The Brewers are 7-1 in their last 8 home games and are on a season-high 5-game home winning streak.

Walk Like A Man

The Brewers drew a season-high 11 walks last night, their most since walking 11 times in a 9-4 win on 9/2/18 at Washington.....the team walked 6 times in the seventh inning, tying the franchise record for an inning, now done three times: also 5/19/77 vs. Toronto (3rd inning) and 9/21/06 vs. San Francisco (5th inning).

Christian Walker

Christian Yelich has walked in 6 consecutive games (9 walks).....his 25 walks this season tie **Luis Urias** for the team lead.....Yelich has a .395 OBP on the season despite a .235 BA.

Captain Narvel

All-Star candidate **Omar Narváez** is batting .319 with 6 HR and 17 RBI in 44 games this season.....he ranks among the MLB top three as a catcher in OBP (2nd, .416), SLG (T2nd, .531) and OPS (3rd, .947).....the team has gone 24-12 in his starts.

Dan The Man

Daniel Vogelbach is on a career-high 7-game hitting streak during which he is batting .308 (8-for-26) with 3 HR and 4 RBI.....he is just a game away from tying **Jackie Bradley Jr.** and **Kolten Wong** for the longest hitting streak by a Brewer this season.

AT HOME: The Brewers are 18-15 at home, going 3-5-2 in series play.....the team is 7-1 over its last 8 home games with a current season-high 5-game winning streak.....had a season-high 3-game home losing streak from 5/13-5/15.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 18-12 on the road, going 8-2-0 in series play.....had a season-high 6-game road winning streak from 5/22-6/8.....had a season-high 5-game road losing streak from 5/3-5/7.

MANAGER: **Craig Counsell** is in his seventh season as manager (470-439) and sixth full season.....he is second in franchise history in wins, trailing Phil Garner (563-617).....under Counsell, the Brewers have made the postseason in three consecutive years for the first time in franchise history.....Counsell was named the 19th manager in franchise history on 5/4/15, replacing Ron Roenicke.....he is signed through 2023.

COACHES: Assistant hitting coach **Jacob Cruz** (2nd season), hitting coach **Andy Haines** (3rd season), pitching coach **Chris Hook** (3rd season), bullpen coach **Steve Karsay** (3rd season), third base coach **Jason Lane** (6th season, 1st as 3B coach), associate pitching, catching and strategy coach **Walker McKinven** (2nd season) and bench coach **Pat Murphy** (6th season) all returned from the 2020 coaching staff.....new to the staff is first base coach **Quintin Berry**.

TODAY’S STARTER: #39 - RHP CORBIN BURNES (10gs, 3-4, 1.97)

BURNES AT A GLANCE: Corbin Burnes, 26, will make his 11th start of the season and first against the Pirates.....Burnes last started last Sunday vs. Arizona and earned a 2-0 win (7ip, 4h, 0bb, 13k, 106 pitches).....his 13 strikeouts marked a career high.....it was his eighth career 10+ strikeout game and fourth this season.....he joined **Dave Bush** (2008) and **Yovani Gallardo** (2012) as the only pitchers in franchise history to have 13+ strikeouts in a game without a walk.....the team is 4-6 in his starts.....he has 7 quality starts.....opponents are batting .166 (35-for-211, 2hr).....he has 94 strikeouts in just 59.1 innings.....he was on the injured list (non-injury related) from 4/29-5/12.....Burnes was selected by Milwaukee in the fourth round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of St. Mary’s (CA) College.

KING CORBIN: Burnes began the season with 58 consecutive strikeouts before walking his first batter (Tommy Edman) on 5/13 vs. St. Louis.....his streak is the longest ever in the Major Leagues (since 1893) to begin a season.....the previous record was 51 strikeouts by reliever **Kenley Jansen** (2017 with LAD).....Burnes also broke the overall record of 56 by **Curt Schilling** (2002 with Ari) and **Gerrit Cole** (2021 with NYY).....Cole since reclaimed the record (61k).....Burnes began the season with 7 consecutive starts in which he had 9+ strikeouts, tying the Indians’ **Shane Bieber** (also 2021) for the second-longest streak in Major League history to begin a season.....**Pedro Martinez** had 9 starts in a row with 9+ strikeouts in 1999 with the Red Sox.

LAST SEASON: Burnes was named Brewers Most Valuable Pitcher by the Milwaukee Chapter of the BBWAA as he went 4-1 with a 2.11 ERA in 12 games / 9 starts.....he finished sixth in National League Cy Young Award voting.....the team went 5-4 in his starts.....he made 4 quality starts.....opponents batted .174 (37-for-213, 2hr).....he struck out 88 batters (9th in NL) in just 59.2 innings.....he fell a third of an inning short of qualifying among the NL ERA leaders (would have ranked 4th).....Burnes was placed on the 10-day injured list on 9/25 with a left oblique strain, ending his 2020 season.

CAREER: Is 15-10 with a 3.76 ERA in 84 games / 23 starts (206ip, 88er).....is in his fourth Major League season (2018-21).....is 7-7 with a 3.12 ERA as a starter (124ip, 43er).

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 8-8 with a 3.96 ERA in 40 games / 13 starts (116ip, 51er).....is 2-4 with a 2.40 ERA in 7 starts this season (41.1ip, 11er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 7-2 with a 3.50 ERA in 44 games / 10 starts (90ip, 35er).....is 1-0 with a 1.00 ERA in 3 starts this season (18ip, 2er).

CAREER vs. PIRATES: Is 3-0 with a 2.67 ERA in 14 games / 2 starts (27ip, 8er).....went 1-0 with a 2.38 ERA in 2 starts vs. Pittsburgh last season (11.1ip, 8h, 3r, 3er, 3bb, 17k).

CAREER AT THE PLATE: Is a .217 (5-for-23) hitter with 2 RBI.....has not homered.....has 2 walks and 11 strikeouts.....has 3 sacrifice bunts.

2021 AT THE PLATE: Is batting .188 (3-for-16) with 2 RBI.....has 2 walks and 9 strikeouts.....has 1 sacrifice bunt.
