YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles beat the Rays, 3-1, in the series opener...The Birds scored all three runs in the sixth inning...Austin Hays delivered a pinch-hit, game-tying single and Jorge Mateo ripped a two-out, two-run double to give the O's their first lead...Albert Suárez surrendered one run over 5.0 innings and **Craig Kimbrel** secured his 13th save of the year and 430th of his career, moving into fifth all-time and snapping a tie with Boston's Kenley Jansen for the most among active players.

COMEBACK KIDS: Baltimore overcame a 1-0 deficit last night to register the 17th comeback victory, tied with the Phillies and Yankees for the most in MLB this season...Since the start of 2023, the 0's have 65 come-from-behind wins, most in the majors during that time.

MONTHLY DUES: With a 17-9 record in May, the 0's have now been above .500 in eight consecutive full months since the start of 2023, the longest streak by the team (min. 10 games played in the month) since May 1982 through September 1983 (11), per the *Elias Sports Bureau*...The current stretch is the longest active in the majors after Atlanta had its streak of 11 since June 2022 snapped with a 13-14 record in May.

TOP GUNN: Gunnar Henderson is tied for second in MLB with 18 home runs behind New York-AL's Aaron Judge (20)...Henderson hit his second career grand slam on Wednesday night (6/13 vs. TOR), his 50th career home run...He ranks among MLB leaders in a variety of

(b) In his 238th game, Henderson became the second-fastest player who began their career as an Oriole to reach 50 career homers behind Ryan Mountcastle (231 G) and the ninth-fastest to reach 50 home runs in an 0's uniform overall, joining Mountcastle, Orioles Legend and National Baseball Hall of Famer Frank Robinson (157), Mark Trumbo (190), Chris Davis (216), Rafael Palmeiro (218), Miguel Tejada (219), Albert Belle (224), and Orioles Hall of Famer Jim Gentile (230); he's the fourth player in O's history to hit 50 career home runs before turning 23, joining Manny Machado, Orioles Legend and National Baseball Hall of Famer Eddie Murray, and Orioles Hall of Famer Rose Parall Orioles Hall of Famer **Boog Powell**.

START ME UP: 0's starters have a 3.01 ERA (102 ER/305.0 IP), the third-best rotation ERA in MI B behind the Phillips (2.60) and Various (2.70). MLB behind the Phillies (2.69) and Yankees (2.72)...In 28 games since April 29, the rotation's ERA is 2.26 (39 ER/155.0 IP), second-best in MLB during that time behind the Yankees (2.19).

THE ERAS TOUR: The Orioles have a 2.73 ERA (77 ER/254.0 IP) in their last 28 games since April 29, the second-best mark in MLB behind the Yankees (2.43)...During that time, the Birds have surrendered an MLB-low 180 hits.

Th club posted a 2.86 ERA (75 ER/236.0 IP) in May, the best mark in a month by the O's since September 2014 (2.67).

HOMER HAPPY: The Orioles rank second in MLB with 79 home runs behind the Yankees (86), the fourth-most homers through the first 55 games of a season in 0's history behind 1996 (87), 1987 (85), and 2016 (80).

The Orioles have eight players with six home runs and six players with at least seven homers, both the most in MLB: Gunnar Henderson (18), Adley Rutschman (10), Anthony Santander (9), and Jordan Westburg (8), Colton Cowser and Ryan O'Hearn (7), and Ryan Mountcastle and Cedric Mullins (6).

LEADING ACTORS: Baltimore leads MLB with six leadoff homers this season...**Gunnar Henderson** has hit five of those, tied with Philadelphia's **Kyle Schwarber** for the most in MLB, and tied for the fifth-most in a single season in 0's history...**Jordan Westburg** has the other opening blast for the Orioles...Since the start of 2021, the Birds have 23 leadoff blasts, ranked fourth in the AL and tied for eighth in MLB.

FEELS GOOD TO BE HOME: The Orioles continue a six-game homestand today with the second of three games against the Rays (1-0)...Baltimore went 2-1 against the Red Sox from Monday through Wednesday before a scheduled off day on Thursday...The O's are 20-11 (.645) at home, the fourth-best home winning percentage in the AL and the fifth-best in MLB this season...The Birds are 69-43 (.616) at Oriole Park since the start of 2023, the best home winning percentage in the AL and fourth-best in MLB during that time.

RAYS UP: Baltimore and Tampa Bay are meeting this weekend at Camden Yards for the first three of 13 games against each other in 2024...The 0's went 8-5 (.615) against the Rays last season, the best record against their AL East rival since 2016 (.684, 13-6)...The Birds will travel to Tropicana Field from June 7-10 (4 G) and August 9-11 (3 G) before the teams complete their regular season series in Baltimore from September 6-8 (3 G).

Ob Of the 13 games in 2023, two games went to extra innings while five games were decided by one run and three were determined by two runs; three games were won in the final at bat for the 0's, including two walk-off victories.

AL BEAST: The Orioles have gone 18 straight sets against AL East opponents without a series loss, while going 13-0-5 in series during that time...That is the longest such streak in team history since divisions were introduced in 1969, per the *Elias Sports Bureau*...The O's are 40-19 (.678) overall against division opponents since the streak began on April 24, 2023...The O's went 32-20 (.615) against the AL East last year, the second-best winning percentage against the division by the team since 1981 behind the .618 (47-29) mark in 2014...The Birds won the season series against the Blue Jays (10-3), Rays (8-5), Red Sox (7-6), and Yankees (7-6), the first time since 2014 that the Orioles won the season series against each of their division apponents (7-0), and faintees (7-0), the first time since 2014 that the offices won the season series against each of their division opponents.

NEED FOR SPEED: Cedric Mullins ranks eighth in Orioles history with 104 career stolen bases; next on the list is Don Baylor (118)...Jorge Mateo is tied with Melvin Mora for 13th in team history with 82 stolen bases as an Oriole; next on the list is Don Buford (85).

Ob The Orioles are one of five teams with multiple players with double-digit stolen bases this year, along with the Nationals (4), Phillies and Royals (3), and Reds (2).
Ob Since the start of the 2022 season, the Orioles are the only team in MLB with multiple players with 60+ stolen bases; Mateo has 77 and Mullins has 64.

WE DO BASEBALL HERE: Oriole Park at Camden Yards drew 764,016 fans in the first 30 games to begin this season, up 27 percent from 602,069 during the first 30 games last year... The 27 percent increase is the second-biggest jump in the league behind the defending NL Champion Arizona Diamondbacks.

THE SKIPPER: Manager Brandon Hyde is in his sixth season in Baltimore...In 2023, he led the O's to an AL-best 101-61 record, their second straight winning campaign and the first time since 1997 that the Orioles claimed the top seed in the AL...He made his Postseason managerial debut in the ALDS, and was named the BBWAA AL Manager of the Year, becoming the fourth Orioles manager to win the award...He was also voted the Sporting News American League Manager of the Year by fellow AL managers for the second consecutive year...Hyde's 351 wins rank fifth all-time among Orioles managers, trailing Hank Bauer (407), Paul Richards (517), Buck Showalter (669), and Orioles Legend and National Responsibility of Foreign Fort Weaver (1480) Baseball Hall of Famer **Earl Weaver** (1,480).

QUICK HITS: Scheduled to make his sixth start of the season this afternoon against the Rays...Has not surrendered a home run since September 14, 2023 vs. Tampa Bay...Made his season debut on May 2 vs. New York-AL...Began the year on the 15-day Injured List (right UCL sprain)...Made three rehab starts, one with Double-A Bowie and two with Triple-A Norfolk, pitching to a 3.97 ERA (5 ER/11.1 IP) with 14 strikeouts and four walks...Went 12-7 with a 2.83 ERA (53 ER/168.2 IP), 168 strikeouts, and a 1.04 WHIP in 30 starts (18 quality starts) for the 0's in 2023 and finished fourth for the AL Cy Young; became the first qualified 0's pitcher with a sub-3.00 ERA since Mike Mussina posted a 2.54 ERA (68 ER/241.0 IP) in 1992...Spent time on the Injured List with a right foot contusion from April 5-19 after being struck by a comebacker in the second inning of his season debut on April 3 at Texas...Acquired by the Orioles along with RHP Kyle Brnovich, RHP Zach Peek, and RHP Isaac Mattson from Los Angeles-AL in exchange for RHP Dylan Bundy on December 4, 2019...Originally drafted by the Angels in the fourth round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of New Mexico State.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned the win in his last start on May 26 at Chicago-AL...Tossed 7.0 shutout and no-hit innings with four walks and a career-high-tying 11 strikeouts (5/10/22 at STL); marked the longest no-hit bid by an Orioles pitcher since John Means took one into the seventh on September 23, 2023 at Cleveland; first 0's pitcher to finish a start with at least 7.0 no-hit innings since John Means' no-hitter on May 5, 2021 at Seattle...Threw 103 pitches, 63 strikes, both season highs.

AGAINST THE RAYS: Slated to make his sixth career start against the Rays...0wns a lifetime 1-3 record with a 6.18 ERA (19 ER/27.2 IP) in his five prior outings against them...Suffered the loss in his last start against the Rays on September 14, 2023 in Baltimore; allowed four runs on seven hits (1 HR) with five strikeouts in 7.0 innings; the four runs allowed in that start are the most he has surrendered in his last 16 outings (5, 7/26/23 at PHI).

AGAINST THE AL EAST: Making his 27^{th} career start against the AL East and first since he faced the Blue Jays on May 15 in Baltimore...0wns a lifetime 4-11 record with a 5.66 ERA (79 ER/125.2 IP) in his 26 prior starts against AL East opponents; the 5.66 ERA is his highest mark against any division; his 3.94 ERA (7 ER/16.0 IP) against the NL West is the next highest...AL East foes are slashing .283/.350/.459 (140-for-495).

AT HOME: Bradish has posted a 5-4 record with a 2.32 ERA (22 ER/85.1 IP) in 15 starts at 0 riole Park since the start of last season... Opponents are slashing .204/.268/.306 (62-for-304) in that stretch.

DAY MAN: Slated to make his fourth afternoon start of the year...Owns a 4-1 record with a 1.75 ERA (15 ER/77.0 IP) in 14 starts during the day since the start of last season

STATCAST STUD: His hard hit percentage is ranked in the 100th percentile (19.3)... Also ranks among MLB leaders in average exit velocity (99th, 83.5), xSLG (99th, .242), xBA(98th, .163), xERA(98th, 2.27), xw0BA(98th, .243), and K% (92nd, 32.1), per Statcast.

REVERSE SPLITS: Bradish is holding lefties to a .163/.280/.233 (7-for-43) slash line this season, while righties are slashing .188/.291/.292 (9-for-48) off him...Has allowed 11 extra-base hits to lefty hitters in his last 20 starts and two in his last eight

2023 HIGHLIGHTS: Appeared on his first career Opening Day roster...Finished fourth in the AL Cy Young voting, earning six third-place, eight fourth-place, and five fifth-place votes; marked the highest finish by an Orioles hurler since Zack Britton finished fourth in 2016...Led the O's in nearly every pitching category last season, including ERA (2.83), strikeouts (168), opponent batting average (.215), on-base percentage (.275), OPS (.605), WHIP (1.04), and quality starts (18)...Ended the campaign ranked among qualified MLB leaders in ERA and WHIP (4th), as well as opponent batting average (7th), and among qualified AL leaders in opponent average (2nd), ERA (3rd), WHIP (4th), and winning percentage (T-8th, .632)...The 168 strikeouts were a career high and the most by an O's hurler since Dylan Bundy fanned 184 batters in 2018...Logged five straight quality starts from August 6 to September 8, the longest such streak of his career...The last longer streak by an Oriole was Alex Cobb's six-gamer from July 26 to August 24, 2018...Had a 16.0-inning scoreless streak to end the regular season. streak to end the regular season.

POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE: Made his Postseason debut as the starter in Game 1 of the ALDS vs. TEX; dealt the loss after allowing two runs on seven hits with one walk and nine strikeouts in 4.2 innings; became the third player in 0's history (since 1954) to strike out at least nine batters in his Postseason debut, joining Mike Boddicker (14, September 6, 1983 vs. CWS - ALCS G2) and Moe Drabowsky (11, September 5, 1966 at LAD - WS G1).

Scheduled to make his 11th appearance and ninth start of the season tomorrow against the Rays...Picked up the win in his last start, tossing 5.0 shutout innings with four hits, three walks, and six strikeouts on May 27 vs. Boston; has won his last five starts after not recording a win since June 10, 2023 vs. Kansas City...Owns a lifetime 1-2 record with a 4.19 ERA (9 ER/19.1 IP) in four career appearances (3 GS) against the Rays...Picked up the win in his last start against them on April 14, 2022 at Tampa (w/OAK), allowing three runs on five hits (1 HR) with two strikeouts in 6.1 innings... Appeared against the Rays in relief once last season, allowing one run on two hits and one walk with two strikeouts in 1.0 inning on June 21 at Tropicana Field.
