**TODAY'S GAME:** Having lost the series, SF seeks a win in the finale this afternoon to salvage a game to end this east coast road trip... the Giants have gone 2-2 on the trip thus far (2-0 in Atlanta and 0-2 here in Miami).

- ▶ Sundays have been kind to the Giants in 2026 as they are 7-4 in their 11 contests on Sundays this season...the .636 win % on Sundays is tied for fourth-best in the Majors...Tampa Bay paces the Majors with a .750 win % (9-3) on Sundays.
- ▶ In the 11 Sunday games, Giants pitching has a 2.94 ERA (33er, 101.0ip).

**SPIDERWEBB:** RHP Logan Webb makes the start this afternoon looking to continue his recent run of success...since coming off the injured list on May 29, Webb 2-0 with a 0.66 ERA (2er, 27.1ip), 23 strikeouts, four walks and a 0.73 WHIP in four starts.

- ▶ In this time, Webb has lowered his season ERA from 5.06 to its current spot at 3.46 entering today's outing.
- ▶ He's worked 8.0 innings each of his last two times out, last pitching a week ago today versus the Cubs in the Giants' 5-1 win...he worked 8.0 innings, allowed one unearned run, struck out seven and didn't walk a batter.
- ▶ In fact, Webb has not walked a batter in either of his last two starts (16.0 innings), has gone 17.0 innings since his last walk (in the 6th inning of his June 3 start at Milwaukee) and has one walk overall in his last three starts (23.0 innings).
- ▶ Like he did last Sunday, Webb will be pitching with his team having lost the first two games of a series trying to salvage the finale...when pitching after a Giants loss in the previous game this season, Webb is 2-0 with a 0.81 ERA (3er, 33.1ip) in five starts (SF is 2-3).

**HOO HOO HOO, YEAH HOO:** OF Jung Hoo Lee went racked up two more hits yesterday and is hitting .469 (38-for-81) with eight doubles, one triple, one homer, nine RBI and 19 runs scored in 20 games since coming off the IL on May 29.

- ▶ Take it back further to before his injury, and Lee's .402 batting average since May 8 is best in the Majors (min. 130 PA) in that time ahead of LAD's Shohei Ohtani (.341) and teammate Luis Arraez (.325).
- ▶ Lee's .331 average for the season is second-best behind MIA's Otto Lopez (.332)...among outfielders with at least 275 plate appearances, Lee's .331 average is best in the Majors while his .361 OBP is 10th-best and his .823 OPS is 11th-best.

**BRYCE, BRYCE, BABY:** IF Bryce Eldridge has reached base safely in 23 of his last 24 games dating to May 23, sporting a .376/.465/.647 slash line with eight doubles, five homers, 14 RBI, 18 runs scored, 15 walks and a 1.112 OPS.

- ▶ The 21-year-old enters today ranking among qualified rookies in average (.306, 2nd), OBP (.393, 3rd), SLG (.529, 2nd) and OPS (.922, 2nd).
- ▶ Lastly, Eldridge ranks among the MLB leaders in June in average (.365, 5th), OBP (.452, T-4th) and OPS (1.055, 12th).

**STREAKALIVE!:** IF Luis Arraez went 1-for-3 yesterday to avoid going hitless for the first time in consecutive games this season.

- ▶ His 73 games to begin the year without being held hitless in consecutive games ties the mark by Willie Mays in 1967 for the fourth-longest by a Giant to start a season since 1940...research courtesy of Elias via Sarah Langs.

**HOP, SKIP & A JUMP:** Following today's finale the Giants will jet back to the Bay Area to enjoy an off day tomorrow before opening up a three-game series versus the Athletics Tuesday through Thursday.

- ▶ SF took two-of-three from the A's in mid-May up in West Sacramento and is 7-2 against the A's dating to the start of last season.
- ▶ The Giants are 5-10 this season versus AL foes this year...their last series against an AL opponent was May 22-24 when they took two-of-three from the White Sox at Oracle Park.

JUNE 21, 2019

Alex Dickerson made his Giants debut, starting in left field and going 3-for-5 with a single, a triple, a grand slam and six RBI. He hit the second grand slam of his career in the 3rd inning off RHP Taylor Clarke and became just the third Giant in franchise history to hit a grand slam in his Giants debut, joining Bobby Bonds (June 25, 1968 vs. LA) and Brandon Crawford (May 27, 2011 at MIL).

**WEBBMASTER:** Is in his eighth season in a Giants uniform and is in the third year of his five-year contract extension he signed in 2023... the 29-year-old is the longest-tenured Giant on the roster after making his MLB debut on August 17, 2019 at Arizona.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Matched a season-high 8.0 innings last Sunday in SF's 5-1 victory over the Cubs...earned his fourth win of the season after limiting batters to one unearned run on seven hits with seven strikeouts...batters were 1-for-8 (single) off his four-seamer with two strikeouts...overall, the outing marked his second straight start in which he threw 8.0 innings and did not issue a walk.

**VS. MIAMI:** Will face the the Marlins for the eighth time in his career...the righty is 1-2 with a 3.61 ERA (17er, 42.1ip) and 40 strikeouts in the seven starts...has pitched just twice at loanDepot park and will make his first start here since April 17, 2023...overall, he is 0-1 with 6.35 ERA (8er, 11.1ip) in two career starts in Miami.

**GUESS WHO'S BACK:** Webb has been dominant since returning from the 15-day IL on May 29, sporting a 0.66 ERA (2er, 27.1ip) with 23 strikeouts, a .168 BAA and 0.73 WHIP in four starts...the stretch helped lower his ERA from a 5.06 ERA in eight starts before the IL stint to his current 3.46 mark...Webb landed on the IL on May 9 and missed 20 games with right knee bursitis in what was his first trip to the injured list since October 2022 (low back strain).

**JUNE BLOOM:** Leads all MLB pitchers with a 0.39 ERA (1er, 23.0ip) in three starts this month...prior to Webb, the last Giants starting pitcher with an ERA 0.40 or lower and at least 20.0 innings pitched in a month was **Ray Sadecki** in March/April, 1968 (0.25 ERA).

**ON A HEATER:** Webb has gone three straight starts with at least 7.0 innings pitched and one or fewer runs allowed for the second time in his career (also April 13-23, 2023)...the only other Giants pitcher to do that since 2016 is **Dereck Rodriguez** in 2018...the last Giant with a streak of four such starts was **Tim Lincecum** in 2011 (SIS).

**STAY GROUNDED:** Has a 55.3% ground ball rate this season, third-best in the Majors behind LAA's Jack Kochanowicz (57.2%) and PHI's Cristopher Sánchez (57.1%) (min. 60ip).

**FIRST IMPRESSIONS:** Has only given up one run (solo HR) in the 1st inning this year, with batters slashing .146/.205/.293 (.497 OPS) off him with six hits, three walks and 16 strikeouts...additionally, leadoff hitters are slashing .154/.154/.282 off Webb...the .154 average is sixth-lowest with pitchers with at least 70.0 overall innings pitched this season.

**HOME VS. ROAD:** Has gone 3-1 with a 2.97 ERA (12er, 36.1ip), .197 BAA and .587 OPS in six starts on the road vs. a 1-3 record and 3.92 ERA in six outings at home...overall through his career, Webb is 40-28 with a 2.92 ERA at Oracle Park (96 games), compared to a 34-29 record and 3.89 ERA in 96 games on the road.

**WORKHORSE:** Since 2022, no pitcher in the Majors has thrown more innings than Webb's 895.1 innings...the next closest pitcher is Framber Valdez, who has logged 851.1 innings...Webb's 93 quality starts and 144 total games started since 2022 are most in MLB over that span.

**TOUGH LUCK:** SF is 4-8 in Webb's 12 starts this year after going 18-16 in his 34 starts a season ago (they were 16-17 in his 33 starts in '24)...since 2022, SF as a team is 71-73 in Webb's 144 starts, yet his 3.24 ERA in that time is sixth-best in MLB among starters (min. 100 GS).

# ROBBIE RAY LHP

2026 RECORD: 5-6, 4.07 ERA

- ▶ Earned the win on June 16 vs. Atlanta...Ray resumed the Giants' suspended game and threw 6.1-scoreless innings, allowing just two hits and two walks with eight strikeouts... it marked just his fifth career appearance out of the bullpen and his first since in the regular season since Sept. 1, 2020 with Toronto at Miami.
- ▶ Is slated to make his ninth career start against the Athletics...is 2-3 with a 3.23 ERA (17er, 47.1ip) and 61 strikeouts...his last start against the Athletics came on July 30, 2024 when he allowed four runs in 4.1 innings of work in the Giants' 5-2 loss to the A's.
