RAY REPORT—The Rays conclude their six-game road trip to California against the Angels (1-2) and the Dodgers (0-2, one to play) today at UNIQLO Field at Dodger Stadium...return home with an off day tomorrow before embarking on a span of 23 games in 24 days, a stretch that begins with a season-long 10-game homestand against the Nationals (June 19-21), Royals (June 22-25), and Diamondbacks (June 26-28)...despite dropping 14 of their last 21 games (May 24-pres.), they are tied for the fifth-best start to a campaign in franchise history (also: 2008)...after starting 27-13 in their first 40 games (March 26-May 11), they are 14-16 in their previous 30 games (May 12-pres.)...had the best record in the AL for 35 straight days between May 9-June 12, which included eight consecutive days leading the majors from May 18-25...are 2.5 games behind the Yankees for first place in the AL East...have spent 41 days leading the division, 29 in second, six in third, four in fourth, and three in fifth.

* The Rays fell 1-0 to the Dodgers last night, their first 1-0 defeat since July 12, 2025 at BOS and their fifth shutout loss of the campaign.

* **Drew Rasmussen** extended his scoreless innings streak to 19.0 frames before allowing a solo home run...per Elias, it is tied for the ninth-longest streak in the majors this season and is tied for the third longest in the AL (also: BOS **Ranger Suarez**), behind LAA **Jose Soriano** (25.2IP) and teammate **Shane McClanahan** (23.2IP).

* It marked the second Rays loss this season when a starting pitcher throws 7.0 innings or more (also: Rasmussen, May 24 at NYY).

* Despite the one-run loss, the Rays are still 10-6 (.625) in one-run contests this year, the third-best record in the AL behind the White Sox (14-6/700) and Astros (7-4/636).

* All five runs allowed this series have come on three home runs...130 of the 305 runs (42.6%) the Rays have allowed this season have come via the long ball...only six teams in the majors have allowed a higher pct. of runs on homers (see table on the right).

* With 92 games left in the season, the Rays have the sixth-easiest remaining schedule (.489 opp. winning pct.).

THREE-ARMED MONSTER—The Rays three probable starters this series (**Nick Martinez**, **Drew Rasmussen**, and **Shane McClanahan**) have combined to go 18-9 with a 2.78 ERA (227.0IP, 70ER) and 200 strikeouts to 49 walks in 41 starts this season...together, they have produced 17 quality starts, more than five major league clubs have as a team (ATH - 16, NYM - 16, SD - 14, WSH - 12, COL - 9)...the trio combined have more starts with one or zero runs allowed (21GS) than starts yielding two runs or more (20GS).

* Today's probable starter, McClanahan, is coming off of his first time being handed a losing decision in back-to-back starts in a single season since July 31-Aug. 6, 2022...he has allowed two walks or fewer in 10 straight starts (April 19-pres.) after conceding three or more in each of his first three starts to begin the campaign...his six wins are tied with Martinez and Rasmussen for most on the team and are tied for eighth in the AL.

* McClanahan is four strikeouts from tying **Tyler Glasnow** (526) for eighth-most strikeouts in franchise history...the southpaw is 40 strikeouts behind **Chris Archer** (562) for the fourth-most strikeouts by a Rays pitcher through his first four major league seasons.

* The left-hander is looking to become the 11th pitcher in team history to record 40 wins in a Rays uniform...with a win today, he would tie **Jeremy Hellickson**, **Jeff Niemann**, **Jake Odorizzi**, and **Ryan Yarbrough** (each 40) for seventh most in club history.

ALL THE RAS-LEDAZZLE—In three starts this June, **Drew Rasmussen** paces the AL in ERA (0.43/21.0IP, 1ER), strikeouts (29), innings pitched, quality starts (3), and strikeout-to-walk ratio (29.00/29SO, 1BB)...he also ranks highly in wins (1st, 2), WHIP (2nd, 0.48), opp. on-base pct. (2nd, .153), opp. slugging pct. (2nd, .171), opp. OPS (.324), and opp. average (3rd, .129)...his 0.43 ERA is on pace to be the best ERA in a month in franchise history (min. 30.0IP), the lowest in the AL since OAK/HOU **Scott Kazmir** (0.26) in July 2015, and the lowest by an AL right-hander since OAK **Cory Lidle** (0.20) in August 2002.

* He is the second Rays arm in team history to throw 20.0 innings or more, one or zero runs allowed, and 29 strikeouts or more in a three-start span, joining **Blake Snell** (June 25-July 7, 2018 - 21.2IP, 1R, 29SO)...his 29 strikeouts over a three-start span are the most since **Tyler Glasnow** (31SO, June 25-July 7, 2023), and he is the fourth Ray (5x, see table on the right) to have 29 strikeouts or more with one or zero walks in a three-start span.

* On the season, he paces AL arms in opp. average (.192/51-for-266) and WHIP (0.88), while ranking highly in opp. slugging pct. (.301), strikeout-to-walk ratio (5.92), and ERA (5th, 2.71/73.0IP, 22ER)...he is seeking to become the third pitcher in franchise history to be named an All-Star in consecutive seasons alongside McClanahan (2022-23) and **David Price** (2010-12).

THE GREAT YANDINO—**Yandy Diaz** ranks highly among AL designated hitters (min. 200PA, min. 50% of games as DH) in hit-by-pitches (1st, 7), average (2nd, .314), hits (2nd, 81), home runs (2nd, 12), RBI (2nd, 46), on-base pct. (2nd, .390), slugging pct. (2nd, .502), OPS (2nd, .892), OPS+ (2nd, 130), doubles (3rd, 11), and walks (3rd, 27)...in Monday's All-Star balloting update, he ranked third behind HOU **Yordan Alvarez** and TOR **George Springer**...he is seeking his second All-Star nod (also 2023).

* He had his 27-game on-base streak (May 12-June 14) snapped Monday vs. LAD...it was the longest active streak in the majors and tied with ATL **Ronald Acuña Jr.** (27G, April 7-May 22) for the third longest in the majors this year...it was tied for the second longest of his career (also: June 3-July 4, 2025), behind a 29-game streak between May 26-June 28, 2024...it marked Diaz's third on-base streak of 25 games or more in his career, tied for the most in franchise history with **Evan Longoria**.

* Diaz's four leadoff homers are fourth most in the majors to MIN **Byron Buxton** (6), LAD **Shohei Ohtani** (5), and WSH **James Wood** (5)...three of those blasts have come in his last 17 games...he needs two more leadoff homers over the Rays final 92 games to match **Corey Dickerson's** club record set in 2017 (6).

* His .390 on-base pct. is on pace to be the 10th-best on-base pct. at the All-Star break in team history (min. 250PA) and the best since **Jonathan Aranda** produced a .399 OBP before the break in 2025.

JUNIOR CIRCUIT HITTER—**Junior Caminero** has reached base in 12 of 14 games in June, including eight straight (June 8-pres.)...in 70 games this season, he has reached base safely in 59 of them and hit safely in 54 of them...only MIA **Otto Lopez** (58), KC **Bobby Witt Jr.** (58), and TOR **Ernie Clement** (55) have hit safely in more games this season...the Rays are 34-20 when he tallies a hit and 12-5 when he tallies multiple hits...the club is 18-6 when he registers an extra-base hit.

* Among all AL third basemen (min. 200PA, min. 50% of games at 3B), he ranks highly in OPS (1st, .860), OPS+ (1st, 137), on-base pct. (2nd, .371), slugging pct. (2nd, .489), home runs (T2nd, 15), runs (3rd, 43), and average (4th, .273/72-for-264)...he is looking to become the first Ray to start back-to-back All-Star games.

* Caminero notched his 50th career double Monday...he is one of 23 players since 2000 to have 50 doubles or more and 50 home runs or more before the end of their age-22 season...alongside MIL **Jackson Chourio** (75 2B, 51HR), who joined the group on June 13 with a multi-homer game, they are the first to turn the trick since SEA **Julio Rodriguez** (62 2B, 60HR) in his age-22 season in 2023...Caminero will turn 23 on July 5.

CALIFORNIA DREAMIN'—The Rays finish their six-game stay in Southern California against the Angels (1-2) and Dodgers (0-2, one to play) today...this series marks just the fifth time in franchise history (0-3-2) the Rays have played at Dodger Stadium (Aug. 23-25, 2024; Sept. 17-18, 2019; July 26-27, 2016; and Aug. 9-11, 2013)...the Rays are 0-2-0 in series in the state of California this season (1-2 at LAA, 0-2 at LAD) after going 4-0-0 in 2025 against the Giants (Aug. 15-17, 2-1), Athletics (Aug. 11-13, 2-1), Angels (Aug. 4-6, 2-1), and Padres (April 25-27, 3-0)...they return to the state one more time this season against the Athletics (Aug. 10-12) at the tail end of a nine-game road trip.

* In eight games opposite the Dodgers, **Junior Caminero** has slashed .355/.375/.742 (11-for-31) with 3 2B, 3HR, 4 RBL, 1BB, and 7 R...he has reached base in each of his last four games against the Dodgers, tied for the fourth-longest on-base streak by a Ray against the Dodgers in team history (last: **Taylor Walls**, 6G - Aug. 2, 2025-June 16, 2026)...he homered in back-to-back games at Dodger Stadium from Aug. 23-24, 2024, marking the first time in his career he homered in consecutive games.

10 FOR 10—After an off day tomorrow, the Rays will begin their longest homestand of the season with 10 games in 10 days against the Nationals (3G), Royals (4G), and Diamondbacks (3G)...they are an MLB-best 24-9 at home and have won 20 of their last 25 at Tropicana Field...the last time they won 21 in a span of 26 home games was April 8-May 26, 2023.

* The Rays have won or split seven straight home series (4-0-3) against the Nationals/Expos dating back to 2000...the only series the Nationals/Expos franchise has won at Tropicana Field was between June 5-7, 1998...the Rays are 20-14 since the Nationals relocated to Washington D.C. and have taken eight of the last nine contests (April 3, 2023-pres.).

TODAY'S START—Shane McClanahan will toe the rubber for his 14th start of the season and eighth on the road...will be making his 88th career start and 42nd on the road...missed the last two years after his second Tommy John surgery wiped out his 2024 season and nerve-related issues sidelined him for 2025...selected by the Rays in the Compensatory Round (31st overall) of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of South Florida.

- With a win today, McClanahan would be tied for the seventh-most wins in franchise history (40) with **Jeremy Hellickson**, **Jeff Niemann**, **Jake Odorizzi**, and **Ryan Yarbrough**.
- McClanahan's 19 career wins in daytime starts are tied for ninth-most among AL pitchers since 2021, matching SEA **Luis Castillo**...with a win today, he would become one of three pitchers in franchise history with 20 day-game wins or more, joining **James Shields** (31) and **David Price** (27).
- His 522 career strikeouts are ninth most in franchise history, four shy of eighth-ranked **Tyler Glasnow** (526SO).
- Min. 50.0 IP, his 0.42 HR per 9.0 IP ranks second in the AL to NYY **Max Fried** (0.15) and fifth in the majors...has allowed 2 HR his last 53.0 IP.

LAST TIME OUT—Was dealt his second consecutive loss on June 12 at MIA after tying season highs in runs and hits (L, 4.0IP, 8H, 4ER, BB, 7SO), matching his totals from April 19 at PIT and June 6 at MIA...marked the third time in his career he has given up 4 ER or more in back-to-back starts (last: Sept. 20-25, 2022, 5ER/4ER)...threw 62 pitches over the first three innings and reached 99.0 mph on his four-seam fastball, his highest velocity since being sidelined in 2023.

- He issued the same number of walks (11BB) over his first three starts (March 31-April 14) as in his last 10 outings combined (April 19-pres.) with 53 strikeouts...recorded 3.43 walks per 9.0 IP over his first three starts compared to 1.97 in his last 10 outings.

COAST TO COAST—Today will be his first career start against the Dodgers...is 2-0 with a 0.71 ERA (12.2IP, 1ER) and 10 strikeouts in two career starts against NL West competition, the only division McClanahan has never lost to...took the mound against one NL West foe this year, firing 6.0 scoreless innings on May 1 vs. SF (W, 6.0IP, 5H, OR, 5SO).

- In 10 ABs, he has limited LAD **Shohei Ohtani** to a .200 average (2-for-10, 2B, RBI, BB, 2SO).
- Dodger Stadium will be the 23rd major league stadium McClanahan has pitched in during his career.
- Through seven road starts, McClanahan is 1-4 with a 4.32 ERA (33.1IP, 16ER) and a .242 opp. average (32-for-132).

NATIONAL PASTIME—In five starts against NL opponents this season, McClanahan is 1-3 with a 4.50 ERA (24.0IP, 12ER) opposed to 5-1 with a 2.48 ERA (40.0IP, 11ER) in eight starts when facing AL foes...in his career, he is 9-4 with a 2.57 ERA (101.2IP, 29ER) and 118 strikeouts against the NL...among major league southpaws (min. 100.0IP), McClanahan's ERA vs. NL clubs ranks fourth since 2021, behind ATL **Chris Sale** (2.28), ATL **Dylan Lee** (2.42), and HOU **Josh Hader** (2.50).

- His .222 (83-for-374) opp. average against the NL ranks third among AL pitchers since 2021 (min. 100.0IP) behind NYY **Carlos Rodon** (.203) and DET **Tarik Skubal** (.210) and his nine career wins against the NL rank sixth.

SUPPORTING OUR STARTER—McClanahan has received three runs of support or more in 44 of his 87 career starts...in those 44 outings, he holds a 34-1 record, 2.74 ERA (246.1IP, 75ER), .212 (194-for-915) opp. average, 1.07 WHIP, and 271 strikeouts to 69 walks...in games where he receives three runs of support or more, the Rays are 40-4 and have won 20 of the last 21 (Aug.13, 2022-pres.).

- Since his rookie season in 2021, McClanahan has the fourth-best run support average (5.36) among AL southpaws (min. 250.0IP), behind NYY **Max Fried** (6.69), NYY **Carlos Rodón** (5.72), and CLE **Logan Allen** (5.68).

MASTERPIECE OF A MONTH—During May, McClanahan went 4-0 with a 1.41 ERA (32.0IP, 5ER) across six starts, the lowest ERA among AL pitchers (min. 30.0IP), while also ranking among AL starters in WHIP (4th, 0.84), opp. on-base pct. (5th, .231), and run support average (6th, 7.03).

- Was one of three MLB starters and the lone AL starter to post four starts or more of 5.0 scoreless innings or more in May, alongside MIL **Jacob Misiorowski** (5GS) and PHI **Cristopher Sánchez** (5GS).
- McClanahan's 1.41 ERA in May joined teammate **Nick Martinez** (1.52ERA/29.2IP, 5ER) as the only Rays duo in franchise history to turn in a 1.55s or lower during May (min. 25.0IP).
- Posted the fourth-lowest May ERA in franchise history by a traditional starter (min. 30.0IP), trailing **Rich Hill** (0.78, 2021), **Scott Kazmir** (1.15, 2008), and **Jeremy Hellickson** (1.36, 2011).
- The southpaw has posted his best career numbers in May, going 13-1 with a 1.84 ERA (122.2IP, 25ER) and 134 strikeouts...his 13 wins in the month are nearly double his next-highest total in any month, with seven victories in both April and June... McClanahan's career 1.84 ERA (122.1IP, 25ER) in May is the lowest by a traditional starter (min. 50.0IP) in franchise history...since 2021, his 13 wins in May are tied for the sixth most in the majors.

K MACHINE—He has recorded four strikeouts or more in 11 of his 13 starts this year...his 522 career strikeouts are ninth most in franchise history, four shy of eighth-ranked **Tyler Glasnow** (526SO)...ranks fourth among Tampa Bay left-handers behind **David Price** (1,065SO), **Scott Kazmir** (874SO), and **Blake Snell** (648SO).

- With three strikeouts on May 25 at BAL, McClanahan reached 50 strikeouts through his first 10 starts to a season for the fourth season in a row (2021-23, 2026)...the last Ray to collect 50 strikeouts or more in his first 10 starts was **Shane Baz** in 2025, fanning 52 in that span. 2021, his 13 wins in May are tied for the sixth most in the majors. 2021, his 13 wins in May are tied for the sixth most in the majors.
