### Scoring Position

After going 0-for-3 with runners in scoring position yesterday, Atlanta has gone hitless with RISP in each of its last two games.

The Braves' last hit with RISP was Mauricio Dubón's bases-loaded, go-ahead single off Jacob Misiorowski on Friday night.

Atlanta has batted below its season average (.277) with RISP in each of its last seven games, and in 10 of its last 11 games overall.

The team's .277 batting average with RISP is still the third-best in MLB behind Minnesota (.287) and Milwaukee (.281).

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Braves and Padres today begin a three-game midweek series with the first of seven scheduled games between the clubs this season...The Braves will host the Padres at Truist Park for a four-game set from July 20-23.

*A* Atlanta took two-of-three games from the NL Central-leading Brewers over the weekend...Jacob Misiorowski and Kyle Harrison owned two of the NL's top eight ERAs entering the series (min. 65.0 IP), and the Braves took both games against them.

*A* The Braves went 1-6 against the Padres in 2025... Their only win, 7-1, occurred at Truist Park on May 24...San Diego outscored Atlanta 25-18 during the season.

*A* Prior to last year's season-opening sweep here, Atlanta hadn't lost a series to the Padres at Petco Park since 2018...Since 2019, the Braves are 4-1-1 in sets here.

*A* RH Michael King is slated to square off against the Braves for the third time (second start) in his career...The right-hander is decisionless against the club with a 4.26 ERA (3 ER/6.1 IP)...He earned the Opening Day start against Atlanta last season and pitched just 2.2 innings...He walked four batters and allowed three runs, all earned...A native of Rochester, NY, King's other appearance against the Braves came in relief for the Yankees...He covered 3.2 scoreless innings in a Braves win, 2-0.

*A* RH Grant Holmes will face San Diego for the third time (second start)...He enters play 1-0 with a 1.13 ERA (1 ER/8.0 IP) versus the Padres...He beat the Padres in Atlanta's only win against them last year...A native of Conway, SC, Holmes last pitched on June 16 versus San Francisco...He covered 2.0 innings before the game was suspended due to rain.

**SUAREZ RETURNS:** Braves reliever Robert Suarez today returns to San Diego after pitching the first four seasons of his major-league career here...In total, he appeared in 206 games for the Padres, posting a 2.60 ERA (70 ER/242.0 IP) with 81 saves...From 2024-25, Suarez's 76 saves were the most in MLB.

*A* Suarez logged a single save in his first two seasons as a Padre...Despite playing just four seasons with the team, Suarez ranks seventh on San Diego's all-time saves leaderboard behind Trevor Hoffman (552), Heath Bell (134), Rollie Fingers (108), Rich Gossage (83), Huston Street (80) and Mark Davis (78).

*A* Suarez, an All-Star in each of the last two seasons, pitched twice in last season's opening series against Atlanta, converting both save opportunities without allowing a hit.

*A* Since 2018, Suarez is one of just five pitchers to record at least 35 saves in back-to-back seasons alongside Emmanuel Clase, Jordan Romano, Kenley Jansen and Liam Hendriks.

**ALL-STAR BALLOTS:** Major League Baseball today announced a voting update in Phase 1 of All-Star balloting...Three Braves are currently the leading vote-getters at their respective positions: catcher Drake Baldwin, second baseman Ozzie Albies and outfielder Ronald Acuña Jr...First baseman Matt Olson and outfielder Michael Harris II are also in position to advance to Phase 2 of voting.

*A* The top two vote-getters at each infield position will advance to Phase 2 of voting, while the top six outfielders will also advance.

*A* Atlanta's three first-place vote-getters at present are the second most of any team in baseball behind the Los Angeles Dodgers (4).

*A* In addition to Baldwin, Albies and Acuña Jr., three additional NL vote leaders also have Atlanta ties...Shortstop CJ Abrams (WSH) was born in Alpharetta, GA and attended Blessed Trinity Catholic HS in Roswell, GA...Outfielder Brandon Marsh (PHI) was born in Buford, GA and attended Buford HS...First baseman Freddie Freeman spent his first 12 major-league seasons as a Brave from 2010-21.

*A* Several other Braves are in contention to advance to Phase 2 of voting at their positions...Third baseman Austin Riley is in third place (572,816 votes), designated hitter Dominic Smith is in third place (599,893 votes) and outfielder Mauricio Dubón in 11th place (667,778 votes).

**STARTING DIFFERENTLY:** Atlanta today returns to San Diego for the first time since it began the 2025 season here at Petco Park...The Braves were swept by the Padres in four games, the beginning of a seven-game losing streak to begin the season...The Braves were swept in three games by the Los Angeles Dodgers in the following series.

*A* In 2026, the Braves started 5-2 in games against the Royals, Athletics and Diamondbacks and played to a +27 run differential.

*A* Both of San Diego's confirmed starters for this series, Michael King and Randy Vásquez, started against Atlanta in that season-opening series...King pitched Opening Day and allowed three earned runs in just 2.2 innings...Vásquez pitched 6.0 scoreless innings in Game 3.

*A* The Braves were the final team in baseball last season to secure a win...The team started 0-7 for the fifth time in modern-era franchise history (since 1900), and for the fourth time since moving to Atlanta in 1966...The club opened a franchise-worst 0-10 in 1988.

*A* Seven days into its season, Atlanta owned a -18 run differential and was already facing a 5.5-game deficit in the National League East...The year snapped the club's string of seven consecutive postseason appearances and stood as Atlanta's first losing season since 2017.

#### Today's Game

- Makes his 15th start of the season and the 43rd of his career in the opener of a three-game series at San Diego.
  - Has made two career appearances against San Diego, both in 2025, going 1-0 with a 1.13 ERA (1 ER/8.0 IP)...In his lone start, he allowed one run over 7.0 innings and struck out six in a 7-1 Atlanta win on May 24.
- Took the loss in his most recent outing June 16 against San Francisco, allowing three runs on four hits over 2.0 innings with three walks and two strikeouts on 55 pitches in a 7-2 defeat...The series opener was suspended by rain after the second inning and completed the following day with the bullpen.
- Has posted five quality starts over 14 turns this season, going 4-3 with a 4.33 ERA (33 ER/68.2 IP) and 61 strikeouts...Is holding opponents to a .243 average (64-for-263).
- Has issued 32 walks and surrendered 13 home runs through 14 starts, equating to a 4.19 BB/9 and a 1.70 HR/9.
- Has generated 41 of his 61 strikeouts this season with his slider, the fourth-most in the National League prior to tonight's game.
  - Opponents are missing 40.9 percent of their swings against the pitch, the third-highest slider whiff rate among pitchers with at least 400 thrown.
- Opponents are batting .198 (22-for-111) with a 2.97 ERA (10 ER/30.1 IP) against him the first time through the order this season.
  - The second time through, opposing hitters are batting .320 (33-for-103) with a 7.30 ERA (20 ER/24.2 IP).
- Has held opponents 0-for-8 with the bases loaded in 2026.
- Enters with a streak of 35 consecutive appearances issuing at least one walk, dating to March 31, 2025.
- His 42 career starts for the Braves are the most in Atlanta-franchise history by a South Carolina-born player.

#### 2026

- Took the loss June 16 against San Francisco, allowing three runs on four hits over 2.0 innings with three walks and two strikeouts on 55 pitches in Atlanta's 7-2 defeat...The series opener was suspended by rain following the second inning and completed the next day...Arraez's double was the lone extra-base hit allowed.
- Received a no-decision June 9 at Chicago (AL), allowing three runs on four hits over 3.2 innings with two walks and two strikeouts on 67 pitches in Atlanta's 6-5 loss in 10 innings at Rate Field...Made his first career start against the White Sox and his first appearance at the ballpark...Surrendered a two-run home run to Vargas in the third.
- Recorded his 250th career strikeout June 3 against Toronto, earning the win after allowing two runs on five hits over 6.0 innings in a 7-3 victory for his fifth quality start of the season.
- Recorded the third 10-strikeout game of his career and his first of 2026 on May 23 against Washington, fanning the side in order in the first inning - the first such frame by a Braves pitcher since Bryce Elder on May 4, 2025.
- Reached 200 career strikeouts April 3 at Chase Field in Arizona.
- Went 1-0 with a 1.02 ERA in five spring appearances (four starts), fanning 20 over 17.2 innings with just one walk.

#### Career Recap

- Awards: Midwest League Midseason All-Star (2015); Texas League Pitcher of the Week (July 30, 2017).
- In his MLB debut season in 2024, went 2-1 with a 3.27 ERA (11 ER/30.1 IP) in 26 relief appearances and one start...Was recalled by Atlanta from Triple-A Gwinnett on August 8, 2024.
- In 2022, pitched for three different minor league teams throughout the Oakland and Atlanta organizations...Separately, went 1-2 with Triple-A Las Vegas before joining the Braves system.
- Pitched the entire 2021 season for Triple-A Las Vegas and saw more relief appearances (29) than starts (7) for first time in career.
- Set career highs and led the team in games (50) and saves (13) in 2023 with Triple-A Gwinnett...Led all Strippers relievers in strikeouts (74).
- Named Gatorade Player of the Year in South Carolina following his senior year in 2014.
- Selected by the Los Angeles Dodgers in the first round (22nd overall) of the 2014 June draft (Conway High School, SC).
- On August 1, 2016, traded by the Dodgers to the Oakland Athletics along with RHP Frankie Montas and RHP Jharel Cotton for OF Josh Reddick and RHP Rich Hill.
- Pitched 10 seasons in the minors before making his MLB debut.
- Signed by the Atlanta Braves as a minor league free agent on August 13, 2022.
