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BIRDLAND BITES: The Orioles continue a nine-game road trip this afternoon against the Cardinals (2-0, 1 to play), Athletics (3 to play), and Rockies (3 to play)...The Birds are coming off a 2-4 homestand, having been swept by the Yankees before taking two of three from the Rays... The O's are in fourth place in the AL East and 2.5 games behind the Guardians for the final Wild Card spot.

- ⚾ **Christian Encarnacion-Strand** (4-for-4, 2 2B, R, 2 RBI) matched a career high with four hits (also 8/30/23 at SF)...His two doubles matched a career high (also 4/15/24 at SEA)... Last night marked his fourth career go-ahead RBI in the ninth inning or later, including his first since hitting a walk-off double on June 6, 2025 vs. Arizona...In seven career games against the Cardinals, he is 11-for-30 (.367) with two doubles, two home runs, eight RBI, and a 1.058 OPS.
- ⚾ After scoring eight runs last night and 13 runs in the series opener, Baltimore has plated 8+ runs on the road in consecutive games for the second time this year, joining June 4-5...The O's last scored 8+ runs in three straight away games from September 6-9, 2023.
- ⚾ **Pete Alonso** hit his MLB-best 15th opposite field home run, outpacing CIN's Sal Stewart and WSH's James Wood (both 13)...The 15 such homers are the third most in a season by an Oriole in the Statcast era (since 2015), trailing Chris Davis (17, 2016) and Trey Mancini (16, 2019).
- ⚾ Today, Baltimore looks for its first three-game sweep of St. Louis since the clubs first met in 2003...The Birds can earn a third consecutive win over the Cardinals for the second time, joining June 17, 2017-May 10, 2022.

ROGER THAT: Over his last 14 starts, **Trevor Rogers** is 7-2 with a 2.57 ERA (24 ER/84.0 IP) and 1.05 WHIP...He has nine quality starts during that period, with the O's going 10-4 in those outings.

- ⚾ Among 52 MLB pitchers who have thrown at least 75.0 innings during that period, his 2.57 ERA is ninth lowest in the majors and fourth lowest in the AL behind TOR's Dylan Cease (1.86), DET's Troy Melton (1.89), and NYY's Cam Schlichter (2.42).
- ⚾ During the 14-start stretch, he has permitted six homers (0.64 HR/9.0 IP), including zero multi-homer games, after allowing eight home runs (three multi-HR games) over his first 10 starts (1.48 HR/9.0 IP).

POLAR VORTEX: **Pete Alonso** has recorded 1+ RBI and 1+ run in each of his last five road games, becoming the first Oriole to accomplish the feat since **Jackson Holliday** (6 G) from August 2-8, 2024.

- ⚾ Alonso has hit safely in each of his last 11 road games, batting .548 (23-for-42) with three doubles, seven home runs, 16 RBI, and seven walks against six strikeouts.
- ⚾ It is tied for the second-longest active road hitting streak in MLB, trailing ATH's Tyler Soderstrom (12 G) and marks the second-longest such streak of his career, trailing a 17-game run from August 16-September 22, 2021.
- ⚾ In 22 career games at Busch Stadium, Alonso is slashing .363/.463/.788 (29-for-80) with seven doubles, nine home runs, 22 runs, 20 RBI, and 12 walks.
- ⚾ He enters play today with 91 RBI, tied for the AL lead HOU's Yordan Alvarez...Alonso looks to become the eighth player in franchise history (since 1954) to lead the AL in RBI, joining Chris Davis (138 RBI, 2013), Miguel Tejada (150 RBI, 2004), Eddie Murray (78 RBI, 1981), Lee May (109 RBI, 1976), Frank Robinson (122 RBI, 1966), Brooks Robinson (118 RBI, 1964), and Jim Gentile (141 RBI, 1961).
- ⚾ Through 23 games in August, Alonso is slashing .391/.448/.736 (34-for-87) with three doubles, nine home runs, 22 RBI, and a 1.184 OPS...The .391 batting average would signal his highest in any month of his career (min. 25 AB in month), surpassing April 2025 (.358, 34-for-95)...His career high for hits in a month came in August 2025 (36).

PLAYING THE LONG GAME: The Orioles have homered in 14 straight games, the longest active streak in the majors ahead of the Cardinals and Yankees (both 9 G)...It marks Baltimore's longest streak since going deep in 16 straight from August 4-21, 2024.

- ⚾ Baltimore has homered in a season-high-tying eight straight road games (also 4/17-5/2)...The Birds have not homered in nine straight road games in a single season since an 11-game stretch from August 4-27, 2024.
- ⚾ The O's have hit multiple home runs in eight of their last 10 road games (21 HR total).
- ⚾ Overall, the Birds have hit 29 homers since August 9, second most in MLB behind the Cubs (31).

'PEN PALS: **Cam Sanders** has not permitted a hit in each of his last five appearances, tied for the second-longest active streak in the majors behind NYM's Nate Lavender (6 G).

- ⚾ Sanders has not allowed a hit to any of the last 21 batters he has faced...According to *STATS Perform*, it is the longest active streak in MLB.
- ⚾ **Yennier Cano** has gone 44 consecutive appearances (33.2 IP) without allowing a home run...It is the fourth-longest active streak among all MLB relievers behind MIL's Trevor Megill (60 G), CLE's Colin Holderman (51 G), and LAD's Edgardo Henriquez (46 G).
- ⚾ **Alex Hoppe** has not allowed a hit in a career-best four straight appearances and has not permitted a run across 7.1 innings since making his club debut on August 5.

NIP AND TUCK: The Orioles are 42-45 (.483) in games decided by three runs or fewer, the fifth-most such games in the league this season and 20th in winning percentage in those situations this year.

- ⚾ Despite owning a 14-19 (.424) in one-run affairs this season, the Birds are 4-1 in their last five such games since August 14.

PINCH ME: The Orioles lead MLB with 34 pinch-hit RBI this season, ahead of the Nationals (27)...The O's are one of six teams in the majors this year with at least six pinch-hit home runs, led by the Nationals (8).

- ⚾ **Tyler O'Neill** is one of five players in the majors with at least three pinch-hit homers this year, along with CHC's Michael Conforto (4) and CWS' Randal Grichuk, MIA's Heriberto Hernández, and PHI's Derek Hill (all 3)...His three pinch-hit home runs are tied for the single-season franchise record (since 1954), joining Sam Horn (1991), Jim Dwyer (1986), Pat Kelly (1979), Sam Bowens (1967), and Whitey Herzog (1962).
- ⚾ **Jeremiah Jackson** leads all Orioles batters with six pinch-hit RBI this season.
- ⚾ The team record for most pinch-hit RBI in a season is 45 in 1982...Miami led the majors with 33 pinch-hit RBI in 2025.

QUICK HITS: Rogers is scheduled to make his 25th start of the season and 127th of his career...Was reinstated from the 15-day Injured List (illness) on May 12...Voted as the winner of the 2025 Most Valuable Oriole Award by members of the local media, joining Randy Myers (1997), Mike Cuellar (1974), and Dave McNally (1968) as the only left-handed pitchers in franchise history to be named Most Valuable Oriole...He was the first pitcher to earn the honor since Rodrigo Lopez (2002).

LAST TIME OUT: Earned the win on August 21 vs. Tampa Bay after tossing a season-high tying 7.0 innings (4x, last: 7/24 vs. ATL), allowing three runs on six hits (1 HR) and one walk with six strikeouts...Threw a season-high 103 pitches, 75 strikes.

⚡ Marked his most pitches thrown since September 19, 2025 vs. New York-AL (106).

⚡ Has permitted exactly one home run in each of his last four starts (23.0 IP) after allowing one long ball over his previous eight outings from June 14-July 29 (49.2 IP).

SEEING RED: Rogers is set to make his fourth career start opposite St. Louis, having gone 0-2 with a 3.00 ERA (5 ER/15.0 IP).

⚡ In two career starts at Busch Stadium, has allowed four runs (3 ER) across 11.0 innings.

THAT'S MORE LIKE IT: Over his last 14 starts since June 4, Rogers is 7-2 with a 2.57 ERA (24 ER/84.0 IP) and 1.05 WHIP.

⚡ Among 52 MLB pitchers who have thrown at least 75.0 innings during that period, his 2.57 ERA is ninth lowest in the majors and fourth lowest in the AL behind TOR's Dylan Cease (1.86), DET's Troy Melton (1.89), and NYY's Cam Schlitler (2.42).

⚡ He went 0-3 with a 10.31 ERA (21 ER/18.1 IP) and .996 opponent OPS across four May starts...Among all MLB starters who made at least four starts in May, his 10.31 ERA was second highest ahead of COL's Kyle Freeland (12.46).

SWEPT AWAY: Rogers has limited the opposition to a .187 (14-for-75) clip on his sweeper...Over his last 14 starts, opponents are 6-for-38 (.158) with a 29.0 percent whiff rate on the offering.

⚡ Overall, he is holding lefties to a .125 (3-for-24) mark with 10 strikeouts on the sweeper, compared to 11-for-51 (.216) with 21 punchouts against righties.

LEFT SIDE STORY: Over his past 11 starts, Rogers has limited left-handed hitters to a .147 (10-for-68) clip with three doubles and 22 strikeouts.

⚡ Over his previous seven starts from May 12-June 14, lefties went 11-for-39 (.282) with two doubles, one triple, one home run, four walks, and seven strikeouts.

⚡ Rogers opened the season limiting left-handed hitters to a .091 (2-for-22) mark with two doubles, three walks, and eight strikeouts over six starts.

SWING AND MISS STUFF: In 11 starts since June 20, Rogers owns a 24.8 percent strikeout rate and 25.5 percent whiff rate...He posted a 16.6 percent strikeout rate and 22.0 percent whiff rate over his first 13 outings.

⚡ Over his last 11 starts, he owns a 29.5 percent strikeout rate on his four-seam fastball, while producing a 26.9 percent whiff rate on the offering...Over his first 13 starts, he owned a 13.8 percent strikeout rate on the heater with a 21.2 percent whiff rate.

TWO-OUT TALK: Opponents are slashing .275/.335/.365 (46-for-167) with seven doubles, one triple, two home runs, and 30 RBI off Rogers with two outs.

⚡ Over his last 14 starts since June 4, however, he has limited the opposition to a .196/.257/.247 (19-for-97) line with two outs after they slashed .386/.442/.529 (27-for-70) over his first 10 outings.

PINPOINT: On July 24 vs. Atlanta, Rogers' 81.8 percent strike rate (72-of-88) marked the highest by any pitcher in MLB this season (min. 50 pitches thrown), ahead of MIL's Jacob Misiorowski on August 2 at Los Angeles-AL (79.5%, 66-of-83).

⚡ Under the same parameter, it was the highest strike rate by an Oriole pitcher in the pitch tracking era (since 2008), ahead of Kevin Gausman's 80.4 percent clip (86-of-107) on May 11, 2018 vs. Tampa Bay.

⚡ From July 24-August 5, Rogers recorded 6+ strikeouts while issuing zero walks in three consecutive starts, tying the longest streak by an Oriole pitcher in franchise history (since 1954) along with Scott McGregor's three-start stretch from July 13-24 (G2), 1979.

⚡ His 62.9 percent ground ball rate is the third highest in MLB (min. 30.0 IP) behind NYY's Tim Hill (66.7%) and TOR's Tyler Rogers (64.3%)

⚡ Has not allowed a home run in a career-high 44 straight games (33.2 IP) since 4/24
