RAY REPORT—The Rays continue a seven-game, two-team homestand against the Giants (2-1) and Angels (4 to play) tonight at Tropicana Field...they are 2-1 so far in a stretch of 13 consecutive games without an off day that concludes on April 24 vs. Detroit.

With yesterday's 9-4 victory over the Giants, the Rays secured their third straight series victory (2-1 at COL, 2-1 at LAA, 2-1 vs. SF) for the first time since Sept. 4-13, 2023 and recorded their first series victory at Tropicana Field since Sept. 19-21, 2023 vs. LAA.

The Rays hit a season-high four home runs in yesterday's win after conceding five long balls in Saturday's 11-2 defeat...it marked the third time in franchise history the Rays allowed 4+ HR in a single game, then hit 4+ HR the very next game (Elias)...it previously happened from April 21-22, 2000 and May 15-16, 2016.

The Rays played a season-high nine runs, their most since scoring 12 in the 2023 season finale at Toronto on Oct. 1.

#42—Tonight, the Tampa Bay Rays and the rest of Major League Ball honor and commemorate the life of Hall of Famer **Jackie Robinson**, who broke baseball's color barrier 77 years ago on April 15, 1947 as a member of the Brooklyn Dodgers.

POWER SURGE—Yesterday, Tampa Bay recorded its first multi-homer effort since April 1 vs. Texas (2HR), snapping a 10-game streak with one homer or fewer.

The Rays 4 HR were their most in a game since July 31, 2023 at Yankee Stadium (4HR) and their most at Tropicana Field since April 11, 2023 vs. Boston (4HR).

René Pinto tallied his first career multi-homer performance and recorded a career-high 4 RBI...he became the first Ray with a multi-homer game since **Jose Siri** on Aug. 9, 2023 vs. St. Louis (2HR) and the first Rays catcher with a multi-homer game since **Francisco Mejía** on July 2, 2022 at Toronto (2HR).

SOUTHPAW SUCCESS—The Rays are 4-2 against left-handed starters this season...they are one of three teams in the AL with four wins against left-handed starters, joining the Guardians and Tigers (both 4-0).

Tampa Bay faced tonight's starter, **LHP Patrick Sandoval**, on April 9 and handed him the loss...he allowed four runs on six hits with three walks and six strikeouts across 5.0 innings.

Isaac Paredes is 5-for-9 (.556) with 1 HR, 3 RBI and two walks and 1 SO in his career opposite Sandoval...min. 8 AB, it marks his highest average vs. any pitcher.

TURNING A CORNER—**Randy Arozarena** drove in a run in yesterday's win, snapping a streak of eight consecutive games without an RBI...he also snapped an 11-game streak without stealing a base.

Yandy Díaz registered a leadoff double in the opening frame, snapping a seven-game run without an extra-base hit...it was his longest stretch without an extra-base hit since a seven-game run from June 18-27, 2023.

After a 1-for-17 (.059) start to the season, **Harold Ramirez** is batting .366 (15-for-41) with 5 RBI and eight runs scored over his last 10 games since April 2.

IN PENCIL, NOT PEN—Tampa Bay relievers have posted an MLB-worst 6.23 ERA (65.0IP, 45ER), ahead of only Colorado (5.97/57.1IP, 38ER).

Rays relievers own a 14.4 pct. walk rate, the highest mark in the AL and second highest in the majors behind the Rockies (14.5%)...their 1.37 SO/BB ratio is second lowest in the majors behind Colorado (1.15 BB/SO).

UNFAMILIAR TERRITORY—Tampa Bay has suffered five losses by 5+ runs this season, the most in the majors ahead of Chicago-AL, Houston, Miami and Toronto (4 each).

The Rays suffered only eight such defeats all of the least season, the fewest in the majors ahead of both Atlanta and Seattle (9G).

BAG BANDITS—The Rays have stolen 17 bases in 21 attempts (81.0%), the second-most thefts in the AL behind the Royals (20SB) and fifth most in the majors behind the Reds (31SB), Nationals (28SB) and Brewers (21SB)...with **Jose Siri** (6SB) and **José Caballero** (5SB), the Rays join the Nationals and Reds as the only teams in the majors with two players having 5+ stolen bases.

The Rays stole at least one base in franchise-record-tying nine straight games to open the year, becoming the first team in the majors to turn the trick since the 1999 Devil Rays (also 9G)...the Rays are just 3-for-5 (60.0%) on stolen base attempts in their last seven games since the streak ended.

THE ROAD AHEAD—The Rays are in the midst of a stretch from April 5–May 30 in which 14 of their 16 series are against clubs that missed the postseason in 2023, having gone 6-3 thus far...12 of those sets are against clubs that were under the .500 mark last season.

With 748 career wins, Rays manager **Kevin Cash** is seven victories shy of surpassing his predecessor, **Joe Maddon**, as the Rays all-time managerial wins leader...the earliest he could reach the milestone is April 21 at Yankee Stadium.

COAST TO COAST—The Rays and Angels continue a seven-game season series tonight at Tropicana Field, with all seven matchups between the clubs coming over an 11-day period...the Rays took two of three games from the Angels in Los Angeles from April 8-10.

Tampa Bay earned a 4-2 season series victory over Los Angeles in 2023...after dropping the season series in 2014 (2-5) and tying in 2015 (3-3), the Rays have won each of the last seven season series (did not play in 2020), going 35-16 (.686) during that time.

Tampa Bay's .686 winning pct. against Los Angeles since 2016 is its highest against any AL opponent during that timeframe, ahead of Detroit (.587, 27-19).

DOWN ON THE FARM—Double-A Montgomery swept the Southern League weekly awards, as **SS Carson Williams** was named Player of the Week and **RHP Cole Wilcox** was claimed Pitcher of the Week honors.

Williams went 10-for-19 (.526) with two doubles, one homer, 3 RBI, eight runs and four steals in five games...rated the No. 19 overall prospect in the majors by MLB.com, the 20-year old Williams ranks among the Southern League in AVG (1st, .444), XBH (1st, 5), hits (T1st, 12), doubles (T1st, 4), OPS (2nd, 1.220), OBP (2nd, .516), total bases (T2nd, 19), runs (T2nd, 10) and steals (T7th, 4).

In his season debut on April 11 vs. Pensacola, Wilcox tossed 5.0 hitless innings, allowing an unearned run on one walk with four strikeouts...Wilcox, 24, is rated the Rays No. 12 prospect by MLB.com.

- Last season, a three-game set between the Rays and Angels in Anaheim was impacted by Hurricane Hilary, resulting in the series concluding with a day-night doubleheader on Saturday, Aug. 19.
- After serving as Tampa Bay's manager from 2006-14, **Joe Maddon** was at the helm for Los Angeles (2020-22) following five seasons managing Chicago-NL (2015-19).
- Guy Gallagher**, the Angels Director, Equipment and Clubhouse Operations, joined Los Angeles after spending the previous 23 seasons as the Rays Visiting Clubhouse Manager. He originally joined the Tampa Bay organization in 1996 as a minor league equipment and clubhouse manager.
- LHP Reid Detmers** threw the 12th no-hitter in Angels history on May 10, 2022 vs. Tampa Bay.
- Angels LHP **Matt Moore** made 96 appearances (94GS) for the Rays between 2011-2016, going 39-28 with a 3.88 ERA (540.0IP, 233ER) and 494 strikeouts...he was selected as an All-Star in 2013 with Tampa Bay.
