Mariners pitcher to throw 5.0+ scoreless innings in his debut with the team since LH Wade LeBlanc threw 6.0 scoreless IP on June 24, 2016 in his Mariners debut in a 4-3 win vs. St. Louis...marked Flexen's first win in the Majors in 1,319 days (Oct. 1, 2017 w/New York-NL at Philadelphia).

**DOMINATING THE KBO...**spent 2020 season with Doosan Bears in the Korean Baseball Organization and went 8-4 with a 3.01 ERA (39 ER 116.2 IP) with 30 walks and 132 strikeouts over 21 starts...struck out 28% of batters faced, the 4th-highest rate in the KBO.

**PLAYOFF MVP...**posted a 1.91 ERA (6 ER, 28.1 IP) in the KBO playoffs, while pitching in both starting and relieving rolls.. named series MVP of the semi-finals after tossing 10.1 innings and allowing 2 earned runs with 13 strikeouts in one start and one relief appearance...started Game 1 for Doosan and tossed 7.1 IP of 2-run ball...came out of the bullpen in Game 4 on 3 days rest and tossed 3.0 scoreless IP.

**#100...**tallied his 100th strikeout of the season on 9/5 at Arizona when he got David Peralta swinging to end the 1st inning.

**RACKKKK 'EM UP...**tallied 10+ strikeouts in 4 starts while pitching for Doosan in the Korean Baseball Organization during the 2020 season...ended the season with back-to-back games of 10+ Ks (10/20 at Lotte: 12 K & 10/27 vs. Hanwha: 10 K)...tallied a season-high 13 strikeouts on 9/22 at Hanwha.

**W#1...**earned his first career Major League win with the Mets on Aug. 8, 2017 vs. Texas.

30-year-old left-hander is scheduled to make his 28th start of the season, his 69th Major League start and his 2nd against Kansas City this season...ND on 9/12 vs. ARI (5.0,6,1,1,1,8,0 HR)...L #8 in start on 9/6 at HOU (1.2,3,6,4,4,0,1 HR)...ND on Aug. 31 vs. HOU, tossing 7.0 shutout innings allowing 4 hits and a walk while striking out 4...named to 2021 ASG, but did not pitch...has 14 quality starts and a .236 (134x569) opponent batting average against...has struck out at least 10 batters 3x this season: 4/2 vs. SF (6.0,6,3,3,1,10,2HR), 5/11 at LAD (6.1,6,3,3,1,11,HR) & 7/23 vs. OAK (6.0,6,3,3,1,12,2HR)...**Historic Debut...**with his start March 21, 2019 at Oakland in the Tokyo Dome, became the first Japanese-born player to make his Major League debut in Japan...was just his second career start (3rd appearance) as a professional in the Tokyo Dome...while with the Seibu Lions, started against the Yomiuri Giants on June 8, 2018 at the Tokyo Dome; earned the win, going 7.0 scoreless innings and scattering 2 hits and 3 walks while striking out 3...in 2011, made a 1.0-inning relief appearance against the Giants in a preseason game...vs. KCR allowed 4 runs in 5.0 innings in his only start this season against the Royals on 8/26/21.
